San Francisco Giants (74-78) at Baltimore Orioles (84-68) RHP Logan Webb (12-10, 3.53) vs. RHP Zach Eflin (10-9, 3.55)

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants can sweep the Orioles with a win today after taking the first two games of this three-game series...neither team has swept one another in their brief head-to-head history.

- ▶ The last time the Giants swept any series of three games or more from an American League opponent came back in 2022 when they took a three-game set from the Cleveland Guardians from April 15-17 at Progressive Field.
- ▶ SF is trying to sweep its third series of the season...the only two sweeps the Giants have completed this year have both come against the Rockies (a three-game set at Oracle in May and a four-game set at Oracle in July).
- ▶ The Giants are 13-20 (.394) since August 11...the .394 winning percentage in that span is second-lowest in the NL ahead of only Miami (13-21, .382) and fourth-lowest in MLB.

BALTIMORE SUN: This visit is just the third time SF has come to Baltimore since Interleague play began with the only other prior visits coming in 2004 and 2019...SF is 6-2 in this facility and has won all three series they've played here.

- ▶ **OF Mike Yastrzemski**, who was originally drafted by the Orioles in 14th round in 2013, has gone 7-for-20 in five games played here with a triple, three homers, six RBI, eight runs scored and four walks.
- ▶ Baltimore-native **IF LaMonte Wade Jr.** is playing his first-ever MLB games in this ballpark during this series...he's 3-for-9 with two RBI in this series thus far.

ROAD CHALLENGES: The road has been a challenge for SF in 2024 as they enter today with a 33-41 (.446) road record...the .446 road winning percentage is tied for 20th of 30 MLB clubs and is tied for fourth-lowest in the NL with Pittsburgh.

- ▶ However, SF has won each of its last two road series which have both come against teams currently in playoff position...the Giants took two-of-three from San Diego September 6-8 and have already secured this series win.
- ▶ SF has won four consecutive road games entering play today, the club's second four-game road winning streak this year (also May 22-25 at Pittsburgh and at the Mets).

ON A HEATER: **OF Mike Yastrzemski** led off the game with a homer for a second straight day yesterday...he's the fourth Giant in franchise history, and third in the SF-era (since 1958), to have consecutive games with a leadoff homer...the other three are **Dan Gladden** (Oct 1-2, 1985), **Bobby Bonds** (June 5-6, 1973) and **Whitey Lockman** (July 18-19, 1953) (*Sport Radar*).

- ▶ With yesterday's homer, Yastrzemski has homered in consecutive games for the third time this month (also Sept. 1-3 and Sept. 10-11).
- ▶ Eight of Yastrzemski's 17 homers this year have come in his last 20 games since August 24...he's also homered six times this month.
- ▶ It's the first time Yastrzemski has homered six times in a month since hitting seven homers in July of 2021...his career-best mark for homers in a single month is nine from his rookie campaign in August 2019.
- ▶ Since August 24, Yastrzemski has a .946 OPS with two doubles, eight homers, 14 RBI, 15 runs scored and 10 walks in 20 games.

WEBB SLINGER: **RHP Logan Webb** makes is set to make his 32nd start of the year for SF...it'll be the third straight season that Webb has made at least 32 starts (he made 32 in 2022 and 33 last season).

- ▶ The last Giant to make at least 32 starts in three consecutive seasons prior to Webb was **Madison Bumgarner**, who did so in three straight seasons from 2014-2016.
- ▶ In three starts this month, Webb has a 6.75 ERA (12er, 16.0ip) and has allowed 25 hits with opposing hitters batting .362 off him...SF has gone 1-2 in those games.
- ▶ In his most recent start last Friday against the Padres, Webb lasted only 4.0 innings...it was the first time since May 5 at Philadelphia Webb failed to finish 5.0 innings, snapping a 22-start streak of doing so from May 10-September 7.

WALK THE LINE: **RHP Ryan Walker** notched his eighth save of the year with his scoreless 9th inning last night.

