RAY REPORT—The Rays wrap up a brief three-game road trip at Yankee Stadium in this afternoon's rubber match...following today's contest, the Rays will return to Tropicana Field to host the Tigers from April 22-24 ahead of a six-game road trip against the White Sox and Brewers from April 26-May 1...they have alternated wins and losses over their last eight contests (4-4) following a 5-1 stretch from April 6-12...they are 5-4 so far in a stretch of 13 consecutive games without an off day that concludes on April 24 vs. DET.

The Rays picked up their second extra-inning victory in yesterday's 2-0 win...it marked their first shutout of the season and first at Yankee Stadium since Aug. 15, 2022(4-0)...it was the Rays second extra-inning shutout vs. New York, joining Sept. 13, 2010 (1-0), and their first in the Bronx...the Rays have now posted two extra-inning shutouts over the last six seasons since 2019 (also: Aug. 30, 2023 at MIA).

The Rays have won two of their last three games despite plating three runs or fewer in each contest...their four victories when scoring three or fewer times are tied for second most in the majors behind the Mets (5).

The Rays pitching staff has not allowed an ER in its last 21.0 IP dating back to the 7th inning on April 18 vs. LAA...the staff carries a season-long 11.0 scoreless inning streak into today's contest.

Yesterday's win marked the 751st of Kevin Cash's career...he is four victories shy of surpassing Joe Maddon (754) as the Rays would:

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

Win back-to-back series in the Bronx for the first time since Aug. 18, 2020-April 18, 2021...they took two of three from July 31-Aug. 2, 2023 at Yankee Stadium.

Avoid their first series loss to New York since Sept. 9-11, 2022 in the Bronx, improving to 4-0-1 in series against the Yankees since the beginning of last season...it would mark their most consecutive undefeated series against the Pinstripes since Sept. 24, 2019-April 18, 2021 (6).

Improve to 11-1-1 in their last 13 road series dating back to July 28-30 at HOU. Remain undefeated over their last five series (4-0-1) following an 0-1-1 start. Improve to 4-1 in rubber games, claiming their fourth straight win after dropping their first series-deciding contest on April 3 vs. TEX.

Move to a season-high three games above .500.

ON THE OFFENSIVE—The Rays are averaging 2.75 runs per game in their last four contests despite collecting 10+ hits in two of those games...on the season, they own the AL's fifth-highest average (.248) while ranking 10th in slugging pct. (.364)...they lead the AL in infield hits (25) and rank second in singles (136), but are tied for 12th in extra-base hits (48)...the Rays have been held to 2 XBH or fewer in six straight games, their longest streak since May 26-31, 2022 (6G)...their last streak of 7+ games came from June 11-18, 2018 (8G).

Over their last six games, the Rays are 8-for-51 (.157) with RISP while batting .277 (44-for-159) in all other situations...this comes on the heels of posting a .312 (24-for-77) RISP average from April 2-13 (10G).

Rays hitters have been at their best in late-game situations, batting an AL-leading .318 (56-for-176) from the 8th inning on, second in the majors behind the Brayes

3.18 (56-for-176) from the 8th inning on, second in the majors behind the Braves (.358)...their .227 (128-for-565) average in innings 1-7 ranks 25th.

At 31.1 pct., the Rays own the ALs highest chase rate, trailing only the Marlins (33.7%) and Rockies (32.5%) in all of MLB...they have recorded 45 swinging strikeouts on pitches out of the strike zone, tied with the Red Sox for second most in the AL behind the Athletics (47).

In yesterday's win, the Rays did not draw a walk for the second time this season (also April 10 at LAA)...it marked the fifth time in franchise history Rays hitters did not record a free pass in an extra-inning game (last: June 19, 2021 at SEA).

PITCHING PROWESS—Rays pitching has posted a 1.65 ERA (49.0IP, 9ER) over the last five games after producing a 7.33 ERA (27.0IP, 22ER) in their previous three contests (April 13-15)...their season ERA has dropped from 5.11 to 4.27 in that timeframe, 11th in the AL/21st in the majors...they have allowed only 1 ER over their last three games (27.0IP), tallying a 0.33 ERA in that span...it marks the 10th time in club history the Rays have yielded 1 ER or fewer over a three-game stretch (last: April 8-10, 2023).

The Rays rotation carries an 11.1 scoreless inning streak into today's game...Rays starters have pitched to a 1.93 ERA (37.1IP, 8ER) over their last seven outings.

Over the last five games since April 16, the Rays bullpen owns a 0.90 ERA (20.0IP, 2ER)...this, after opening the season with an MLB-high 6.92 ERA (67.2IP, 52ER) over their first 17 games...they have not allowed an ER in their last three games (9.2IP).

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—The Rays have been tagged for 30 HR, tied with the Blue Jays for the most in the majors...the Rays have allowed at least 1 HR in 16 of 22 games, going 6-10 in those affairs compared to 6-0 when holding the opposition homerless...on the season, 48 of the 106 (45.3%) runs allowed by Rays pitching have come off the 30 HR...today's starter, RHP Aaron Civale, has yielded eight runs this season, seven of which have come via the 5 HR against him.

Meanwhile, the Rays offense has tallied 3 HR in their last six games since launching a season-high 4 HR on April 14 vs. SF...they have 10 HR in their last 16 games since April 3, fourth fewest in the majors, ahead of only the White Sox (4HR), Tigers and Cardinals (9HR each)...from Opening Day through April 2, their 8 HR tied the Astros and Royals for the AL lead.

The Rays have been out-homered, 30-18 (-12)...it ties the Blue Jays for the thirdworst home run differential in the majors, ahead of only the White Sox (-18) and Cardinals (-13)...their +53 (230-177) HR differential last season paced the AL.

