THE WORD ON THE BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their longest homestand of the first half playing nine games over 10 days with the final game of a three-game series against the Chicago Cubs. Tomorrow night, the Texas Rangers come to town for a three-game series with the Cincinnati Reds concluding the homestand (June 5-7).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis concludes a stretch of 10-straight divisional games (3-7) tonight with previous matchups against Pittsburgh (1-2), Milwaukee (0-3), Cincinnati (1-1) and Chicago (1-1) including two rain outs. The Cardinals and Cubs have seen-sawed 2nd place in the N.L. Central standings the first two games of this series. The Cardinals sit in 3rd place, 4.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and a half game back of the Cubs. All five teams in the National League Central enter Sunday above .500 with Cincinnati carrying the anchor at 29-28.

DOBBINS RECALLED, PUSHARD DFA'd: RHP Hunter Dobbins was recalled from Memphis (AAA) today and RHP Matt Pushard was designated for assignment. Dobbins made a spot start vs. Pittsburgh (4/30) in a 10-5 Cardinals win and was 3-0 with a 3.43 ERA in nine starts for the Redbirds. Dobbins wears uniform #40.

WHEN RUBBER MEETS ROAD: The Cardinals and Cubs are playing the rubber match of this three-game series. The Cardinals have won 3 of the last 4 rubber matches vs. the Cubs in 3-or-5 game series after teams split the first 2 or 4 games. St. Louis is 4-3 in all rubber games this season.

THE WETHER FORECAST: Cardinals rookie infielder JJ Wetherholt tied his season/career-high with three hits last night (4/25 vs. SEA), the first Cardinals rookie vs. the Cubs since Brendan Donovan (6/4/22). The Cardinals 2024 1st round draft pick leads all MLB rookies in times on base (90), ranks 2nd in on-base percentage (.356) and walks (28). He's batted in the lead-off position 54 of 56 games, and his 251 plate appearances from the slot is 2nd only to James Wood (WSH, 278) in MLB.

VOTE FOR PEDRO! Pedro Pagés enters tonight with a Major League-best 12 caught stealing. The Cardinals backstop set a career-high with two caught stealing on Monday against the Brewers. Pagés' 12 caught stealing is three more than Cubs catchers combined this season (Carson Kelly 5, Miguel Amaya 4, Moises Ballesteros 0).

PORT SIDE PUNCHOUTS: Tonight's starting pitcher Matthew Liberatore has racked up 34 strikeouts this month, most by a Cardinals left-hander in May since Rick Ankiel with 35 in 2000. Steve Carlton set the Cardinals southpaw record with 52 strikeouts in May 1970. Liberatore would need 18 tonight to catch Lefty, but could catch the following marks: Will Bill Hallahan (41) in May 1932, Vinegar Ben Mizell (40) in May 1956 and Dave LaPoint (38) in May 1984.

UNDER THE BRIGHT LIGHTS: The Cardinals are playing the third of a string of seven straight night games. St. Louis is 20-11 (.645) in night games this season, 3rd-best record in MLB behind Atlanta (.721, 31-12) and Tampa Bay (.677, 21-10). The Chicago Cubs, owners of the most home day games in MLB each season, are 19-12 (.613) for the 6th-best record in night games this season.

GAMES OF THE WEEK: Tonight marks the Cardinals 10th appearance on a National Television broadcast through their first 57 games with their appearance on NBC. St. Louis has posted a 5-4 record in national broadcasts this season including 1-0 on NBC/Peacock (W at DET on Easter Sunday, April 5).

FREE TV: Tonight's game is the third of three straight that will be broadcast on free, over-the-air television in the St. Louis metro area (KMOV 4-CBS, KTVI 2-FOX, KSDK 5-NBC), marking the first instance that three Cardinals regular season telecasts will be accessible on over-the-air local channels since August 10-12, 2007 when the team's three-game weekend series versus the Los Angeles Dodgers was televised on KSDK (Friday, Sunday) and KTVI (Saturday).

CHICAGO CUBS CONNECTIONS

Iván Herrera tallied his first MLB hit vs. the Cubs with a single on June 26, 2022. José Fermín notched his first career MLB hit at the Cubs on July 21, 2023 with a bunt single and Pedro Pagés swatted his first MLB home run on June 14, 2024 at the Cubs.

JoJo Romero recorded his first MLB save on July 30, 2023 vs. the Cubs.

George Soriano's first cousin is former Cubs OF Alfonso Soriano (2007-13).

Carson Kelly was drafted by St. Louis in 2012 and played three seasons (2016-18) for the Cardinals.

Phil Maton pitched in 40 games as a reliever for the Cardinals in 2025 after he signed a one-year deal as a free agent in March 2025.

Shelby Miller was a 1st round selection (19th overall) by the Cardinals in 2009 and pitched in 69 games (63 starts) for St. Louis from 2012-14.

Brant Brown was the Cubs 3rd round draft pick in 1992 and played parts of four seasons (1996-98 & 2000) with the North Siders.

Jon Jay played in 141 games for the Cubs in 2017 and was part of their playoff run to the NLCS.

Nelson Velázquez played parts of two seasons with the Cubs (2022-23), where he made his MLB debut (May 30, 2022 vs. Milwaukee)...singled off Ethan Small in his first career plate appearance.

Cubs Scouting VP Dan Kantrovitz previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cards 25th Rd. draft pick from Brown Univ...first MLB job was Cardinals Scouting Coordinator.