- ▶ Since taking over the closer's role on August 9, Walker has converted all eight of his save opportunities while allowing just one unearned run in 16.0 innings...he's struck out 25 and walked just four in that time while opposing hitters have batted .127 (7-for-55).
- ▶ Since the All-Star break, Walker has allowed two earned runs in 26.0 innings for a 0.69 ERA in 24 games...his 0.69 ERA since the break is third-best among relievers (min. 25.0ip) behind ARI's AJ Puk (0.35) and CLE's Emmanuel Clase (0.35).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN...: Following this afternoon's game the Giants will hop a flight and fly to Kansas City where they open a three-game series with the Royals tomorrow night.

- ▶ It'll be the Giants' first series in KC since they went 1-1 in Kansas City from April 18-19, 2017.
- ▶ The winning pitcher in SF's win in that series on April 18 was **RHP Derek Law**, who was in his second season as a Giant after debuting in 2016...no Giants player that played in that series is currently on the roster...**OF Hunter Pence**, who played both games of that series in right field for SF, is here serving as the color analyst for the Giants on NBC Sports Bay Area.

This Date in Giants History

SEPTEMBER 19, 1998 - The Giants scored seven runs in the 3rd inning, and six more in the 4th, as they demolished the Dodgers by a score of 18-4. **Bill Mueller** and **Jeff Kent** banded grand slams in the two frames, just the second time in Giants history that two players have hit grand slams in a game (April 26, 1970 was the other).

#43 TRISTAN BECK ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Changeup

Last Game: 9/17 at BAL; 1.0ip, 2h, 1k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has made four appearances totalling 9.0 innings for SF since being activated off the 60-day IL on Sept. 1...he's struck out 10 batters in those 9.0 innings.
- ▶ Was on the IL for first 137 games of 2024 undergoing surgery to remove an aneurysm from his upper right arm on March 4 at Stanford Medical Center...the surgery was performed by Dr. Jason Lee.
- ▶ Appeared in 33 games (making three starts) for the Giants last season and logged a 3.92 ERA...entered Spring Training this year with a chance to be a mainstay on SF's Major League roster.

#76 SPENCER BIVENS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Two-Seam FB, Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Sweeper

Last Game: 9/15 vs. SD; 0.2ip, 1h, 1r, 0er (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed 11 runs (nine ER) in his last 10 games (18.0ip) dating to August 17 (4.50 ERA)...had a 1.90 ERA in the 12 games prior.
- ▶ Opponents are just 5-for-31 (.161) off him with RISP.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut on June 16.
- ▶ Went 5-1 with a 2.92 ERA in 27 relief outings for Triple-A Sacramento...struck out 42 in 49.1ip with opponents hitting .231 off him.
- ▶ Began his professional career with the Savigny-sur-Orge Lions in French Division One in 2019 before coming back stateside to pitch for Steel City in Indy Ball in Washington, PA in 2020.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 9/15 vs. SD; L, 1.0ip, 2h, 2r, 1er, 1k (19 pitches)

- ▶ In 11 outings since returning from AAA, Doval has a 7.20 ERA (8er, 10.0ip), 15 strikeouts and seven walks...opponents are 11-for-38 (.289) off him in that time.
- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on August 24...appeared in 5g for the River Cats and allowed two runs on two hits in 5.2ip.
- ▶ Is 22-for-27 in save opportunities w/SF...posted an 8.59 ERA (7er, 7.1ip) and a 1.91 WHIP over last eight ML outings before he was optioned to Triple-A on August 9 (first time in AAA since 2021).
- ▶ Has walked 36 batters in 54.0ip (6.0 BB/9.0) w/SF this year.

