**THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY**  
On this date in 1977, the Orioles celebrated **3B Brooks Robinson** with "Thanks Brooks Day"...51,798 fans flocked to Memorial Stadium to honor the O's third baseman, who had retired in August...His replacement, **3B Doug DeCinces**, hit a three-run home run, but it wasn't enough as the Orioles fell to the Red Sox, 10-4.



**YESTERDAY...:** The Orioles fell 3-1 to the Tampa Bay Rays in Game 1 of Thursday's doubleheader before a 10-6 loss in Game 2...The O's fell to 3-4 against the Rays this season and are now 0-18 in games when scoring three runs or fewer.

👉 Rookies **RHP Dean Kremer** and **LHP Bruce Zimmermann** started each game of Thursday's twin bill...According to STATS, LLC., it marked the first O's doubleheader started by rookie pitchers since rookies **RHP Ryan Meisinger** and **RHP Jimmy Yacabonis** did so on September 26, 2018 at Boston.

**BORN TO BE AN ORIOLE:** Baltimore-area native **LHP Bruce Zimmermann** made his Major League debut in Game 2 of Thursday's doubleheader against the Rays...He did not factor in the decision after allowing five earned runs on four hits, with one walk, and two strikeouts...Struck out **Nate Lowe** in the first inning for his first career strikeout.

👉 Zimmermann became the 28<sup>th</sup> Maryland-born player to appear in a game in Orioles history (since 1954), and the first native Marylander to debut for the Orioles since **RHP Brandon Kline** on April 20, 2019 in Game 2 of a doubleheader against Minnesota.

👉 Zimmermann became the fifth O's player to make his Major League debut this season, joining **LHP Keegan Akin**, **INF Ramón Urías**, **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle**, and **RHP Dean Kremer**.

**KING IN THE CASTLE:** **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle** played in his 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> career games during last night's doubleheader...Among O's rookies in club history through their first 26 games, his 21 RBI rank as the third-most (**Trey Mancini** - 25, **Jim Traber** - 22) and his 31 hits are tied for the third-most (**Curtis Goodwin** - 35, **Billy Ripken** - 34, **Jeffrey Hammonds** - 31).

👉 He also ranks in the top five among Orioles rookies (min. 75 PA) through their first 26 games in on-base percentage (3<sup>rd</sup> - .406), batting average (4<sup>th</sup> - .348), OPS (4<sup>th</sup> - .979), and slugging (5<sup>th</sup> - .573), according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

**NO HOMERS CLUB:** Thursday's Game 1 loss to Tampa Bay marked the third game at home this season without a home run by either team and the first since Wednesday night's win over Atlanta...The Orioles are 1-2 this season in homerless games at Oriole Park, after going 0-2 in such games last year...According to STATS, LLC., it was the 261<sup>st</sup> homerless game at Oriole Park since opening in 1992...The Orioles are 129-131-1 in homerless games at Camden Yards since 1992.

**HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH:** The Orioles and Major League Baseball will celebrate Hispanic Heritage Month by focusing on the contributions to baseball by Latino players past and present...The O's will recognize Hispanic heritage on Saturday...Orioles Hall of Famer **Dennis Martínez** will throw out a virtual ceremonial first pitch prior to that evening's game against the Tampa Bay Rays...Martínez, nicknamed "El Presidente," will also join the MASN and Orioles Radio Network pregame shows to discuss his work aiding COVID-19 relief efforts in his native Nicaragua.

**WAKE ME UP WHEN SEPTEMBER ENDS:** According to *teamrankings.com* the O's remaining strength of schedule (as of Sept. 18) ranks as the toughest in the AL and third-toughest in the majors.

👉 During the month of September, O's hitters rank seventh in the AL in OPS (.750), rank seventh in batting average (.255), and are tied for fourth in home runs (23).

👉 **OF DJ Stewart's** seven home runs are tied for second in the AL lead in September and **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle** ranks fourth in the AL with 17 RBI, Stewart ranks eighth in the AL with 14 RBI, and **INF Rio Ruiz** is tied for 11<sup>th</sup> in the AL with 12 RBI during the month.

👉 The O's 4.29 ERA (66 ER/138.1 IP) during September ranks seventh-best in the AL...O's pitchers have allowed 66 earned runs during the month to rank seventh-fewest in the AL.

**IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST:** On the first pitch of a plate appearance, the Orioles rank first in the majors in batting average (.415), and rank second in the AL and fourth in the majors in OPS (1.103), while ranking seventh in the majors in extra-base hits (29)...The Orioles rank second in the AL and are fourth in the majors in doubles (18), and are second in the AL in hits (76) as a team on the first pitch.

**SMALL BALL FOR ALL:** The O's lead the majors with 15 bunt hits this season...**OF Cedric Mullins** leads the majors with nine bunt hits, while **INF Hanser Alberto** is tied for fourth in the majors with four bunt hits and **INF/OF Andrew Velazquez** is tied for ninth in the majors with two bunt hits.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** Orioles pitchers have allowed just seven runs in the seventh inning this year for a 1.34 ERA (7 ER/47.0 IP)...It is the fewest runs allowed in the seventh inning in the majors, with the second-closest team (New York-AL) allowing 14 runs.

👉 **LHP Tanner Scott** has made nine appearances in the seventh inning (6.1 IP) without allowing a run, while **LHP Paul Fry** has made seven appearances in the seventh inning (5.2 IP) without allowing a run.

👉 On the offensive side, the Orioles have scored 30 runs in the seventh inning, tied for fourth-most in the AL and tied for eighth-most in the majors.

**RACE FOR .400:** **INF José Iglesias** is hitting .375 (48-for-128) through his first 34 games with the Orioles...Among players with at least 120 at-bats, Iglesias' .375 average leads the majors...

