THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: The Cardinals conclude their final regular season road trip (4-0 at CHI, 1-1 at ARI) this afternoon with the rubber game of a three-game series at Chase Field...the Cardinals lost 3-2 in 19 innings last night, snapping their season-high six-game win streak...the Cardinals posted dramatic 5-4, 2-1, 9-8 & 3-2 wins last weekend in Chicago, recording their first four-game series sweep of the Cubs at Wrigley Field since May 27-29 [2], 1921...with four games remaining, St. Louis entered play today in first place in the NL Central, 2.5 games ahead of the Brewers...they clinched their first postseason berth since 2015 with Sunday's win and their magic number for clinching their 12th NL Central title stands at three over Milwaukee.

EXTRA: Last night (this morning), the Cardinals played their first 19 inning game since 8/19/12 vs. PIT...the 6:53 time of game was the longest for the Redbirds since playing 20 innings in the same 6:53 on 4/17/10 vs. the Mets.

STRENGTH IN NUMBERS: With Yadier Molina's HR (#10) on Monday, the Cardinals joined the 2019 Los Angeles Dodgers as the only teams in NL history to have 11 or more players hit 10+ homers...the Cardinals are also seeking just their second trio of 30+ HR players, done only in 2004 by the MV3 of Albert Pujols (46), Jim Edmonds (42) and Scott Rolen (34)...Paul Goldschmidt (33) is pacing the Cardinals this season, with Marcell Ozuna and Paul DeJong both at (29).

BASH & DASH: The 2019 Cardinals (203 HR, 112 SB) are just the 3rd team in franchise history to have recorded 200+ HR and 100+ stolen bases in the same season, joining the 2004 (214 HR, 111 SB) and 1998 (223 HR, 133 SB) squads.

EARLY BIRDS: Through August 9th the Cardinals were being out-scored in the first 3 innings by 40 runs (185-145)...since then, they have out-scored their opponents in the first 3 innings by 43 runs (91-48). *(Orf)*.

GOLDY'S CHASE: Former D-Back (2011-18) **Paul Goldschmidt** made his return to Chase Field on Monday for the first time since last off-season's trade, and with

his 3rd inning homer, became the first player to hit 100 career homers at the desert diamond...Goldy is the all-time leader at Chase Field in home runs (101), walks (361) and runs (384).

HOLLIDAY SHOPPING LIST: Not since 2012 (Matt Holliday, 102), has a Cardinal collected 100+RBI...Paul Goldschmidt is currently leading the Cardinals with 95, including 58 since the All-Star break (2nd in NL) and 22 in September (1st, NL).

FIREMEN SAVE 52: Monday night's save by **Carlos Martinez** was the team's 52nd of the season, with Tsunami leading the way with 24, followed by **Jordan Hicks** (14), **Andrew Miller** (6), **John Gant** (3) and five others with one apiece...the Cardinals lead the majors with 52 rescues and have nine players with at least one save this season, just one shy of the club record of 10 players with saves which has been done four times (1966, 1965, 1964 and 1951)...the team's 52 saves are 5th in club history (club record 62 in 2015).

SNAKE CHARMERS: Since Arizona joined MLB as an expansion team in 1998, the Cardinals' .609 win pct. (92-59) vs. the D-Backs is their 2nd-highest vs. any opponent who play St. Louis each season (Padres, .623, 94-57)...the Cardinals have won or tied their road series at Arizona each of the last five seasons (2014-18), last dropping a series here when they opened the 2013 season (April 1-3) by going 1-2.

THE EDMAN EFFECT: Rookie **Tommy Edman** parked his 11th home run Mon. night and was on base four times, scoring three runs...Edman made his ML debut on June 8 at Wrigley Field as the Cardinals fell to 31-31 that night...since then, the Cardinals are 59-37 (.615 win pct.)... Edman has reached base safely in 14-staight games and has a 1.056 OPS and .667 SLG pct. in 23 September games.

TIME TO FLY: After going 0-5 during their West Coast trip to Oakland and Los Angeles-NL (August 3-7), the Cardinals are 32-13 since August 9, leading Major League Baseball in wins while boasting a MLB-best 2.97 ERA and eight shutouts in that span...the Cardinals lead the N.L. in winning pct. (46-24; .657) since the All-Star break and are 2nd in the National League (Milwaukee, 18) in September wins (15).

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: The Cardinals are 45-28 (.616) in divisional play, including a 30-11 (.731) mark since the All-Star Break...their .616 divisional win pct. leads all NL Central clubs and is their 4th best all-time.