AMED. A MYTH. A LEGEND—Amed Rosario has gone 21-for-52 (.404) with 2 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR and 9 RBI during his 12-game hitting streak, the longest active run in the AL and tying the longest run of his career (June 5-18, 2022)...the streak is the longest by a Rays batter since Yandy Diaz hit safely in 14 straight from May 3-21, 2023...Rosario has multiple hits in four of five and six of his last eight games...his average has increased from .167 on April 3 to .343 today, fifth highest in the AL...his .404 average since the streak started on April 4 paces the AL.

NEW YORK, NEW YORK—The Rays and Yankees continue a 13-game season series today in the Bronx, concluding the first of four individual series in 2024...the next meeting will come from May 10-12 when the Yankees travel to Tropicana Field for a three-game weekend series...the Rays went 8-5 against the Pinstripes in 2023, taking four of seven games in New York...they have won three of the last four season series vs. the Yankees since 2020, posting the best record against New York by any AL team over that span (36-27/.571)...they went 38-57 (.400) from 2015-19.

The Rays have out-hit the Yankees in four straight games dating back to Aug. 26, 2023 in St. Pete, going 3-1 in that span and out-hitting New York by a cumulative 40-15 (+25) margin...it marks their longest such streak against the Yankees since out-hitting them in 10 straight from May 14-Sept. 16, 2015.

TODAY'S START—Civale will make his fifth start of the season, including his second on the road...has allowed 3 ER or fewer in each of his first four starts...the Rays are 5-4 in his last nine outings compared to 4-1 in his first five after being acquired from the Guardians on July 31, 2023...in 14 starts since the trade, has turned in a 4.48 ERA (68.1IP, 34ER)...enters today's outing at 498.1 IP, 1.2 shy of reaching 500.0 career IP.

LAST TIME OUT-Did not factor into the decision on April 16 vs. Los Angeles-AL (6.0IP, 5H, 3ER, 2HR, 0BB, 8SO)...was scoreless through 3.2 innings, but was tagged for three runs in the top of the 4th frame following a Miguel Sanó single and back-to-back homers by Mickey Moniak and Logan O'Hoppe to give the Angels a 3-0 lead.

He allowed multiple homers for the first time since Sept. 14, 2023

at BAL (2HR).

CONCRETE JUNGLE—Civale will make his sixth career start opposite New York, having gone 1-3 with a 4.78 ERA (26.1IP, 14ER) in the prior five outings...he has yet to face the Yankees as a member of the Rays.

In three career starts at Yankee Stadium, he is 1-2 with a 4.80 ERA (15.0IP, 8ER)...he made his lone postseason start in this venue, but

was removed after recording two outs in Game 5 of Cleveland's 2022 ALDS (0.2IP, 2H, 3ER, HR, BB, SO, HBP).

Civale has made 15 career starts against the AL East, going 6-6 with a 5.17 ERA (76.2IP, 44ER)...is 1-1 with a 4.00 ERA (18.0IP, 8ER) in four starts against the division since joining Tampa Bay.

STRIKEOUT STUFF—He has struck out 26 batters, tied for his most strikeouts through four games to begin a season (also 2020)...he has 8 SO in two of four starts (April 3 vs. TEX and April 16 vs. LAA) after having four such starts all of last season, three of which came with the Rays.

Since joining Tampa Bay, Civale has made 14 starts and produced a 29.3 pct. strikeout rate (84SO/287BF)...in 76 starts for the Guardians, he posted a 21.1 pct. strikeout rate (370SO/1750BF).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN—Civale has allowed three runs or fewer in each of his last 15 road starts dating back to Sept. 20, 2022, including six outings in which he yielded one or zero runs...it is the second-longest active streak in the majors, trailing only MIL **Wade Miley** (16GS)...last season, his 2.40 ERA (60.0IP, 16ER) on the road ranked third in MLB behind SD **Blake Snell** (1.99) and NYY **Gerrit Cole** (2.34).

BIT BY THE LONG BALL—Through four starts, six of his seven earned runs have come via the home run ball, including four solo shots by TOR **George**

Springer, TEX Corey Seager, LAA Mike Trout and LAA Logan O'Hoppe.

He has yielded at least one home run in eight consecutive starts dating back to Sept. 9, 2023 vs. Boston, the longest streak of his career and second-longest active streak in the majors behind DET

Jack Flaherty (10GS).
Since permitting just 1 HR in a span of 10 starts from June 25–Aug. 16, 2023 (0.15 HR/9.0IP), he has been tagged for 12 HR in his last 11 starts dating back to Aug. 23, 2023 (2.04 HR/9.0IP).

3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER—For his career, Civale is 31-1 with a 3.09 ERA (302.2IP, 104ER) in games when he receives three or more runs of support... he has a 2-26 record with a 5.06 ERA (195.2IP, 110ER) in games receiving two or fewer runs of support...since joining the Rays, Civale is 4-0 with a 3.61 ERA (42.1IP, 17ER) with 3+ runs of support and 0-4 with a 5.88 ERA (26.0IP, 17ER) when receiving two or fewer runs.

MIX IT UP-Against right-handed hitters, Civale relies primarily on his sinker/sweeper, throwing one of those two pitches 55.4 pct. of the time and holding opponents to a combined 6-for-39 (.154) with 11 SO...when facing left-handed batters, he predominately turns to his cutter/curveball, recording a combined 65.5 pct. usage rate, .200 (3-for-15) opp. average and 5 SO on those offerings.

His .182 (10-for-55) opponent average against right-handed batters overall is 10th lowest among AL pitchers.

After throwing his cutter a career-high 37.2 pct. of the time last season, he has utilized the pitch 25.0 pct of the time in 2024...he has thrown 23.9 pct. sinkers, his highest usage rate on the offering since his rookie year in 2019 (35.1%).
