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THE TWINS: Have gone 3-4 through seven games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, going 1-2 at Seattle, 1-2 at Kansas City and 1-0 at Milwaukee...tonight, they will continue the trip with the second of three against the Brewers at American Family Field...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel home to begin a nine-game, 10-day homestand with three against the Orioles, three against the Phillies (MLB at Field of Dreams - August 13) and three against the Braves. **⚡** Despite the 3-4 trip record, the Twins have gone 15-11 on the road since June 15.

SAY CHEESE: The Twins beat the Brewers last night in Milwaukee by a score of 8-6, erasing a 4-0 deficit...Zebby Matthews (5-8) was the starter and winner, allowing six runs (3 earned) on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings; Tommy Nance, A.J. Minter, Jeff Hoffman and Andrew Morris each earned a hold while Yoendrys Gómez earned his 16th save (16th opp)...the offense recorded 13 hits, four from Josh Bell, who tied his career high (10th time)...Kaelen Culppepper made his major league debut and homered in his second career plate appearance (list below).

ADDITIONALLY: Culppepper became the 16th player in Twins history (since 1961) to homer as his first career hit, first since Ryan Fitzgerald on August 10, 2025 vs. Kansas City.

BATTLE OF I-94: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the fifth of six games this season...Minnesota has won back-to-back games over Milwaukee, seeking their first three-game winning streak against them since winning four-straight in 2021.

⚡ Twins have won four of their last five games at American Family Field.

⚡ Since 2020, the Twins have hit 45 home runs in 34 games against the Brewers, their most against any NL opponent.

⚡ Over his last 20 games vs. Milwaukee, Josh Bell is hitting .377 (26-for-69) with three doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, a .638 slugging percentage and a 1.088 OPS...Bell's 86 career hits vs. the Brewers are his second-most vs. any opponent (Cincinnati - 99)...his 109 career games are his personal most.

⚡ In eight career games at American Family Field, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .387 (12-for-31) with three doubles, two home runs, six RBI and a 1.101 OPS.

⚡ In 11 career games vs. the Brewers, Kody Clemens is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI and an .825 OPS.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING (FOR MIKE VASSALLO): With a win tonight or tomorrow, the Twins will earn their 19th series victory of the season...they have gone 18-17-2 in series play, 11-5-1 at home and 7-12-1 on the road.

⚡ Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 10-4-1 their last 15 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.

⚡ Twins have gone 4-3-1 in series play on the road over their last seven chances, but 0-3-1 in their last four...their last road series win was July 3-5 at Yankee Stadium.

⚡ Twins last series win over the Brewers was May 16-18, 2025, taking two of three in Wisconsin...they haven't won a series in Milwaukee in consecutive seasons since 2020 and 2021.

JOSHIN' AROUND: Josh Bell is hitting .339 (21-for-62) with a .976 OPS in his last 15 road games...below are Bell's overall number comparisons from Opening Day through May 31 and since June 1:

⚡ He has 68 RBI on the season, the 10th-most in the AL.

⚡ He is on pace to record 94 RBI, which would be the second-most of his career (116 - 2019)...the last Twin to drive in 90 in a season was Jorge Polanco with 98 in 2021.

⚡ Twins are 30-13 when Bell drives in at least one run and 13-4 when he drives in at least two.

YOU WIN SOME, YOU LEWIS SOME: Royce Lewis has hit safely in a career-long 12-straight games...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Ryan Jeffers' 12-gamer from July 25-August 10, 2025...the last Twin with a streak of 13-plus was Brooks Lee (19 in 2025)...Lewis' streak is the longest active streak in baseball...during the streak, Lewis is hitting .370 (17-for-46) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, nine RBI, a .696 slugging percentage and a 1.091 OPS...in those 12 games (since July 25), among players with a minimum of 30 plate appearances, he leads baseball in average exit velocity (95.8 mph) and 11th in barrels-per-plate appearance percentage (12.8%).

⚡ Additionally, he has reached safely via hit or walk in a career-high 18-straight games.
