SNAKEBITES

RACE AGAINST CANCER 5K REGISTRATION NOW OPEN: The D-backs’ 12th annual Race Against Cancer 5K presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute and benefitting cancer research and patient care is on Sunday, September 28 at Chase Field...register at dbacks.com/race.

D-BACKS MOURN THE PASSING OF JIM MARSHALL: The D-backs lost a member of their family last Sunday as Jim Marshall (May 25, 1931-Sept. 7, 2025) passed away at age 94...his baseball career took him from the field to the dugout to the front office, spanning 8 decades and 72 seasons from 1950-2021.

- Marshall spent the final 26 years of his career, 1996-2021, with the Arizona Diamondbacks as one of the organization's original employees...he helped prepare the D-backs for the 1997 Expansion Draft and assisted Manager Buck Showalter from 1998-2000...as Director, Pacific Rim Operations for 12 seasons from 1996-2007, his responsibilities included introducing the D-backs to Japan/Asia, making transactions to send players to Japan and scouting potential signees in Japan/Asia...he then transitioned to Senior Advisor, Pacific Rim Operations for his final 14 seasons, from 2008-21, and maintained relations with baseball organizations in Australia, Japan, Korea and Taiwan.

SNAKE BITES: Since August 1, the D-backs’ 22-16 (.579) record is the fourth-best record in the Majors, behind the Phillies (26-13, .667), Brewers (25-14, .641) and Red Sox (22-15, .595).

- On August 1, the D-backs were a season-high 13.0 games back in the division and 10.0 games back in the NL Wild Card. . . now the D-backs are 9.5 back in the division and 3.0 back in the NL Wild Card...12 of the D-backs remaining 15 games are against opponents either leading their division or ahead of them in the Wild Card race (Giants, Phillies, Dodgers, Padres).
- The D-backs have won 9 of their last 14 games, since Aug. 27.
- Have won or split 6 of their last 7 series and have 8 series wins in their last 12.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won the series finale in downtown San Francisco, defeating the Giants, 5-3.

- Eduardo Rodriguez** opened the game with 4.1 no-hit innings, the ninth time he’s done so in his career...has now won each of his last 3 starts since Aug. 30, pitching to a 0.49 ERA (1 ER in 18.1 IP) and a .161 opponent batting AVG).
- Geraldo Perdomo** hit his first career leadoff homer in what was his 82nd career game hitting atop the order...he has now homered 5 times in his last 18 games since Aug. 23.
- Gabriel Moreno** went 2-for-4 with a pair of singles and a walk...in 16 games since being activated from the Injured List on Aug. 22, he is hitting .340 (18-for-53)/.966 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 13 RBI and 6 walks.

VS. MINNESOTA TWINS: The D-backs are in Minnesota for their sixth-ever series @ Twins (last: Aug. 4-6, 2023, preceded by road series in 2017, 2014, 2008 and 2003) and their fourth at Target Field (opened in 2010).

- The D-backs’ last win @ Twins was on Sept. 22, 2014 and only won their first-ever series from June 13-15, 2003 (2-1).
- James McCann**, who played in the AL Central for the Tigers (2014-18) and White Sox (2019-20) for 7 seasons, has tallied 27 career extra-base hits vs. Twins, notching 14 doubles, 1 triple and 12 home runs (.466 SLG).

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE: The D-backs currently face the fifth-hardest remaining strength of schedule: Cardinals (.559), Rays (.550), Twins (.535), Red Sox (.530) and **D-backs (.529)**.

START ME UP: The D-backs starting rotation has pitched to an 8-1 record with a 2.66 ERA (24 ER in 81.1 IP), 63 strikeouts, 23 walks and an opponent .230 batting AVG over their last 14 games since Aug. 27...their 8 wins in that time are tied for the Major League lead with the Yankees and Phillies, while their 2.66 ERA leads the NL and ranks third in the Majors behind the Yankees (2.48) and Rays (2.60).

- This 14-game stretch of success has come against opponents with a combined .550 winning percentage (Brewers, Dodgers, Rangers, Red Sox and Giants).
- The starting rotation has posted quality starts in 7 of their last 9 games, 9 of their last 12 and 10 of their last 14.
- D-backs starting pitchers’ streak of 6 straight quality starts from Sept. 1-7 tied their longest since 2017 (also: 6 from April 8-15, 2025), behind 8 straight from Sept. 9-16, 2017.

HIT, RUN, SCORE: Since August 8, the D-backs’ 5.28 runs per game rank fourth in MLB, behind the Mets (6.03), Yankees (5.61) and Tigers (5.32).

