



San Francisco Giants (44-45) at Cleveland Guardians (54-32) LHP Kyle Harrison (4-3, 3.96) vs. LHP Logan Allen (8-4, 5.75)

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to take a fourth straight series with a win today in the second game of this three-game set with the Guardians after last night's 4-2 win.

- ▶ SF is 8-3 in their last 11 games dating to June 24, taking series from the Cubs (3-1), Dodgers (2-1) and Braves (2-1) before winning here last night here in Cleveland.
- ► This streak has brought the Giants back to within a game of .500 and a win today would bring SF to .500 for the first time since they were 29-29 after a loss to the Yankees on May 31.
- ▶ The road has been a tough place for the Giants in 2024 as they are 19-26 (.422) outside of Oracle Park...SF is trying to win back-to-back road series for the first time since taking consecutive series in Pittsburgh and New York in late May.

ROSTER MOVES: LHP Kyle Harrison (#45) was reinstated from the 15-day IL and **LHP Kolton Ingram** (#56) was recalled from Double-A Richmond.

In corresponding moves, **RHP Spencer Bivens** and **IF David Villar** were optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

ON THE CUYAHOGA RIVER: The Giants are visiting Cleveland for the first time since 2022 and are only playing just their third series in this ballpark since Interleague play expanded.

- ► SF has won both of its previous series at Jacobs/Progressive Field, going 2-1 here in 2008 and sweeping a three-game set here in April of 2022.
- ➤ Since losing their first-ever regular season series to the Cleveland franchise in 2005, the Giants have won each of the other six series the two teams have played since 2008... SF is 16-3 in that time.

ONE SMALL STEP...: RHP Alex Cobb (right shoulder) made his second rehab start for Single-A San Jose last night at Stockton, throwing 45 pitches (27 strikes) over 2.0 scoreless innings...Cobb didn't allow a hit, struck out five, walked one and hit one batter.

BIG BROS & LITTLE BROS: Last night's game featured two sets of brothers facing off against one another in SF's Taylor and Tyler Rogers along with CLE's Josh and Bo Naylor... below are the last few instances of a pair of brothers facing off against an opponent who also played a pair of brothers courtesy of Elias.

- This same occurrence also took place on September 11, 2023 at Oracle Park with the same sets of brothers facing off against one another when SF hosted the Guardians.
- Prior to these two matchups, the last time it happened was April 26, 2009 when the Padres Edgar & Adrian González squared off against the Pirates Adam and Andy LaRoche.

LOOKING UP AT US: The Giants bullpen technically covered the whole game yesterday as SF used seven of its nine available relievers.

- ► The Giants' 371.2 reliever innings this year are most in the Majors, now nearly eight full innings more than the second-place Brewers (363.1ip).
- ▶ RHP Tyler Rogers lead the Majors in appearances (46) followed by teammate RHP Ryan Walker's 44 appearances, second-most in MLB...last night's opener LHP Erik Miller has made 41 appearances in his rookie campaign (tied for 11th-most in the Majors).

HARRY...I TOOK CARE OF IT!: LHP Kyle Harrison returns from the IL today to make his 15th start of the season and first since June 10.

- ▶ Harrison was on the IL because of a right ankle injury he suffered working out in the days leading up to his scheduled start on June 16.
- ▶ The 22-year-old has been the Giants good luck charm of sorts with the Giants going 10-4 in his 14 starts this season and 5-2 as a team in his seven road starts.
- ➤ Today marks his second career start against the Guardians after facing them last season in mid-September at Oracle Park..he allowed five runs (three earned) on seven hits in 4.0 innings but the Giants won the game in 10 innings, 6-5.

CAN HE REACH...THE ASG?: OF Heliot Ramos rattled off another multi-hit game last night, going 2-for-4...since his recall, the 24-year-old is slashing .302/.376/.530 for a .905 OPS in 52 games...he's tied for the team lead in home runs (12) and is second on the team in RBI (40).

- ▶ Ramos' 23 multi-hit games since his recall on May 8 are tied for most in the Majors with SD's Luis Arraez.
- ▶ His 40 RBI since May 8 are tied for most in the National League with CHC's Ian Happ and tied for third-most in MLB behind Judge (62) and CLE's José Ramírez (46).

BIG MIKE: OF Michael Conforto is slashing .321/.429/.679 over his last 12 games dating to June 22 with seven of his nine hits in the span going for extra bases (five doubles, one triple, one homer).

▶ He was 2-for-4 last night with a pair of doubles and RBI... the Giants are 14-8 this year when Conforto drives in a run and are a staggering 44-15 when he drives in a run during his time as a Giant dating to last season.

DON'T SQUINT TO SEE: The Giants are playing consecutive day games over the weekend here in Cleveland and are 21-17 overall this year in day games.

- ▶ SF opened the year 15-7 in their first 22 day games but have since gone 6-10 in their last 16 day contests (including dropping five of their last six day contests dating to June 19).
- ▶ The Giants own a .742 OPS in day games, seventh-best in MLB and third-best in the NL...on the flip side, SF has a .678 OPS in night games (22nd of 30 clubs).

JULY 6, 1953 - In his first Major League start, **Al Worthington** blanked the Pirates 6-0. The Giants rookie would repeat the feat in his next start, blanking the Dodgers to tie a Major League mark.

TODAY'S START: Harrison is scheduled to make his 15th start of the season today after missing SF's previous 20 games with a right ankle sprain...Harrison is 4-3 with a 3.96 ERA (34er, 77.1ip) in his 14 starts this season...the Giants are 10-4 in his starts this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on June 10 vs. Houston (a 4-3 SF win)...had one of his best starts of the season prior to hitting the IL...allowed just one run on four hits and no walks while striking out three.

