Capital Punishment

José Quintana is 4-1 with a 1.91 ERA in 8 career starts against Washington (47ip, 32h, 11r, 10er, 15bb, 30k, 0hr), including 2-0 without allowing a run in 3 starts with the Mets last season (21ip, 7h, 6bb, 10k).

Mr. Vaughnderful

Andrew Vaughn, who was acquired from the White Sox on June 13 and joined the team on July 7, is batting .365 (19-for-52) with 5 HR and 21 RBI in 16 games as a Brewer while posting a .426 OBP/.731 SLG/1.157 OPS.... Vaughn is currently on a 6-game hitting streak, batting .476 (10-for-21) with 3 HR and 9 RBI while posting a .478 OBP/1.000 SLG/1.478 OPS.

Don't Mess With Bill

In his last 17 games, **William Contreras** is batting .324 (23-for-71) with 2 HR and 10 RBI....in this stretch, he has a .347 OBP/.479 SLG/.826 OPS....he hit a pair of homers on Wednesday against the Cubs, his first home runs since 6/14 vs. St. Louis (134 at-bats).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 1 of a 6-game road trip to Washington (3g) and Atlanta (3g).....the team is coming off a 3-3 homestand against Miami (1-2) and Chicago-NL (2-1).....following this trip and an off day next Thursday, the Brewers return home for 6 games against New York-NL (3g) and Pittsburgh (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without **Bob Uecker** on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (136 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 22*, **SECOND:** 57, **THIRD:** 43, **FOURTH:** 11, **FIFTH:** 3....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the Cubs by 1.0 game (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING:

The team is 21-12-2 in series play. **Game 1:** 21-14, **Game 2:** 21-14, **Game 3:** 19-15, **Game 4:** 3-1 **Sweeps (6):** vs. BOS (3g, 5/26-5/28), at PHI (3g, 5/30-6/1), at MIN (3g, 6/20-6/22), vs. LAD (3g, 7/7-7/9), vs. WSH (3g, 7/11-7/13) and at LAD (3g, 7/18-7/20) **Were Swept (1):** at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The team is 36-20 at home, going 13-5-0 in series play....are 24-11 in the last 35 home games and 13-4 in the last 17....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 7/7-7/13.

ON THE ROAD: The team is 28-24 on the road, going 8-7-2 in series play....are 18-6 in the last 24 road games and 6-1 in the last 7 contests....have had three season-high 5-game road winning streaks, coming from 5/25-6/2, 6/19-7/2 and 7/6-7/21.

MANAGER: **Pat Murphy** is in his second season as Brewers manager....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Associate manager **Rickie Weeks** (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach **Jim Henderson** (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (2nd season), lead hitting coach **Al LeBoeuf** (1st season), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (4th season), hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (1st season), assistant coach **Daniel de Mondesert** (2nd season), infield coach **Matt Erickson** (2nd season), first base coach **Julio Borbón** (1st season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (10th season/5th in current role).

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 19 replay challenges this season, going 12-7....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/30 vs. Chicago-NL as an out call at first base involving William Contreras stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6)....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24)....this does not include 2020....the Brewers have 730 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

2025 Arsenal: Sinker (45.9%) - Changeup (21.9%) - Curveball (13.3%) - 4-Seam Fastball (10.5%) - Slurve (8.4%)

QUINTANA AT A GLANCE: José Quintana, 36, will make his 16th start of the season and first against the Nationals....he last started last Saturday vs. Miami and took a 7-4 loss (5ip, 7h, 5r, 2er, 2bb, 2k, 2hr, 99 pitches)....the team is 10-5 in his starts....he has 4 quality starts....opponents are batting .247 (77-for-312, 11hr)....he was on the 15-day injured list from 5/14-5/31 with a left shoulder impingement, retroactive to May 11....Quintana signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on March 5....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026....name is pronounced "keen-TAH-nuh."

MR. COLOMBIA: Quintana, born in Arjona, Colombia, is his country's all-time leader in nearly every statistical category in the Major Leagues, including games (374), starts (348), wins (109), innings pitched (2052.0) and strikeouts (1,782)....he pitched for Colombia in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

BEEN THERE, DONE THAT: Quintana has made 348 starts since 2012 - his first season - trailing only **Max Scherzer** (363)....this includes nine seasons of 30+ starts.

CAREER: Is 109-107 with a 3.73 ERA in 374 games/348 starts (2052.0ip, 851er)....is in his 14th Major League season while pitching for Chicago-AL (2012-17), Chicago-NL (2017-20), Los Angeles-AL (2021), San Francisco (2021), Pittsburgh (2022), St. Louis (2022), New York-NL (2023-24) and Milwaukee (2025)....was an All-Star in 2016 as he finished 10th in American League Cy Young Award voting....Quintana was originally signed by the Mets as a non-drafted free agent on 4/26/06.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-7 with a 4.25 ERA in 19 starts (103.2ip, 49er)....is 2-3 with a 4.91 ERA in 7 starts this season (36.2ip, 20er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 55-56 with a 3.73 ERA in 189 games/177 starts (1034.0ip, 429er)....is 5-1 with a 2.36 ERA in 8 starts this season (45.2ip, 12er).
