Leaving it Late

Atlanta is set to play games No. 161 and 162 this afternoon, and has yet to determine its postseason fate.

Per Elias, the latest in a season the Braves have clinched a postseason spot is game No. 162, done three times in franchise history.

Atlanta clinched the NL West on the final day of the season in 1982 with an 89-73 record, which the club can match with a single win today. The Braves also clinched the West in game No. 162 in 1993 with a 104-58 mark, and earned the only NL Wild Card spot on the final day in 2010. Atlanta played to a 91-71 record that year.

TODAY'S GAMES: The Braves and Mets today play the final games of their regular seasons with the 12th and 13th games between the teams this season...The two clubs are next scheduled to meet from June 17-19 of next year, here at Truist Park.

A The Braves and Mets are playing a doubleheader today after their scheduled games from Wednesday and Thursday were postponed by weather earlier this week.

A Atlanta beat New York, 5-1, here at Truist Park last Tuesday, and is 6-5 in 11 total games between the clubs the season...The Braves have won each of the last three games in the series by a combined score of 18-3.

A The Braves have won 22 of the last 31 games with New York dating to the 2022 season, outscoring the Mets 190-123 (+67) over the stretch.

A The Braves have taken the season series from their NL East rivals for six consecutive seasons, and can do so again with one win today...Prior to last year's 10-3 mark, they went 10-9 in both 2022 & 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 67-43 (.609) against New York overall.

A Atlanta went 5-1 against New York here at Truist Park last season, but did drop the only series between the clubs here this year...The Mets won two-of-three here in April...Since Truist Park opened in 2017, the Braves are 37-25 (.597) against the Mets here in their home park.

A RH Spencer Schwellenbach is set to start Game 1 for Atlanta, and also started for the Braves against the Mets last Tuesday...The 6-foot-1, 200-pound native of Saginaw, MI, allowed three hits and one run over 7.0 innings in that start to earn the win, and is a perfect 2-0 with a 0.64 ERA (1 ER/14.0 IP) in two turns versus New York this season...The right-hander has won each of his last three starts dating to September 13, going 3-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP) in that stretch.

A LH Chris Sale is scheduled to pitch Game 2 for Atlanta, and is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (7 ER/23.1 IP) in four total starts against the Mets in his career...In his only such start this season, the left-hander allowed two hits and two runs over 7.1 innings in a no-decision...The 6-foot-6, 180-pound native of Lakeland, FL, currently leads the National League in wins (18), ERA (2.38) and strikeouts (225), and is a perfect 10-0 with a 2.28 ERA over 14 starts at Truist Park this season.

A RH Tylor Megill will start Game 1 for New York and has made nine starts and pitched in 10 total games against Atlanta in his career...The right-hander is 1-4 with a 4.94 ERA (26 ER/47.1 IP) all-time against the club, including allowing five hits and four runs over 6.0 innings in his lone such start this year...The Mets have won each of Megill's last five starts dating to August 30, during which he has gone 2-0 with a 1.78 ERA (5 ER/25.1 IP).

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Braves enter play today with an 88-72 (.550) record, and currently hold the second wild card position in the National League playoff field by virtue of tiebreaker...Atlanta and New York currently have identical records, while Arizona ended its regular season yesterday with an 89-73 (.549) mark.

A Atlanta can clinch a postseason berth today with a win in either game of the doubleheader.

A Atlanta went 5-2 over seven games with Arizona this season to earn the tiebreaker, meaning that if the two teams finish the season with the same record the Braves will earn the playoff spot...Atlanta currently leads New York, 6-5, over 11 games this season, and with one additional win over the Mets next week will clinch the season series and the tiebreaker.

A The Mets can also clinch a postseason berth today with a win in either game of the doubleheader...If either team sweeps today's two games, Arizona will earn the final NL Wild Card spot.

A The Phillies, Brewers and Dodgers have clinched the NL East, Central and West divisions, respectively, while the Padres have clinched a postseason berth.

DOUBLEHEADER: Atlanta has played three sets of doubleheaders this season, and went an even 3-3 over the six total games...The Braves split doubleheaders with the Padres (May 20) and Cardinals (June 26 & July 20).

A Atlanta won the first game of both sets with St. Louis before dropping the nightcap, while San Diego won the opener in May.

