RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Seattle Mariners wrap up a three-game weekend series/homestand this afternoon at Busch Stadium ... After yesterday's wild come-from-behind slugfest defeat, 11-9, the Cardinals have now dropped seven of their last eight to Seattle, including six in a row.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis has dropped three of its last four after winning a season-best five straight ... The Cardinals enter today in 4th place in the National League Central, 3.5 games back of first place Cincinnati ... Today's game is their third of a season-high 17 straight without an off day (April 24-May 10).

SWEEPSTAKES: With a win this afternoon, the Cardinals are looking to avoid their second consecutive series sweep to the Mariners, their first sweep of the season overall, and first at Busch Stadium III since Aug. 15-17, 2025 to the Yankees.

NATIONAL FASTBALL DAY: The Cardinals and Mariners yesterday combined for eight home runs, tying the most in a single game this season (Tigers-4 & Reds-4 on April 24 at Cincinnati), and one shy of the Busch Stadium III record of nine on May 18, 2023 vs. the Dodgers (STL-7, LAD-2) ... Both teams combined for 33 hits, the most in a single MLB game this season and three shy of the stadium record of 36 between St. Louis (26) and Atlanta (10) on Aug. 22, 2008.

DIVISION ON DECK: Following today's game, the Cardinals fly to Pittsburgh for a four-game series with the Pirates for their first divisional game, Game No. 28 on the schedule ... The only other time St. Louis played its first divisional game this late into the season was May 7, 1993 at Philadelphia's Veterans Stadium (also Game No. 28), when the Cardinals were one of seven teams in the National League East Division.

• The Cardinals host the Brewers in Game No. 35 on May 4, tying the 1998 Redbirds for the latest St. Louis has played its first home divisional game ... But as their 19th home game, this sets a franchise record for latest to play their first home divisional game. - *Elias Sports Bureau*

HURTS SO GOOD: St. Louis paces MLB with 22 hit by pitches, highlighted by an Major League-leading eight by Iván Herrera ... Rookie JJ Wetherholt (6) is tied with CJ Abrams (6) and Colson Montgomery (6) for 2nd-most in MLB ... 2014 Jon Jay (20) was the last Cardinal to lead all of Major League Baseball in hit by pitches.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Masyn Winn, who has 11 RBI over his last seven games, is slashing .400/.432/.600 (16-40) with five multi-hit efforts over a 10-game hitting streak, T-3rd longest active in MLB and the 2nd-longest of his career behind an 18-gamer in 2024 ... Iván Herrera is batting .323 (10-31) over his current season-best eight-game hitting streak and riding a 12-game on-base safely streak, the longest active on the team.

BAZOOKAS: Cardinals outfielders have thrown out eight baserunners this season, most in Major League Baseball ... Jordan Walker's four assists lead MLB, while Nathan Church has two, and Thomas Saggese and Victor Scott II each have one.

DOBBINS DOINGS: RHP Hunter Dobbins (right knee surgery) made his 5th injury rehab start with Memphis (AAA) last night at Norfolk (AAA-Orioles), throwing 76 pitches (45 strikes) over 4.0 innings while allowing three runs on four hits with five walks and three strikeouts ... In five rehab starts with Memphis overall, the 26-year-old Dobbins has gone 3-0 with a 4.37 ERA (22.2 IP), 16 strikeouts, and seven walks.

IT IS YOUR BIRTHDAY: Happy 44th birthday to Cardinals pitching coach Dusty Blake ... Other notables born on this date include Aaron Judge (34); actors Kevin James (61) and Jet Li (63); actress Carol Burnett (93), Hall of Famer Hack Wilson (1900-48), former Cardinals pitcher Sal Maglie (1917-92), and wrestler Kane (59).

SEATTLE CONNECTIONS

Riley O'Brien was born in Seattle and resides in Shoreline, WA... graduated from Shorewood (WA) High School...pitched two seasons at Everett (WA) Community College (2014-15)...traded by Cincinnati to the Mariners for Luis Chevalier (April 17, 2022) and pitched in one game for Seattle (May 7, 2022 vs. TB)...2023 PCL Post-Season All-Star for AAA-Tacoma...acquired by the Cardinals from the Mariners for cash considerations (Nov. 5, 2023).

Ramón Urías's younger brother, **Luis Urías**, played in 41 games for the Mariners in 2024.

Ryne Stanek pitched in 46 games for Seattle during the 2024 season before traded to the Mets for OF Rhylan Thomas (July 26, 2024)...originally drafted by Seattle in the 3rd round of the 2010 MLB draft, but did not sign to attend the University of Arkansas.

Brant Brown coached parts of six seasons over two stints in the Mariners organization (2013-17, 24), previously serving as the Mariners Bench Coach/Offensive Coordinator (2024), Offensive Coordinator (2017), and Minor League Outfield Coordinator (2013-16).

