LAST SEASON: Rea went 6-6 with a 4.55 ERA in 26 games/22 starts during five stints with Milwaukee last season....the team went 14-8 in his starts....he had 4 guality starts....opponents batted .235.....he set career highs in wins (6), games (26), starts (22), innings pitched (124.2) and strikeouts (110).