**DJ LeMahieu** of the New York Yankees ranks second in the majors with a .373 mark (min. 120 AB)...The last player in the majors to hit over .390 in a season was San Diego's **Tony Gwynn**, who hit .394 during 110 games of the strike-shortened 1994 season.

**INJURED LIST:** Six players are on the Injured List...**RHP Shawn Armstrong** (left SI joint inflammation), **INF Chris Davis** (left knee patellar tendinitis), and **OF Anthony Santander** (right oblique strain) are on the 10-day Injured List...**LHP Wade LeBlanc** (left elbow stress reaction), **INF/OF Trey Mancini** (colorectal cancer recovery/treatment), and **INF Richie Martin** (right wrist fracture) are on the 60-day IL.

**COACHING STAFF:** The O's named **Fredi González** as Major League Coach, **Darren Holmes** as Bullpen Coach, and **Anthony Sanders** as First Base Coach...**José Hernández** shifted from Major League Coach to Assistant Hitting Coach...All other coaches remained in their same positions from the 2019 season: **Doug Brocail** as Pitching Coach, **Tim Cossins** as Major League Field Coordinator/Catching Instructor, **José Flores** as Third Base Coach, and **Don Long** as Hitting Coach.

### #17 RHP ALEX COBB

**LAST START:** Faced the Yankees in New York in Game 1 of a doubleheader on 9/11...Was charged with his fourth-straight loss after allowing five runs on seven hits (three home runs) and one walk with five strikeouts through 4.0 innings of work...Marked the fifth time in his career that he has allowed three-or-more home runs in a game (last: 4, 4/26/19 at MIN)...Surrendered a leadoff home run to DJ LeMahieu for the third leadoff home run he has allowed in his career...Was the third time this season that he has allowed five runs...Allowed four-or-fewer hits in each of his first four starts this season, becoming only the seventh starter in team history (since 1954) to do so.

**CAREER VS. TAMPA BAY:** Cobb will be making his sixth career start against his former team, having gone 0-3 with a 4.61 ERA (14 ER/27.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts through his first five starts...His first four outings against the Rays came in the 2018 season, and they batted .323 (30-for-93) with two home runs against him...His last start against Tampa Bay was on 7/31 of this year, and he did not factor in the decision after allowing two runs on four hits and three walks with a pair of strikeouts through 4.0 innings.

**AGAINST THE AL EAST:** Owns a career record of 24-23 with a 3.70 ERA (162 ER/393.2 IP) in 68 starts against AL East opponents...Among all pitchers with at least 300.0 innings pitched against the division since his rookie season of 2011, Cobb ranks eighth in ERA and tied for 14th in winning percentage against the AL East...He has recorded 33 Quality Starts against AL East foes...Has thrown 6.0-or-more innings in 36 of 68 starts.

**HOME NOT-SO-SWEET HOME:** Cobb is a career 23-29 in 75 home starts with a 3.58 ERA (178 ER/447.2 IP)...In 24 career games started at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, he has pitched to a 3-11 record with a 5.20 ERA (74 ER/128.0 IP) and opponents have batted .290 (148-for-511) with 24 home runs and 40 walks...His 24 home runs allowed in 24 starts at Oriole Park rank second among all ballparks he has pitched in, trailing only Tropicana Field, where he has allowed 25 home runs in 59 career starts...**Has been held winless at Oriole Park since joining the Orioles in March 2018, pitching to a 0-10 record with a 5.44 ERA (55 ER/91.0 IP) in 17 starts.**

**THE TERRIBLE THREES:** This season, Cobb has posted a 6.75 ERA (6 ER/8.0 IP) with 12 hits (two doubles and one home run) and five walks in the third innings of his first eight starts...In his career, he owns a third-inning ERA of 4.76 (79 ER/149.1 IP), which is his highest mark of any inning (min. 50.0 IP).

**FINISHING STRONG:** In his only full season with the Orioles in 2018, Cobb posted a 2.56 ERA (17 ER/59.2 IP) in the second half of the season, compared to his 6.41 ERA (66 ER/92.2 IP) in the first half...Opponents batted .232 (51-for-220) against Cobb in the second half of 2018, compared to .313 (121-for-386) in the first half...**In his career, Cobb has posted a 12-7 record and 3.68 ERA (63 ER/154.0 IP) through 28 outings (27 starts) in the months of September and October.**

**AS AN ORIOLE:** Since signing with the Orioles in March 2018, Cobb has started 39 games and pitched to a 6-21 record with a 5.29 ERA (120 ER/204.0 IP) and 139 strikeouts...In his 39 starts, opponents have batted .285 (235-for-825) with 97 extra-base hits (51 doubles, five triples, and 41 home runs)...Through the first six seasons of his career with the Tampa Bay Rays, Cobb owned a 48-35 record and 3.50 ERA (272 ER/700.0 IP) with 570 strikeouts, and held opponents to a .246 (648-for-2639) clip.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JORGE LÓPEZ (2-0, 5.23)

López will make his fifth start of the season after earning the win in his last outing on 9/14 vs. ATL...He tossed 7.0 innings, his longest start of the year, allowing just one run on five hits (one home run) and two walks with three strikeouts...In his career, López has faced Tampa Bay two times (one start), and has pitched to a 0-1 record with a 1.50 ERA (1 ER/6.0 IP)...He faced the Rays this season on 8/25, tossing 1.0 inning in relief, and his last start against them came on 8/20/18, as a member of the Royals organization, when he tossed 5.0 innings and allowed one run on five hits and three walks with three strikeouts at Tropicana Field.

# BIRDS IN THE BULLPEN