Brendan Donovan played four seasons in St. Louis (2022-25), here won the 2022 Rawlings Utility Gold Glove Award and was a 2025 NL All-Star... originally selected by the Cardinals in the 7th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...traded to Seattle as part of the three-team trade with Tampa Bay, with St. Louis receiving SHP Jurrangelo Cijntje, OF Tai Peete, OF Colton Ledbetter, and two Comp. Round B Draft picks, and the Rays receiving INF Ben Williamson from Seattle (Feb. 2, 2026).

Randy Arozarena played in 19 games for St. Louis in 2019 and parts of three minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (2017-19)...originally signed with the Cardinals as an international free agent (Aug. 1, 2016)...traded to Tampa Bay with José Martínez, and Cardinals Compensation draft pick A (INF Alike Williams) in exchange for Matthew Liberatore, Edgardo Rodríguez and Rays Compensation draft pick B (RHP Tink Hance) on Jan. 9, 2020.

Mariners Pitching Strategy Coach **Trent Black** was born in St. Louis...graduated from nearby Columbia (Ill.) High School.

Patrick Wisdom played in 32 games for St. Louis during 2018 debut season...originally selected by the Cardinals in the Supp. 1st round (No. 52) of the 2012 MLB Draft, as compensation for Octavio Dotel signing with Detroit...traded by St. Louis to Texas for **Drew Robinson** (Dec. 11, 2018).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in Seattle in 1995, including all 11 postseason games.

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray** worked for the Seattle Mariners for three seasons (1993-95).

Cardinals Director, Pitching **Matt Pierpont** worked four seasons in Seattle's organization (2021-24), most recently as minor league pitching coordinator.

Mariners broadcaster **Aaron Goldsmith** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Principia College in Elsay, Ill...began broadcast career in 2007 with the nearby Gateway Grizzlies in the independent Frontier League.

Mariners broadcaster **Rick Rizzo** is a 1975 graduate of Southern Illinois Univ. in Carbondale...previously served as a broadcaster for the Memphis Chicks (AA-Expos) from 1978-80.

TODAY'S STARTER:

- The 25-year-old righty is making his 6th start of the 2026 season today, 25th career start (27th career game).
- Is making his 2nd career start vs. Seattle, his 1st meeting with the M's at Busch Stadium.
- Ranks 3rd in NL with a 4.8% walks/batter faced ratio which is 8th best in MLB.
- The Cardinals are 16-8 (.667 win pct.) in his 24 career games started**, losing consecutive games that he has started just once. St. Louis is 3-2 (.600) in his games started this season.
- Since joining the Cardinals rotation last June, the Cardinals have posted 13 wins in his games started - the most among all Cardinals starters.
- Has made 14 career appearances (12 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 6-3 with a 4.06 ERA (71.0 IP).

LAST TIME OUT (Mon., April 20 at Miami): L, 5-3; 5.2 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR; 80 pitches.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

WALKING PNEUMONIA: His 1.65 walks/9 IP ratio ranks 2nd in the NL and his 0.91 WHIP is ranked 6th best in NL.

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has MLB's lowest percent (14.1) of swing & miss; Ranks 4th in the NL among starting pitchers with a .192 BABIP.

THROW IT BACK: Didn't hook any keepers in 5-3 loss at Miami on 4/20, allowing a season-high 4 runs over his 5.2 IP; the loss snapped the Cardinals season-high 5-game win streak.

CURLY W: Limited the Washington Nationals to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on 4/8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS: Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak as a starter (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

JOINING THE LEGENDS: Became the second pitcher in Cardinals history to throw a hitless start in one of the first two starts of the season (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0 or more innings. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) followed with 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

SPRING FLING: Bent 4-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 5 Spring Training starts, striking out 16 to just 2 walks but did allow a team-high 6 HR's; Led MLB with his 4 Spring Training wins and ranked in top 10 in ERA (2.45), Opp. BA (.229) and WHIP (0.98)

McGreevy vs. SEATTLE:

- Making his 2nd career start against the Mariners - his 1st here at Busch Stadium.
- His lone prior appearance against SEA came on 9/10/25 at T-Mobile Park when he limited the Mariners to just one run over 6.0 IP, but he had to settle for a ND in the Cardinals 4-2 loss in 13 innings.
- Is 1-1 with a 2.14 ERA in six career starts vs. American League teams. His lone win came when he defeated Texas in his MLB debut (7/31/24).
- Has worked 5.0 or more IP in five of his six career Interleague starts, three of those being Quality Starts.

THE NOTES WRITE THEMSELVES: Recorded his first career walk-off hit with a two-RBI knock in the 10th inning vs. TB (3/28). Was the first Cardinals rookie with a walk-off since **Lars Nootbaar** (8/25/21) vs. DET also in the 10th inning.

INTERLEAGUE: Has reached base safely in each of his last eight Interleague games since 4/13 vs. CLE, going 10-for-29 (.345) with a 1.129 OPS in that span. Has reached base safely in 15 of his 17 career Interleague contests.
