THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY

AUG. 20

1992 - The Astros and Marlins play a 16.0-inning marathon that lasts 5:44 with Houston topping Florida 6-4 at Pro Player Stadium...**3B Ken Caminiti** is the hero, as he breaks the 4-4 tie with a solo homer to lead off the 16th...Houston sets a franchise record by walking 17 times in the contest, while **1B Jeff Bagwell** ties a Major League record by drawing six walks... Bagwell is still one of just four players in MLB history to walk six times in a game.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The first-place Astros, who own a slim 2.0-game lead in the AL West, will host the Angels tonight for the rubber game of their three-game series at Daikin Park...**RHP Peter Lambert** (8-6), the Astros most consistent starter this season, will get the start for Houston opposite **RHP Grayson Rodriguez** (3-5) and the Angels.

THE LAMBO: **RHP Peter Lambert** leads the club in wins (8), starts (21), innings (118.2) and strikeouts (117)...among AL pitchers with at least 115 IP, Lambert ranks seventh in opponent average (.208) and eighth in ERA...a minor league signing by Houston this offseason, Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 starts.

THE TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 44-32 since May 22, which is the second-best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: Among American League teams, the Astros rank first in slugging (.411), first in total bases (1755), second in home runs (170), third in runs scored (580), and fourth in OPS (.728)...in the Majors, the Astros rank third in homers, trailing only the Nationals (182) and Yankees (173).

VS. THE ANGELS: The Astros are 7-5 against the Angels and have won their sixth straight season series vs. the Angels (2021-26)...the Astros 145-93 (.609) all-time record against the Angels is their best against any single opponent in club history.

TONIGHT'S RADIO BROADCASTS: The Astros English radio broadcast can be heard on SportsTalk 790 featuring **Robert Ford** and **Brian Bogusevic**... the Spanish radio broadcast will feature **Francisco Romero** and **Alex Treviño** on TUDN 102.9 FM.

MEDIA WALL OF HONOR: The Astros are taking nominations for the 2026 inductee into the Houston Baseball Media Wall of Honor, which each year recognizes a Houston media member who has made significant and lasting contributions to the landscape of baseball in Houston...please submit all nominations via email to sgrande@astros.com.

WINSDAY NIGHT: The Astros earned a much-needed victory last night with a 3-2 win over the Angels... **RHP Ethan Pecko** (2ER/3.2IP) made his MLB debut before giving way to a dominant Astros bullpen that tossed 5.1 scoreless innings...**C Christian Vázquez** (1x2, HR) hit a solo homer, but the biggest swing came off the bat of **RF Cam Smith** (0x2, RBI), who drove in the go-ahead run with a sac fly.

STARTING BLOCKS: The Astros used their 17th different starting pitcher of the season last night in **RHP Ethan Pecko**, who made his Major League debut...their 17 starters used are the most by any Major League team this season and ties as their franchise record, also reached by the 1965 Astros.

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** holds the lead in all AL Triple Crown categories, ranking first in average (.317), first in HR (36) and first in RBI (88)... additionally, he leads MLB in OPS (1.040), OBP (.430), SLG (.610), and TB (277)...in the AL, he ranks first in XBH (61), and second in hits (144), walks (86), and runs (83)...AL leaders below:

YOR-GONE!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has hit 36 home runs this season, which leads the AL...he's just one homer shy of matching his career high in homers (37 HR in 2022) and is 11 homers shy of matching the franchise record for a single season, set by **1B Jeff Bagwell** in 2000 (47 HR).

AUGUST HEROES: **RF Cam Smith** is hitting .340 (16x47) with four homers, nine RBI and a 1.020 OPS in 15 games this month...**2B Jose Altuve** is also having a strong month, hitting .340 (18x53) with a .410 OBP and an .882 OPS in 15 games in August.

THE CLOSER: **LHP Josh Hader** made his 500th career appearance last night becoming the 15th active pitcher to reach that milestone...Hader has been stellar since returning from injury in early June, going 4-1 with a 0.87 ERA (3ER/31IP), 41 strikeouts, a .123 opponent average (13x106) and a 0.77 WHIP, while also converting all 18 of his save opportunities in 32 appearances.

MY BOY BLU!: **RHP A.J. Blubaugh** has taken a commanding Major League lead in innings pitched as a reliever with 78.0, far ahead of second-place **LHP Adrian Morejon** (68IP)...the Astros have not had a reliever lead the Majors in innings pitched since **RHP Doug Jones** (111.2IP) in 1992.

