TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to even the series this afternoon after dropping a nail-biter last night, 4-3.

- ▶ Despite last night's loss, the Giants are still 6-2 in their last eight road games dating to June 3...overall, the Giants are 17-24 away from Oracle Park this year.
- ▶ With last night's loss, the Giants will have to wait longer for a four-game winning streak this season...SF is one of three MLB teams this year (also Baltimore and Boston) that has yet to win four straight.
- ▶ The 75 games without winning four in a row is the longest the Giants have gone to start a season without a four-game win streak since 2006 when they went 96 games without one (secured the fourth-straight win in their 97th game) (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ **RHP Trevor McDonald** looks to bounce back from 3.2 innings of four-run ball against the Cubs last Saturday in the Giants' 6-1 defeat...it was McDonald's second consecutive outing against the Cubs.
- ▶ In his last five starts, McDonald owns a 6.46 ERA (17er, 23.2ip) compared to a 2.37 ERA (5er, 19.0ip) in his first three starts of the year w/SF.

MR. 305?: IF Rafael Devers went 2-for-3 with a homer, RBI and a walk in last night's loss, which was his ninth career game here at this facility.

- ▶ Devers has reached safely in all nine games and hit safely in eight of the nine...statistically, he's 14-for-36 (.389) with four doubles, one triple, two homers, 12 RBI, seven runs and six walks in the nine games...against the Marlins overall in his career he's 27-for-81 (.333) with 13 XBH, 16 RBI, 13 runs scored and 10 walks in 21 games (1.018 OPS).
- ▶ He rides a modest five-game hitting streak (dating to June 13) into tonight's game with Miami...he's 8-for-17 with three doubles, two homers and three RBI in that time.
- ▶ In 86 plate appearances as the DH this year, Devers is slashing .306/.407/.556 (.963 OPS) with four homers in 20 games...SF has actually gotten good production out of its DH spot this year as a whole with the second-best SLG (.546), third-best average (.315) and OPS (.933) and fourth-best OBP (.387) (*Sports Info Solutions*).

STARTING OVER...: IF Bryce Eldridge had his 22-game on-base streak snapped with his 0-for-4 day yesterday...it was the longest by a Giants rookie since **Buster Posey**, who reached in 25 straight games from June 30-July 28, 2010.

- ▶ The 21-year-old enters today ranking among qualified rookies in average (.308, 2nd), OBP (.393, 2nd), SLG (.538, 2nd) and OPS (.931, 2nd).
- ▶ Lastly, Eldridge ranks among the MLB leaders in June in average (.373, 5th), OBP (.456, 5th), OPS (1.083, 11th) and SLG (.627, 17th).

CHAP-MAN: IF Matt Chapman is slashing .321/.426/.698 (1.125 OPS) in 16 games this month...his 22 RBI this month are tied for the most in a single month in his career with it being the third time he's done it (also August 2020 with the A's and July 2022 with Toronto).

- ▶ This surge has catapulted him into the team lead for RBI with 41 on the season.
- ▶ Chapman's 22 RBI in June are most in the Majors and he also ranks among the MLB leaders this month in OPS (1.125, 5th), SLG (.698, 6th) and OBP (.426, 14th).
- ▶ He's reached base safely in 12 straight games vs. Miami dating to April 16, 2024...in 16 career games against the Marlins he's 17-for-51 (.333) with six doubles, three homers, eight RBI and seven runs scored.

BOUNCE BACK: IF Luis Arraez was 0-for-5 last night but has still hit safely in 17 of his last 20 games dating to May 27 (.330 average in that time).

- ▶ Arraez has yet to go consecutive games without a hit to start this season (72 games played)...that streak is the fifth-longest to begin a season in Giants history since 1940...see full chart on the right courtesy of *Elias* via Sarah Langs.

IT'S TRUE: Last night, **RHP Landen Roupp** became SF's first starter to finish 6.0 innings other than **RHP Logan Webb** since today's starter **RHP Trevor McDonald** went 6.1 innings vs. Arizona on May 27.

THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

JUNE 20, 1980

Jack Clark hits a walk-off triple in the 10th to beat the Mets, 4-3. It was the first walk-off triple in Giants history, and the first of two he'd hit that season (also: July 26). He's now one of just four Giants to record a walk-off triple, and the only player in MLB history to hit two walk-off triples in a single season.

TREVOR McDONALD RHP #72

T-MAC: Was the Giants' 11th-round pick in 2019 out of George County High School in Lucedale, MS...originally committed to South Alabama for college ball before signing...made his debut with SF during the final game of the 2024 season and has made appearances at the Major League level in each season since.

LAST TIME OUT: Matched his shortest outing of the season last Saturday versus the Cubs in the Giants 6-1 loss...lasted only 3.2 innings and allowed four runs on six hits while walking three batters and hitting one...he was facing the Cubs for a second consecutive start after facing them the weekend before at Wrigley Field.

A FEW BUMPS: After pitching extremely well in his first three outings while filling in for the injured Logan Webb (2-0 with a 2.37 ERA with SF going 3-0 in those outings), McDonald has gone 0-4 with a 6.46 ERA (17er, 23.2ip) in his last five starts with the Giants winning only one of those games...McDonald himself has failed to finish 5.0 innings in two of those five starts.

DIGGING DEEPER: During this rough stretch, batters have slashed .321/.419/.415 (.834 OPS) off his sinker compared to .255/.300/.319 (.619 OPS) off the sinker in his first three outings...he also has an 11.0% walk rate during these last five starts (3.9% walk rate in his first three starts).

GROUNDING: Entering this start he owns a 57.7% groundball rate, which sits in the 96th percentile among Major Leaguers...however, in his last outing against the Cubs, only three of the 12 balls that were put in play by the Cubs were on the ground (25%)...his 57.7% groundball rate this year would lead the Majors if he had enough innings to qualify...PHI's Cristopher Sánchez currently leads MLB with a 57.2% groundball rate with McDonald's teammate RHP Logan Webb not too far behind in second (55.3%).

ORDER UP...: He's been at his best the first time through the order this year with hitters going a combined 11-for-67 (.164) with a .595 OPS...it goes upward from there with opposing hitters hitting .290 with a .760 OPS the second time through and .303 with an .824 OPS the third time through.

VS. MIAMI: Is facing the Marlins for the first time in his career...it's worth noting that according to *Sports Info Solutions* when combining hitting, hitting for power, and avoiding strikes, the Marlins are the second-best team vs right-handed sliders...they have the highest batting average .287 and the fifth-highest slugging .442...McDonald's slider is his most-used secondary pitch (28.0%).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Has gone 1-1 with a 3.27 ERA (8er, 22.0ip) in four starts away from Oracle Park this year...the Giants are 3-1 in those four games...conversely, he owns a 6.10 ERA (14er, 20.2ip) in four home starts and the Giants are 1-3 in those games.

IN THE MAJORS: When his number has been called at the MLB level over the last few seasons he's stepped in well...in 12 career games (10 starts) he owns a 3.71 ERA (25er, 60.2ip) with 56 strikeouts to just 18 walks...his WHIP is 1.20 and he'd held opposing hitters to a .231 clip.

IN TRIPLE-A IN 2026: Went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (9er, 15.0ip), 12 strikeouts and a 1.53 WHIP in five Triple-A games (four starts) for Sacramento...was much better at home (1-0 with a 2.79 ERA in three games) than on the road (0-1 with a 10.13 ERA in two games).

- ▶ Earned his fourth win of the year last Sunday vs. the Cubs...threw 8.0 innings with no earned runs and seven strikeouts...it marked his second straight start in which he threw 8.0 innings and did not issue a walk.
- ▶ Since returning from the IL (right knee bursitis) on May 29, he has a 0.66 ERA (2er, 27.1ip) with 23 strikeouts, a .168 BAA and 0.73 WHIP in four starts...he lowered his ERA from 5.06 prior to his IL stint to a current 3.46.
- ▶ Will face the Marlins for the eighth time in his career...is 1-2 with a 3.61 ERA in the seven starts.