Lars Nootbaar and Shota Imanaga were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Stubby Clapp (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made his MLB debut vs. the Cubs...was also a coach on Team Canada for the 2013 & 2026 WBC squads that featured Jameson Taillon on the pitching staff.

Daniel Descalso played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Cardinals Hall of Famer Jim Edmonds played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Brant Brown was the Cubs 3rd round draft pick in 1992 and played parts of four seasons (1996-98 & 2000) with the North Siders.

Marquee Sports Network Analyst Rick Sutcliffe played for St. Louis in 1994.

Nolan Gorman won the 2017 Under Armour High School All-America Game HR Derby at Wrigley Field.

Cubs Staff Assistant AJ Lewis played college baseball at the University of Missouri in 2017 and John A. Logan College (Carterville, IL) in 2018.

Cubs Major League Assistant Strength & Conditioning Coach Mark Weisman was the Director of Performance at Southeast Missouri State University (Gape Girardeau, Mo.) in 2020.

Cardinals VP & Sr. Advisor Michael Girsch is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Cardinals.TV play-by-play announcer Chip Caray served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, Harry Caray, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

Cardinals.TV Analyst Mark Sweeney made his MLB debut with St. Louis vs. the Cubs on Aug. 4, 1995 at Busch Stadium II.

Hall of Fame manager Tony La Russa played in one game for the Cubs in 1973.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The 26-year-old Cardinals Opening Day starter makes his team-leading 12th start of the season. Tonight's game marks his 132nd career Major League appearance and his 65th career start.
- Is facing the Cubs for the 1st time on 2026 after making a pair of starts last season, one at Busch Stadium and one at Wrigley Field.
- Is seeking his 1st win since 5/7 at SD and his 1st Home win since a 7-2 victory over the Dodgers on 5/1.
- Tied for the Major League lead with three pick-offs; most pick-offs by a Cardinals pitcher since **Lance Lynn** (4, 2015) and by a southpaw since **Mark Mulder** (5, 2005).
- Sports a 2-3 record, but the Cardinals are 7-4 in his 11 starts this season.
- The Cardinals are 16-15 in his 31 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 11-10 with a 4.11 ERA (153.1 IP/70vER) with 10 quality starts.
- Has allowed 3+ runs in each of his last three starts, but has established career single-game highs for strikeouts in each of the last two starts, fanning 9 on 5/19 vs. PIT and 10 on 5/25 at MIL.

LAST TIME OUT (Monday, May 25 at Milwaukee): L, 5-1; 5.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 10 SO; 101 pitches).

- Struck out a career-high 10 batters in Memorial Day contest and threw 100+ pitches for the 2nd time this season.
- He and Brewers starter Jacob Misiorowski (12) combined for 22 strikeouts in the games.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

K-CLUB: Has notched single-game career highs for strikeouts in each of his last two starts, fanning 9 on 5/19 vs. PIT and then bettered that with 10 K's on Memorial Day (5/25) at MIL.

SLAMMED: Took the loss in Sacramento (5/13) allowing his first career grand slam (**Nic Kurtz**) in a 4-3 loss, coming during an inning where he threw a career-high 43 pitches.

FRIAR FRYER: Earned his 2nd straight win holding the Padres (5/7) to one run over 6.0 innings in a 2-1 come-from-behind win at Petco Park. Recorded his 300th career strikeout fanning **Nick Castellanos** in the 5th inning.

HR DERBY: Surrendered a career-high 3 HR's in 3.1 IP vs. SEA (4/25) as the two teams combined for 33 hits and 8 HR's in 11-9 Mariners win.

SPACE DUST: Worked a season high 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on three hits, taking a ND in the Cardinals 7-5 extra inning win on 4/19 at HOU to complete the series sweep of the Astros.

FIRST TO 100: Threw a career high 105 pitches in 9-3 loss vs. CLE on 4/13 in 5.0 IP; He was the first Cardinals pitcher to reach the 100 pitch plateau.

NO FOOLING: Held the Mets to one run in his second start on April Fools Day, a day after **Andre Pallante** and company shut out New York. Retired the first 12 Mets batters (first time a Cardinal vs. NYM since 1968) and carried a no-hitter through 4.2 innings, longest of his career.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that Libby was born. He became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020 that included Randy Arozarena, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP **Tink Hence**.
- Is a career 15-24 with a 4.85 ERA (309.2 IP) in his 64 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.
- Has limited left-handed batters to a .255/.311/.398 (100-392) with a .709 OPS average over his Major League career.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year, his first season of play in the Cardinals organization.

LIBERATORE vs. CHICAGO CUBS

- Is making his 5th career start and 11th appearance vs. the Cubs in tonight's start
- Meeting the Cubs for the 1st time this season; He started two games vs. CHC last season, one at Busch Stadium (6/23) and Wrigley Field (7/5).
- As a starter is 1-1 with a 4.08 ERA in 17.2 IP (8 ER) vs. CHC; 0-0, 2.70 ERA in six relief appearances with an 0.60 WHIP including five straight scoreless relief app.
- Matched his 2025 season high (3rd time) with 7.0 IP in the Cardinals 8-2 win over the Cubs on 6/23/25 at Busch in their 1st series meeting of the season. Allowed single runs in the 5th & 7th as he received his 2nd highest run support (8 runs) of the season.
- His 11th appearance vs. the Cubs will tie with PIT for 2nd most against any team - Has faced the Brewers 12 times.