ARIZONA CONNECTIONS

Paul Goldschmidt was selected by Arizona in the in the 8th round of the 2009 MLB Draft and played eight seasons in a Diamondbacks uniform (2011-18), hitting .297/.398/.532 with 209 home runs and 710 RBI...selected to six All-Star squads (2013-18)...won four Silver Sluggers (2013, '15, '17-18) and three Gold Gloves (2013, '15, '17)... acquired by St. Louis from Arizona in exchange for catcher Carson Kelly, pitcher Luke Weaver, infielder Andy Young, and the 2019 Cardinals Compensation Round B selection (Dec. 5, 2018).

John Brebbia was selected by St. Louis from the Arizona in the Triple-A phase of the 2015 Rule 5 Draft.

Daniel Ponce de Leon pitched in four games for the University of Arizona as a freshman in 2011.

Dominic Leone pitched parts of two seasons (2015-16) with Arizona...originally traded by Seattle with catcher **Welington Castillo** and infielder **Jack Reinheimer** to Arizona for pitcher **Vidal Nuno** and outfielder **Mark Trumbo** (June 3, 2015).

Cardinals coach **Willie McGee** rehabbed for four games with the Phoenix Firebirds (AAA) as a member of the San Francisco Giants organization in 1991.

David Peralta was originally signed by St. Louis as a non-drafted free agent pitcher (Sept. 26, 2004)... pitched three minor league seasons (2005-07) before transitioning to the outfield...underwent pair of left-shoulder surgeries...released in May 2009.

Carson Kelly played parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18)...originally selected by the Cardinals as a third baseman in the 2nd round of the 2012 MLB Draft...2016 Cardinals Minor League Player of the Year...younger brother, Parker Kelly, pitches in the Cardinals organization.

Luke Weaver pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18)...selected by the Cardinals in the first round (27th overall) in 2014 MLB Draft...2016 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

Ildemaro Vargas signed by St. Louis as a non-drafted free agent (June 26, 2008) and played seven seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2008-14).

Diamondbacks First Base Coach **Dave McKay** served in the same position for the Cardinals for 16 seasons (1996-2011).

Diamondbacks hitting coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for the Cardinals in 1995.

Diamondbacks coach **Luis "Pipe" Urueta** played in 24 games in the Cardinals minor league organization in 2003.

Sam Narron, uncle of Diamondbacks bench coach Jerry Narron, played parts of three seasons with the Cardinals (1935, '42-43).

Cardinals President of Operations **John Mozeliak** attended the University of Arizona before graduating from the University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Sr. Special Asst. to the GM **Bob Gebhard** worked for the Diamondbacks as VP & Special Asst. to the GM for 12 seasons (2005-16).

Cardinals Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** served as the Diamondbacks Chief Baseball Analyst for four seasons (2014-17).

Diamondbacks Vice President, Player Development Mike Bell is the younger brother of former Cardinals coach (2014-17) and infielder (1995-98) David Bell...Mike also played in eight games for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) in 2005.

- Makes his 23rd start (28th appearance) of the season, and the 150th start of his career (155th appearance). Is facing the Cubs for only the 2nd time this season.
- Has held his opposition to three runs or less in his last eight straight starts (0-2, 2.52 ERA, 35.2 IP), his 3rd-longest streak, posting 10 games in 2018 and 14 in 2013-14.
- Is two strikeouts away from reaching 758 for his career and tying Mort Cooper (1938-45) for 19th all-time in Cardinals history.
- Is his 10th straight start attempting to coral his 60th career win. His .602 career winning percentage (59-39) ranks 8th all-time among Cardinals with 90 or more decisions.
- His last win was 7/18 at Cincinnati in relief; his last win in a start was 6/21 vs. Angles.
- 10 of his last 17 appearances (14 starts, 3 relief) have come on the road.
- Is 2-1, 4.07 ERA in 10 starts (12 app.) at Busch Stadium in 2019.
- In his last eight home outings (six starts), has gone 1-0 with a 1.77 ERA (35.2 IP/7 ER) dating to June 4, with 34 strikeouts and just seven walks.
- Is 5-7 with a 4.57 ERA in 23 starts and 1-0 with a 5.68 ERA in five relief appearances.
 However, he is 1-0 with a 1.54 ERA in his last four relief appearances following a six-run outing (1.0 IP) in his first relief appearance of the season at PHI (5/29).

LAST TIME OUT

 Allowed one run over 4.0 frames in St. Louis' come-from-behind 2-1 win over the Cubs last Friday at Wrigley Field. Lowered his ERA to 4.68, his lowest since April 29 (4.78).

- Has worked 5.0 or more innings in just 3 of 9 starts since his return to rotation on 8/5.
- Is averaging 5.05 run support, which would rank 3rd on St. Louis and 20th in the National League, but does not have enough qualifying innings.

 Was the 13th-lowest ERA in the NL and the lowest June ERA in his career.
- Has thrown 3.0 innings or more in each of his last two relief appearances with the most recent tossing 4.2 innings vs. HOU (7/27) holding the Astros to one run on six hits.
