BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals play the first of a three-game series with the San Francisco Giants in their final stop of a three-city road trip through the National League West. The Cardinals arrived in San Francisco at 9:00 p.m., Pacific Time coming off a 10-8 comeback win at Colorado to secure a second straight road series win and are 4-2 through the first six games of this trip. Tonight's game is nationally televised on NBC Peacock with Dave Flemming, Albert Pujols, Hunter Pence, Adam Ottavino and Ashley ShahAhmadi on the broadcast.

SPEAKING OF ALBERT: Former Cardinal **Albert Pujols** will be on tonight's call. Pujols, who will be inducted into the Cardinals Hall of Fame on Saturday, has been in the Cardinals research a lot this road trip. **Thomas Saggese** became the 17th Cardinals player and first since Pujols with a multi-HR game at Dodger Stadium and first since Pujols hit his 700th career home run. Rookie **Joshua Báez** 7 HR in his first 21 games matched Pujols from his rookie year in 2001. **Jordan Walker** and **Alec Burleson** became the first Cardinals right-left combo with 100+ RBI season since Pujols teamed up with **Jim Edmonds** and **Scott Rolen** to hit the 100 RBI in a trifecta in 2004.

THE MAIN EVENT: With today's game on NBC/Peacock, the Cardinals have previously appeared on national television 18 times. Their record stands at 10-8: FOX/FS1 (3-4), NBC/Peacock (3-1), Apple TV (2-2), ESPN (1-1), TBS (1-0).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 16.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 9.0 games behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals are 4.0 games out of the 3rd Wild Card position held by Arizona with San Diego in their path. St. Louis has nine road games remaining and nine home games.

HEADING OUT TO SAN FRANCISCO, FOR THE LABOR DAY WEEKEND SHOW...: The Cardinals are 91-106-3 in their history on Labor Day and 39-75-1 on the road. The Cardinals last played San Francisco on Labor Day in 2019 at Busch Stadium, and won 3-1. The last time the Cardinals played the Giants on the road on Labor Day, they swept a doubleheader from the New York Giants at the Polo Grounds in 1902 (6-4 & 8-2).

STRZELECKI BEGINS REHAB ASSIGNMENT: Injured RHP **Peter Strzelecki** (right forearm) will begin an injury rehabilitation assignment with Memphis (AAA) on Tuesday.

THE SCOOP ON COOP': Cardinals rookie LHP **Cooper Hjerpe** fired 4.0 perfect innings in his Major League debut at Colorado yesterday. He became the first left-handed relief pitcher to hurl 4.0 perfect innings in his MLB debut and the 2nd reliever ever behind University of Missouri alum, RHP **Max Scherzer** with 4.1 perfect IP with Arizona on April 29, 2008 vs. Houston.

CLOSING IN ON 400: Manager **Oliver Marmol** could achieve his 400th career win if they sweep the Giants making him the 9th manager in Cardinals history (since joining the National League in 1892) to win 400 and the first since **Mike Matheny**.

FOREVER YOUNG: Among the Cardinals final six opponents, Cardinals 40-year old manager **Oliver Marmol** will be matched up with five managers who have yet to record a full season (Schaeffer, COL; Vitello, SF; Venable, CWS; Butera, WSH & Kelly, PIT). Only Pat Murphy (MIL) has managed more than a full season, while Marmol is coming to the end of his 5th full season as manager in St. Louis.

DIRTY MIKE AND THE BOYS: Starting pitcher **Michael McGreevy**, a California native and UC-Santa Barbara alum, is an out-standing 6-0 in eight career starts on the road against National League West opponents with the Cardinals 8-0 in those games. McGreevy hurled a career-high 8.0 innings in a win at Oracle Park on Sept. 29, 2024 in the final game of the regular season.

20/20 VISION: Cardinals All-Star OF **Jordan Walker** (28 HR/19 SB) needs one stolen base to become the 11th instance a Cardinals player has achieved 20 HR and 20 SB in a single season and the first since **Tommy Pham** in 2017. Walker would join a Cardinals list that includes Pham, **Ray Lankford** (5x), **Lou Brock** (1967), **Brian Jordan** (1995), **Fernando Tatis** (1999), **Reggie Sanders** (2004). Lankford ran off four consecutive seasons (1995-98).

