# San Francisco Giants (67-67) at Milwaukee Brewers (76-56)

**TODAY'S GAME:** This afternoon's game versus the Brewers will wrap this three game series and SF's six-game road trip... SF needs a win today to secure a .500 trip having gone 1-2 in Seattle and 1-1 thus far here in Milwaukee.

- ▶ Despite dropping nine of their last 15 games, the Giants are still 18-12 (.600) since July 26, which is tied for fifth-best in the Majors with the Yankees...in the National League only the D-Backs (23-7, .767), Padres (21-9, .700) and Cubs (19-11, .633) have been better in that time.
- ▶ With last night's loss, SF is now 6.5 games back of the Braves for the final Wild Card spot in the NL, with the Mets (69-64, .519) and Cubs (68-66, .507) in between...according to *FanGraphs*, SF's playoff chances have dropped to just 1.7%.

**ROSTER MOVES:** **C Patrick Bailey** (#14) was reinstated from the 10-day IL and **C Andrew Knapp** was designated for assignment.

**TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT:** SF is 2-3 on this road trip with all five games being decided by two runs or fewer and four of the five being decided by a single run.

- ▶ Dating back to August 9 vs. Detroit, eight of SF's 17 games have been decided by one run (3-5 record)...since August 8 at Washington, 11 of SF's 18 games were one-run games at the end of the 8th inning (5-6 record).
- ▶ The Giants have played 70 games this year that have been decided by two runs or fewer, third-most in the Majors behind Milwaukee (73 such games) and Tampa Bay (70 games)...the Giants, however, are 32-38 (.457) in those contests, the sixth-worst win % in two-run games in MLB.

**STRAP IN:** The Giants play 22 of their final 28 games against opponents who are currently .500 or better, with the only exceptions being Miami (48-85) and St. Louis (66-67).

- ▶ The Giants are 34-43 (.442) this year against opponents who are currently at or above .500, 16th of 30 MLB teams.
- ▶ SF and Tampa Bay have toughest remaining schedules in the Majors with their remaining foes having a .540 win %.

**MR. 1,000?: IF Matt Chapman** can reach the 1,000 games played mark this afternoon if he plays.

- ▶ Chapman has accumulated 36.8 bWAR in his eight-year career while hitting 176 homers with a .788 career OPS.
- ▶ Defensively he's won four Gold Gloves and two Platinum Gloves in those eight years...Chapman enters today leading all MLB third basemen in defensive runs saved with 12 according to *Fangraphs*.

**SLINGSHOT...ENGAGED:** With **C Patrick Bailey** returning today the Giants will get one of the league's top catcher's back behind the dish...Bailey has thrown out 19-of-74 (25.7%) potential basestealers this season, including nine of 19 (47.4%) basetealers dating to June 25.

- ▶ The rest of the Giants catchers combined are credited with just five catcher caught stealings and allowed 71 steals.

**BIRD IS THE WORD:** RHP Hayden Birdsong makes the 11th start of his rookie campaign this afternoon in the series finale.

- ▶ Birdsong, who hails from Mattoon, IL which is four hours south of here, has pitched better in his last two starts, allowing one run in 8.2 combined innings...at the same time he's also failed to finish 5.0 innings in either start.
- ▶ In the first game of this road trip on Friday night in Seattle, Birdsong allowed only one hit but walked four in 4.0 innings.
- ▶ He is making today's start on regular rest, something he's done five times so far this year with SF...he has a 1.52 ERA (4er, 23.2ip) in those games but has worked only 23.2 innings due to 15 walks (SIS).
- ▶ Birdsong turns 23 years old tomorrow.

**ANYONE ORDER A RIB EYE?: OF Heliot Ramos** logged his 65th RBI yesterday...Ramos' 65 RBI lead the team and are most by a Giant 24 or younger in a single season since **IF Matt Duffy** had 77 RBI as a 24-year-old in 2015.

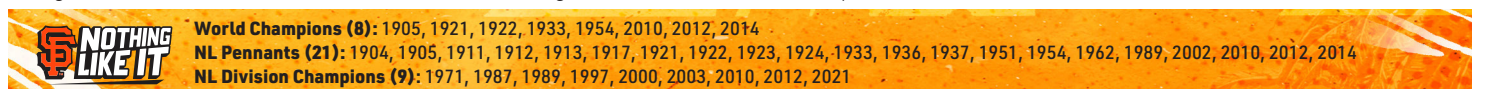
- ▶ The last Giants outfielder 24 or younger to log at least 65 RBI in a season was **Chili Davis** in 1984 (81 RBI also at 24).
- ▶ Ramos has reached base safely in nine straight games dating to August 18 and in 12 of his last 13 games dating to August 13, hitting .306 (15-for-49) with four doubles, one triple, three homers, nine RBI, seven runs scored and three walks.

