THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: The Cardinals and division-rival Chicago Cubs play the finale of a season-ending three-game series this afternoon at Busch Stadium. St. Louis clinched its first postseason berth since 2015 with last Sunday's win at Wrigley Field, and enters play today in first place in the NL Central, 1.0 game ahead of the Milwaukee Brewers (at Colorado Rockies).

POSTSEASON SCENARIOS: If the Cardinals win or Brewers lose today, St. Louis faces Atlanta on Thursday in Game 1 of the NLDS at SunTrust Park. If the Cardinals lose and Brewers win today, St. Louis and Milwaukee play a tie-breaker tomorrow (2:09 p.m.) at Busch Stadium to decide the NL Central Division champion. The tie-breaker winner faces Atlanta in the NLDS, while the loser plays Washington on Tuesday (7:08 p.m.) in the NL Wild Card game at Nationals Park.

162: The last time St. Louis needed a win on the final day of the regular season to clinch the division was 2014 (89-72), leading Pittsburgh (88-73) by 1.0 game on Sept. 28, 2014...the Pirates lost 4-1 in Cincinnati before the Cardinals won 1-0 at Arizona (**Carlos Martinez's** 1st career save).

DIVISION DANDIES: The Cardinals are seeking their first NL Central title since 2015 and a share of their 12th overall (co-winners with Houston in 2001)...the Cardinals have won outright NL Central titles in 1996, 2000, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2009, 2013, 2014 & 2015 since the division was formed in 1995.

TOMMY BOY: Tommy Edman's .366 (52-142) batting average at Busch Stadium ranks as the 3rd-highest by a Cardinals rookie at home in franchise history and is the highest in MLB since Rockies rookie 2B Luis Gonzalez (.373) at Coors Field in 2004. (min. 150 PA). **HOLY SCHNIKE!** Since September 1, Edman ranks among NL leaders in total bases (68, 1st), hits (36, 1st), times on base (47, 1st), runs (21, T2nd), triples (4, 1st), extra-base hits (16, T4th), average (.364, 3rd), OBP (.427, 7th), SLG (.687, 6th), and OPS (1.114, 4th). **WHAT'D YA DO?:** Edman has already established new Cardinals September rookie records in extra-base hits (15) and total bases (68). **TOMMY LIKEY!** Edman has reached base safely in 17 straight (Sept. 10-present) and hit safely in a career-best 10 in a row (.476, 20-42)...nine have been multi-hit efforts, including the last seven in a row (longest streak of multi-hit games by a Cardinal since **Matt Carpenter** from April 12-19, 2015, longest active in MLB, and one behind Arizona's **Ketel Marte** for longest in MLB this season). **THAT'S GONNA LEAVE A MARK:** Edman made his MLB debut on June 8 at Wrigley Field as the Cardinals fell to 31-31 that night...since then, the Cardinals are 59-40 (.596 win pct.).

JACK ATTACK: Jack Flaherty sports the lowest ERA (0.97) in Major League Baseball since the All-Star Break (14 starts) and enters today tied with **Roger Clemens** (1990 Red Sox) for the 4th-lowest single-season post All-Star ERA in MLB history. **THATS A FACT, JACK:** Today marks Flaherty's 6th start against Chicago this season, his most vs. any opponent in a season and most by a Cardinal vs. the Cubbies since **Danny Cox** (6 in 1987). Over his career, Flaherty has limited the Cubs to a .164 average against (25-152), lowest in Major League history (*minimum eight starts*). **BACK-TO-BACK JACK?:** In five starts since September 1, the reigning NL Pitcher of the Month leads the NL in ERA (0.97), strikeouts (47), WHIP (0.59), average against (.122), and opponent OPS (.363).

WORST TO FIRST: St. Louis leads MLB this season with a .989 team fielding pct. (66 errors), currently the highest mark in franchise single-season history, ahead of the 2013 Cardinals (.988, 75 errors). The last time St. Louis led MLB in team fielding pct. was 1985 (.983, 108 errors). Last season, the Cardinals' .978 team fielding pct. ranked last in Major League Baseball (.978, 133 errors).

RUNNIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals (115-for-144) lead the NL in stolen bases this season, the first time leading the NL since 1992 (208). Their 79.9% SB success rate stands as the highest all-time in franchise history since 1951 (*STATS LLC*)...19 different Cardinals have stolen at least one base, most in MLB and T5th-most in franchise history (record held by 1906 club with 21 Cardinals).

