**THE GRAPEFRUIT GANG:** The St. Louis Cardinals are in the midst of their 29th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2026) ... The Cardinals previously hosted spring training at Al Lang Stadium (1947-97) in St. Petersburg ... On Monday, March 23, the Cardinals break camp in Florida and fly to Springfield, Mo. to play an exhibition with the Double-A Cardinals at Hammons Field at 6:05 p.m. CT.

**AHOY MATEY:** The Cardinals return to Bradenton for the first time since relocating across the state of Florida to Jupiter from St. Petersburg in 1998 ... The last Spring matchup between St. Louis and Pittsburgh in Bradenton was March 29, 1998.

**WORLD CLASS:** The Cardinals have nine players, two coaches, and one athletic trainer on provisional rosters for the 2026 World Baseball Classic taking place from March 5-17 ... Among those in Major League camp include Riley O'Brien (Korea), Leo Bernal (Panama), Gordon Graceffo (Italy), Thomas Saggese (Italy), Luis Gastelum (Mexico), Matt Koperniak (Great Britain), Bryan Torres (Puerto Rico), coaches Stubby Clapp (Canada) and Julio Rangel (Panama), and Certified Asst. Athletic Trainer Chris Conroy (Puerto Rico).

**OLI EXTENDED AS CARDS MANAGER:** The Cardinals recently signed Manager Oliver "Oli" Marmol to a two-year contract extension through the 2028 season, with a club option for 2029 ... The 39-year-old Marmol has piloted the team over the past four seasons (2022-25) and enters 2026 ranked 11th on the franchise's all-time managerial wins list with 325 victories ... Oli is currently the 3rd-longest tenured manager in the National League ... 2026 is Oli's 20th year in the organization as a player, coach, instructor, and manager (2007-present).

**GEORGE KISSELL AWARD:** Dominican Summer League Cardinals (R) Manager Fray Peniche (pah-NEE-chee) was recently named the 2025 recipient of the George Kissell Award ... Since 2008, winners have been selected by a poll of Cardinals minor league staff ... The award is presented to a Cardinals staffer who exhibits excellence in player development ... Peniche, 52, enters his 16th season as a coach in the Cardinals organization (28th overall), all as manager for the DSL Cardinals at the Cardinals Dominican Academy in Boca Chica ... The Dominican native has compiled a 449-462 record since he was hired in 2011.

**IN FULL BLOOM:** The Cardinals introduced Chaim Bloom on Sept. 30 as the team's new President of Baseball Operations taking the post that had been held by John Mozeliak who headed the team's baseball operations since Oct. of 2007 ... Bloom, who worked previously with the Boston Red Sox (2020-23) and Tampa Bay Rays (2005-19) had served as an advisor for the Cardinals the past two seasons.

**HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES:** The Cardinals recently celebrated their 7th high school graduating class with three players earning their diploma from the Cardinals Baseball Academy in the Dominican Republic: Jarol Baéz (HA-roll), Edward Guribe (goo-REE-bay), and Xavier Cruz (zah-vee-air).

**BE OUR GUEST:** Those scheduled to visit Jupiter in a coaching capacity this Spring Training include special Guest Instructors David Freese, Kolten Wong, Adam Wainwright, and Ozzie Smith, and Cardinals Special Assistants Yadier Molina and Willie McGee.

**CARDS TRIM 11 FROM ROSTER:** The Cardinals reduced their Spring Training roster to 57 players Monday, optioning RHP Tekoah Roby to Memphis (AAA), and re-assigning SHP Jurrangelo Cijntje, LHP Pete Hansen, LHP Ixan Henderson, RHP Austin Love, RHP Hancel Rincón, RHP Sem Robberse, LHP Jared Shuster, LHP Zack Thompson, C Grayson Tarlow, and OF Mike Antico to minor league camp.

**FEELING A DRAFT:** The Cardinals own six of the top 86 picks (13, 32, 50, 68, 72, 86) in the upcoming 2026 MLB Draft, the most of any Major League team ... Since the DeWitt ownership group (1996-present), 2026 will be only the third time St. Louis has possessed as many as six of the top 86 picks, following 2005 (6 of top 78) and 2012 (6 of top 86).

**PROSPECTING:** Seven of the Cardinals top 10 prospects open Spring in Major League camp, highlighted by two of Baseball America's Top 100 overall: INF JJ Wetherholt (#3) and OF Joshua Baez (#54) ... Wetherholt is the highest-rated position player in the Cardinals organization since outfielder Oscar Taveras (No. 1 in 2014) ... The Cardinals enter the 2026 season rated as the No. 2 farm system behind the Pirates, their highest ranking since being No. 1 in 2013.

