## St. Louis Cardinals (90-67) at Arizona Diamondbacks (80-77) Game No. 158 - Road Game No. 80 - Chase Field • Tuesday, September 24, 2019 <br> RHP Jack Flaherty (10-8, 2.96) vs. RHP Mike Leake (12-11, 4.38)



THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: The Cardinals continue their final regular season road trip ( $4-0$ at CHI, 1-0 at ARI) this evening, as they play the middle game of a three-game series at Chase Field...the Cardinals posted dramatic 5-4, 2-1, $9-8 \& 3-2$ wins last weekend in Chicago, recording their first four-game series sweep of the Cubs at Wrigley Field since May 27-29 [2], 1921...the Cardinals have matched their season-high, having won six-straight, and are a season-high 23 games over . 500 with five games remaining...St. Louis entered play today in first place in the NL Central, 3.5 games ahead of the Brewers...they clinched their first postseason berth since 2015 with Sunday's win and their magic number for clinching their 12th NL Central title stands at three over Milwaukee.
STRENGTH IN NUMBERS: With Yadier Molina's HR (\#10) last night, the Cardinals joined the 2019 Los Angeles Dodgers as the only teams in NL history to have 11 or more players hit $10+$ homers...the Cardinals are also seeking just their second trio of 30+ HR players, done only in 2004 by the MV3 of Albert Pujols (46), Jim Edmonds (42) and Scott Rolen (34)...Paul Goldschmidt (32) is pacing the Cardinals this season, with Marcell Ozuna and Paul DeJong both at (29).
BASH \& FLASH: The 2019 Cardinals ( 201 HR, 112 SB) are just the 3rd team in franchise history to have recorded $200+$ HR and $100+$ stolen bases in the same season, joining the 2004 ( $214 \mathrm{HR}, 111 \mathrm{SB}$ ) and 1998 ( $223 \mathrm{HR}, 133 \mathrm{SB}$ ) squads.
EARLY BIRDS: Through August 9th the Cardinals were being out-scored in the first 3 innings by 40 runs (185-145)...since then, they have out-scored their opponents in the first 3 innings by 42 runs ( $90-48$ ). (Orf).
GOLDY'S CHASE: Former D-Back (2011-18) Paul Goldschmidt made his return to Chase Field last night for the first time since last off-season's trade, and with his 3rd inning homer, became the first player to hit 100 career homers at the desert diamond...Goldy is the all-time leader at Chase Field in home runs (100),

HOLLIDAY SHOPPING LIST: Not since 2012 (Matt Holliday, 102), has a Cardinal collected 100+RBI...Paul Goldschmidt is currently leading the Cardinals with 94, including 57 since the All-Star break (2nd in NL) and 21 in September (T1st, NL).
FIREMEN SAVE 52: Last night's save by Carlos Martinez was the team's 52 nd of the season, with Tsunami leading the way with 24 , followed by Jordan Hicks (14), Andrew Miller (6), John Gant (3) and five others with one apiece...the Cardinals lead the majors with 52 rescues and have nine players with at least one save this season, just one shy of the club record of 10 players with saves which has been done four times (1966, 1965, 1964 and 1951)...the team's 52 saves are 5th in club history (club record 62 in 2015).
SNAKE CHARMERS: Since Arizona joined MLB as an expansion team in 1998, the Cardinals' 613 win pct. (92-58) vs. the D-Backs is their 2nd-highest vs. any opponent who play St. Louis each season (Padres, .623, 94-57)...the Cardinals have won or tied their road series at Arizona each of the last five seasons (2014-18), last dropping a series here when they opened the 2013 season (April 1-3) by going 1-2.
THE EDMAN EFFECT: Rookie Tommy Edman parked his 11th home run last night and was on base four times, scoring three runs...Edman made his ML debut on June 8 at Wrigley Field as the Cardinals fell to $31-31$ that night...since then, the Cardinals are $59-36$ (. 621 win pct.)... Edman has reached base safely in 13 -staight games and has a 1.111 OPS and .709 SLG pct. in 22 September games.
TIME TO FLY: After going 0-5 during their West Coast trip to Oakland and Los Angeles-NL (August 3-7), the Cardinals are 32-12 since August 9 , leading Major League Baseball in wins while boasting a MLB-best 3.05 ERA and eight shutouts in that span...the Cardinals lead the N.L. in winning pct. (46-23; .667) since the All-Star break and are 2nd in the National League (Milwaukee, 17) in September wins (15).
TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: The Cardinals are 45-28 (.616) in divisional play, including a 30-11 (.731) mark since the All-Star Break...their . 616 divisional win pct. leads all NL Central clubs and is their 4th best all-time.
RUNNIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals (112-for-141) lead the NL in stolen bases this season, three more than 2nd place Washington (109). Their $79.4 \%$ SB success rate (6th in NL) currently stands as the highest all-time in franchise history since 1951 (STATS LLC)... 19 different Cardinals have stolen at least one base, most in MLB and T5th-most in franchise history (record held by 1906 club with 21 Cardinals).

- Makes his 32nd start of the season and his 65th career start (66th appearance).
- Has established single-season career highs in wins (10), innings pitched (182.1), strikeouts (214), quality starts (18) and games started (31).
Is the 8th different Cardinal (19th instance) and youngest in franchise history to strike out $200+$ batters in a season.

His 214 strikeouts currently rank 10th in franchise single-season history, three behind Carlos Martinez (217 in 2017) and five shy of tying Adam Wainwright (219 in 2013).

- His 10.56 strikeouts/ 9 IP ( 215 K in 182.1 IP) this season ranks 1st all-time in franchise single-season history.
- Ranks 2nd among NL pitchers with 202 strikeouts Post All-Star Break over the last two seasons (2018-19) behind only Jacob deGrom (230).
- His 416 career strikeouts are most by a Cardinal in their first 64 career appearances and rank 12th-most in National League history.
- Sports the lowest ERA (1.05) in Major League Baseball since the All-Star Break (13 GS). It's the majors 5th-lowest single-season post All-Star ERA all-time.
- Matched his single-game career high by pitching 8.0 IP in three of his last four starts.
- Allowed just seven earned runs in his last 79.0 innings ( 0.78 ERA).

Limiting opposing right-handed batters to a . 185 average (62-336), ranking 3rd in the NL this season and currently 2nd all-time in Cardinals history (Jose DeLeon, .148).

## LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed one run on three hits while striking out eight over 8.0 innings (season-high 118 pitches) in last Thursday's $5-4$ win in 10 innings over the Cubs at Wrigley Field.

- Faces Arizona for only the second time in his career. Came away with a loss on July 3, 2018 at Arizona, allowing a go-ahead, opposite field three-run homer to Paul Goldschmidt with two strikes and two outs in the 5th inning.
- In 2019 vs. the NL West, is $3-1$ with a 0.46 ERA ( 39.0 IP) and 47 strikeouts in six starts. His 0.46 ERA is the lowest single-season mark all-time vs. the NL West (min. 6 starts), while his . 141 BA ties JR. Richard ( 1980 Astros) for 1st.
- Is lifetime 4-4 with a 2.48 ERA (80.0 IP) and 97 strikeouts in 14 carer starts against the NL West. Limited the opposition to one run or fewer in 10 outings, including his last eight in a row (August 22, 2018-present).
