### 2025 Award Winners

The Braves will honor their players who won notable awards last season in a pre-game ceremony prior to tonight's game.

**Drake Baldwin** was named National League Rookie of the Year by both the Baseball Writers' Association of America and Baseball Digest, becoming the 10th player in franchise history to win the honor from the BBWAA. He compiled a .274/.341/.469 line with an .810 OPS in his debut season, with 18 doubles, 19 homers and 80 RBI over 124 total games.

**Ronald Acuña Jr.** was named NL Comeback Player of the Year by Major League Baseball last season, and was honored at the MLB Awards in Las Vegas last November. Acuña Jr. made his season debut on May 23 of last season after returning from a torn ACL suffered in 2024, and batted .290/.417/.518 with 21 home runs in 95 total games. He started in the outfield for the NL All-Star team here at Truist Park.

**Mauricio Dubón** and **Matt Olson** won their second and third Rawlings Gold Glove awards, respectively, last season. Dubón earned his as a utility player in the AL while with the Astros, appearing at every position except pitcher and catcher while ranking in the 99th percentile in outs above average with 20. Olson earned his first such award with Atlanta, after leading all NL first basemen in both outs above average (+9) and defensive runs saved (+17).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Athletics tonight continue a three-game midweek set in what are the only scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...The A's won two-of-three to take the series between the clubs last year.

- A* Atlanta scored three runs in the bottom of the first inning last night and never trailed, shutting out the A's, 4-0, to win the opener.
- A* The two clubs last played here at Truist Park in 2024, and Atlanta won two-of-three...Since the facility opened in 2017, the Braves are 5-1 in six total games versus the Athletics here...The A's are 4-11 all-time in the city of Atlanta.
- A* Despite dropping the series last season, Atlanta is 20-9 (.690) all-time against the Athletics franchise...Atlanta's .690 winning percentage versus the A's is its second-best mark against any AL club in interleague play (Minnesota, 20-8, .714)... Conversely, the A's .310 winning percentage against the Braves is also its second-lowest mark against any NL club (Chicago, 7-17, .292).
- A* RH Aaron Civale has made one start and three career appearances against Atlanta, and all three came last season...The 6-foot-1, 245-pound native of East Windsor, CT, went 0-1 with a 2.79 ERA (3 ER/9.2 IP) versus the Braves last season, doing so as a member of both the Brewers and Cubs... The right-hander signed a one-year major league contract with the A's in February, and he is set tonight to make his team debut.

**JOSÉ SUAREZ:** Makes his first start of the season in what will be his eighth major league campaign... The 5-foot-10, 225-pound Venezuela native made his second straight Opening Day roster with Atlanta this season, after the club acquired him on March 23 of last year from the Angels and he broke camp with the team.

- A* Made seven total appearances (one start) with Atlanta across two stints on the major league roster last season...Went a perfect 2-0 with a 1.86 ERA (4 ER/19.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts.
- A* Made his lone start of the season on September 16 at Washington in the first game of a doubleheader and allowed two runs over 7.0 innings to earn the win...He struck out a career-high nine batters in the effort.
- A* The left-hander has made five career starts and nine total appearances against the Athletics, all while he was a member of the Angels...Suarez is 3-2 with a 3.86 ERA over 42.0 total innings against them, including wins in each of his last two decisions dating to 2022.

**GOOD START:** Mike Yastrzemski came off the bench and went 1-for-2 with a triple and a run scored last night, and has five hits in his first 10 at-bats with Atlanta...He has hits in all three games in which he has played.

- A* At 35 years, 219 days old, he is the oldest Brave to record a triple since Reed Johnson on July 11, 2013 (36 years, 215 days).

**PITCHING:** Bryce Elder, Aaron Bummer, Robert Suarez and Raisel Iglesias combined to pitch a seven-hit shutout last night, and Atlanta has held its opponent scoreless twice in its first four games...The Braves and Yankees are the only two teams in baseball with multiple shutouts this season.