A Dating to the start of last season, no club in baseball has won more doubleheader games than Atlanta...The Braves are 10-6 (.625) over 16 total sets of games, and their 10 total wins are one more than the Yankees (9-7, .563) and Tigers (9-11, .450).

STRIKEOUTS: Five Atlanta pitchers combined to strike out 14 Kansas City batters yesterday afternoon, and the Braves staff recorded each of its final 11 outs via strikeout...Atlanta leads all of baseball with 1,535 strikeouts on the season.

A Minnesota, with exactly 1,500 strikeouts, was the only other staff to reach that threshold this season.

A The 2024 Braves staff is the third in franchise history to fan over 1,500 in a single season, all of which have come since 2022...Atlanta struck out 1,554 batters in 2022, and 1,516 last year...The Braves need 20 strikeouts between the two games today to set the single-season franchise record.

RUNNERS IN SCORING POSITION: Atlanta outhit Kansas City, 8-5, yesterday afternoon, but went just 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position...The Braves stranded nine total runners on base.

A In its 88 wins this season, Atlanta has batted .295/.366/.509 with runners in scoring position...In their 72 losses, the Braves have hit just .172/.229/.267 in such situations.

Today's Game

- A Making his 21st start of the season and third against New York (NL).
 - A Earned the win while scattering three hits over 7.0 innings of one-run ball in his last start against the Mets.
 - A Is a combined 4-1 with a 2.44 ERA in seven starts against NL East opponents.
 - A Recordedeed strikeout 122 of his career, passing Ian Anderson and Brandon Beachy for the most in Braves franchise history through a player's first 20 games.
- A He's fanned 122 batters, to just 23 walks...In the Modern Era (since 1900), his 5.30 K/BB ratio is the sixth-highest among rookies with as many innings pitched (116.2), shy of Masahiro Tanaka (6.71, 2014), Shota Imanaga (6.21, 2024), George Kirby (6.05, 2022), Roy Oswalt (6.00, 2001) and Noah Syndergaard (5.35, 2015)...Is 4-2 with a 2.75 ERA and averaging 6.0 innings pitched over his last 10 starts.
 - A Since the beginning of July, his ERA is the seventh lowest in the NL (min. 10 GS).
- A Schwellenbach is 7-3 with a 3.01 ERA against teams with .500 records or better this year.
 - A Only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.32) and LA's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (NL - 2.28) have lower ERA's among rookies against such clubs this season (min. 10 starts).
- A Producing a 34.3% chase rate this season.
 - A The second highest rate among pitchers with at least 10 starts this year... Trailing only Philadelphia's Christopher Sánchez (36.9%).
- A Throwing strikes on 69.3% of his pitches.
 - A The highest mark among MLB starters with at least 10 outings.

2024 Recap

- A His 122 strikeouts are the most in Braves franchise history through a player's first 20 career games.
- A Schwellenbach struckout 42 hitters in the month of August; the most by a Braves pitcher in franchise history in their first year in a single calendar month.
- A His 102 strikeouts are the most in franchise history through a player's first 15 games.
 - A Schwellenbach recorded his 85th career strikeout on 8/16 and passed Ian Anderson for the most strikeouts in franchise history through a player's first 13 games.
- A Became the first pitcher in the live ball era to have at least 77 strikeouts and issue 12 walks or less through a player's first 12 career games.
- A Schwellenbach fanned 28 hitters and issued just one walk in the month of July... Became the first player in the live ball era to strikeout as many hitters without issuing more than a walk in a calendar month in their first year.
- A Fanned 11 Mets hitters while scattering two hits over 7.0 scoreless innings on July 27...The 11 strikeouts set a new career high.
 - A Since the mound moved to its current distance of 60 ft. 6 inches in 1893, he is just the third rookie to strike out at least 10 in two straight starts, following Dwight Gooden (September 12 and 17, 1984) and Cincinnati's Nick Lodolo (September 9 and 14, 2022).
- A Became the first player in Braves franchise history to strikeout at least 10 hitters without allowing a run in one of his first 10 career games.
- A Became the third Braves rookie in franchise history with 7.0 or more shutout innings, no walks, and 11 or more strikeouts...Bob Sadowski, 9/5/63 and Spencer Strider, 9/1/22 are the other two.
- A Through his first 11 career games, Schwellenbach has struckout 70 hitters while only allowing 10 free passes...became the first player in the live ball era to record as many strikeouts while issuing 10 or less walks.
 - A Prior to his last start, he was just the third pitcher in Baseball Reference's database with at least 60 strikeouts and 10 or fewer walks issued over the first 10 games of a career.
- A Became the only rookie in the modern era to to strikeout eight or more hitters without issuing a walk in three consecutive starts (7/21-8/2)...Credit StatsPerform.
- A Struckout J.D. Martínez to reach 60 punchouts through his fist 10 games...Tied with Brandon Beachy for the second most in franchise history through a player's first 10 games.
- A Pitched 13.0 scoreless innings in two starts with Double-A Mississippi while recording 17 strikeouts and issuing just one walk, earning the win in both games.
- A Made six starts for High-A Rome and went 2-1 with a 2.53 ERA this season.
- A Began his major league career with 24 starts at the professional level between Single-A Augusta, High-A Rome and Double-A Mississippi.