NL CENTRAL RIVALS: St. Louis is 45-30 (.600) in divisional play, including a 30-13 (.714) mark since the All-Star Break...A win today would give St. Louis season series win over the Cubs for the second straight year (7th time in nine seasons since 2011) and a winning record vs. NL Central opponents for the first time since 2015 (46-30 vs. NL Central). **SWEEP STAKES:** With a Cardinals win today, they would avoid their first series sweep to the Cubs since June 7-9, 2019 at Wrigley Field and first at Busch Stadium since September 13-15, 2010.

BASH & DASH: The 2019 Cardinals (207 HR, 115 SB) are just the 3rd team in franchise history to have recorded 200+ HR and 100+ stolen bases in the same season, joining the 2004 (214 HR, 111 SB) and 1998 (223 HR, 133 SB) squads.

A WINNING TRADITION: The Cardinals have posted their 12th consecutive winning season (2008-19), something they'd done just once previously in franchise history when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-53. Only the Yankees (27 seasons) sport a longer active consecutive winning season streak in Major League Baseball.

MILESTONE WATCH: Jack Flaherty needs one strikeout to pass former Cub/Cardinal **Sam Jones** (1958) and **Bob Gibson** (1966) for 6th place in Cardinals single-season history ... **Paul DeJong** needs three runs scored to become the 5th Cardinals shortstop to score 100 runs in a single-season ... **Marcell Ozuna** needs one home run to reach 30 this season and join **Paul Goldschmidt (33)** and **Paul DeJong (30)**, giving St. Louis just its second trio of 30+ HR players this season, done only in 2004 by the MV3 of **Albert Pujols (46)**, **Jim Edmonds (42)** and **Scott Rolen (34)** ... **Yadier Molina** needs 1 double to reach 380 and pass **Jorge Posada** (1995-2011) for 9th all-time among catchers in MLB history and one home run to reach 157 and pass **Matt Holliday** (2009-16) for 11th all-time in Cardinals history ... **Paul Goldschmidt** needs five RBI to become the first Cardinal since **Matt Holliday** (102 in 2012) to collect 100+ RBI in a season.

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 33rd start of the season and his 66th career start (67th appearance).
- Has established single-season career highs in wins (10), innings pitched (189.1), strikeouts (225), quality starts (19) and games started (32).
- Is the 8th different Cardinal (19th instance) and youngest in franchise history to strike out 200+ batters in a season.
- His 225 strikeouts this season currently tie Sam Jones (1958) and Bob Gibson (1966) for 6th in place franchise single-season history.
- His 10.70 strikeouts/9 IP (225 K in 189.1 IP) this season ranks 1st all-time in franchise single-season history.
- Ranks 2nd among NL pitchers with 213 strikeouts Post All-Star Break over the last two seasons (2018-19) behind only Jacob deGrom (237).
- His 427 career strikeouts (49th in Cardinals history) are most by a Cardinal in their first 65 career appearances and rank 12th-most in National League history.
- Has recorded double-digit strikeouts in three of his last four starts (5 in 2019 and 8 career). His 8 games with 10+ strikeouts in his first 66 games are a Cardinals record.
- Sports the lowest ERA (0.97) in Major League Baseball since the All-Star Break (14 GS). Enters today tied with Roger Clemens (1990 Red Sox) for 4th-lowest single-season post All-Star ERA in MLB history.
- In five September starts, leads the NL in ERA (0.97), strikeouts (47), WHIP (0.59), average against (.122), and opponent OPS (.363).
- Named N.L. Pitcher of the Month for August (4-1 with 0.71 ERA in six August starts).
- Allowed just seven earned runs in his last 86.0 innings (0.73 ERA).
- Limiting opposing right-handed batters to a .182 average (62-340), ranking 3rd in the NL this season and currently 2nd all-time in Cardinals history (Jose DeLeon, .148).
- Matched his single-game career high by pitching 8.0 IP in three of his last five starts.

LAST TIME OUT

Came away with a no-decision in Tuesday's (9/24) 3-2 loss to the D-backs in 19 innings at Chase Field. Fanned a season-high 11 and held Arizona hitless until a seventh inning single by Eduardo Escobar. Exited with 1-0 lead before Arizona tied it in the 9th.
