New York & Kalamazoo Jeter's Leaders Come Together to Help **Hurricane Sandy Survivors**

On October 29, 2012, Hurricane Sandy hit New York. Many people were left with little hope; their homes were destroyed or flooded, and personal belongings damaged or unrecoverable. This hurricane affected Americans including the Jeter's Leaders. The Jeter's Leaders from New York City and West Michigan worked together to host a drive for the people that were significantly impacted by Hurricane Sandy.

With great support from their communities and the Turn 2 Staff, the Leaders collected clothing, shoes, personal products and canned foods. The Jeter's Leaders donated the supplies to the Young Women's Christian Association (YWCA) of New York, whose mission is to eliminate racism and empower women. Kristina, a junior in the New York Jeter's Leaders Program, said during a recent visit to the Turn 2 Office "I am happy Kalamazoo was able to get involved and that we have a lot of options for the people receiving these items during this devastating time." As time passes, the Leaders hope to extend more support for Sandy survivors and restoration efforts.





nthony Hamilton's voice just keeps getting better with time. The Grammy Award winner's arresting voice—a favorite staple on the scene since 2003 recently hailed at No. 1 for 4 weeks on Billboard's Urban Adult Contemporary chart with his soul-stirring single, "Pray For Me". The Babyface-produced track is the second single from his fourth studio album, Back to Love. Hamilton's "Pray For Me" and his Back To Love album are both nominated for Grammy Awards (Best R&B Song/Best R&B Album).

Back To Love is the follow-up to his 2008 gold-certified, No. 1-debuting album, The Point of It All (So So Def/Zomba Label Group). The album marks his first album with the newly restructured RCA Records—and signals the eagerly anticipated next chapter in the multi-talented singer/songwriter's evolving career.

Leading up to Back To Love's release, Hamilton provided the perfect accompaniment to Jill Scott's earthy vocals on the captivating duet "So in Love." Their dynamic pairing also set a record: 18 weeks at No. 1 on Billboard's Urban Adult Contemporary chart, tying with Maxwell for the most consecutive weeks atop the tally. The single, in turn, helped propel Scott's album, The Light of the Sun, to a No. 1 debut on the Billboard 200 and Top R&B/Hip-Hop Albums!!

Fans began paying attention to Hamilton in 2002, when he sang the infectious hook on the Nappy Roots' "Po' Folks." That performance netted the singer the first of 12 Grammy nominations for best rap/sung collaboration. After signing with So So Def, Hamilton scored a platinum debut with Coming From Where I'm From in 2003, featuring the chart-topping hit "Charlene." Two years later, he returned with gold-certified sophomore set Ain't Nobody Worryin', which spun off the No.1 hit "Can't Let Go." Then in 2008 came The Point of It All, which elicited USA Today's declaration that Hamilton is "one of the genre's rare singers." Hamilton won his first Grammy Award in 2009 for his collaboration on Al Green's "You Got the Love I Need."

Among the Hamilton-described "firecrackers and life-reflecting songs" comprising Back to Love are the OutKast-influenced "Sucka For You" and "Best of Me" - both invigorating examples of the singer's rejuvenation. His reflective nature is embraced on "Never Let Go," a duet with singer/songwriter Keri Hilson and "Life Has a Way," originally written for the movie "Pursuit of Happyness." While "Pray for Me's" emotional lyrics about a lost love ("Dear God/If you're listening now/I need you to do a thing for me ... I need you to bring her back to me") and gospel-influenced melody are signature Hamilton.

Overall, Back to Love showcases Hamilton's distinctive, multifaceted voice. "There are different tones in my voice that people have fallen in love with; I can sing hard or real soft," says the singer. "I pay attention to that."

Singing in church since he was 10 years old, Hamilton's natural talent— rich, soul-steeped vocals breathing sonorous life into emotion-packed lyrics—has earned him a reputation as an "artist's artist." He counts guest stints on a diverse roster of projects from Dr. Dre and Young Jeezy to Keyshia Cole, Josh Turner, Santana and John Rich (Big & Rich). Between his own album sales and collaborations, Hamilton has sold more than 20 million albums.

Hamilton's 18-city national headlining Back To Love Tour with special guest Estelle, kicked off September 2012. Says Hamilton, "the immense reception to the tour, "So in Love"—and now "Pray For Me"—shows that "R&B is about to be the new mainstream. Real music is coming back." And who better to deliver that message than Anthony Hamilton?

arold Reynolds exemplifies success on and off the field. During his 12-year career as a Major League Baseball player, Harold spent 10 seasons with the Seattle Mariners and a year each with the Baltimore Orioles and Los Angeles Angels. As a Mariner, Harold was a two-time American League All-Star, a three-time Gold Glove second baseman and led the American League in steals in 1987. He is currently among the Mariners' career leaders in 10 offensive categories.

