The Brewers have gone 12-1 in their last 13 games against the White Sox, including 8 straight wins....it is the team's longest active winning streak against an opponent.

Great Rate

The Brewers are 8-1 in their last 9 games played at Rate Field, including 7 straight victories.

Four!

With a win today, the Brewers would record their second 4-game winning streak of the season (also 4/1-4/4).....it would mark the second time this season the team immediately followed a 4-game losing streak with a 4-game winning streak.

Sweep Dreams

Milwaukee is aiming for its first sweep of the season this afternoon.....the team's last sweep came from 8/16-8/19, 2024 (3g) vs. Cleveland and its last road sweep from 8/6-8/8, 2024 (3g) at Atlanta....it would mark Milwaukee's third-straight 3-game sweep of the White Sox

They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 82-44 (.651) since 2022 during Interleague Play, trailing the Dodgers (80-38, .678).....the team is 8-6 in Interleague Play this season.

William the Conqueror

William Contreras has hit safely in 20 of his last 21 games, including a current 9-game hitting streak in which he is batting .333 (11-for-33) with 6 RBI and a .476 OBP (9bb).

<u>DuRBIn</u>

Caleb Durbin has hit safely and recorded an RBI in each of his last 4 games, batting .364 (4-for-11) with 5 RBI....since being recalled from Triple-A Nashville on April 18 Durhin tied with Miami's Liam Hicks for the MLB lead among rookies in RBI (8).

<u>Home Sweet Home</u> The Brewers conclude their longest road trip of the season this afternoon (10 games, 11 days).....the team returns home Friday to begin a 6-game homestand against Chicago-NL (3g) and Houston (3g).....Milwaukee is 9-4 at American Family Field this season including 4-0-0 in series play.

TODAY'S GAME: Is game 10 (4-5) of a season-long 10-game, 11-day road trip to San Francisco (1-3), St. Louis (1-2) and Chicago-AL (2-0)....following today's game, the team returns to American Family Field for a 6-game homestand against Chicago-NL (3g) and Houston (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (44 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 10*, SECOND: 16, THIRD: 12, FOURTH: 3, FIFTH: 3.....the Brewers are currently tied for second place with the Reds, trailing the first-place Cubs by 2.0 games (* 9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing their first game).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 6-4-0 in series play, including this series. Game 1: 5-5, Game 2: 6-4, Game 3: 4-5, Game 4: 1-1 Sweep Wins [-]: None.....Sweep Losses [1]: at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The Brewers are 9-4 at home, going 4-0-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 7-11 on the road, going 2-4-0 in series play, including this series.....the team has won a season-high 3 consecutive road games

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager. 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Returning from 2024 is associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach **Jim Henderson** (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), hitting coach Season/2nd in corrent role), bullper coach **Chaine Grene** (2nd season), intiting coach **Connor Dawson** (4th season), assistant coach **Daniel de Mondesert** (2nd season), infield coach **Matt Erickson** (2nd season) and third base coach **Jason Lane** (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach **Julio Borbón**, lead hitting coach **Al LeBoeuf** and hitting coach **Eric Theisen** are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made four replay challenges, going 4-0.. their last challenge came on 4/30 at Chicago-AL, as an out call on a force play at second base involving William Contreras was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons.....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 682 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TODAY'S STARTER: #39 - RHP CHAD PATRICK (6g, 5gs, 1-2, 2.

PATRICK AT A GLANCE: Chad Patrick, 26, will be making his seventh appearance and sixth start of the season.....Patrick last pitched last Friday in a start at St. Louis and took a 3-2 loss (4.1ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 2k, 70 pitches).....the team is 2-3 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .247 (23-for-93, 3hr).....Patrick was on the Opening Day roster and made his MLB debut on 3/29 at Yankee Stadium, pitching in relief.....he was acquired from Oakland on 11/15/23 in exchange for INF Abraham Toro.

PATRICK STAR: The Hebron, Indiana native was supported by 300+ quests for his first Major League start on 4/1 vs. Kansas City, including his parents, coaches, family friends and high school friends.....many of them returned to see his first Major League win on 4/6 vs. Cincinnati.

LAST SEASON: Patrick went 14-1 with a 2.90 ERA in 26 games/24 starts last season at Triple-A Nashville to earn International League Pitcher of the Year honors.....the 2024 International League All-Star led the league in wins, ERA, strikeouts (145) and WHIP (1.09) while ranking second in opponent batting average (.215).....he was added to the 40-man roster on Nov. 19.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Patrick has gone 23-14 with a 4.06 ERA in 68 games/60 starts while pitching in the Arizona (2021-23), Oakland (2023) and Milwaukee (2024) organizations.....he has produced 334 strikeouts in 312.1 innings pitched.....Patrick was selected by Arizona in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.....he was traded by Arizona to Oakland on 7/31/23 in exchange for INF Jace Peterson, who is now a consultant to the Brewers' performance psychology department.