- Since August 1, the D-backs’ 82 RBI with 2 outs rank third in MLB, behind the Phillies (94) and Mets (84).
- Since August 1, the D-backs’ 52 runs scored in innings 1-2 are second most in the NL behind only the Mets (58)...the D-backs’ 9 occasions scoring 3+ runs in the first and/or second inning are tied for the most in the Majors in that time.
- The D-backs lead the Majors with 45 homers this season in the 8th inning or later.
- Over their last 6 games since Sept. 5, D-backs 6-9 hitters have combined to hit .310 (27-for-87)/.754 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run and 16 RBI.

CARROLL 2 SHY OF 100 RUNS: **Corbin Carroll**, with 2 more runs scored, would become the third D-back all-time to collect 3+ straight seasons of 100+ runs (also: 121 in 2024, 116 in 2023), to join Luis Gonzalez (1999-2001) and Paul Goldschmidt (2015-17)...no D-back has ever done it 4 seasons in a row.

- Currently, Shohei Ohtani/LAD, Francisco Lindor/NYM and Kyle Schwarber/PHI are the only MLB players to score 100+ runs each of the last 3 seasons (2023-25).

CARROLL’S EXTRA BASES: **Corbin Carroll** has a MLB third-best 75 extra-base hits, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (77) an Aaron Judge/NYY (76)...no D-back has ever led a MLB season in the category.

- His 75 extra-base hits are tied for ninth in franchise history in a single season (with 4 others), behind Luis Gonzalez (100 in 2001), Gonzalez (80 in 2000), Ketel Marte (77 in 2019), Gonzalez (76 in 2003), Aaron Hill (76 in 2012), Stephen Drew (76 in 2008), Steve Finley (76 in 1999) and Jay Bell (76 in 1999).

CARROLL NEARING A 30-30 SEASON: **Corbin Carroll**, at 30 homers and 26 stolen bases, is looking to become the first-ever D-back to have a 30+-homer/30+-stolen base season...since his debut year in 2022, only 7 players have accomplished the feat: Juan Soto/NYM (2025), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (2x - 2023-24), José Ramírez/CLE (2024), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (2024), Ronald Acuña Jr./ATL (2023), Francisco Lindor/NYM (2023) and Julio Rodríguez/SEA (2023).

- Since 2022, he is 1 of 3 players with 2+ consecutive 20+-HR/30+-SB seasons: **Corbin Carroll** (2 - 2023-24), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (4 - 2022-25) and José Ramírez/CLE (2 - 2024-25).

DEPENDABLE DOMO: **Geraldo Perdomo** has played in 146 games this season, 2 shy of his career high of 148 in 2022...his 146 games played are 1 off the MLB lead, held by Rafael Devers/SF, Manny Machado/SD, Kyle Schwarber/PHI, Pete Alonso/NYM and Brent Rooker/ATH (all with 147).

- He has started in the leadoff position 37 times this season, a new career high (previous: 36 in 2023).

SPREADING THE SAVES: The D-backs’ **8 pitchers with 2+ saves** are tied for the most all-time/since 1969 (*when saves became an official stat*) with the 2024 Rays, 2022 Rays, 2003 Tigers, 1979 Dodgers, 1973 Braves and 1970 Indians...the D-backs’ **6 pitchers with 3+ saves** are tied for second most all-time/since 1969 with the 2022 Rays, 2021 Reds, 1992 Braves, 1991 Brewers, 1991 Pirates, 1990 Pirates, 1984 Mariners, 1983 Athletics, 1973 Braves, 1980 Angels and 1970 Indians...the record is 7 pitchers set by the 2003 Tigers [source: Elias Sports Bureau]:

- 2+ SAVES:** Shelby Miller (10), Justin Martinez (5), A.J. Puk (4), Kevin Ginkel (3), Andrew Saalfrank (3), Jake Woodford (3), Anthony DeSclafani (2), Taylor Rashi (2).
- 3+SAVES:** Shelby Miller (10), Justin Martinez (5), A.J. Puk (4), Kevin Ginkel (3), Andrew Saalfrank (3), Jake Woodford (3).

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (7-3, 3.48)

- Is 5-1 with a 2.93 ERA (30 ER in 92.0 IP), 80 strikeouts, 21 walks and an opponent .215 batting AVG (73-for-339) over his last 16 starts since June 13.
- Will make his third career start vs. Twins and second @ Target Field..lost both of his previous outings vs. Minnesota on Aug. 5, 2023 @ Target Field and June 26, 2024 @ Chase Field.

SNAKEBITES

AT A GLANCE: Third season with the D-backs...debuted in May 2023 and made 5 starts in the Postseason (1 Wild Card, 1 NLDS, 2 NLCS, 1 World Series).

