RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a five-game road trip through Baltimore (0-1, 2 to play) and Miami (2 to play) today at Oriole Park...are 3-2 in their last five games on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak...however, they have lost eight of their last 11 contests overall after posting an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 from May 3-18...are 11.5 games back in the AL East, matching their largest deficit of the season (also entering play on May 26)...are in the midst of a stretch of four off days over 15 days from May 23-June 6, which precedes a run of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

Last night, the Rays went 1-for-their-last-16 following **Isaac Paredes'** one-out double in the 3rd inning, with the lone hit being a replay-assisted infield single by **José Caballero** in the 7th...they totaled five hits in the contest and have not recorded a 10+ hit game since May 18 at TOR (12)...the 11-game drought without a 10+ hit effort is their longest since July 28-Aug. 9, 2020 (12G).

The Rays have lost five straight games against AL East opponents, their longest skid since another five-game streak to conclude the 2022 season (Sept. 24-Oct. 5)...their last longer streak came from March 30-April 8, 2018 (8G).

Tampa Bay's pitching staff has turned in a 2.49 ERA (47.0IP, 13ER) over the club's last five games since May 26, second lowest in the AL behind Oakland (2.17).

The Rays 23 road games played are the fewest in the majors, with the Orioles 24 being next closest...17 of their 23 (73.9%) contests on the road have been decided by two runs or fewer, the highest percentage in MLB.

Tampa Bay is 3-6-2 in series in which it lost the opening contest...the three wins came from April 5-7 at COL, April 8-10 at LAA and May 28-30 vs. OAK.

The Rays need a win today in order to avoid their first road series loss since April 29-May 1 at MIL (2-1)...a loss would also mark their fourth straight defeat against the Orioles dating to Sept. 16, 2023, which would be their longest streak since losing seven straight to Baltimore from April 27-July 16, 2016.

CLIMBING THE LADDER—Last night, **Yandy Díaz** achieved multiple franchise milestones...his leadoff single marked the 603rd hit of his Rays tenure, tying **Fred McGriff** for seventh on the club's all-time list...**Kevin Kiermaier** (756H) is sixth...Díaz also drew a walk in the 7th frame, matching **Carl Crawford** (293BB) for the sixth-most free passes in franchise history, with McGriff (305BB) ranking fifth...it marked Díaz's 587th appearance in a Rays uniform, surpassing McGriff (577G) for the 10th-most games in club history, eight shy of ninth-place **Toby Hall** (586G)...he also has an opportunity to overtake **Matt Joyce** (586G) for eighth on the list later this season.

RAYS IN MAY—The Rays finished the month of May 14-13, sixth best in the AL/tied for 12th best in the majors...they recorded their seventh straight winning May dating back to 2017 (excl. 2020)...the Rays went 11-5 in their first 16 games and 4-8 in their last 12...they went 9-9 at home and 5-4 on the road...the 18 home games tied their most in a calendar month in franchise history, joining May 2015, June 2014 and May 2007.

The Rays are below .500 entering June for just the second time under **Kevin Cash** (since 2015), joining 2016 (22-28)...they have held a winning record entering June 11 times in the last 14 seasons since 2010 (excl. 2020).

During May, the Rays went 13-4 when scoring 4+ runs and 1-9 with three or fewer.

COMEBACK KIDS—The Rays 15 comeback wins are tied with the Tigers for third most in the AL behind the Orioles and Yankees (17 each)...they have recorded each of their last four wins in come-from-behind fashion, their longest streak since Sept. 5-9, 2023 (4)...the Rays have trailed at some point in each of their last 12 games, going 4-8 in that span...they have yet to hold a lead entering the 6th inning in any of those 12 games (trailed - 9; tied - 3)...their last wire-to-wire win came on May 17 at TOR (4-3)...overall, 53.6 pct. (15/28) of their victories have been comeback wins vs. 37.4 pct. (37/99) in 2023.

Tampa Bay ranks among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (T2nd, 6), seven (T1st, 5) and eight (T3rd, 3) innings.

In the 8th inning or later, Rays hitters lead the AL in on-base pct. (.335) and rank third in average (.255) behind the Rangers (.260) and Tigers (.256)...**Isaac Paredes'** .405 (17-for-42) average from the 8th frame on paces the AL (min. 30AB) and ranks third in MLB behind CHC **Mike Tauchman** (.436) and LAD **Shohei Ohtani** (.425).

DOWN TO THE WIRE—The Rays are 11-4 (.733) in one-run games, second in the majors behind the Mariners (12-4/.750)...Tampa Bay's 20-9 (.690) record in games decided by two runs or fewer leads MLB, ahead of Philadelphia (15-7/.682) and Baltimore (19-9/.679)...their 28 games decided by two or fewer runs are tied with the Angels, Athletics and Yankees for most in the AL...they lead the majors in wins by two runs or fewer (20) and are tied for second in losses by 3+ runs (21) behind the White Sox (27)...15 of the Rays last 17 contests since May 13 have been decided by three runs or fewer.

