HOME PLATE PROJECT—Fifty major league players, including Charlie Morton and Joey Wendle, have teamed up for nearly \$1 million, providing over 4 million meals as part of the "Home Plate Project" initiative to address childhood hunger due to the COVID-19 crisis...the effort is a partnership between MLB, Garth Brooks' Teammates for Kids Foundation and Big League Impact, which was founded by STL Adam Wainwright, and is currently led by Wainwright and TEX Kyle Gibson.

GAMING FOR GOOD–Blake Snell, playing as the Rays in the *MLB The* Show Players League, is 10-2 thus far, including a 9-game winning streak... his 10-2 mark leads the AL East, ahead of TOR **Bo Bichette** (9-3), and is 2nd among all 30 players behind TEX Joey Gallo (11-1)...updated standings, schedule, stats and results are available at <u>mlb.com/playersleague</u>...the two-week regular season schedule features 29 three-inning games, roundrobin style, followed by a postseason similar to the MLB format...fans can watch streams of games throughout the season on a variety of digital platforms, including Twitch and YouTube...games begin at 9 p.m. each night.