- A* This season marks the first time in Atlanta history (since 1966) that the club has tossed a shutout twice in its first four games, and stands as just the third such time it has done so in franchise history...The 1899 Boston Beaneaters were the first to do so, before the 1906 Boston Nationals matched them.
- A* The Braves currently lead the National League and rank second in the majors with a 1.50 ERA (6 ER/36.0 IP), trailing just the Yankees (0.76)... Atlanta starters also pace the NL with a 1.57 ERA, and their 23.0 total innings from the rotation are tied for the most by any club with just four games played.

**OZZIE IN PLAY:** Ozzie Albies went 1-for-4 last night and has reached base in all four games to start his season...He is batting .333/.375/.533 with a homer, walk and two runs scored through the Braves' first four games.

- A* Albies has not struck out in any of his 16 plate appearances this season, extending his streak to 36 consecutive plate appearances without fanning dating to 2025...It is the longest active streak in the majors.
- A* Albies (426) needs just one extra-base hit to pass Braves Hall of Famer Tommy Holmes and Brian McCann (426) for 10th in franchise history and sixth in Atlanta history...His Opening Day homer tied Holmes and McCann in franchise annals.

**FORMER TEAM CARD:** Matt Olson is set tonight to face the A's for the 15th team in his career...A former first-round pick of the A's in 2012, he appeared in 575 career games for the club from 2016-21.

- A* The Atlanta native finished fourth in AL Rookie of the Year voting for the A's in 2017, won Gold Gloves with the franchise in 2018 & 2019, and represented the club at the 2021 All-Star Game... His 142 home runs for the A's rank 16th in the 125-year history of the franchise.
- A* Olson has batted .255 (14-for-55) in his first 14 games against his former club, with three homers, 10 RBI and an .806 OPS...He doubled in a run in last night's first inning to open the scoring.

**OPENING IN INTERLEAGUE:** For the first time in franchise history, Atlanta opened its season with an interleague series as the Braves hosted the Kansas City Royals this weekend.

- A* Atlanta will play 12 of its first 16 games against American League opponents to open the year, with just one of its first five series of the season against a fellow NL club...The Braves are hosting the Athletics (AL) to complete its opening homestand, before subsequent series against the D-backs (NL), Angels (AL) and Guardians (AL).

- A Making his fifth appearance with Atlanta, first start of the season and 63rd of his career.
- A Making his first appearance against the Athletics since October 1, 2023 with Los Angeles (AL)...Spent six seasons in the AL West with the Angels from 2019-24 and is 3-2 with a 3.86 ERA (18 ER/42.0 IP) in nine career appearances (five starts) against Oakland.
- A Went 2-0 with a 3.38 ERA (6 ER/16.0 IP) and 14 strikeouts across five spring appearances (two starts).
- A Went 2-0 with a 1.86 ERA (4 ER/19.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in seven appearances (one start) for Atlanta in 2025 after being recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett on September 16.
- A Struck out a career-high nine batters over 7.0 innings in his only start of 2025, a win at Washington on September 16...It was also his longest outing since tossing 9.0 innings in his career complete game on September 4, 2021 with Los Angeles (AL) against Texas.
  - A Earned his first career save on September 22, 2025, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings against the Nationals.
- A Was claimed off waivers by Baltimore on January 15, 2026...Designated for assignment on January 22 following the acquisition of Weston Wilson...Claimed back off waivers by Atlanta on January 26.
- A Is making his second career start for Atlanta...His first came at Washington on September 16, 2025, when he became the eighth Venezuelan-born player to start a game in Braves franchise history.