The Rays have won each of their last five one-run games, their longest single-season streak since April 23-May 6, 2022 (5)...their last longer streak was a seven-game run from Aug. 10-Sept. 2, 2019.

The Rays -50 run differential is third worst in the AL and their worst mark through 59 games since 2007 (-71)...they have a +22 (80-58) differential in innings 1-3 (7th in MLB), -68 (58-126) in frames 4-6 (30th in MLB), and -4 (87-91) from the 7th inning on (18th in MLB).

NO HELP FROM MY FRIENDS—Tampa Bay starters have posted a 2.81 ERA (41.2IP, 13ER) over their last nine games since May 21, the fourth-best mark in the AL/sixth best in the majors during that stretch...however, the rotation has not earned a win in its last 12 outings, with the last victory coming on May 17 at TOR (**Tyler Alexander**)...Rays starters have received three or fewer runs of support in each of those 12 games, including seven outings with one or zero runs of support...on the season, the Rays rotation is 12-18—the 12 wins are second fewest in the AL, ahead of White Sox (11).

ON-BASE PAREDES—**Isaac Paredes** has reached base safely in 27 of his last 28 games since April 28, hitting .323/.429/.525 (32-for-99) with 8 2B, 4 HR, 16 RBI, 16 BB and 16 SO...he ranks among AL leaders in OBP (3rd), AVG (5th) and OPS (8th, .954) over that span...Paredes is currently on a nine-game on-base streak...his three on-base streaks of 9+ games are tied for second most in MLB behind NYM **Brandon Nimmo** (4).

BIRDLAND—The Rays and Orioles continue a 13-game season series with the second of seven matchups over 11 days from May 31-June 10...the clubs will meet again from June 7-10 at Tropicana Field...the Rays will return to Baltimore from Sept. 6-8 to conclude the season series...in 2023, the Rays went 5-8 against the Orioles, snapping a streak of six consecutive season series victories...Tampa Bay is 6-12 at Oriole Park since 2022...the Rays have lost nine of their last 13 games against the Orioles overall and are 12-18 in the last 30 matchups on the heels of a 27-2 stretch in the previous 29 meetings.

Randy Arozarena is a career .337 (66-for-196) hitter with 9 2B, 1 3B, 16 HR and 43 RBI in 51 games vs. BAL, his most hits, home runs and RBI against any opponent...among active players, only HOU **José Abreu** (.345) and HOU **Jose Altuve** (.339) own higher career batting averages against the Orioles.

Since the left-field wall at Oriole Park was moved back 26.5 ft. and raised by nearly six feet in 2022, the Rays have hit 20 HR over 18 games in Baltimore...they hit 25 HR in nine games at this venue in 2021, their most at any visiting ballpark that season, ahead of Yankee Stadium (14HR).

RAYS vs. ORIOLES

In club history, four Rays have hit home runs onto Eutaw Street: Ben Grieve (2002), Aubrey Huff (2003), Logan Morrison (2017) and Austin Meadows (2019)...three have been hit against the Rays, most recently by Adley Rutschman off Zach Eflin on May 9, 2023.

Rays RHP **Shawn Armstrong** spent parts of three seasons with Baltimore from 2019-21, appearing in 85 games.

Rays LHP **Garrett Cleavinger** was selected by the Orioles in the third round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and remained in the organization until being dealt to the Phillies in 2017 in a trade involving former Ray RHP **Jeremy Hellickson**.

Rays Hitting Coach **Chad Mottola** appeared in six games for the Orioles in 2004...he was originally drafted by the club in 1989, but opted to attend UCF.

Rays Asst. Pitching/Rehab Coach **Rick Knapp** is a Baltimore native.

Rays Director, Amateur Scouting **Chuck Ricci** was drafted by the Orioles in 1987, spending seven seasons in the club's farm system from 1987-93.

Rays Head Athletic Trainer **Joseph Bengt** spent 10 seasons as an AT in the Orioles system (2001-10).

Rays Vice President, Asst. GM **Kevin Ibach** spent seven years with the Orioles as a baseball operations coordinator from 2000-07.

INF **Nick Maton**, the brother of Rays RHP **Phil Maton**, is a member of the Orioles Triple-A affiliate, the Norfolk Tides...the two have a third brother, RHP **Jacob Maton**, who is in the Rangers minor league system.

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will make his fifth start of the season this afternoon, including his second on the road...opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) before making his 2024 debut on May 10 vs. NYY...suffered the injury while warming up for his scheduled spring start on March 12 at BAL.

LAST TIME OUT—Did not factor into the decision on May 26 vs. KC...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit and a season-high three walks while fanning six batters.

