CORBIN CARROLL STAR WARS BOBBLE: Saturday, August 9th's fan-favorite Star Wars Night @ Chase Field features a **Corbin Carroll** Rebel Pilot Bobble giveaway, courtesy of Cox, for the first 20,000 fans.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 6-4 @ Athletics yesterday for their second straight win and first series win since July 18-20 vs. Cardinals....was their third straight series win vs. Athletics (also: 2-1, June 28-30, 2024 @ home; 2-1 from May 15-17, 2023 on the road).

- Alek Thomas** had his third straight multi-hit game (fourth 3-hit game in 2025) and has reached base safely in 5 straight games.
- Geraldo Perdomo** had his second 3-hit performance in 4 games...since the All-Star break, his 5 games with 3+ hits are the most in the Majors, ahead of 11 others with 3 games.
- Tyler Locklear** had his first hit as a D-back (single to RF in second inning) and first career multi-hit game.
- Blaze Alexander** hit his first homer (solo in seventh inning) and had his third multi-hit game.
- Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 6 straight games (since July 28), batting .300 (6-for-20) with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 3 RBI, 5 walks (3 K) and 1 stolen base.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP **Andrew Hoffmann** (No. 56) and placed RHP **Kevin Ginkel** on the 15-day injured list (sprained right shoulder; retro to Aug. 3).

VS. PADRES: The D-backs are 4-3 vs. Padres this season, splitting their previous 4-game road series from July 7-10 and winning the first series 2-1 @ Chase Field from June 13-15.

HEAD-TO-HEAD WITH NL WEST: The D-backs are 15-12 (.556) vs. NL West opponents this season, the second-best interdivision win pct., behind the Dodgers (19-7, .731) and ahead of the Padres (14-12, .538).

- In head-to-head NL West play, the D-backs own the best OPS (.820), SLG (.489) with the most homers (49), extra-base hits (105) and stolen bases (20).
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 22 of his 26 games vs. NL West, batting .330 (32-for-97).396 OBP/.536 SLG/.932 OPS with 9 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 21 RBI, 12 walks and 2 stolen bases.
- Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 7 straight games vs. NL West (2 2B, 2 HR, 3 RBI) and in 22 of his 26 games vs. NL West this season, slashing .295/.402/.684/1.086 with 7 doubles, 10 homers, 20 RBI, 15 walks, 2 hit-by-pitches and 1 stolen base.
- Marte's 45 times on base and Perdomo's 44 rank third and fourth, respectively, in most times on base in head-to-head play, behind Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (48) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (46).

CARROLL'S CONSECUTIVE 14+-TRIPLE, 22+-HOMER SEASONS: **Corbin Carroll** is the fifth MLB player since 1901 to have consecutive seasons with 14+ triples and 22+ homers, joining Jim Rice/BOS (1977-78), Johnny Mize/STL (1938-39), Joe DiMaggio/NYY (1936-37) and Lou Gehrig (1930-31).

ALEK ON THE ATTACK: **Alek Thomas**, in 10 games since the All-Star break, is hitting .355 (11-for-31)/.394 OBP/.581 SLG/.975 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 2 walks.

HITTIN' AT HOME: In his last 12 home games, **Geraldo Perdomo** is hitting .477 (21-for-44)//566 OBP/.568 SLG/1.134 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 8 RBI, 7 walks (4 K), 2 hit-by-pitches and 2 stolen bases.

- Corbin Carroll**, in his last 6 home games, is hitting .308 (8-for-26)/.333 OBP/.654 SLG/.987 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 triples, 3 RBI, 1 walk and 2 stolen bases.
- Adrian Del Castillo**, in his first 3 home games this season, is hitting .417 (5-or-12) with 1 double and 2 RBI.

ON-BASE MACHINE: **Geraldo Perdomo's** 54 times on base since July 1 are tied for the most in the Majors with Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR and Nick Kurtz/ATH, ahead of Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (53).

- Has reached base in 25 of his 28 games since July 1, hitting .327 (33-for-101)/.439 OBP/.455 SLG/.894 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 17 RBI and 18 walks (10 K).
- Is the third MLB player to have 18+ walks and 10 or fewer strikeouts in a 27-game span this season (also: Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR and Gleyber Torres/DET)...is the first D-back to reach the feat within a season since Conor Jackson from May 22-June 28, 2006 (18 BB, 10 K).

RUNS VS. OPPOSING STARTERS: In their last 2 games vs. opposing starters, the D-backs have scored 8 earned runs in 7.1 innings (9.82 ERA) while hitting .300 (9-for-30)/.436 OBP/.433 SLG/.869 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 8 walks and 6 strikeouts.

