TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Toronto finish a two-game series with the fourth of four games between the clubs this season...The teams split a two-game series in Toronto last Tuesday and Wednesday, with the Braves winning the finale, 9-4.

- A* The teams have split each of their last four series, dating to May 17-18, 2017...The Braves swept the two-game series, May 15-16, marking the last time the teams did not split...The Braves won yesterday's series opener, 6-3.
- A* The Braves and Blue Jays are meeting for the third consecutive year and for the fourth time in five seasons.
- A* RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set to face Toronto for the fifth time in his career, for the fourth time as a starter and for the second time this season...The righty went 4.2 innings on August 28 at Toronto and took a no-decision in the Braves' 9-4 win...Foltynewicz's teams have won all four of his career appearances against Toronto.
- A* RHP Wilmer Font has pitched against the Braves three times this season, allowing just one hit with eight strikeouts in 5.0 total innings...Font served as Toronto's opener last week at Rogers Centre, going 2.0 innings and allowing one hit with four strikeouts in a 3-1 win...In Font's nine starts with Toronto this season, the righty is 0-1 with a 1.56 ERA (3 ER/17.1 IP) and 27 strikeouts.

31 OVER: With yesterday's 6-3 win, the Braves are 85-54 and a season-best 31 games over .500...Atlanta has not been this far over .500 since after play on September 3, 2013, when the club moved to 32 games over at 85-53...Atlanta has the fifth-best record in baseball, and the second-best mark in the National League, 4.5 games behind Los Angeles.

- A* The last time the club was more than 32 over was at the end of the 2003 season, when the Braves finished 40 over at 101-61.
- SURGING:** The Braves have won 16 of their last 20 games and 13 of 15 after yesterday's win over Toronto...The club moved its magic number to clinch the National League East to 19 after second-place Washington dropped a 7-3 decision to New York (NL).
- A* This is the club's best 15-game stretch since going 14-1 from July 27-August 11, 2013.
- A* Over their last 15 games, the Braves have compiled a 2.60 ERA (40 ER/138.1 IP) and allowed just 11 home runs.
- A* The Braves have not lost a multi-game series since July 23-24, when Kansas City swept both games here at SunTrust Park...They have gone 8-0-3 in multi-game series play over this stretch, and can win another series with a victory tonight.
- A* The Braves are on pace to win 99 games this season...Eight different teams in franchise history have won triple digits in a season (last, 2003; 101).

WINNING AT HOME: The Braves have won nine straight in Atlanta after yesterday's 6-3 victory over Toronto, the club's longest home winning streak of the season...They last won nine consecutive home games in a single season from May 18-June 2, 2010.

- A* The Braves have held the opposition to 27 total runs in these nine games (24 earned runs/2.67 ERA), while striking out 91, converting five saves and collecting 12 holds.
- A* The last time the Braves won 10 consecutive home games in a single season was 2000, when the club won a franchise modern-era record 12 straight from April 8-May 5.
- A* The longest home single-season winning streak by any Braves team in franchise history is 18, set in 1897 by the Boston Beaneaters...Led by 31-game winner Kid Nichols and four other future Hall of Famers (manager Frank Selee, 3B Jimmy Collins, OF Billy Hamilton, OF Hugh Duffy), the Beaneaters won 18 straight at South End Grounds from May 31-June 25.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today recalled LHP A.J. Minter and RHP Bryse Wilson from Triple-A Gwinnett...The club now has 31 players on its active roster.

- A* Minter, 26, returns to a 3-4 record and a 7.24 ERA (22 ER/27.1 IP) with five saves in 34 games for the Braves...He has walked 23 and struck out 33.
- A* Wilson, 21, is 1-1 with a 6.75 ERA (14 ER/18.2 IP) in five games, four starts, with Atlanta...The righty went 10-7 with a 3.42 ERA (46 ER/121.0 IP) in 21 games, all starts, for the Stripers this season.

INTERLEAGUE: The Braves are set to play their 18th interleague game of the season today, and they are 11-6 so far against the American League...The Braves are finishing a seven-game stretch against the AL tonight.

- A* The Braves are ensured of a winning record against the AL after yesterday's 6-3 win over Toronto...They had not finished over .500 against the American League in a single season since going 11-9 in 2013...

FOLTYNEWICZ WINS: Atlanta has won each of RHP Mike Foltynewicz's last eight starts dating to June 11 vs. Pittsburgh, including each of his five turns since returning from his option to Gwinnett.

- A* The run of team wins in his starts is the second longest such streak of his career, trailing just a nine-start stretch from June 7 to July 25, 2017.
- A* It is the third such run by Atlanta in a pitcher's starts this season, after winning eight straight games started by Mike Soroka from June 1 to July 14, and each of Max Fried's last eight games, dating to July 15.
- A* Atlanta is the only team in the majors to win eight straight starts by a single pitcher on three occasions this season, and one of just two teams with at least two such streaks...The Yankees won eight straight starts by Chad Green (9 straight) and Domingo German (8 games).

Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his 17th start of the season and the 113th of his career...Set for his 133rd career appearance.
- A* Atlanta has won each of his last eight starts dating to June 11 vs. Pittsburgh, including each of his five turns since returning from his option to Gwinnett.
- A* The run of team wins in his starts is the second longest such streak of his career, trailing just a nine-start stretch from June 7 to July 25, 2017.
- A* It's the third such run by Atlanta in a pitcher's starts this season, after winning eight straight games started by Mike Soroka from June 1 to July 14, and each of Max Fried's last eight games dating to July 15.
- A* Atlanta is the only team in the majors to win eight straight starts by a single pitcher on three occasions this season, and one of just two teams with at least two such streaks...The Yankees won eight straight starts by both Chad Green (9 straight) and Domingo German (8 games).
- A* Set for his fourth career start and fifth career appearance against the Blue Jays, and his second consecutive...Is undefeated in his previous four games, going 2-0 with a 5.00 ERA (10 ER/18.0 IP).
- A* Pitched against them just six days ago, August 28 at the Rogers Centre... Allowed eight hits and three runs (two earned) over 4.2 innings, taking a no-decision in Atlanta's 9-4 win.
- A* Made his major league debut against Toronto, August 2, 2014 with Houston... Pitched 0.2 scoreless innings in relief.
- A* Starts against the same opponent in consecutive turns for the fifth time in his career, and for the second time this season...Made back-to-back starts against Pittsburgh, June 6 and June 11.
- A* Is 2-1 with a 3.16 ERA (10 ER/25.2 IP) in his combined first starts, and 1-2 with a 4.35 ERA (10 ER/20.2 IP) in the second turn.
- A* Pitches an average of 1.1 innings fewer in the second leg of his back-to-back starts.
- A* Went 2-0 with a 3.90 ERA (12 ER/27.2 IP) over five starts in August...Was recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, August 5.
- A* Had a 6.37 ERA (42 ER/59.1 IP) in his first 11 starts of the season before being optioned.

2019 Recap

- A* Was recalled by Atlanta, 8/5, and started at Minnesota the following day...Allowed five hits (two homers) and three runs in 5.1 innings.
- A* All three runs scored in the sixth inning, after Atlanta sent 10 men to the plate and scored six runs in the top of the frame...Allowed just four baserunners through the first five innings.
- A* Made six starts with the Stripers following his option on 6/22, and went 4-0 with a 2.67 ERA (10 ER/33.2 IP) and 31 strikeouts...Opponents batted .254/.299/.325 against him.
- A* Pitched to a 1.13 ERA (2 ER/16.0 IP) over his last three turns, and allowed opponents to hit just .179.
- A* Started for Atlanta in Washington, 6/22, and allowed a career high-tying eight runs over 4.0 innings...Was optioned to Gwinnett postgame.
- A* In his previous six starts, had gone 2-2 with a 3.97 ERA.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 5/24 at STL, after allowing five hits and one unearned run over 6.0 innings.
- A* The win stopped a seven-game losing streak for the Braves in Foltyniewicz's starts, dating to his final regular-season start of 2018...Atlanta lost each of Foltyniewicz's two playoff starts last season, and his first five turns this year.
- A* Started, 5/14 vs. STL, for his 100th career start, all of which have come for Atlanta.
- A* Became the 20th pitcher to make 100 starts for the Braves since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966...Of the 20 pitchers to make 100 such starts, Foltyniewicz's 8.61 SO/9.0 IP at the time were most, and he stood as one of just two starters to strike out at least eight batters per 9.0 innings for Atlanta.
- A* Went 6.0+ innings in his season debut, 4/27 vs. COL, and allowed six hits and four runs with a walk and five strikeouts...Two of the four runs scored before he recorded an out in the seventh.
- A* Was activated off the 10-day injured list, 4/27, and made his first major league start of the season...Missed Atlanta's first 25 games.
- A* Placed on the injured list with a right elbow bone spur on March 28, retroactive to March 25...Marked his third career trip to the injured list...Missed from June 4 - June 30, 2016 (right elbow soreness), and from June 13 - June 25, 2018 (right triceps tightness).

Career Recap

- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Ryo Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

- Is 1-0 with 4.05 ERA (12 ER/26.2 IP) in 36 games with Atlanta...Twenty-nine of his 36 appearances have been scoreless, including 16 of his last 20.
- Converted his first save chance of the season, 8/14 vs. NYM...Was the seventh save of his career.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.
- Has a 27.00 ERA (6 ER/2.0 IP) against LAD this season...Has a 2.19 ERA (6 ER/24.2 IP) against all other teams.
- Twenty of his 36 appearances have been less than 1.0 inning.
- Holding left-handed batters to a .167 (8-for-48) average with 16 strikeouts...Righties are 13-for-52 (.250).
- Atlanta acquired him from the Oakland A's on 4/28 in exchange for cash considerations...Was designated for assignment by Atlanta on 5/14 and re-signed to a major league contract on 5/18.

- Is 0-1 with a 4.11 ERA (7 ER/15.1 IP) in 17 games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.03 ERA (12 ER/53.1 IP) in 55 games on the season...He has converted 22 of 27 save opportunities.
- Has 11 consecutive scoreless appearances spanning 11.0 innings, allowing just four hits and striking out 11.
- Allowed runs in four of his first six appearances with the Braves, and allowed all four inherited runners to score.
- Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save.
- Acquired from Detroit on 7/31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...Prior to joining the Braves ranked fourth in the American League with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball to San Diego's Kirby Yates among qualifying relievers.
- Was 0-2 with 22 saves and a 1.18 ERA (5 ER/38.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 12 walks in 38 games out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season.

- Is 8-2 with a 3.58 ERA (26 ER/65.1 IP) in 62 games this season...Has converted 18 of his 25 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019...His seven blown saves are tied for third most in the majors.
- Has eight wins in relief this season, the most by a Braves reliever since Oscar Villarreal also had eight in 2006.
- Per Statcast, has an expected batting average of just .204 and an average exit velocity of 87.5 mph...Opponents are officially batting .263 (67-for-255).
- Left-handers have just 16 hits in 96 at-bats (.167) against him...Righties are hitting .321 (51-for-159).
- Has fanned 90 batters in 65.1 innings for a career-best 12.40 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
- Earned his 18th save, 8/11 at Miami...Has four saves of at least 1.1 innings.
- Recorded his second consecutive two-inning save, 5/15 vs. STL, to become the first Braves closer with back-to-back two-inning saves since Hall of Famer John Smoltz in 2002
