

San Francisco Giants (74-78) at Baltimore Orioles (84-68) RHP Logan Webb (12-10, 3.53) vs. RHP Zach Eflin (10-9, 3.55)

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants can sweep the Orioles with a win today after taking the first two games of this three-game series...neither team has swept one another in their brief head-to-head history.

- ▶ The last time the Giants swept any series of three games or more from an American League opponent came back in 2022 when they took a three-game set from the Cleveland Guardians from April 15-17 at Progressive Field.
- ▶ SF is trying to sweep its third series of the season...the only two sweeps the Giants have completed this year have both come against the Rockies (a three-game set at Oracle in May and a four-game set at Oracle in July).
- ▶ The Giants are 13-20 (.394) since August 11...the .394 winning percentage in that span is second-lowest in the NL ahead of only Miami (13-21, .382) and fourth-lowest in MLB.

BALTIMORE SUN: This visit is just the third time SF has come to Baltimore since Interleague play began with the only other prior visits coming in 2004 and 2019...SF is 6-2 in this facility and has won all three series they've played here.

- ▶ **OF Mike Yastrzemski**, who was originally drafted by the Orioles in 14th round in 2013, has gone 7-for-20 in five games played here with a triple, three homers, six RBI, eight runs scored and four walks.
- ▶ Baltimore-native **IF LaMonte Wade Jr.** is playing his firstever MLB games in this ballpark during this series...he's 3-for-9 with two RBI in this series thus far.

ROAD CHALLENGES: The road has been a challenge for SF in 2024 as they enter today with a 33-41 (.446) road record...the .446 road winning percentage is tied for 20th of 30 MLB clubs and is tied for fourth-lowest in the NL with PIttsburgh.

- ▶ However, SF has won each of its last two road series which have both come against teams currently in playoff position... the Giants took two-of-three from San Diego September 6-8 and have already secured this series win.
- ▶ SF has won four consecutive road games entering play today, the club's second four-game road winning streak this year (also May 22-25 at Pittsburgh and at the Mets).

ON A HEATER: OF Mike Yastrzemski led off the game with a homer for a second straight day yesterday...he's the fourth Giant in franchise history, and third in the SF-era (since 1958), to have consecutive games with a leadoff homer...the other three are **Dan Gladden** (Oct 1-2, 1985), **Bobby Bonds** (June 5-6, 1973) and **Whitey Lockman** (July 18-19, 1953) (*Sport Radar*).

- ▶ With yesterday's homer, Yastrzemski has homered in consecutive games for the third time this month (also Sept. 1-3 and Sept. 10-11).
- ▶ Eight of Yastrzemski's 17 homers this year have come in his last 20 games since August 24...he's also homered six times this month.
- ▶ It's the first time Yastrzemski has homered six times in a month since hitting seven homers in July of 2021...his career-best mark for homers in a single month is nine from his rookie campaign in August 2019.
- ➤ Since August 24, Yastrzemski has a .946 OPS with two doubles, eight homers, 14 RBI, 15 runs scored and 10 walks in 20 games.



WEBB SLINGER: RHP Logan Webb makes is set to make his 32nd start of the year for SF...it'll be the third straight season that Webb has made at least 32 starts (he made 32 in 2022 and 33 last season).

- ▶ The last Giant to make at least 32 starts in three consecutive seasons prior to Webb was **Madison Bumgarner**, who did so in three straight seasons from 2014-2016.
- In three starts this month, Webb has a 6.75 ERA (12er, 16.0ip) and has allowed 25 hits with opposing hitters batting .362 off him...SF has gone 1-2 in those games.
- In his most recent start last Friday against the Padres, Webb lasted only 4.0 innings...it was the first time since May 5 at Philadelphia Webb failed to finish 5.0 innings, snapping a 22-start streak of doing so from May 10-September 7.

WALK THE LINE: RHP Ryan Walker notched his eighth save of the year with his scoreless 9th inning last night.

