HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 8 of their 12 series post-All-Star break (also: split 1, lost 3).

- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 13 straight games, batting .356 (16-for-45)/1.207 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 triples, 2 homers, 4 RBI, 9 walks (7 K) and 4 stolen bases.
- **Brandon Pfaadt**, in his last 10 starts, is 7-0 (team is 9-1) with a 1.79 ERA (13 R-12 ER in 60.1 IP), opponent .214 AVG (48-for-224)/.545 OPS, 0.91 WHIP, 7 walks and 38 strikeouts.
 - In 4 career starts vs. Cubs, is 1-2 with a 1.78 ERA (6 R-5 ER in 25.1 IP), opponent .185 AVG (17-for-92), 0.79 WHIP, 3 walks and 24 strikeouts.
- **Tim Tawa** has reached base safely in a career-high 10 straight games, hitting .342 (13-for-38)/.943 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 7-0 vs. Cubs last night.

- **Corbin Carroll** (0-for-3, BB, 2 SB) recorded his franchise-best 13th career occurrence of 2 stolen bases in an inning...his franchise-high 27 career multi-stolen base games are tied for most in the Majors since 2023 (also: Elly De La Cruz/CIN).
- **Tim Tawa** (1-for-3) hit safely in his fourth straight game.
- **Merrill Kelly** took the loss after allowing 3 runs on 5 hits and 3 walks with 4 strikeouts in 5.2 innings.

YESTERDAY'S ROSTER MOVES: Yesterday, the D-backs recalled RHP **Juan Burgos** from Triple-A Reno and optioned LHP **Mitch Bratt** following Sunday's game.

THE BOUNCE-BACK: The D-backs are 5-3 after being shut out this season.

BEST GLOVES FACE OFF: The D-backs' .990 fielding pct. (49 errors) ranks best in MLB with the Cubs (49 errors).

- The D-backs' 116 double plays rank third in the Majors, behind the Cardinals (132) and Giants (120)...the Cubs' 100 rank tied for 13th.

KEPLER VS. CUBS: Max Kepler, vs. Cubs, has reached base safely in 15 of his 16 career starts, batting .361 (22-for-61)/1.081 OPS with 4 doubles, 5 homers, 13 RBI, 5 walks and 1 stolen base...has reached 2+ times in 8 of those starts.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 2.0 games behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5), 4.0 games behind the Phillies (WC2, lead season 2-1) and 7.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1).

GABI IN RARE CATCHER COMPANY: Gabriel Moreno (103 G, .303 AVG, 64 RBI, 10 CS, 2 E) is just 1 of 5 primary catchers since 2000 with a .300+ AVG, 60+ RBI, 10+ caught stealing and 2 or fewer errors within the first 110 games of a season, joining Ivan Rodriguez/TEX (2000 - .347 AVG, 83 RBI, 19 CS, 2 E), Jason Varitek/BOS ('04 - .307 AVG, 64 RBI, 20 CS, 2 E), Joe Mauer/MIN ('08 - .324 AVG, 60 RBI, 21 CS, 2 E) and Buster Posey/SF ('15 - .326 AVG, 78 RBI, 20 CS, 1 E).

TAWA'S TREND: Tim Tawa has hit safely in 4 straight games, including 2 hits in 3 of those games.

FERNANDEZ PRODUCES: Jose Fernandez has a 7-game hitting streak since June 4, batting .381 (8-for-21)/.956 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 RBI, 4 walks and 2 stolen bases.

- Has reached base safely in 9 straight games since June 2, batting .346 (9-for-26)/.875 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 RBI, 5 walks and 2 stolen bases.

LAWLAR'S HOME RHYTHM: Jordan Lawlar has reached base safely in 9 of his 10 home starts, batting .406 (13-for-32)/1.097 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 5 RBI, 2 walks and 1 stolen base.

WITH RISP: Since the All-Star break, **Gabriel Moreno's** 27 RBI with runners in scoring position ranks second in the Majors, behind Sal Stewart/CIN (28).

- Since Aug. 1 with runners in scoring position, **Ilde-maro Vargas** is carrying a 1.115 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 1 homer, 12 RBI and 2 walks.

WALDY AMONG NL ROOKIES: Among NL rookies [min. 200 PA], **Ryan Waldschmidt's** .273 AVG ranks tied for fourth with Cole Carrigg/COL, behind TJ Rumfield/COL (.287), Carson Benge/NYM (.278) and Konnor Griffin/PIT (.276).

WAR LEADERS: Since June 1, **Gabriel Moreno's** 3.3 fWAR ranks third in the Majors, behind Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (6.7) and Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (3.4)...**Moreno's** 4.0 season fWAR ranks 11th in the NL.

- **Corbin Carroll's** 4.5 season fWAR ranks third among NL players, behind Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (8.6) and Otto Lopez/MIA (4.6).
- **Geraldo Perdomo's** 1.6 season defensive bWAR ranks eighth in the NL.
- **Eduardo Rodriguez's** 4.9 bWAR for pitchers ranks third in the NL.

DRS LEADERBOARD: Among defensive runs saved leaders, **Gabriel Moreno's** 9 DRS are tied for fifth among catchers with Tyler Heineman/LAA (leaders at 12) and **Corbin Carroll's** 11 DRS are seventh among outfielders (leader at 25).

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs' 24 wins (24-16) since July 9 are tied for third in the Majors with the Yankees and Cubs, behind the Red Sox (30) and Padres (25).

VS. CUBS: The D-backs are 5-5 in their last 10 home games vs. Cubs (since 2023).