VS. CLEVELAND: Harrison faced Cleveland during his debut season in 2023...he allowed five runs (three earned) on seven hits and a walk while striking out 3 across 4.0 innings in SF's 6-5 win at Oracle Park (September 13)...Cleveland scored four runs in the 1st inning off Harrison, two coming on a home run by IF José Ramírez.

NO FREE PASSES: Has limited his walks thus far this season, allowing 22 free passes in 77.1 innings (2.56 BB/9)...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings...he enters today with 15.2 straight innings without a walk allowed, with the last walk coming with two outs in the 2nd inning vs. Philadelphia on May 29 (Kyle Schwarber).

FROM SIS: According to Sports Info Solutions, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues... opposing hitters are 36-for-118 (.305) with five homers in atbats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball... they're 45-for-182 (.247) in at-bats ending with the four-seam... last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

THE FASTBALL: Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 62.5% of the time...he has thrown 774 four-seam fastballs this season, 12th-most in MLB...Cleveland has hit the four-seam fastball well this season, with a .258/.340/.463 slash line and an .803 OPS (sixth in MLB).

3RD TIME'S THE CHARM: He's limited the damage when facing a lineup for a third time in a game...batters are hitting .239 (17-for-71) off him with just seven runs scored.

GOTTA GET THE LAST OUT: Opponents have a slash line of .300/.364/.480 (.844 OPS) off Harrison with two outs...with two outs and runners in scoring position, opponents have a slash line of .306/.359/.444 (.803 OPS).

HOMETOWN HERO OR ROAD WARRIOR: Harrison is 1-1 with a 4.10 ERA, 37 strikeouts and a 1.31 WHIP in seven home starts this season compared to 3-2 with a 3.83 ERA, 31 strikeouts and a 1.35 WHIP in seven road starts...despite the better win-loss record and ERA on the road, opponents have a .731 OPS vs. Harrison at home and a .783 OPS against Harrison away from Oracle Park.

THE STOPPER: The young lefty has been a stopper this year... he is 3-2 with a 3.14 ERA (20er, 57.1ip) with 48 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP in 10 starts following an SF loss...he is 1-1 with a 6.30 ERA (14er, 20.0ip), 20 strikeouts and a 1.80 WHIP in four starts following an SF win.

2023 SEASON: Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected...went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A... Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia.

ABOUT KYLE: Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect for the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America...*Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 7/5 at CLE; S, 1.0ip, h, bb, k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Is 17-for-20 in save opportunities.
- ▶ Over his past eight outings, he's 1-0-5 with a 1.13 ERA (1er, 8.0ip), five hits (.185 avg), two walks and 12 strikeouts.
- ▶ Doval allowed nine runs on 13 hits in 10.0 innings (8.10 ERA) in June...he owned a 2.78 ERA through his first 23 games.
- ▶ Has issued 23 BBs in 35.2ip...his 14.2% BB rate is bottom 3% of league.
- Doval's hard-hit rate of 46.7% this year is in the bottom 5% of the league and a tad more than five percent higher than his hard-hit rate in 2023 (41.3%).
- ▶ Righties are just 14-for-72 (.194) with five extra-base hits off him, while lefties are 18-for-65 (.277) with seven extra-base hits.
- ► Has struck out 47 batters over 35.2 innings of work (11.9 SO/9.0)

#64 SEAN HJELLE > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Cutter, Changeup, Knuckle Curve **Last Game:** 7/3 at ATL; 2.0ip, h, 4k (27 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed a career-high eight runs last Saturday vs. the Dodgers, but bounced back Wednesday and tossed 2.0-scoreless innings.
- ▶ Has given up multiple runs three times in his 27 outings.
- ▶ Has recorded at least four outs in 18 of his 28 games w/SF.
- ▶ Has a 63.3% ground ball rate this year.
- At 6'11, he is tied for tallest pitcher in MLB history with Jon Rauch.

#56 KOLTON INGRAM ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Cutter, Slider, Sweeper, Changeup **Last Game:** 7/3 at BOW; 1.0ip, 2bb (21 pitches) (w/AA Richmond)

- ▶ Recalled from Double-A Richmond today after being claimed by SF off waivers from the Cardinals on Tuesday.
- ▶ Made one appearance for the Squirrels, throwing 1.0 scoreless inning on Wednesday at Bowie.
- Is in his sixth different organization this year after starting the calendar year with the Angels...has also been with the Tigers, Mets, Rangers and Cardinals organizations after being claimed by each team off waivers.
- ▶ In 21 combined games between Triple-A Syracuse (Mets), Triple-A Round Rock (Rangers), Triple-A Memphis (Cardinals) and Double-A Richmond (Giants) he's gone 3-0 with a 4.10 ERA in 26.1 innings with 26 strikeouts and 21 walks.
- Former 37th-round pick of Detroit in 2019 made his MLB debut last season with the Angels, appearing in five games and posting an 8.44 ERA.

#77 LUKE JACKSON > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball **Last Game:** 7/3 at ATL; 1.0ip, h, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Had a 9.31 ERA (10er, 9.2ip) in 11 games in June.
- ▶ Lefties are 15-for-42 (.357) off him...righties are 15-for-62 (.242).
- Opposing hitters are hitting .300 and .259 off his slider and four-seamer, respectively, this year...last season they batted .200 off his slider and .174 off his four-seamer.

#68 ERIK MILLER > LHP
