TODAY'S GAME: The Giants evened this series with a 6-2 win over the Marlins yesterday.

- ▶ The Giants are 3-2 on this six-game homestand after going 2-1 vs. the Dodgers before splitting the first two games of this series vs. Miami.
- ▶ Giants pitchers have combined for a 3.23 ERA (51er, 142.0ip) over their last 16 games (since April 7)...the 3.23 ERA ranks second-best in MLB over that span.
- ▶ SF hit three homers in yesterday's win (**OF Drew Gilbert, IF Casey Schmitt, OF Heliot Ramos**), the team's most in a home game since September 8, 2025 vs. AZ (five homers).

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Landen Roupp is slated to make his sixth start of the season...he has just one career game vs. the Marlins, tossing a scoreless inning of relief in 2024.

- ▶ Roupp has won three straight starts, posting a 1.06 ERA (2er, 17.0ip), 17 strikeouts and a 0.94 WHIP over that span.
- ▶ The righty allowed just one run on one hit over 5.0 innings vs. LAD in his last start...dating to the start of 2025, Roupp is 3-3 with a 3.12 ERA (20er, 57.2ip) in 11 home starts.
- ▶ In 18 career day games (11 starts), Roupp is 4-3 with a 3.00 ERA (23er, 69.0ip), 68 strikeouts and a 1.32 WHIP.
- ▶ Roupp's most-used pitch is his sinker (40.5%)...he has eight strikeouts, a 28.6% putaway rate and .152 (5x33) opposing batting average with the pitch...Miami's .299 batting average vs. sinkers this season is seventh-best in MLB.

PENMANSHIP: The Giants' bullpen has allowed just three earned runs over their last 11 games (0.70 ERA, 38.1ip, 36 strikeouts and 16 walks)...SF is 6-5 in those 11 games.

- ▶ The Giants' bullpen has a 1.55 ERA (9er, 52.1 ip) over their last 16 games, which is the best bullpen ERA in MLB over that span.
- ▶ Overall, the Giants' bullpen has a 2.98 ERA (30er, 90.2ip) for the season, third-lowest in MLB and second-lowest in the NL entering play today behind the Reds (2.59 ERA).

THE FISH: SF snapped its six-game home losing streak to Miami yesterday...with a victory today, the Giants would win their first home series vs. Miami since May 19-21, 2023 (2-1)...the last time SF won home games vs. Miami on consecutive days was April 22-23, 2021.

- ▶ Miami starter Max Meyer's most-used pitches are his slider (27.7% usage rate) and sweeper (24.7% usage rate)...SF's .581 OPS vs. sliders/sweepers is ranked 23rd in MLB.
- ▶ **IF Luis Arraez** is 4-for-6 with two doubles and an RBI in his career vs. Meyer.
- ▶ **OF Jung Hoo Lee** has a career .405/.488/.595 slash line with six runs, two doubles, a triple, two RBI and a homer in 11 games vs. Miami...**IF Matt Chapman** has a .351/.467/.622 slash line with four runs, four doubles, two homers and seven RBI in 11 games vs. Miami.

IN THE OUTFIELD: All three Giants starting outfielders have homered in this series...since the start of last road trip (April 10), Giants outfielders are slashing .299/.335/.503 with an .839 OPS...the .503 slugging percentage is third-best in MLB over that span.

- ▶ **OF Heliot Ramos** hit his second career homer to right field at Oracle Park yesterday (other being a splash hit on September 15, 2024 vs. San Diego)...since coming off the bench in two straight games at Cincinnati, Ramos is batting .379 (11x29) with six runs, three doubles, three homers, seven RBI and a 1.231 OPS over eight games (since April 17).
- ▶ **OF Jung Hoo Lee** is slashing .404/.436/.615 with eight runs, five doubles, two homers, five RBI and a 1.052 OPS over his last 14 games...the .404 batting average is tied for his best batting average over a 14-game span in his MLB career (also: April 5-19, 2025).
- ▶ **OF Drew Gilbert** tied yesterday's game at 1 in the 5th inning with his second home run of the season...the Giants are 9-3 in games Gilbert records an RBI (5-0 when he homers).

