THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JUNE 19
1972 - RHP **Larry Dierker** makes history with a one-hit, 3-0 shutout over the Mets in the 'Dome...Dierker's gem gave the Astros one-hitters in back-to-back games for the first and only time in franchise history as **Jerry Reuss** had one-hit the Phillies, 10-0, the day before...the back-to-back one-hitters also tied an MLB record, which has only happened 12 times in modern MLB history.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros, who have won three of their last four series, will open a three-game weekend series with the Guardians tonight at Daikin Park...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** (3-3) will make his 10th start of the season tonight for the Astros opposite **RHP Tanner Bibee** (2-7) and the Guardians.

ABOUT IMAI: RHP **Tatsuya Imai** has proven to be tough to hit at the Major League level, as he's held opponents to a .227 (29x128) average with 37 strikeouts in 35.0 innings...he's had flashes of brilliance, including starting a no hitter on May 25 at TEX (0ER/6IP) and fanning nine on April 4 at ATH (0ER/5.2IP)...in January, the Astros signed Imai to a three-year deal...in 2025, he was an All-Star for the Seibu Lions in the NPB in Japan, where he went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games.

A MONTH OF WINNING: Over the last month, dating back to May 19, the Astros have gone 16-11 (.593), which ties as the fourth-best record in the Majors and ties as the second-best record in the AL.

WITH A WIN: A win tonight would move the Astros to five games below .500, a mark they have not reached since they were 8-13 after a loss on April 17.

VS. THE GUARDIANS: The Astros and Guardians have played each other in the regular season 100 times in their franchise histories, with the two teams splitting those matchups with 50 wins apiece...those games have also been evenly split in Houston (25-25) and Cleveland (25-25), which includes a 22-22 record at Daikin Park.

PEN PALS: Since May 15, the Astros bullpen has a 2.77 ERA (34ER/110.2IP) with 105 strikeouts, a 1.03 WHIP and a .188 opponent average...among AL teams since May 15, the Astros bullpen ranks first in ERA, first in WHIP, and first in opponent batting average...the Astros are also 18-13 since May 15.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Astros have committed the fewest errors (29) and own the best fielding percentage (.989) in the AL...**1B Christian Walker** has led the way, as he has not committed an error in 75 games and 529 total chances.

HAPPY BELATED: The Astros would like to wish a Happy Birthday to **CF Jake Meyers**, who turned 30 yesterday...he shares a birthday with HOFer **OF Lou Brock** and with former teammate **C Jason Castro**.

ON WINSDAY: The Astros took the rubber game of their three-game series against the Tigers on Wednesday, winning 4-2 for the second straight game...**RHP Peter Lambert** (1ER/7IP) pitched the Astros to victory en route to his fourth straight winning decision...**SS Jeremy Peña** (2x4, HR, 2RBI) hit his fourth homer of the season in a 2x4 day.

THE LINEUP: For the first time this season, the Astros repeated a lineup on Wednesday and have now used 75 different lineups in their 76 games...**DH Yordan Alvarez** has the most starts at any spot in the lineup among Astros, hitting second 64 times.

ON ASSIGNMENT: RHP **Ronel Blanco**, who's recovering from right elbow surgery, began a minor league rehab assignment for the FCL Astros earlier today...he worked 3.0 scoreless innings in his start, allowing one hit and one walk with five strikeouts.

WEISS OUTRIGHTED: Announced on Wednesday, **RHP Ryan Weiss** cleared waivers and was outrighted to Triple A Sugar Land...Weiss was designated for assignment by the Astros on June 12.

ALL-STAR VOTING UPDATE: On Monday, MLB announced the first balloting update for the 2026 MLB All-Star Game, which revealed **DH Yordan Alvarez** as the AL's top vote-getter among all position players...other Astros among the AL's top 10 at their respective positions: **2B Jose Altuve** (4th), **SS Jeremy Peña** (5th), **1B Christian Walker** (9th), **3B Isaac Paredes** (9th), and **C Yainer Diaz** (9th).

ON THE LEADERBOARD: **DH Yordan Alvarez** leads MLB in OPS (1.070), SLG (.642), and total bases (176), and ranks tied for first in extra-base hits (39)...in the AL, he ranks first in batting average (.325), first in hits (89), first in homers (24), second in RBI (55), second in OBP (.428), fourth in walks (46) and seventh in runs (50).

ON-BASE MACHINE: **OF Yordan Alvarez** is on a 24-game on-base streak (dating back to May 22), in which he's batting .371 (33x89) with nine homers, 24 RBI, 15 walks, a .462 OBP and a 1.181 OPS...this ranks as the fifth-longest streak of his career and his longest since he posted a 26-game streak from Aug. 2-Sept. 2, 2024.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** ranks third in the AL in RBI (52), behind only **1B Nick Kurtz** (57) and teammate **DH Yordan Alvarez** (55)...he also ranks tied for sixth in the AL in extra-base hits (33) and in total bases (139), and tied for seventh in homers (18).

BACK WITH A VENGEANCE: **SS Jeremy Peña** is batting .288 (30x104) with four doubles, four home runs, 21 runs scored, 15 RBI and an .801 OPS in 28 games since being activated from the IL on May 18...the Astros are 16-12 since his return.