- Named the D-backs' 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after leading the organization's farmhands in wins (11), ERA (3.83) and strikeouts (218).
- D-backs' fifth-round pick in the 2020 draft (Bellarmine University).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Making his 30th start...becomes the 12th D-backs starting pitcher all-time with 2+ consecutive 30+-start seasons, most recently Merrill Kelly (2 from 2022-23) and Zac Gallen (2 from 2022-23)...this will be his 80th career start, 16th most in franchise history, having passed Josh Collmenter (75 GS) with Zack Godley next up at 81 starts.

- His career-high 13 wins are tied for third among NL starters with Sonny Gray/STL, Nick Pivetta/SD, Cristopher Sánchez/PHI and Brady Singer/CIN, behind Freddy Peralta/MIL (16), Jesús Luzardo/PHI (14) and Logan Webb/SF (14).
- 10 of his 13 wins have come when the D-backs scored 6+ runs.
- In his last 7 starts, since August 4, has only allowed 2 solo homers...is 1 of 10 pitchers since Aug. 4 to allow 2 or fewer home runs.
- Has 2 straight quality starts vs. interleague opponents as the team won both games on Aug. 20 with a 3-2 win vs. Guardians in 10 innings and on Sept. 6 with a a 5-1 win vs. Red Sox, going 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (3 ER in 13.0 IP), opponent .220 AVG (11-for-50), 0.92 WHIP, 1 walk and 12 strikeouts.
- The D-backs are 4-1 in his 5 career starts vs. AL Central opponents.

LAST START: Extended his career high to 13 wins in his quality start on Sept. 6 vs. Red Sox, allowing 1 run on 6 hits and 0 walks with 7 strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

VS. TWINS: Making his second career start, first @ Target Field.

- Made his last start on June 25, 2024 in a 5-4 win vs. Twins (ND; 4 ER in 6.1 IP, 5 H, 2 BB, 2 K).

30+ STARTS: Becomes the 12th D-backs starting pitcher all-time with 2+ consecutive 30+-start seasons.

- Brandon Webb holds the franchise record with 5 straight seasons (2004-08) followed by Randy Johnson's 4 straight (1999-2002), Ian Kennedy's 3 straight (2010-12) then 2 straight seasons by Brandon Pfaadt (2024-25), Merrill Kelly (2022-23), Zac Gallen (2022-23), Zack Greinke (2017-18), Patrick Corbin (2017-18), Wade Miley (2013-14), Dan Haren (2008-09), Curt Schilling (2001-02) and Andy Benes (1998-99).

ON THE ROAD: Owns a 2.04 walk rate...has walked 1 or fewer batters in 10 of his 14 starts, including 3 starts with 0 walks.

- Has held opponents to 1 or fewer walks in 10 of his 14 starts, including 3 starts with 0 walks.
- Has tossed 5.0+ innings in 8 of his 13 starts, including a career-high 8.0 innings on July 9 @ Padres.

NO WALK PFAADT: Among NL starting pitchers (min. 25 GS), his 33 walks are second fewest to Nick Lodolo/CIN (26).

- His 1.94 walks per 9.0 innings ratio is fifth-lowest in the Majors behind Tarik Skubal/DET (1.40), Zack Littell/CIN (1.52), Bryan Woo/SEA (1.74) and Sonny Gray/STL (1.92) and ahead of Joe Ryan/MIN (1.95).
- Since the start of the 2024 season, his 17 starts with no walks are tied for second in the NL with Shota Imanaga/CHC, behind Miles Mikolas/STL (21).
- Has held opponents to 1 or fewer walks in 20 of his 29 starts.

BY INNING: In his last 6 starts, in innings 4-7, has allowed 4 runs in 13.1 innings (17 H – 0 HR, 3 BB, 15 K).

- In innings 1-2 in his last 10 road starts, since May 17, has held opponents to 7 runs in 20.0 innings (20 H – 1 HR, 1 BB, 17 K).

WINNING WAYS: Secured his 10th victory in 7-3 win vs. Cardinals on July 18 to become the second-youngest D-back starter (26-165), behind Patrick Corbin (23-261, 8 wins in 2013), and sixth overall to collect 7+ wins in their first 10 starts of a season.

APRIL WAS NO JOKE: Had a career-high 5-game win streak from April 4-April 27.

 - Since June 6, limiting lefties to a .154 AVG (4-for-26) with just 1 extra-base hit (2B), 1 walk and 8 strikeouts.
 - Has issued 2 walks to his last 44 left-handed batters faced (34 games since May 20).
 - Has allowed just 1 home run in his last 17 games (64 BF, 0.57 HR/9.0 IP).