Nathan Church and **Matt Chapman** are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

Bryan Torres was selected by the Giants from the Brewers in the Triple-A phase of the 2019 Rule 5 Draft & played in 43 games for Double-A Richmond in 2021.

Justin Bruihl was born in nearby Petaluma, Calif., and earned his first save on Sept. 18, 2022 at San Francisco while with the Dodgers.

Quinn Mathews pitched at nearby Stanford University from 2020-23, going 25-10 in 68 games (45 starts) and was the 2023 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year.

Alec Burleson and **Carson Whisenhunt** were teammates at East Carolina University in 2020.

Daniel Descalso was born in Redwood City and resides in Danville, Calif...graduated from Saint Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at UC-Davis (2005-07).

Giants Manager **Tony Vitello** is a St. Louis native...attended De Smet High School and the University

of Missouri, where he played baseball from 2000-02...was an asst. coach at Mizzou from 2003-10.

Hayden Birdsong was born in Mattoon, Ill...pitched at Eastern Illinois University in Charleston, Ill., where Sr. Dir., Player Dev. **Kyle Haines** graduated with a kinesiology and sports mgt. degree.

Andrew Knizner played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2019-23)...selected in the 7th round of the 2016 MLB Draft by the Cardinals.

Giants Hitting Coach **Hunter Mense** played baseball at the Univ. of Missouri from 2004-06 and was an assistant coach from 2011-16...Bench Coach **Jayce Tingler** played at Mizzou from 2000-03.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Willie McGee** played four seasons (1991-95) with the Giants...was born in San Francisco...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill...resides in Hercules...worked as an asst. coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, CA.

Harrison Bader was a 3rd-round selection by St. Louis in the 2015 MLB Draft and played in 523 games for the Cardinals from 2017-22.

JT Brubaker (July 26, 2020 at STL w/ PIT), **Adrian Houser** (Sept. 26, 2015 at STL w/MIL), **Trevor McDonald** (Sept. 29, 2024 at Oracle Park w/SF), **Blade Tidwell** (May 4, 2025[1] at STL w/NYM) & **Keaton Winn** (June 13, 2023 at STL w/SF) all made their MLB debuts against the Cardinals.

Giants 1B Coach **Shane Robinson** was selected by St. Louis in 5th round of the 2006 MLB Draft and played in 268 games for STL from 2009, 11-14.

Cardinals Bullpen Coach **Julio Rangel** was the Giants Minor League Pitching Coordinator in 2018.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in San Francisco (2006-07).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Keith Hernandez** was born in San Francisco, CA...graduated from Capuchino High School in San Bruno, CA.

Giants Special Asst. **Will Clark** played in 51 games

TONIGHT'S START:

- Making his 28th start of the season, extending his career-high in starts and appearances.
- Is 6-0 with a 3.54 ERA in eight career road starts against National League West opponents, while the Cardinals have gone 8-0 as a team in those starts.**
- Leads the Cardinals with a career-high 147.1 innings. Pitched a career-high 173.0 innings between Memphis-AAA (150.0) and St. Louis (23.0) in 2024.
- Allowed two runs or fewer in 15 of his 27 starts this season, while his 13 starts of 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer runs allowed lead the Cardinals and rank T-10th in the NL.**
- Ranks among NL leaders in Pct. Pitches Taken (55.4%, 4th), Pct. Pitches Put in Play (19.4%, 5th) and Pct. Swings Put In Play (43.4%, 2nd).
- The Cardinals are 27-19 (.536 win pct.) in his 46 career starts, and since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 24 of his starts - most among all Cardinals starters.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 46 career starts, longest such streak to begin a career by a Cardinal. Seattle's **George Kirby** leads active pitchers with 139 starts.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 27 of 46 career starts (23 quality starts), including 9 of his last 16 since June 1.
- Allowed 1 run or fewer with 6.0+ IP in a four-start stretch (April 26-May 14), the longest such streak by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, September 1 at Los Angeles-NL): W, 13-8; 5.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 0 HR, 2 BB, 4 SO - 90 pitches.