SEÑOR CIEN: **IF Isaac Paredes**, who recently reached 500 career hits and 100 career homers, recorded his 100th career double on Tuesday vs. DET...he is now just the fourth Mexican-born player in MLB history with 500 career hits, 100 doubles and 100 home runs, joining **IF Vinny Castilla**, **IF Jorge Orta** and **IF Aurelio Rodriguez**.

WHAT A RELIEF: **LHP Josh Hader** is 1-0 with four saves and a 1.29 ERA (1ER/7IP) in seven appearances this season...he's allowed just three baserunners (one walk, two hits) and has fanned 11...Hader had a delayed start to the season, missing the first two months with left biceps tendinitis.

ON THE FARM: Astros No. 10 prospect **OF Lucas Spence** had the first two-homer game of his career last night for Double A Corpus Christi...Spence is having a strong season with the Hooks, hitting .270 with 10 doubles and 30 RBI in 41 games...in 14 games in June, Spence is hitting .377 with five doubles, four homers, 19 RBI and a 1.115 OPS.

LAST START, JUNE 12 at KC: Allowed 5 runs on 4 hits with and 1 walk with 1 strikeout in 0.2 of an inning.

ABOUT IMAI (pronounced ee-MY): Rookie starter joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...has made 9 Major League starts this season around a month-long IL stint (April 13-May 10) due to right arm fatigue.

IMAI'S ARSENAL: Has thrown 44.3% sliders in his MLB career, while throwing four-seamers (42.5%) and sinkers (8.8%) as his fastballs...among fastballs, has heavily featured his four-seamer over his last 5 starts, throwing the pitch 198 times compared to just 11 sinkers...has also worked in select split fingers (2%), changeups (2%), and curveballs (1%)...has raised eyebrows by featuring his unique wrong-way slider, which was well known during his time pitching in the NPB...Imai's slider is averaging 4.2 inches of arm-side run...for context, the average MLB slider breaks 4 inches to the glove side.

KEEP IT 100: Tossed a career-high 110 pitches on May 31 vs. MIL, which ties as the 3rd most pitches thrown by any MLB starter in a game this season...are the most pitches thrown by an Astro since **LHP Framber Valdez** threw 114 pitches on Aug. 25, 2023 at DET.

A NO-HITTER!: On May 25 at TEX, Imai tossed the first 6.0 innings of the 18th no-hitter in Astros franchise history, the 5th combined no-hitter...navigated 6.0 scoreless, hitless innings despite walking 4 batters, including the first 2 batters of the game and 3 total walks in the 1st inning...retired 15 of the next 16 batters he faced to finish the outing, striking out 2...was relieved in the no-hitter by **LHP Steven Okert** (1 IP) and **RHP Alimber Santa** (2 IP), with Santa making his MLB debut in the outing...marked the Astros first combined no-hitter since **RHP Cristian Javier**, **RHP Bryan Abreu**, **RHP Rafael Montero** and **RHP Ryan Pressly** combined to no-hit the Phillies in Game 4 of the 2022 World Series at Citizens Bank Park.

NO HITTER HISTORY: Imai became the 4th Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history to start a no-hitter, joining **RHP Hideo Nomo** (1996, 2001), **RHP Hisashi Iwakuma** (2015) and **LHP Shota Imanaga** (2024)...both of Nomo's no-hitters and Iwakuma's no-hitter were complete-game efforts...the Astros no-hitter ended a 630-day drought between the last no-hitter thrown in the Majors when the Cubs tossed a combined no-hitter vs. the Pirates on Sept. 4, 2024...coincidentally, that no-hitter was started by Imanaga, who was relieved by **RHP Porter Hodge** and Imai's current Astros teammate, **RHP Nate Pearson**...was the longest no-hitter drought in the Majors since a span of 841 days between the 2004-06 seasons.

2025 RECAP: Went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games with Seibu in the NPB in 2025...recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the 2nd consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

JAPANESE CAREER: Prior to signing with the Astros, Imai starred in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB) for the last 8 seasons (2018-25)...he went 58-45 overall with a 3.15 ERA (337ER/963.2IP) and 907 strikeouts in 159 career games in the NPB...was a 3-time All-Star in the NPB (2021, 2024 and 2025).

JAPAN CONNECTION: Became the 33rd Japanese-born pitcher to make a start in the Majors...is the fourth Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining **IF Kazuo Matsui** (2008-10), **OF Norichika Aoki** (2017) and **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** (2024)...Imai knows Matsui well, having played for him from 2023-24, while he was managing in the NPB with the Seibu Lions.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/15 vs. DET): Allowed 1 run on 1 hit with 2 strikeouts in 1.0 inning Monday night vs. DET...allowed a solo home run to Colt Keith.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 3.00 ERA (5ER/15IP) in his last 17 appearances, dating back to May 3...within these appearances, he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the longest by an Astro this season.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Has made 345 career appearances, recently passing RHP Ryan Pressly (342g) for 6th in franchise history in relief appearances...now directly trails LHP Joe Sambito (348g) for 5th on that all-time list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (481) and 10th in innings pitched (354.0).

CAREER: In 345 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.92 ERA (115ER/354IP) with 481 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.23 K/9 and a 0.79 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.

AGAINST THE GUARDIANS: In 11 career appearances vs. CLE, he's recorded a 0.77 ERA (1ER/11.2IP) with 18 strikeouts and a .175 opponent batting average.
