DID I SAY THAT LOUD?: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a seven-game road trip over eight days in the Golden State with the second of four games with the San Diego Padres at Petco Park. The Cardinals rallied for a 2-1 win over the Padres last night in front of a sellout crowd of 44,966. The Cardinals have won 8 of their last 10 games and trail only the Cubs (9-1), Phillies (9-1) and Rays (9-1) for best record since April 27.

60 PERCENT OF THE TIME, IT WORKS EVERY TIME: St. Louis enters play today at 22-15 and in 2nd place in the National League Central, 3.5 games behind first place Chicago. The Cardinals have the 4th-best record in the National League with San Diego at 22-15. The 2021 season was the last time the Cardinals posted a winning percentage of 60 percent (.595) or better through 37 games at 22-15.

DON'T ACT LIKE YOU'RE NOT IMPRESSED: The Cardinals enter on a five-game road winning streak after sweeping a four-pack from the Pirates at PNC Park to conclude April and last night. The last time the Cardinals won six straight road games was June 17-29 with a pair of three-game sweeps against the Chicago White Sox (6/17-19) and Cleveland Guardians (6/27-29). **The Cardinals hold the best road record in MLB at 12-5 (.706) this season with two series sweeps and three series wins.**

BOY, THAT ESCALATED QUICKLY: St. Louis won their 11th game in come-from-behind fashion last night. The Cardinals rank 5th in MLB in comeback wins, while Atlanta leads the pack with 14. The 'Birds have also posted the best record in MLB when scoring first at 15-2.

I'M KIND OF A BIG DEAL: Since making his Major League debut on July 31, 2024, tonight's starting pitcher **Michael McGreevy** has posted a 13-6 record with a 1.10 WHIP over 158.0 innings pitched. The .684 winning percentage and WHIP both rank 9th among MLB pitchers over that period. McGreevy was born in San Clemente, Calif., and grew up a Padres fan. He earned a win in his first career game at Petco Park last Aug. 2, 2025, tossing 6.0 innings.

THAT SMELLS LIKE PURE GASOLINE: This weekend's series features two of the top closers in Major League Baseball in the Cardinals' **Riley O'Brien** and the Padres' **Mason Miller**. The two are tied for 1st in saves among National League firemen. O'Brien took first charge with a 10-pitch save last night on "Mason Miller Bobblehead Night." Both boast an explosive pitch arsenal with numerous pitches at 99 MPH or above; Miller posting a league-best 40.7% (99 of 243 pitches) with O'Brien ranking 9th at 22.1% (59 of 267 pitches). O'Brien has not allowed a home run in an MLB active best 59.2 innings.

BUT KEEP GOING...: Cardinals catcher **Iván Herrera** has reached base safely in a career-high 23 straight games, tied for the 3rd-longest active streak in MLB behind **Nick Kurtz** (31, ATH), **Ian Happ** (28, CHI) and tied with **Ronald Acuña, Jr.** (23, ATL). This is the Cardinals longest on-base streak since **Willson Contreras** ran off 27 last season about this time (Apr. 17-May 16). Over the last five years, 12 Cardinals have on-base streaks of 20 or more games with **Paul Goldschmidt's** 46 in 2022, the longest since 2014.

YOU STAY CLASSY, SAN DIEGO: This season, along with all even years, the Cardinals will play road games at all five California locations starting with the Padres tonight. They will travel to Sacramento to play the Athletics (May 12-14), Anaheim for the Angels (July 20-22), Los Angeles for the Dodgers (Sept. 1-3) and San Francisco for the Giants (Sept. 7-9). The Cardinals are 1-0 to being this season and were 9-7 in their California Five road matchups in 2024.

YOU'RE SO WISE: Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** passed **Miller Huggins** (346) into 11th place all-time on the Cardinals managerial list with his 347 wins. The 39-year old Marmol, is the 3rd-longest tenured manager among his National League peers (**Dave Roberts**, LA & **Torey Lovullo**, ARI) and the 2nd-youngest manager in MLB. Standing next in line is Hall of Fame manager **Joe Torre** (1990-95) for 10th all-time with 351.

SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Fernando Tatis, father of Padres outfielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

Cardinals TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played parts of four seasons in San Diego (1997-98, 2002, 2005) and appeared in the 1998 World Series...was a part of the Padres broadcasting team for 12 seasons (2012-23)...resides in San Diego.

Thomas Saggese was born in and resides in Carlsbad, CA...graduated from Carlsbad High School.

Ramón Urías's younger brother, **Luis Urías**, played parts of two seasons in San Diego (2018-19), where he made his MLB debut.