THROWING STRIKES: **LHP Steven Okert** walked a batter in a scoreless inning last night, snapping a streak of 22 consecutive appearances and 22.0 innings pitched without a strikeout (June 28-Aug. 16)...per Elias, Okert's streak of 22.0 consecutive innings without a walk is the fifth-longest by a reliever in a single season in club history.

ON THE MEND: **RHP Mike Burrows** (rt. elbow neuritis) is scheduled to make another rehab start for Triple A Sugar Land tonight in their home game vs. OKC...Burrows last pitched on Aug. 14 at Triple A, working 4.1 scoreless innings, allowing three hits with three strikeouts on 67 pitches (43 strikes).

DOWN ON THE FARM: Several of the Astros minor league clubs are having success this season:

- **Triple A Sugar Land:** In the second half, the Space Cowboys (32-15) are in first in the PCL East Division.
- **Class A Fayetteville:** For the second half, the Woodpeckers are in first place in the South Atlantic League North Division with a 28-20 (.583) record.
- **Rookie Level FCL Astros:** The Astros won the Florida Complex League championship, finishing with a 42-11 (.792) record in the regular season.
- **Rookie Level DSL Astros:** The DSL Astros Orange finished with a 33-20 record and clinched a spot in the DSL playoffs, which began today.

LAST START, AUG. 14 vs. SEA: Started the opener of the Astros' weekend series vs. SEA and tossed 5.0 innings, allowing 2 runs on 4 hits with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts...did not factor into the decision of the Astros' 10-7 win.

THE LAMBO: Lambert has established himself as one of the top pitchers in the AL this season despite beginning the year at the Triple A level...among AL pitchers with at least 110.0 innings this season, he ranks 6th in opponent batting average (.208), 6th in opponent OPS (.620), 7th in H/9 (6.90) and 8th in ERA (3.11).

LAMBO OF LATE: Has allowed 3-or-fewer runs in each of his 8 starts since July, including 2-or-fewer runs in 7 of 8 starts in that span...has posted a 2.44 ERA (12ER/44.1IP) in his 8 starts since July 5 vs. TB, with the Astros going 6-2 in those starts.

THE STABILIZER: Leads Astros pitchers with 8 quality starts this season and has been scoreless in 3 of his starts (July 5 vs. TB; May 5 vs. LAD; April 22 at CLE)...has also pitched 6.0+ innings in 9 of his 21 starts and 5.0+ innings in 19 of his 21 starts this season...leads the Astros with 118.2 innings pitched.

CAREER YEAR: Has already set single-season career highs in wins (8), strikeouts (117), starts (21) and innings (118.2)...including his time at Triple A, he's tossed 133.1 innings this season...is nearing his professional single-season career high of 148.0 innings from 2018, spent at the Triple A and Double A levels in the Rockies system.

VS. LAA: Is set to make his 3rd start vs. the Angels this season, matching the Rangers for his most vs. an opponent...has recorded a 3.18 ERA (4ER/11.1IP) in his 2 starts vs. LAA this season, including a quality start on June 10 at Angel Stadium (2ER/6.1IP)...the Astros have gone 1-1 in his 2 starts vs. LAA this year...has held **OF Wade Meckler** to 0x6 with 2 strikeouts and **IF Zach Neto** to 1x6 with 4 strikeouts in their matchups this season.

SLIDER COMBO: Is having his greatest MLB success with his slider, holding opponents to a .173 average on the pitch (9x52)...opponents had combined to hit .313 (50x160) vs. his slider through his first 4 MLB seasons...in 2024, his last season in the Majors prior to this year, opponents batted .340 (18x53) vs. his slider.

SUMMER FUN: Went 2-0 with a 1.88 ERA (6ER/28.2IP) in 5 starts in July...among AL pitchers in July, he ranked 5th in ERA (1.88), 7th in opponent OPS (.537), 11th in opponent batting average (.204), 13th in H/9 (6.91) and 13th in WHIP (1.05).

STREAKER: Had a career-long 4-game winning streak from May 24-June 23, which spanned 6 starts...within the streak, he posted a 2.97 ERA (11ER/33.1IP)...the streak is tied as the longest by an Astros starter this season, along with **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (April 15-May 2).

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and began the year at Triple A Sugar Land...made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...added to the Major League roster on April 17.