- Matched a career high with 10 runs of support, his most since he received 10 runs in his MLB debut on 7/31/24 vs. TEX and 2nd most for a Cardinals starter this season (1st: **Andre Pallante**, 16 on 7/3 at CHC).
- Walked two batters in his 5th straight start, the longest such streak by a Cardinals starter since **Matthew Liberatore** had a 5-start streak from 5/26/23-6/25/23 (Last with 6 straight: **Bob Forsch**, 4/23/77-5/18/77).
- Allowed 5 hits or fewer for the team-leading 17th start this season.
- Made his team-high 21st start of 5.0+ IP with 2-or-fewer walks allowed (T-3rd in NL).

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

GETTING DEFENSIVE: Is 1 of 4 qualified NL with a perfect 1.000 fielding pct and ranks among NL pitchers in total chances (35, 5th), assists (19, T-4th), and double plays (4, T-1st) ... Boasts 5 Defensive Runs Saved, T-1st among MLB pitchers with **Nolan McLean**.

RUN PREVENTION: Ranks 2nd among NL pitchers this season w/ 7 Net Bases Prevented (*a sum of advances prevented and outs added*), behind only **Shota Imanaga** (8) ... Since McGreevy's MLB Debut (July 31, 2024), he has conceded 3 SB on just 6 attempts, 3rd-fewest SB in MLB over timespan, while his 50% SB rate ranks 4th-best in MLB (min. 250 IP) ... Out of 1,582 SB career opportunities, McGreevy's SB attempt pct. (0.3%) is 3rd-lowest in MLB to **Mitchell Parker** (0.2%) and **Ryne Nelson** (0.2%).

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has the NL's lowest percent (19.6) of Swing & Miss ... His difference in Opponent BA (.258) vs. xBA (.281) ranks 9th among qualified MLB starting pitchers (-.023) ... **The Cardinals have provided McGreevy with an 11 Fielding Run Value, highest for any MLB pitcher this season.**

ONE FOR THE ROAD: Posted a 3.89 ERA in 14 road starts this season with a team-high seven quality starts (T-10th in NL).

TWO FOR THE PRICE OF ONE: Has induced a career-high 15 groundball double plays (7th in NL).

HERE'S SOME HELP: Has received 7+ runs of support in 3 of his last 4 starts (Aug. 15-present), and his 28 runs of support in that time are the most for any MLB pitcher ... Received 6 runs of support or fewer in each of his first 23 starts (March 28-Aug. 9), and his initial 3.93 run support average in that span was the NL's 8th-lowest (min. 100.0 IP) ... The Cardinals have been shut out 7 times this season, 4 of which were when McGreevy has started ... **Has been in position for 8 wins this season when the game was blown by the bullpen, most of any MLB pitcher.**

HAPPY BIRTHDAY!: Celebrated his 26th birthday on July 8 vs. Milwaukee with a 5-1 win, limiting the Brew Crew to 1 run in a season-high 6.1 innings.

McGREEVY vs. SAN FRANCISCO:

- Making his 4th career start vs. the Giants and 1st this season ... Has yet to face SF in a month other than September ... Becomes the 4th Cardinals pitcher all-time to make at least four September starts against the Giants and first since **Ray Washburn** made his 4th with a no-hitter on Sept. 18, 1968 at Candlestick Park.
- Is 2-1 with a 6.35 ERA (17.0 IP) in his three starts vs. the Giants, including 2-0 with a 4.15 ERA (13.0 IP) in two starts at Oracle Park.
- Has received six runs of support in both starts at Oracle Park, tying CHC (1 home, 1 road) and SD (both road) for his most starts with 6+ runs of support against any opponent.
- Pitched a career-high 8.0 innings and allowed one run in a 6-1 Cardinals win at Oracle Park for his first career appearance against SF in the final regular season game of the 2024 season.
- Went 1-1 and allowed a combined 11 runs across 9.0 IP in his two starts vs. the Giants last season.
- Has made 15 career starts vs. NL West opponents (7-4, 4.76 ERA), his most starts and wins against any opposing division (2nd: NL Central - 13 starts, 6 wins).
