ROAD WARRIORS

The Washington Nationals finish off a three game series with the Miami Marlins at loanDepot park today...Washington dropped yesterday's contest, 8-7, to set up today's rubber match.

- **James Wood** hit his league-leading third leadoff home run of the year yesterday...He added a double to finish 2-for-3 with a walk, an RBI and two runs scored...**CJ Abrams** drove in a pair of runs to take sole possession of the Major League lead in RBI (36).
- Following today's game, The Nationals will head to Cincinnati, where they will enjoy an off day on Monday before starting a three-game set with the Reds from Tuesday-Thursday.

WINNING WAYS

The Nationals have won three of four, four of six and 8 of 13 games since April 25.

- With a win today, the Nationals would secure their fourth series win out of their last five...It would also be Washington's first series win in Miami since they took three straight in South Florida from 2023-2024.

ROAD SWEET ROAD

The Nationals come into today's game with a 13-8 record on the road, tied for the second-highest win total away from home in Major League Baseball, trailing only the Atlanta Braves (15 wins)...Washington has taken at least a share of five of their first six series away from home, including four straight.

- The Nationals rank second in MLB with 115 runs scored on the road.
- Washington's pitching staff is seventh in MLB (fifth in NL) with a .236 opponents batting average away from Nationals Park.

OUT OF THIS WORLD

CJ Abrams is 15-for-42 (.357) with three doubles, a triple, two homers, 15 RBI, five walks, two stolen bases and eight runs scored over his last 11 games...He's reached safely in nine of the 11 (.426 OBP) and has hits in eight of the 11.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (T1st, 36), on-base percentage (6th, .394) and OPS (7th, .931).

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank tied for second in Major League Baseball (T2nd in NL) with 215 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 39 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 81 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 24 times this season, second-most in Major League Baseball.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood leads Major League Baseball with an average exit velocity of 96.3 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (95.9).

- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 48 batted balls over 100 MPH rank fifth in Major League Baseball.

PITCH PERFECT

Simon Mathews' pitching staff ranks third in the National League (6th in MLB) with a 3.24 ERA in 14 games since April 24...The staff has pitched to a 3.88 ERA in 24 games since April 14 after entering play that day with a 6.21 ERA through the first 15 games of the season.

- The starters rank third in the National League (4th in MLB) with a 3.08 ERA since April 24.
- The bullpen has pitched to a 3.06 ERA in 12 games since April 26, the third-best mark in the National League.

SPECIFICALLY...

Some pitching performances of note include:

- **Foster Griffin** ranks fourth in the National League with a 2.12 ERA...His ERA is the third lowest by a Nationals pitcher (2005-pres.) through his first eight starts with the team, trailing only **Max Scherzer** (1.75 in 2015) and **Stephen Strasburg** (2.03 in 2010).
- **Cade Cavalli** ranks seventh in the NL (min. 30.0 IP). with 10.38 strikeouts per 9.0 innings.
- **Richard Lovelady** has not allowed a run in his last eight games (8.2 IP), going 1-0 with a scoreless start, a save, three holds, 10 strikeouts and just six hits allowed.
- **PJ Poulin** has been The Opener five times...He's allowed just one earned run on five hits with five strikeouts and one walk in 6.1 innings pitched.
- Over his last 10 games, **Gus Varland** has pitched to a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2 IP) with three holds, four saves, 11 strikeouts and one walk.

HIGH DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY

Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.4 runs per game more than the league average team...Washington has played 23 games against teams with a record of .500 or better, the most in National League and second-most in Major League Baseball.

- 13 of the Nationals 19 home games have come against teams .500 or better.
- Washington is 10-13 (.435) against teams .500 or better this season.

CAREER

Tall, powerful right-hander was Washington's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Made his Major League debut in 2022 and returned to the mound in 2025.

- 1,076 days passed between his debut on Aug. 26, 2022 vs. Cincinnati and his second career appearance on Aug. 6, 2025 vs. Athletics.
- Was ranked as high as the No. 53 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.com and the No. 61 prospect per *Baseball America* entering the 2023 season.
- Had the "Best Curveball" in Washington's system, per *Baseball America*, for two consecutive seasons (2024-25)...Had the "Best Slider" in the system in 2021 and 2022.
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 175 strikeouts in 2021.

LAST START

Cavalli allowed six runs (three earned) on five hits with two strikeouts and one walk in 4.0 innings on May 5 vs. Minnesota.

vs. MIAMI

Cavalli won both of his starts against Miami last season, the first two starts of his career against the Marlins.

- He posted a 3.60 ERA (4 ER/10.0 IP) with ten hits, seven strikeouts and two walks in those two Sept. outings last season.

NO HOMERS CLUB...WE'RE ALLOWED TO HAVE ONE

Cavalli ranks third among National League starters (min. 30.0 IP) with 0.26 home runs allowed per 9.0 innings and is one of eight Major League starters (min. 30.0 IP) to allow one or fewer home runs this season.

- He surrendered his first and only home run of the season on April 29 at New York (NL)...It was a solo shot by **Juan Soto** in the third inning.

THE RIGHT STUFF

Opposing right-handed batters are just 12-for-62 (.194) with three extra-base hits off Cavalli so far this season...The .194 opponents' batting average vs. righties is 23rd-best in the National League.

- Right-handed batters hit .381/.442/.548 against Cavalli in 2025.

HOMEMADE CADE

Since returning to the mound in 2025, Cavalli is 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA and 51 strikeouts against 16 walks in 10 home starts...For comparison, he is 2-2 with a 5.58 ERA in nine road starts.

- He's pitched to a 3.57 ERA with 20 strikeouts and seven walks in four starts at Nationals Park in 2026.

2026 OPENING DAY

Cavalli made his first career Opening Day start March 26 against the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field...He allowed two earned runs on three runs with five strikeouts.

- Became the 10th different pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to start on Opening Day.

2025

Returned to the Major Leagues after missing all of 2023 and 2024 recovering from Tommy John surgery.

- Made his return on Aug. 6 against the Athletics...Worked 4.1 scoreless innings with six strikeouts.
- In his third start, Cavalli worked 7.0 scoreless innings against the Philadelphia Phillies on Aug. 16 for his first Major League win.
- Collected all three of his wins against National League East opponents (Miami twice, Philadelphia).
- Went 3-0 with a 2.25 ERA (7 ER/28.0 IP) with 19 strikeouts in five starts against the NL East...The Nationals went 5-0 in those starts.
- 2025 Pitch Mix:** 4-Seam (31.2%) Knuckle-Curve (30.5%) Sinker (18.3%) Change-up (13.6%) Cutter (6.3%) Slider (0.1%)

PERSONAL

Steven Cade Cavalli...Graduated from Bixby High School in Bixby, Oklahoma...Attended the University of Oklahoma.

- Went 1-2 with a 4.18 ERA (11 ER/23.2 IP) and 37 strikeouts against just five walks in four starts for the Sooners prior to the cancellation of the 2020 season
- Was named to the 2020 Golden Spikes Award (top amateur player) preseason watch list.