Brant Brown (June 15, 1996 at Wrigley), **Daniel Descalso** (Sept. 18, 2010 at Busch III), **Dustin May** (Aug. 8, 2019 at Dodger Std.), and **Brad Thompson** May 8, 2005 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Padres.

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations **Chaim Bloom** began his baseball career as a Baseball Operations Intern with the San Diego Padres.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 26 games for San Diego in 2008...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for **David Freese** (Dec. 14, 2007).

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)...traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

Yohel Pozo was signed by San Diego as a minor league free agent in Nov. 2020, before the Texas Rangers re-acquired him by selecting him in the Triple-A phase Rule 5 Draft 23 days later.

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach **Mike McCoy** was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002 MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor **Allen Craig** played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for **Woody Williams** (Aug. 2, 2001).

Jon Jay played the 2016 season with San Diego...traded by St. Louis to the Padres for **Jedd Gyorko** and cash (Dec. 8, 2015).

Padres Coach **Peter Summerville's** brother, **Andrew**, was drafted by St. Louis in the 12th round in 2017...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Coach **Nick Punto** played 63 games for St. Louis in 2011 and was a member of the 2011 World Series Champions.

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** played 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with **Nate Tebb**s from the Padres for **Heathcliff Slocumb** and current Memphis (AAA) manager **Ben Johnson**.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- The 25-year-old San Clemente native is making his 8th start of the 2026 season tonight, 27th career start (29th career game).
- It's his 3rd career meeting against the Padres and his 2nd at PETCO Park; Is 1-1 in his two previous starts vs. Friars despite a 9.28 ERA.
- Since his Major League debut July 31, 2024, ranks 9th in MLB in winning percentage (.684, 13-6) and WHIP (1.10).
- HOW THE WEST WAS WON:** Has a 4-0 mark, and the Cardinals are 5-0 in his five career road starts vs. NL West teams; 2-0 at Coors Field, 2-0 at Oracle Park, 1-0 at PETCO Park.
- The Cardinals are 17-9 (.654 win pct.) in his 26 career games started**, losing consecutive games that he has started just twice. St. Louis is 4-3 (.571) in his games started this season.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 16 of 26 career starts.
- Allowed two runs or fewer in five of seven starts this season.
- Since joining the Cardinals rotation last June, the Cardinals have posted 14 wins in his games started - the most among all Cardinals starters.
- Has made 15 career appearances (13 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 6-3 with a 3.58 ERA (83.0 IP). Boasts a 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP) in four starts at home this season.

LAST TIME OUT (May 2 vs. LA Dodgers): W, 3-2; 6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 3 SO, 0 HR; 88 pitches

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has the NL's 3rd lowest percent (17.1) of swing & miss; Ranks 4th in the NL among starting pitchers with a .209 BABIP and his difference in Opp. BA (.201) vs. xBA (.288) is the largest among all MLB starting pitchers.

DODGE BALL: Blanked the Dodgers on 3 hits over 6.0 IP in a 3-2 win last Sat. (5/2) as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.

THROW IT BACK: Didn't hook any keepers in 5-3 loss at Miami on 4/20, allowing a season-high 4 runs over his 5.2 IP; the loss snapped the Cardinals season-high 5-game win streak.

CURLY W: Limited the Washington Nationals to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on 4/8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS: Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak as a starter (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

RARE BIRD: In his season debut on 3/28 vs. TB, became the second pitcher in Cardinals history to throw a hitless start in one of the first two starts of the season (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0 or more innings. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) followed with 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

SPRING FLING: Went 4-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 5 Spring Training starts, striking out 16 to just 2 walks but did allow a team-high 6 HR's; Led MLB with his 4 Spring Training wins and ranked in top 10 in ERA (2.45), Opp. BA (.229) and WHIP (0.98)

McGREEVY vs. SAN DIEGO:

- Is making his third career start vs. the Padres after making consecutive starts vs. the Padres on 7/27 at STL and 8/2 at SD last season.
- It's his 2nd career start at PETCO Park, posting an 8-5 win here on 8/2/25 with 6.0 IP that were backed up by a HR & 3 RBI from Pedro Pages & 3 hits from Ivan Herrera.
- Surrendered a career-high seven runs on nine hits and two walks in his 7/27/25 start at Busch Stadium.
- Has 10 career starts vs. N.L. West opponents in his career going 5-3 with a 5.31 ERA over 57.2 innings with 33 strikeouts and 11 walks; the Cardinals have posted wins in each of his 5 career road games vs. NL West teams (at COL-2, at SF-2, at SD-1).
- San Clemente native remains an avid fan of the NFL's former San Diego, now Los Angeles, Chargers.