WHAT'S NEXT?: The Giants will head east to Philadelphia following today's game...after an off day tomorrow, the Giants will kick off a three-game series vs. the Phillies Tuesday-Thursday...SF won its three-game home series vs. the Phillies earlier this season 2-1.

- ▶ Dating to 2023, SF is 3-8 at Philadelphia with a -14 run differential (55-69)...SF's last series win at Philadelphia was May 30-June 1, 2022.
- ▶ The Giants will then head south to Florida for a three-game series vs. the Rays (Friday-Sunday)...overall this season SF is 6-6 (.500) on the road.

Johnny Cueto tossed his first shut-out in a Giants uniform and struck out 11 batters in SF's 1-0 win over San Diego. The win marked Cueto's 100th career victory, as he became just 12th Dominican born player to win at least 100 MLB games.

LANDEN ROUPP RHP #65

2026 RECORD: 4-1, 2.28 ERA

WITH SAN FRANCISCO: Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco and made his third career Opening Day roster...he is slated to make his sixth start of the season today after going 4-1 through his first five starts.

LAST START: Won his third consecutive start, which is the longest streak of his career, pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run and one hit against the Dodgers while striking out seven...threw a career-high 106 pitches, surpassing his previous high of 104 which came in his most recent start against LAD prior to Tuesday (July 12, 2025)...over his last two starts against Los Angeles-NL, has a 1.64 ERA over 11.0 IP and 15 strikeouts.

VS. MARLINS: Has appeared in just one game against Miami in his career, in which he came out of the bullpen...tossed a scoreless inning at Miami on September 1, 2024.

STOPPER: Roupp has become a stopper for SF...dating back to last season, Roupp is 8-5 following a loss with a 2.93 ERA (28er, 86.0ip).

ROAD WARRIOR: Through the early going this season, has a 0.50 ERA in three starts on the road (3-0,18.0ip,1er) compared to a 5.59 ERA at home (inflated after a tough start vs. the Mets)...this is the opposite of 2025, as he had a 2.63 ERA (14er, 48.0ip) in nine starts at Oracle Park compared to a 4.76 ERA (31er, 58.2ip) in 13 starts on the road...his 2.63 home ERA ranked as the 14th-lowest among NL pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched at home.

MIXING IT UP: In 2025, Roupp's curveball (thrown 35.7% of the time) was very effective, as opponents were just 29x147 (.197) with 49 strikeouts and a 35.8% whiff rate against it...this season, he's mixing his pitches more, throwing the curveball just 27.8% of the time...it's been just as effective, as opponents are 6x34 (.176) off the curve with a 33.3% whiff rate... the big change is his cutter usage, which has increased from 6.7% in 2025 to 12.3% through five starts in 2026...while opponents are 5-for-8 (three singles and two doubles), the pitch helped the rest of his repertoire, as hitters have struggled off his sinker (5x33, .152) and curveball.

2025 SEASON: Was the Giants' fourth starter for most of the season...had his year cut short after suffering a left knee bone bruise in his start on August 20 at San Diego...the injury shut his season down and he went 7-7 with a 3.80 ERA (45er, 106.2ip), 102 strikeouts and 45 walks allowed in 22 starts (eight quality outings)...the Giants went 12-10 in his outings.

AIN'T NOBODY GOT TIME FOR THAT: With the bases empty, Roupp averaged 11.9 seconds between pitches in 2025, which was tied for the second-quickest in the Majors...Cincinnati's Brent Suter was quickest with only 11.5 seconds between pitches with the bases empty...he's been a tad slower this year, averaging 12.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty which is still tied for sixth-fastest in MLB...league average thus far in 2026 is 16.1 seconds.

