Let's Get Started

The Brewers are beginning their 58th season as a franchise and 29th as a member of the National League....the franchise is 29-27-1 all time on Opening Day, going 12-9 at home (6-5 at American Family Field) and 17-18-1 on the road....the Brewers have gone 13-14-1 on Opening Day since joining the National League in 1998.

The Brewers are 102-58 (.638) since 2022 in Interleague Play, tied with the Dodgers for the best record in the Major Leagues....the team went 28-20 (.583) in Interleague Play last season (T5th in MLB).

Hang Tight

The Brewers begin the season with 24 consecutive games before playing an NL Central opponent (Pittsburgh on April 24)....this will mark the team's third-most games into a season before playing a divisional opponent.

The Vaughn That Got Away

Andrew Vaughn, acquired from the White Sox last June 13, plays against his former team for the first time this afternoon....Vaughn batted .308 with 9 HR and 46 RBI in 64 games with Milwaukee last season after batting just .189 with 5 HR and 19 RBI in 48 games with Chicago.

THIS AFTERNOON'S GAME: The Brewers open the 2026 season with a 6-game, 7-day homestand against Chicago-AL (3g) and Tampa Bay (3g)....following this homestand and an off day next Thursday, the team begins its road schedule with a 6-game trip to Kansas City (3g) and Boston (3g).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted National League Manager of the Year for both 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win the award in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25).... Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he agreed to a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator Jason Lane (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator Jim Henderson (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (8th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (3rd season), lead hitting coach Eric Theisen (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach Matt Erickson (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach Juan Sandoval, hitting coach Guillermo Martinez, hitting coach Daniel Vogelbach and first base coach Spencer Allen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

2025 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 97-65 to finish in first place in the NL Central, 5.0 games ahead of the Cubs....Milwaukee had the best record in baseball for only the second time in franchise history (1982) and set a franchise record for regular-season wins....the team beat the Cubs, 3 games to 2, in the National League Division Series before getting swept by the Dodgers in the National League Championship Series.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 763 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (853), Astros (806) and Yankees (788).

SUMMARY: Are 189-209 all time, including 2-1 last season....have gone 12-2 in the last 14 against the White Sox.

at MIL: Are 95-96 all time, going 7-10 at American Family Field and 88-86 at County Stadium....the team also went 6-3 as the Seattle Pilots at Sick's Stadium in 1969.

at CHI: Are 88-110 all time, going 26-37 at Rate Field and 62-73 at old Comiskey Park....went 2-1 last season and have gone 7-1 in their last 8 games in Chicago.
