RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals embark on their longest road trip of the season, a nine-game, 10-day, three-city trip through Cincinnati (May 27-29), Philadelphia (May 31-June 2), and Houston (June 3-5) ... The Cardinals enjoyed a 7-1 homestand after taking 2-of-3 from the Boston Red Sox and then sweeping the Baltimore Orioles (3-0) and Chicago Cubs (2-0) ... The seven wins on the recent homestand were their most since going 7-2 vs. Mets, Brewers, & Reds from April 20-28, 2019.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 1.0 game behind Chicago and 4.5 games behind Milwaukee ... The 3rd place mark is the highest St. Louis has started any day this season after Opening Day ... A win today would bring the Cardinals back to .500 for the first time since April 16 (9-9 record).

MOTHER NATURE: Winners of 10 of their last 12 and a season-high five in a row, the Cardinals sport the National League's best winning pct. (.833, 10-2) since Mother's Day (May 12-present), and over that timespan:

- Lead Major League Baseball in on-base pct. (.361) and BABIP (.343), while ranking among MLB leaders in batting average (.284, T-2nd), runs per game (5.67, 4th), OPS (.806, 3rd), and slugging (.446, 5th);
- Have experienced a total of 8 hours & 15 minutes of rain/hail delays & thunderstorms/tornado warnings that have suspended one game and postponed another.

CARDINALS ON MEMORIAL DAY: The Cardinals are 25-23 all-time on Memorial Day (10-11 on the road) since it became an official holiday in 1971 ... The Cardinals have played and beat the Reds twice on Memorial Day, winning 9-1 in **1983** at Busch Stadium II and 12-4 in **2010** at Busch Stadium III.

WINN...WINN, WINN, WINN: Rookie shortstop Masyn Winn leads Major League rookies with a .301 batting average (10th in NL) ... Since May 5, Winn's career-best 15-game hitting streak (20-55, .364/.390/.582):

- is the longest by a Major League rookie this season and longest by any rookie since teammate **Jordan Walker**'s 17-gamer in 2023;
- ties J.T. Realmuto for MLB's 2nd-longest active hitting streak behind Anthony Volpe (19);
- is the 5th-longest Cardinals rookie hit streak in franchise history (chart left)

MY BISCUITS ARE BURNIN²: OF/1B **Alec Burleson** is enjoying a career high-tying 10-game hitting streak (18-41, .439/.452/.634) since May 14, tied for MLB's 5th-longest active hitting streak ... Burleson's .432 batting average over that timespan ranks 3rd in MLB behind San Diego's **Luis Arraez** (.451) and Detroit's **Colt Keith** (.441).

THE ERROR OF OUR WAYS: The Cardinals have committed an error in 11 straight games (May 13-present), longest error streak since 12 in a row from Sept. 27, 1976-April 14, 1977 ... The Cardinals are 14-16 in errorless games this season and 11-10 when committing at least one error (9-2 record during error streak).

NL Ranks: Lowest Run Support Average (2.81, 1st), Most Pitches/IP (17.5, 2nd), Unearned Runs (6, T-1st)

- Makes his 11th start of the season and the 328th of his career (352nd appearance).
- The Cardinals have lost four of his last fi starts (April 28-present) after having won four of the first five to begin the season.
- His 967 strikeouts as a Cardinal are 12 back of **Jesse Haines** (979) for 7th all-time in franchise history.
- Has thrown fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, or cutter) for 770 of his 897 total pitches (85.9%) this season, highest percentage of fastballs thrown among MLB starting pitchers. Only Nestor Cortes (817 of 1,024, 79.8%) has thrown more fastballs than Lynn.
- In the *Statcast* era (2015-present), has thrown the most fastballs (19,587) of any Major League pitcher. **Gerrit Cole** (15,001) is 2nd.
- St. Louis has played extra innings in three of his 11 starts this year and co-leads MLB starters with six no-decisions in his 11 starts.
- Is 46 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career and 59.2 innings from 2,000.
- Ranks T-4th in MLB with team-leading with eight batters faced with the bases loaded (allowing no hits). Lynn leads MLB pitchers with 6 strikeouts with the bases loaded.
- His .420 OPS with two outs ranks 4th among NL pitchers (min. 50 batters faced).
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout in National League play on May 10 at Milwaukee after fanning Brice Turang (swinging) to lead off the 1st inning.

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed two hits and one unearned run for the win last Tuesday against the Orioles at Busch Stadium. After the top of the 6th inning with the game tied at 1-1, rain suspended the game to the following day as the Cardinals scored two runs in the bottom of the 6th inning in the 3-1 win.
- Marked his first win at Busch Stadium III since Sept. 12, 2017 vs. Cincinnati (13-4).

- Has never pitched at Busch Stadium as a visitor. Before the 2024 Home Opener (April 4), his last appearance in St. Louis was Sept. 28, 2017 vs. the Cubs (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 R, 5 K).
- Trails Adam Wainwright and ranks 2nd in Busch Stadium III history in starts (82), innings pitched (509.2), strikeouts (473), and wins (41).

CAREER

- Member of the 2011 Cardinals World Series Championship team and the 2013 National League Champions.
- Two-time All-Star with the National League (2012, DNP) and the American League (2021). Pitched a scoreless inning at Coors Field in 2021 in relief of pitcher Shohei Ohtani. Current teammates Kyle Gibson and Andrew Kittredge also pitched for the A.L. in that game.
- Placed in Top 10 in the AL Cy Young Award voting in 2019 (5th), 2020 (6th) & 2021 (3rd).
 Has returned to his original drafting/signing team (1st round, 2008) for the first time since 2017 after pitching for the Twins (2018), Yankees (2018), Rangers (2019-20), White Sox (2021-23) and Dodgers (2023).
- Was teammates with current Cardinals manager Oliver Marmol in Quad Cities (2008) and Palm Beach (2009).
- Ranks 2nd behind only **Adam Wainwright** (29) with 24 postseason pitching appearances among Cardinals. Has five postseason wins as a member of the Cardinals, T-3rd in franchise history behind **Chris Carpenter** (10) and **Bob Gibson** (7).

- Made his 200th career appearance in the National League at New York Mets (April 28) and 1,000th NL strikeout on May 10 at MIL.
- Passed **Steve Carlton** (951) in his May 4 start vs. White Sox for 8th place all-time in Cardinals franchise history for strikeouts.
