NATIONALS HISTORY

MAY 13 (11-5)
2018 – Powered by two home runs from the newest Washington National, **Mark Reynolds**, the Washington Nationals completed a four-game sweep of the Arizona Diamondbacks on ESPN's Sunday Night Baseball. Reynolds clubbed a solo home run in the sixth inning and a two-run blast in the top of the eighth.

NATIONALS NEWS

HOMER HEAVEN
The Washington Nationals continue a three-game series with the Cincinnati Reds tonight at Great American Ballpark...The Nationals hit a season-high six home runs last night, en route to a 10-4 win.

- **Luis Garcia Jr.** and **Daylen Lile** both enjoyed two-homer nights...**Brady House** and **James Wood** each joined in with home runs of their own...**Brad Lord** (Win, 2.2 IP, 3 SO) and **Paxton Schultz** (2.0 IP, 3 SO) both offered scoreless relief in the win.
- The Nationals have won four of six, five of eight and nine of 15 games since April 25... They have also won three of their last five series overall and five of the first seven series on the road this year.
- Tonight will be the second of 16 straight games for the Nationals without an off day...Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28.
- Following this series, the Nationals will return home for a three-game series with the Baltimore Orioles, during Major League Baseball's Rivalry Weekend.

GREAT AMERICAN NATIONALS
Since the Nationals began playing at Great American Ball Park in 2005, Washington has homered 108 times in 68 games, including five five-home games as a team...Last night's six-homer effort by the offense was just the 12th in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

- The Nationals average 1.59 home runs per game at Great American Ball Park, the highest average of any team that has played more than 20 games in the stadium...It is the highest average home runs per game of any stadium the Nationals play in on a yearly basis...The Nationals average 1.64 home runs at T-Mobile Park in Seattle (23 HR in 14 games).
- A Nationals hitter has recorded a multi-home run game 197 times since 2005...14 of those have come at Great American Ball Park...Only Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia (15) has seen more multi-homer efforts from a Nationals player...The Nationals have played 68 games at Great American Ball Park...They have played 184 at Citizens Bank Park.

ROAD SWEET ROAD
The Nationals come into today's game with a 14-9 record on the road, tied for the second-highest win total away from home in Major League Baseball, trailing only the Atlanta Braves (16 wins)...Washington has taken at least a share of four of the last five series away from home.

- The Nationals rank second in MLB with 127 runs scored on the road.
- Washington's pitching staff is ninth in MLB (sixth in NL) with a .236 opponents' batting average away from Nationals Park.

OUT OF THIS WORLD
CJ Abrams is 17-for-50 (.340) with three doubles, a triple, two homers, 15 RBI, six walks, two stolen bases and eight runs scored over his last 12 games...He's reached safely in 10 of the 13 (.411 OBP) and has hits in nine of the 13.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (2nd, 36) wRC+ (7th, .400), wOBA (7th, .157) and on-base percentage (8th, .391).
- GOOD WOOD**
James Wood leads Major League Baseball with an average exit velocity of 96.2 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (95.9).
- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
 - Wood's 51 batted balls over 100 MPH rank tied for fourth in Major League Baseball.

PRETTY OFFENSIVE
The Nationals rank second in Major League Baseball (2nd in NL) with 227 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 39 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 84 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 25 times this season, tied for the most in Major League Baseball.
- **Luis Garcia Jr.** is 8-for-14 (.571) with a double, triple, 2 home runs, five RBI and four runs scored over his last three games.
- **Daylen Lile** has hits in five straight games: 8-for-19 (.421), two doubles, two home runs, five RBI, a hit by pitch and two runs scored.

HIGH DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY
Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.4 runs per game more than the league average team...Washington has played 24 games against teams with a record of .500 or better, the most in National League and second-most in Major League Baseball.

- 13 of the Nationals 19 home games have come against teams .500 or better.
- Washington is 11-13 (.458) against teams .500 or better this season and has already played four teams in the top six in wins in Major League Baseball.

FARM REPORT
SO GOOD THIS NOTE BARELY FITZ
Devin Fitz-Gerald homered twice last night, including his MiLB leading fourth leadoff home run...Over his last five games, Fitz-Gerald is hitting .440 (11-for-25) with a double, a triple, five home runs, seven RBI, four walks (.517 OBP) and eight runs scored...He leads the Nationals organizations in home runs (8), slugging (.650), OPS (1.101), triples (3) and runs scored (34).