- ▶ Earned his first win as a Giant last Wednesday against the Dodgers...fired 7.0 shutout innings with three hits, five strikeouts and a pair of walks in the dominant start.
- ▶ Will face the Phillies for a second time this season...tossed 5.2 scoreless innings with three hits and six strikeouts in his start against them on April 8 at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Overall, Mahle is 1-1 with a 2.41 ERA and .222 BAA in four career starts vs. Philadelphia.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper
Last Game: 4/24 vs. MIA; 1.0ip, h, bb (24 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-18 (.111) with two walks and six strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .178 clip (69-for-387) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 9-for-18 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup
Last Game: 4/24 vs. MIA; 3.0ip, 3h, r, er, bb, 3k (54 pitches)

- ▶ Tossed a season-high 3.0 innings of relief on Friday.
- ▶ Eight of his 10 appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Has issued at least one walk in seven of 10 contests (5.7 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 10-for-32 (.313) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 3-for-20 (.150).
- ▶ Four of his 10 appearances have been 2.0 or more innings.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter
Last Game: 4/25 vs. MIA; W, 1.0ip, h, bb (23 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are just 1-for-12 (.083) against him this season, and 18-for-95 in his career (.189).
- ▶ Has appeared in 12 of SF's 27 games, tossing 11.0 innings and allowing two earned runs (1.64 ERA).
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 4/24 vs. MIA; 1.0ip, h, bb (18 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed one run on four hits in 12.0 innings with 14 strikeouts and seven walks in 12 games.
- ▶ Owns a 29.8% strikeout rate but also has a 14.9% walk rate...his .172 xBA ranks in the top 6% of MLB.
- ▶ Batters are 1-for-17 with four Ks in ABs that end with his four-seamer...eight of his 14 strikeouts have come w/his knuckle curve.
- ▶ Earned his first MLB win with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief in extras on April 18 at Washington.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup
Last Game: 4/25 vs. MIA; 1.0ip, bb, 2k (21 pitches)

- ▶ Has not allowed a run in his last six appearances dating back to April 8 vs. Philadelphia (6.0ip, 2h, 4bb, 11k).
- ▶ Has appeared in 10 of SF's 27 games, allowing four runs in 9.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 54.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fourth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

#46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter
Last Game: 4/23 vs. LAD; 2.0ip, h, bb, 2k (25 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in six of his seven outings (2er, 10.0ip) and posted a 0.80 WHIP and .182 BAA.
- ▶ Has only walked two batters in 10.0ip this season (5.6% walk rate).
- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with RHP José Buttó being placed on the IL...logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Played for Giants MGR Tony Vitello while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside RHP José Buttó and OF Drew Gilbert in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider
Last Game: 4/25 vs. MIA; 1.0ip, h, r (12 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in 12 of SF's first 27 games and converted three of his four save opportunities.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB...this season it sits at 83.1 mph, which ranks in the top 2% of MLB.
- ▶ Batters are 3-for-19 in ABs that end with his slider (.158) and 7-for-26 (.269) in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his sinker and .207 (18x87) off his slider.
- ▶ In his 44 career save opportunities, Walker owns a 5.74 ERA (27er, 42.1ip)...in his 162 games in a non-save situation, Walker owns a 2.33 ERA (45er, 174.0ip).

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider
Last Game: 4/25 vs. MIA 1.0ip (11 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with five holds on the season.
- ▶ 10 of his 12 appearances this year have been scoreless...opponents are just 4-for-36 (.111) off him this year.
- ▶ Struck out 13 batters in 10.2 innings of work.
- ▶ Batters are just 1-for-20 with 11 K's off his splitter this season.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.

- ▶ Is 0-for-his-last-21 dating to his second at-bat on Tuesday vs. LA... is 1-for-27 (.037) with 13 strikeouts over his last six games.
- ▶ 13 of his 23 hits this year have been for extra-bases (10 2B, three HR)...the 10 doubles are tied for fourth-most in MLB and are second-most in the NL.
- ▶ Has a .153 average and .461 OPS in 15 games at Oracle Park this season...posting a .269 average and .816 OPS in 12 road games.
- ▶ Is usually a slow starter but his 13 XBH in March/April have surpassed his career-best 11 from March/April 2024 (29 games).
- ▶ His 145 home runs as a shortstop since 2021 are most in the Majors ahead of NYM's Francisco Lindor (141).

- ▶ Has struck out just four times over his first 111 PA...hasn't struck out in his last 60 PAs dating to April 8, the longest active streak in MLB.