- ▶ Since taking over the closer's role on August 9, Walker has converted all eight of his save opportunities while allowing just one unearned run in 16.0 innings...he's struck out 25 and walked just four in that time while opposing hitters have batted .127 (7-for-55).
- ➤ Since the All-Star break, Walker has allowed two earned runs in 26.0 innings for a 0.69 ERA in 24 games...his 0.69 ERA since the break is third-best among relievers (min. 25.0ip) behind ARI's AJ Puk (0.35) and CLE's Emmanuel Clase (0.35).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN...: Following this afternoon's game the Giants will hop a flight and fly to Kansas City where they open a three-game series with the Royals tomorrow night.

- ▶ It'll be the Giants' first series in KC since they went 1-1 in Kansas City from April 18-19, 2017.
- ▶ The winning pitcher in SF's win in that series on April 18 was **RHP Derek Law**, who was in his second season as a Giant after debuting in 2016...no Giants player that played in that series is currently on the roster...**OF Hunter Pence**, who played both games of that series in right field for SF, is here serving as the color analyst for the Giants on NBC Sports Bay Area.

This Date in Giants History

SEPTEMBER 19, 1998 - The Giants scored seven runs in the 3rd inning, and six more in the 4th, as they demolished the Dodgers by a score of 18-4. **Bill Mueller** and **Jeff Kent** banged grand slams in the two frames, just the second time in Giants history that two players have hit grand slams in a game (April 26, 1970 was the other).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his 10th loss of the season last Friday vs. San Diego...gave up four runs (three earned) on seven hits with a homer, a walk and four strikeouts...Webb failed to reach the 5.0 inning mark for the first time since May 5 (22 starts)...the homer he allowed was his fourth in his last four starts (21.0ip)...prior to that, he had not given up a home run in six consecutive starts (42.1ip).

VS. BALTIMORE: Is facing the Orioles for the second time in his career...suffered the loss in his lone start against them on June 2, 2023 at Oracle...worked 7.0 innings and held the O's to three runs on four hits with a walk and six strikeouts...Webb gave up three hits in the 2nd inning before retiring 12 of the next 13 batters he faced.

ON THE LEADERBOARDS: Webb leads all NL pitchers in innings this season at 193.2 and ranks second in MLB, just behind KC's Seth Lugo (197.2ip)...the right-hander also ranks among the top of the NL leaderboards in quality starts (19, T-2nd), FIP (3.01, 3rd), fWAR (4.0, 5th) and ERA (3.53, 9th).

KEEP 'EM IN THE YARD: Webb given up just 11 homers this season (tied for third-fewest among qualified pitchers) and has surrendered a total of six homers over his past 15 starts (94.1ip)...Webb's 0.51 HR/9ip this season would match a career-best (also: 2022) and ranks as the third-best figure in the Majors, trailing only ATL's Chris Sale (0.42) and PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (0.47).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Webb has struggled in the first inning this season, allowing 19 runs on 35 hits in his 31 outings...his 5.52 ERA in the inning ranks as the fourth-highest figure among qualified NL pitchers, with his .285 opposing average ranking second in the NL behind only COL's Austin Gomber (.381)...however, the numbers indicate Webb has been mostly unlucky in the inning...his 2.79 FIP in the 1st is the sixth-best figure in NL, while his .363 BABIP is fifthhighest in MLB and second in the NL to Gomber (.422).

DOUBLE DIPPING: Webb has induced 24 double plays this year, second-most in MLB behind Framber Valdez (31).

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Through 31 starts this year Webb owns a 57.1% ground ball rate, fourth-best in the Majors behind HOU's Framber Valdez (61.6%), ATL's Max Fried (59.1%) and PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (58.9%)...he leads the Majors with 336 produced ground balls this season.

DADDY LONG LEGS: Webb has finished at least 7.0 innings on 15 different occasions so far this season, most of any pitcher in the Majors...only three other Giants starters this year have finished 7.0 innings (Blake Snell (4x), Jordan Hicks on April 5 vs. SD and Kyle **Harrison** on May 7 at COL).

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Earned his first career All-Star selection, joining **OF Heliot Ramos** as the two Giants in the Midsummer Classic...Webb became the first homegrown (drafted and developed) Giants pitcher to be named to an All-Star Game since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** was selected to the team in 2016.

SEPTEMBER: After a memorable month of August, Webb has been having a contrasting start to this month...the righthander has allowed 25 hits in just 16.0 innings in September after giving up 21 hits in all five starts in August...below are his splits in each of the months so far.