**ON THE WAY HOME:** The Giants fly back to SF following today's game to open up a six-game, seven-day homestand against the Marlins and D-Backs on Friday night vs. Miami.

- ▶ Friday begins a stretch of just over three weeks where the Giants don't leave the state of California...after the homestand they'll fly down to San Diego for a quick three-game set before returning to SF for another six-game homestand.
- ▶ After its three-game series with the Miami this weekend, SF plays 21 straight games against teams in playoff position before wrapping the year with the Cardinals for three games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ SF is 38-28 in the home confines this year but is 5-5 in its last 10 games there dating to August 9.

**AUGUST 29, 1977** - Wisconsin-born Giants Broadcaster **Duane Kuiper** hit the only home run of his 12-year Major League career while playing for Cleveland on this date in 1977. # HAYDEN BIRDSONG RHP #60

2024 RECORD: 3-3, 4.57 ERA

Height/Weight: 6-4/215 Bats/Throws: R/R

**TODAY'S START:** The 22-year-old is scheduled to make his 11th big league start today...he's gone 3-3 with a 4.57 ERA (23er, 45.1ip) in his 10 starts, with the Giants going 4-6 in his outings... had his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento on June 26.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Completed one of his strongest outings of the season after throwing 4.0 shutout innings...allowed a season-low one hit and struck out five in SF's 6-5 loss to the Mariners.

**TAKING FLIGHT:** Birdsong has found his footing after struggling earlier this month...in his first two starts this August, Birdsong posted a 17.05 ERA (12er, 6.1ip) after allowing seven extra-base hits (four homers) and a .345 opponent batting average...over his two most recent starts, he has posted a 1.04 ERA (1er, 8.2ip), allowed zero extra-base hits, and held opponents to a .143 average.

**THROW THAT CURVE:** He's thrown 182 curveballs this season at the MLB level and batters are 5-for-45 (.111) with 23 strikeouts against it...the Brewers have struggled to hit the curveball this season, batting .215 with a 28.3% strikeout rate against it.

**VS. THE LEFTY:** Lefties are batting just .194 (18x93) with a .312 slugging percentage off Birdsong this season, while righties are hitting .250 (18x72) with a .542 slugging...however, Birdsong has issued nearly twice as many walks to lefties (6.31 BB/9) vs. righties (3.66 BB/9).

**STRIKE THREE!** His 12 strikeouts in his start against Colorado at Coors Field on July 21 were the most he'd ever accumulated in an outing in his professional career...in fact, his 12 punchouts were the most by a Giants pitcher ever at Coors Field...they were also the most by a Giants rookie since **Tim Lincecum** fanned 12 on July 1, 2007.

**PRIOR TO HIS DEBUT:** Birdsong has spent parts of three seasons in the Giants system after being selected in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Illinois University (Charleston, IL).

**THE FUTURE IS NOW:** With the prospect graduation of **LHP Kyle Harrison**, Birdsong is currently the Giants' top pitching prospect, No. 2 overall, according to *MLB.com*...he also enters today's start as #87 on *MLB.com*'s Top-100 prospects...Birdsong was the last of six consecutive pitchers the Giants selected during the 2022 draft, which is a group that included **LHPs Reggie Crawford** and **Carson Whisenhunt**.

**2023 SEASON:** Split last season between three levels (San Jose -A, Eugene -A+ and Richmond -AA) and combined to go 2-5 with a 3.31 ERA (37er, 100.2ip) with 149 strikeouts overall...his 3.31 season ERA was best among SF Minor Leaguers (min 100.0ip) and earned him three awards, including SF Giants' 2023 MiLB.com Organization All-Star.

**WITH THE SQUIRRELS:** Birdsong entered the season ranked as the Giants #6 prospect according to *Baseball America*...he began the year at Double-A Richmond and posted a 4-2 record with a 2.05 ERA (11er, 48.1ip) with 61 strikeouts in 11 starts for Double-A Richmond before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on June 11.

**WITH THE RIVER CATS:** Made two starts for Sacramento after the promotion and posted a 5.00 ERA (5er, 9.0) with 14 strikeouts.

**EARLY ARRIVAL:** Birdsong became the second Giant from the 2022 draft to reach the Majors, joining **OF Wade Meckler** (eighth round), who did so last year...there are just four players from the *first* round of that 2022 draft that have reached the Majors overall (IF Jackson Holliday with Baltimore, IF Zach Neto with the Angels, OF Jordan Beck with Colorado, IF Brooks Lee with Minnesota)...*at the time of his debut, there were just 12 players selected ahead of Birdsong (6th round, 30th pick) in that 2022 draft that had made their debuts.*