 - A Played shortstop in 48 games games for the Cornhuskers while hitting .284 with 40 RBI, six home runs and nine stolen bases.
 - A Went 3-1 with 10 saves and a 0.57 ERA (2 ER/31.2 IP) in 18 relief appearances.
- A Played High School baseball at Saginaw Heritage in Michigan.
- A Drafted by Cleveland in the 34th round of the 2018 MLB June Amateur Draft: did not sign.

Aaron Bummer • LHP • 6-3 • 215 • 30 yrs • #49

Saves/Opp: 0/3 Holds: 2 1st Batter/Retired: 55/39 Inherited Runners/Scored: 28/10

- On August 10 allowed his first barrel this season (Statcast)...Currently, he's the only pitcher in MLB with at least 200 batters faced and two-or fewer barrels allowed.
- On September 16 vs. LAD snapped a 46.0-inning homerless streak.
- In nine of his relief appearances, has struck out at least three batters...Just five National League relievers have done so more often.
- Bummer's 33.1 Hard-Hit Percentage ranks in the 89th percentile among major league pitchers.
- Opponents are hitting ground balls off him 62% of the time (league average 43%)...Ranks in the 98th percentile.
- From July 13-26, struck out three batters in four consecutive appearances...The last Braves reliever with such a run was Steve Bedrosian from July 9-27, 1982.
- Was acquired by Atlanta from Chicago on November 16, 2023, in exchange for INF Braden Shewmake, LHP Jared Shuster, INF Nicky Lopez, RHP Michael Soroka and minor-league RHP Riley Gowens.

Jesse Chavez • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 41 yrs • #60

Saves/Opp: 0/1 Holds: 1 1st Batter/Retired: 46/28 Inherited Runners/Scored: 20/4

- With RISP, opposing batters are hitting .150 (9-for-60) off him, which ranks eighth-best in Major League Baseball among pitchers with as many batters faced (70) in such situations.
- Four of Chavez's 20 inherited runners have scored, the 10th-best percentage (20%) in the N.L. (min. 20 IR).
- Reached 1,000 career strikeouts on June 10...Among active primary relievers, his 1,034 strikeouts rank sixth.
- From 2021-present, owns a 2.55 ERA (51 ER/180.0 IP) as a Brave...With other clubs during that period (TEX, CHC, LAA), has pitched to a 7.16 ERA (13 ER/16.1 IP).

- This season, has pitched to a 2.59 ERA (12 ER/41.2 IP) across 33 relief outings with Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Has posted a 11.23 K/9 at Triple-A this season.
- Earned the win in his MLB debut on July 23 2023 in Milwaukee...Prior to that, the last Atlanta reliever to earn a win in his MLB debut was Jesse Biddle, who beat the New York Mets on April 21, 2018.

Grant Holmes • RHP • 6-0 • 226 • 28 yrs • #66

Saves/Opp: 0/1 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 19/13 Inherited Runners/Scored: 12/4

- Has pitched to a 3.12 ERA (12 ER/34.2 IP) as a reliever and a 4.55 ERA (15 ER/29.2 IP) as a starter.
- On July 29 made his first career start...Became just the second pitcher in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to record the first seven outs of his first career start via strikeout.
- On June 16, pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with two strikeouts and no walks in his major league debut...Holmes is just the second Brave to pitch to those parameters in his major league debut in the Atlanta era (since 1966)...He joined Manny Bañuelos, who did it in a starting nod on July 2, 2015...Just three other pitchers have done it in franchise history.
- Pitched 10 seasons in minors before making MLB debut...Was drafted by LAD with 22nd overall pick in 2014.