- The D-backs' 320 runs vs. opposing starting pitchers are the most in the NL, ahead of the Brewers (316) and Dodgers (314).

STUBBORN AGAINST THE SOUTHPAW: Against lefty starting pitchers, the D-backs' 17.5% strikeout rate ranks lowest in the NL, ahead of the Padres (17.7) while their 9.1% walk rate is fourth highest, behind the Padres (9.5%), Giants (9.3) and Braves (9.3).

RELIEVERS RECENTLY: D-backs relievers, over their last 3 games @ Athletics, have allowed just 3 earned runs in 12.2 innings (2.13 ERA) with a 0.95 WHIP, 3 walks and 8 strikeouts.

- Since July 24, in their last 9 games, D-backs' relievers have allowed a MLB-lowest 14.3 (1-of-7) inherited runs allowed pct., ahead of the Cardinals (15.4, 2-of-13), Dodgers (16.7, 3-of-18) and Padres (20.0, 3-of-15).

DANGEROUS FROM 1-2 SPOTS: From the 1-2 lineup spots since June 1, the D-backs lead the Majors in OPS (.884), SLG (.521), triples (9), extra-base hits (51) and total bases (225)...are second in homers (23), OBP (.363) and RBI (69).

- Since 2024, **Ketel Marte's** .390 AVG (30-for-77) when leading off a game ranks atop the Majors (min. 100 PA) while his 13 strikeouts are tied for the fewest with Nico Hoerner/CHC.

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (6-3, 3.20)

- In his last 3 starts (2 quality), is 1-1 with a 1.04 ERA (2 ER in 17.1 IP), 3 walks and 16 strikeouts.
- In his last 2 starts vs. Padres, is 2-0 with a 0.77 ERA (2 R-1 ER in 11.2 IP), 2 walks and 8 strikeouts...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in his last start on June 13.

AT A GLANCE: Third season with the D-backs...debuted in 2023 and made 5 starts in the Postseason (1 Wild Card, 1 NLDS, 2 NLCS, 1 World Series).

- Named the D-backs' 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after leading the organization's farmhands in wins (11), ERA (3.83) and strikeouts (218).
- D-backs' fifth-round pick in the 2020 draft (Bellarmine University).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: His 10 wins are tied with Sonny Gray/STL, Quinn Priester/MIL, Cristopher Sánchez/PHI and Yoshinobu Yamamoto/LAD for fourth in in the NL, behind Freddy Peralta/MIL (12), Matthew Boyd/CHC (11) and Nick Pivetta (11).

- Is the first D-back starting pitcher with 10+ wins in his first 20 starts of a season since Zac Gallen's 11 wins in 20 starts in 2023.
- Is 1 win shy of tying his career high (11).
- Is 6.0 innings shy of eclipsing 400.0 career innings.
- Making his 23rd start (12th home start).
- In his last 2 home starts, is 1-0 with a 1.46 ERA (2 ER in 12.1 IP), opponent .196 AVG/.506 OPS, 0.89 WHIP, 2 walks and 11 strikeouts.

LAST START: Took the loss on July 29 @ Tigers (7 ER in 4.2 IP, 0 BB, 3 K).

VS. PADRES: Making his eighth career start, fourth @ Chase Field.

- Has won his last 2 starts, going 2-0 with a 2.02 ERA (4 R-3 ER in 13.1 IP), opponent .149 AVG, 0.60 WHIP, 1 walk and 13 strikeouts...tossed a career-high 8.0 innings his last start on July 9 @ Petco Park with 2 earned runs allowed on 4 hits with no walks and 4 strikeouts.
- Over his last 3 starts vs. Padres, is 2-0 (team is 3-0) with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER in 17.2 IP), 1 walk and 19 strikeouts.
- In 3 career starts @ Chase Field, is 1-1 with a 3.71 ERA (10 R-7 ER in 17.0 IP), 3 walks and 21 strikeouts.

GIVE 'EM THE HEATER: Is holding hitters to a .160 AVG (4-for-25)/.320 SLG with 9 strikeouts off his fastball in his last 8 starts...over his last 4 home starts, hitters are just 1-for-11 (.091)/.468 OPS.

PRETTY EVEN: In his last 6 starts, has held righties to a .247 AVG (19-for-77) with 2 walks and 22 strikeouts, while lefties are hitting .246 (16-for-65) with 3 walks and 11 strikeouts.

NIGHT OWL: Has won 2 of his last 3 night games, going 2-1 with a 4.12 ERA (9 ER in 19.2 IP), opponent .247 AVG, 0.97 WHIP, no walks and 13 strikeouts.

BY INNING: Is scoreless in 9 straight starts in the second inning (0 ER in 9.0 IP), 0 walks and 7 strikeouts.