Off the field, Harold is an Emmy Award winning broadcaster who has covered every aspect of baseball from Little League to the pros since 1996. He is the lead studio analyst for MLB Network, providing nightly commentary on all Major League games and coverage for special events such as the Major League Draft, the All-Star Game and World Series. He has interviewed numerous baseball greats, including Derek Jeter, Ryan Howard, Chipper Jones, Torii Hunter, Don Mattingly, Hall of Famers Tom Seaver, Rickey Henderson and Cal Ripken, and noted baseball fan, President Bill Clinton. Harold's broadcast experience also includes work for ESPN, SNY and MLB.com. During his broadcasting career, Harold has consistently rated as one of the most popular personalities in sports television.

Harold is also a noted humanitarian. For his dedication to community service and his commitment to improving the lives of youth, Harold was honored as President George Bush Sr.'s 195th Point of Light, becoming the first athlete to receive such high recognition. In addition, Harold is the recipient of the Roberto Clemente Award and the Martin Luther King, Jr. Humanitarian Award. Over the years, Harold has also worked extensively with numerous community groups and organizations, most notably the Boys & Girls Clubs of America, which recognized Harold's contributions by inducting him into its Alumni Hall of Fame in 2004.

he New York and Kalamazoo Jeter's Leaders traveled to Washington, D.C. for their biannual service project July 22-28, 2012. During their time in Washington, the Jeter's Leaders were determined to leave a lasting impression on the community and aimed to take the ideals and fundamentals of the nation's capital back home with them.

The trip began with a visit to Capitol Hill, where the Jeter's Leaders learned about the rich history of America's struggle to form a democratic government that represents such a diverse nation. They toured the halls of Congress and learned about Statuary Hall, the Rotunda and Crypt.

College preparation is a major component of the Leadership Program. The Jeter's Leaders visited Howard University, a federally chartered, private, coeducational, nonsectarian, Historically Black University. They also visited the United States

Naval Academy in Annapolis, MD, where they learned about the evolution of the Navy and its impact on the history of the United States.

The National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism, part of the National Institutes of Health (NIH), hosted the Leaders to share its latest research findings on the causes, consequences, prevention and treatment of alcohol abuse, alcoholism and alcohol problems among teens. The students participated in the interactive Drunken Brain exhibit, exploring specimens from the world's largest brain collection and taking part in hands-on activities in NIAAA laboratories. They also toured the NIH Clinical Research Center and had a question-and-answer session with scientists about alcohol and adolescence. The Leaders chatted with a bilingual researcher about the importance of getting minorities involved in health research, both as investigators and as volunteers in clinical studies.

The Jeter's Leaders have been making annual site visits to NIAAA since 2002.

"It is extremely important that our Jeter's Leaders are properly educated about the negative impact of alcohol abuse and alcoholism," said Turn 2 Foundation Founder, Derek Jeter. Derek added, "The NIAAA and Turn 2 Foundation collaboration offers our Leaders the opportunity to learn about the unhealthy effects of alcohol and strategies to educate their peers and younger students."

Another major initiative of the Jeter's Leaders program is community service and social activism. In collaboration with HandsOn Greater DC Cares, the Leaders lent their time and services to The Arts and Technology Academy, a public charter school in Washington's seventh ward. Over two days, the Leaders helped to beautify the school's garden, provided mentoring services to the student population, assisted in clerical work and provided necessary building support.

Following the project's completion, the Jeter's Leaders were recognized by the Dean of Students and staff from The Arts and Technology Academy and HandsOn Greater DC staff during a closing ceremony in the auditorium. Turn 2 Foundation President, Sharlee Jeter, presented the school with a \$10,000 donation on behalf of Derek and the Jeter's Leaders.

On their last day in Washington, the Jeter's Leaders went to the Eisenhower Executive Office Building to hear from a panel of President Obama's key staff members. They presented Michael Strautmanis, Deputy Assistant to the President, with a signed Jeter's Leaders jersey for President Obama. Strautmanis shared professional guidance with the group and urged the high school students to continue to work hard in school and in their communities. Kyle Lierman from the Office of Public Engagement spoke to the Lead-

ers about his job as White House Liaison to the Sports Community and Ronnie Cho, Associate Director of the Office of Public Engagement talked about his role as White House Liaison to Young Americans. The discussion offered the Jeter's Leaders an opportunity to gain insight into a variety of careers that are directly related to their social change efforts. Following a discussion with the President's staff, the Leaders were escorted to the White House to explore the



legendary residence that has hosted dignitaries, diplomats and world leaders.

The Jeter's Leaders visited the Smithsonian's National Museum of African Art (NMAfA) later that day. They were welcomed with an inspirational address by Director of the museum, Dr. Johnnetta B. Cole. The NMAfA fosters the discovery and appreciation of the visual arts of Africa and humanity. The Turn 2 Foundation donated \$10,000 to Studio Africa, an NMAfA program with the goal of connecting Washington, D.C. public school children to African art and culture.

To cap off the week, Charles C. Stephenson, Jr., co-author of "The Beat: Go-Go's Fusion of Funk and Hip Hop", was invited to give a brief introduction to go-go, a genre of music that originated in Washington and blends the styles of funk, R&B and hip-hop to create a unique and distinct sound. Following Mr. Stephenson's remarks, the popular female go-go band, Be'la Dona, took the stage providing an exciting night of live entertainment as the Leaders had a chance to unwind, enjoy ice cream and show off their dance moves.



New York City After School Programs