- ✦ The lone hit was an **Adam Frazier** single in the 2nd inning...retired the first batter in the 5th frame before issuing consecutive walks, but fanned **Maikel Garcia** to complete the outing.
- ✦ Threw a career-high-tying 95 pitches (also July 18, 2023 at TEX).
- ✦ Marked his most walks since Sept. 13, 2023 at MIN (also 3BB).

BATTLING THE BIRDS—In two career starts opposite Baltimore, Bradley is 1-0 with a 3.27 ERA (11.0IP, 4ER) and 14 SO against 1 BB...he earned the win on June 21 vs. BAL at Tropicana Field after tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering three hits with zero walks and eight strikeouts in his first career quality start...did not factor into the decision on July 23 in St. Petersburg after allowing three runs across 5.0 IP.

- ✦ Is 1-2 with a 4.00 ERA (18.0IP, 8ER) in three starts against AL East opponents this season...is 4-4 with a 5.02 ERA (52.0IP, 29ER) in 11 career appearances (9GS) against division foes.

KING OF THE K—Bradley has recorded 157 SO in his first 25 career starts, third most in any pitcher's first 25 starts after joining the Rays, trailing **Charlie Morton** (184, 2019) and **Drew Smyly** (168, 2014-16)...Morton (194) also holds the mark through 26 starts, followed by Smyly (173) and **Tyler Glasnow** (159)...Bradley's 157 SO are the most by a Ray in his first 25 career starts, outpacing **Matt Moore** (149, 2011-12).

- ✦ On May 20 vs. BOS, Bradley became the second Ray this year to record 10+ strikeouts, joining **Ryan Pepiot** (11SO) on April 7 at COL...he became one of five pitchers (6 instances) in the majors this season to throw 7.0+ innings, record 10+ SO and issue zero walks.

- ✦ In 2023, Bradley posted a 28.4 pct. strikeout rate, the highest mark by a rookie in Rays history (min. 300BF), surpassing **Shane McClellan**'s 27.3 pct. in 2021.

LONG BALL WOES—Bradley's 25 HR allowed as a starter are the second most through a pitcher's first 25 career starts in franchise history, behind **Doug Waechter** (30, 2003)...last season, from his April 12 debut through June 15, his 0.84 HR/9.0 IP was the 12th-lowest mark in the AL (min. 40.0IP)...from that point on, his 2.77 HR/9.0 IP was second highest in the majors (min. 50.0IP) behind MIN **Joe Ryan** (2.79).

USAGE UPDATE—Bradley has utilized his split-finger 23.1 pct. of the time this season, holding opponents to a .125 (3-for-24) clip with 1 XBH (2B) and 12 SO...he has thrown his curveball 12.4 pct. of the time, with opponents going 0-for-6 with 2 SO.

- ✦ Last season, Bradley featured his curveball 16.7 pct. of the time, compared to 13.6 pct. on his splitter...opponents went 11-for-65 (.169) on his curveball and 12-for-63 (.190) on the split finger...of his 129 SO last season, 30 came via the curve and 26 via the split finger.

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Through his first three starts, Bradley has limited opponents to a 2-for-33 (.061) clip with 17 of his 29 SO the first time through the lineup...opposing hitters are 11-for-32 (.344) the second time through and 2-for-17 (.118) the third time.

ADVANCED TALK—Of Bradley's 54 batted balls, 10 have been barreled (18.5%), the second-highest barrel rate (min. 75BF) in the majors, better than only WSH **Tanner Rainey** (19.2%).

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP ZACK LITTELL (2-3, 3.47)

LAST START—Suffered the loss on May 28 vs. Oakland...struck out a career-high nine batters across a season-high 7.0 innings, but conceded three runs on six hits and one walk...was originally charged with 3 UER, but a scoring change in the days following the game credited Littell with 3 ER.

vs. ORIOLES—Owns a 2.35 ERA (7.2IP, 2ER) in three career appearances (1GS) opposite Baltimore, all coming last season...in his lone start on Sept. 17 at Camden Yards, he tossed 4.2 innings of one-run ball, scattering four hits with zero walks and three strikeouts.

- On Wed. vs. OAK, tallied his 1st career PH RBI, a game-tying single in the 6th inn. Is 6-for-21 (.286) with 1 2B and 1 HR when batting 4th (6G)...is 3-for-21 (.143) with 1 2B in all other spots (3rd: 1G, 5th: 5G, 6th: 2G, 8th: 1G, 9th: 1G).
- Is 6-for-23 (.261) on fastballs...is 3-for-19 (.158) with 1 HR on breaking/offspeed pitches.
- In his career, has hit .250 (32-for-128) with a .783 OPS while playing a defensive position compared to .102 (6-for-59) with a .338 OPS as designated hitter.