#12 JORDAN HICKS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Splitter

Last Game: 9/14 vs. SD; 1.1ip, 4h, 3r, 3er, bb, k (29 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated off the IL last Saturday...missed 18 games with right shoulder inflammation.
- ▶ Is the first Giants pitcher to have both 20 starts and one save in a season since **Tim Lincecum** had 26 starts and a save in 2014.
- ▶ In his nine relief outings w/SF he owns a 4.91 ERA (6er, 11.0ip) with six strikeouts and six walks.
- ▶ As a starter this year w/SF, Hicks was 4-7 with a 4.01 ERA in 20 starts...the Giants went 8-12 in his 20 starts.
- ▶ Has thrown a career-high 109.2 innings this season to date...his previous MLB high was 77.2 in 73 games with the Cardinals in 2018

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Cutter, Changeup, Knuckle Curve

Last Game: 9/18 at BAL; 1.0ip, 1h, 1bb, 1k, 1hb (24 pitches)

- ▶ Owns a 3.26 ERA (11er, 30.1ip) in 23 games since the break.
- ▶ Has walked just 14 batters in 54 outings (77.0ip) this season...his 4.4% walk rate ranks in the top 4% of the league.
- ▶ Batters are just 21x111 (.189) with 44 K's off his knuckle curve.
- ▶ Has a 59.7% ground ball rate this year.
- ▶ Has recorded at least four outs in 29 of his 54 games.
- ▶ At 6'11, he is tied for tallest pitcher in MLB history with Jon Rauch.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 9/18 at BAL; 0.1ip, 2h, 1k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed just two runs (one earned) over his past 12 outings (9.1ip) for a 0.96 ERA...has struck out 16 batters in that stretch and held opponents hitless in seven of the 12 games.
- ▶ His 64.1 innings this year are the most he's thrown in a single season in his pro career, passing his 62.1 innings from 2023 in the minors
- ▶ His 69 appearances are most among NL rookies.
- ▶ Lefties are 14-for-88 (.159) off him and righties are 31-for-142 (.218) with seven home runs (one inside the park) and 19 RBI.
- ▶ His 12.8% walk rate ranks in the bottom 4% of the league.
- ▶ His 30.8% strikeout rate is in the top 8% of the league while his xBA (expected batting average) of .184 is in the top 2%.

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 9/15 vs. SD; 1.0ip, 1k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Has a 3.44 ERA (7er, 18.1ip) in 20 games since the All-Star break...had a 2.15 ERA in 40 games before the break.
- ▶ LHB are 25-for-86 (.291) off him...RHB are 26-for-123 (.211).
- ▶ His 32.2% hard hit rate this season is top 7% of the league.
- ▶ Has stranded 23 of his 30 inherited runners (76.7%) in 2024.

#71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 9/18 at BAL; 1.0ip, 1k (16 pitches)

- ▶ His 74 games pitched this year are tops in the NL and tied for most in the Majors with HOU's Bryan Abreu and OAK's T.J. McFarland.
- ▶ Owns a 1.06 ERA (4er, 34.0ip) in 36 games at home this year...on the road, he is 0-4 with a 4.86 ERA (18er, 33.1ip) with a 1.20 WHIP.
- ▶ Has allowed just four walks (one was intentional) in 67.1 innings pitched...his 1.5 BB% is lowest in MLB (min. 200 BF).
- ▶ Opponents' 85.5 mph avg exit velo off him is fourth-best in MLB.
- ▶ Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (336 games).

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 9/18 at BAL; S, 1.0ip, 1k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Has been serving as the closer for SF since Aug. 9...has converted all eight saves in 13 outings since moving to that role and has struck out 25 of the 59 batters he faced in that stretch (16.0ip, 7h, r, 4bb).
- ▶ Hasn't allowed an earned run in his last 18 games dating to July 30 (20.2ip)...owns a 0.69 ERA (2er, 26.0ip) in 24 games since the break with 34 strikeouts.
- ▶ His 72 appearances are tied for fifth-most in MLB.
- ▶ Has struck out 96 batters over 76.1ip (11.32 K/9.0)...his 32.9% strikeout rate ranks in the top 4% of MLB.
- ▶ Walker's 94 strikeouts as a reliever (he had two in the one game he opened) are the most by a Giants reliever in a single season since **Will Smith** struck out 96 batters in 2019.