#### 2025

- A Was acquired by Atlanta from Los Angeles (AL) in exchange for RH Ian Anderson on March 23...Made the Braves' Opening Day roster as a reliever.
- A Went 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA (2 ER/7.1 IP) in three appearances out of Atlanta's bullpen before being designated for assignment on April 21.
- A Went 5-1 with a 3.50 ERA (24 ER/61.2 IP) and 69 strikeouts across 13 appearances (11 starts) with Atlanta's minor league affiliates, pitching across three levels of the Braves farm system.
  - A Went 3-1 with a 3.53 ERA over eight starts, nine appearances, with Triple-A Gwinnett.
  - A Finished 1-0 with a 4.02 ERA in three starts with Double-A Columbus.
  - A Made one appearance with High-A Rome, going 2.2 scoreless innings in relief.
- A Had his contract selected on September 16...Went 2-0 with a 1.86 ERA (4 ER/19.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in seven appearances (one start) with Atlanta across two stints on the major league roster.
- A Utilized his four-seamer on 38%, sinker 8.6%, slider 20.8%, curveball 6.0% and changeup 26.2% of pitches thrown between Triple-A and Atlanta.

  - A Made three consecutive Opening Day rosters for the Angels between 2022-24.
- A Is 22-29 with a 5.30 ERA in 106 career appearances, 62 starts, between LA and Atlanta.

  - A Scattered five hits without issuing a walk over 9.0 frames...Carried a shutout into the ninth inning.

- A Native of Naganagua, Venezuela...Signed with Los Angeles as an international free agent on July 3, 2014.

- Appeared in 42 games in his second season as a Brave, pitching to a 3-2 record and a 3.81 ERA (23 ER/54.1 IP) with 51 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP, his lowest since 2020...Was placed on the injured list on August 24 due to left shoulder inflammation and missed the remainder of the season.
- Ranked in the 99th percentile in baseball with a barrel rate of just 3.2% in 2025...His seven total barrels and 2.3% barrel rate allowed since joining the Braves in 2024 are both the best in the majors (min. 400 batters faced).
- Opponents hit ground balls off him 55.8% of the time last season (league average 42.4%)...Since his debut in 2017, Bummer's career ground ball rate of 64.2% is highest in the majors (min. 350 games).
- Tossed his curveball a career-high 35.1% of the time in 2025, the most of any major league pitcher with at least 900 total pitches last season...Utilized a curveball for the first time in 2024 at a 2.3% clip.

- Among active pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (222 apps.), Iglesias owns the best WHIP (0.94) and second-best ERA (2.35, 57 ER/218.2 IP).
- Ranked second among Braves pitchers in franchise history (min. 100 G) in WHIP and ERA+ (180), third in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.88), fourth in hits-per-nine-innings (6.5) and fifth in ERA and saves (97).
- Did not allow a run in 42 of 45 appearances from June 9 until the end of the season...Led major league pitchers in this span (min. 40.0 IP) in hits-per-nine-innings (4.15) and saves (21), tied for the most fWAR among relievers (1.5) and ranked second in ERA (1.25, 6 ER/43.1 IP) and WHIP (0.69).
- Was named the NL Reliever of the Month for August for the third consecutive season after converting all 10 of his save opportunities and allowing a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) in the month.

- From his Braves debut on July 31 until the end of the season, Kinley led major league pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) in ERA and ranked third in WHIP and opponent's batting average (.126).
- Among Braves pitchers with at least 24 appearances in a season, Kinley holds the second-best ERA, WHIP, hits-per-nine-innings (4.0) and ERA+ (583) marks in a single campaign.

- Ranked in the 90th percentile or better in baseball in expected ERA (91st, 2.91), walk percentage (92nd, 5.3%), hard-hit percentage (93rd, 33.5%), and whiff percentage (95th, 33.6%).
- Threw his slider 612 times and surrendered just 22 hits on it...Among pitchers that threw as many on the season, those 22 hits were the fewest in MLB...His slider carried a run value of 10, also ranking in the 95th percentile.
- Dating to his first full season in 2022, Lee's 2.76 ERA ranks fourth among all left-handed relievers in baseball to make at least 175 appearances...Among those pitchers, Lee's rate of 4.80 strikeouts-per-walk is best in the majors.