# TODAY'S PITCHERS

## #3 DUSTIN MAY · RHP · 6-6 · 215 LBS · AGE 28

- Signed by the Cardinals to a one-year contract with a mutual option for a second year, December 17, 2025. Was his first free agent contract.
- Played the majority of his professional and Major League career with the Dodgers organization before being traded to the Boston Red Sox at the 2025 trade deadline.
- Missed the entire 2024 season recovering from Tommy John surgery repairing a torn flexor tendon in his right arm from July 2023 and an esophageal tear in July.
- When he made his season debut on April 1, 2025 vs. Atlanta, was his first action in a Major League game in 685 days dating back to May 17, 2023.
- Carries three World Championship rings as a member of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Played in the 2020 World Series at the neutral site at Globe Life Field, home of the Rangers. Was on the Injured List during the 2024 World Series. Was traded before the Dodgers won the World Series in 2025.
- Became the first Dodgers rookie to make an Opening Day start when he took the mound on July 24, 2020 in place of injured Clayton Kershaw. The last Dodgers rookie to make an Opening Day start was Fernando Valenzuela in 1981.
- Pitched for the National League in the 2019 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland. Pitched a scoreless 3rd inning in the game. Was teammates with current Cardinals infielder Nolan Gorman.

## #49 MATT SVANSON · RHP · 6-6 · 240 LBS · AGE 27

- Acquired by the Cardinals from the Blue Jays at the 2023 Trade Deadline for INF Paul DeJong and cash considerations.
- Made his MLB debut on April 17, 2025 at the New York Mets, working a scoreless 7th inning with one hit allowed. His college head coach made the drive from Lehigh to Citi Field for the game and returned for his weekend series that night.
- Has converted 39 consecutive save opportunities since May 23, 2023, with the first six as a member of the Blue Jays organization followed by 33 straight with the Cardinals.
- The 39 consecutive save streak currently ranks as the longest active in MiLB and 4th longest since MiLB records date back to 2005 (Brian Anderson, 41, Mike James, 40, Wander Suero, 40).
- Holds an active streak of at least one strikeout in each of his final 20 appearances with St. Louis, the longest such streak by a Cardinals reliever since Jordan Hicks had a 22-game streak in 2023 and longest a Cardinals rookie relief pitcher since at least 1954, as well as the second-longest active streak by an MLB reliever (1st, CHW's Mike Vasil, 29).

## #60 QUINN MATHEWS · LHP · 6-4 · 210 LBS · AGE 25

- Invited to Major League Spring Training camp for the second consecutive season; worked 6.0 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts in two outings (1 start) in 2025 Spring Training.
- Enters the 2026 season rated as the No. 5 prospect in the Cardinals organization by both Baseball America and Baseball Prospectus, as well as the No. 150 prospect, overall, by ESPN.com.
- Ranked among Cardinals 2025 minor league leaders in strikeouts (115, 6th) and games started (24, T-5th).
- Led Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (202) in 2024 while splitting time among all four Cardinals full-season minor league affiliates. Was the 2nd MiLB pitcher to eclipse 200 K's in a season since 2011, joining ARI's Brandon Pfaadt (218 in 2022).
- Became the 10th Cardinals minor league pitcher in franchise history to reach the 200-strikeout threshold and first since Rick Ankiel (222 in 1998).
- 2024 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year. Was the 4th to be honored in his first pro season, joining Max Rajcic (2023), Anthony Reyes (2004) and Rick Ankiel (1998).

## #30 TINK HENCE · RHP · 6-1 · 200 LBS · AGE 23

- Enters 2026 ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 16 prospect in the Cardinals organization. Was previously ranked as the Cardinals No. 3 prospect and the No. 68 overall prospect in 2025.
- Rated as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Slider" in the Cardinals organization by *Baseball America* in 2025, while *MLB Pipeline* recognized Hence as sporting the "Best Changeup" among all of their Top 100 Prospects in MLB.
- Struck out 31.3% of his batters faced over his five professional seasons covering 257.1 innings.
- Split his 2025 injury-shortened season by making eight starts between Springfield (AA), Peoria (A+), Palm Beach (A), and the FCL Cardinals (R). Missed the first seven weeks of the season with a right lat strain and then a shoulder impingement in July.
