YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Rays, 7-1, setting up a rubber match in today's series finale.. Failed to move to 23 games over .500 for the first time since the end of play on July 9...Have allowed four total runs across their four wins this month compared to 15 in their two losses...**Cedric Mullins** launched his 15th home run of the season, a solo shot in the sixth inning...Mullins has homered twice in his last five games and reached safely in his last nine games since August 29, slashing .385/.529/.654

WHAT'S TRENDING: The 0's have won five of their last eight games since August 30 after going 7-10 from August 11-29...The Orioles trail the Yankees (.577, 82-60) by a half game in the AL East...Baltimore is 24-23 (.511) since the All-Star break and 29-30 (.492) in the last 59 games since July 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 183-122 (.600), the second-best winning percentage in MLB behind the Dodgers (.609, 185-119) during that time.

- HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are second in MLB with 211 home runs behind the Yankees (213)...The Dodgers rank third with 193...The O's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and for the first time since 2019 (213)...Baltimore is averaging 1.48 homers per game this season, which would be the third-best mark in team history behind 1996 (1.58) and 2016 (1.56).

 ① Baltimore has an MLB-best nine players with at least 10 home runs: Anthony Santander (39), Gunnar Henderson (36), Colton Cowser (20), Adley Rutschman and Jordan Westburg (18), Cedric Mullins (15), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (13), and Ramón Urias (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.
 ② Henderson and Santander are one of three duos with at least 30 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (51) and Juan Soto (38) and New York-NL's Pete Alonso (31) and Francisco Lindor (30); Baltimore did not have a player reach 30 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2021 that the team has had multiple players with 30+ home runs (Mountcastle, 33 & Mullins, 30).

 ③ The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and tied with the Phillies for the most in MLB; Gunnar Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one year by an Oriole behind Brady Anderson, who hit all 12 in 1996; Colton Cowser (2) and Jordan Westburg (1) have the other three for the 0's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson scored three times on Tuesday to register his 10th such game this season, tied for the most in MLB with Cincinnati's Elly De La Cruz...His 17 games of at least three runs scored since the start of 2023 are the most in MLB, five more than Cincinnati's De La Cruz during that time...He since the start of 2023 are the most in MLB, five more than Cincinnati's De La Cruz during that time...He ranks fourth in the AL and fifth in MLB with 108 runs scored, the most by an Oriole since Jonathan Villar (111) in 2019...Henderson is the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining with Manny Machado (2, 2015-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Brian Roberts (3, 2007-09), Brady Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Cal Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

① He hit his 35th home run of the season on Wednesday, surpassing Ripken, Jr. (1991) and Miguel Tejada (2004) for the most by an O's shortstop in a single season in team history.

② Henderson ranks fifth in MLB with 7.1 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. in 1991 (10.6); eight Orioles (13 occurences) have reached at least 7.0 fWAR in a season.

③ He's also among AL leaders in walks (3rd, 70), home runs (4^{rh}, 365), total bases (5th, 301), hits (T-6th, 156), extra-base hits (T-6th, 67), on-base percentage (7th, .365), OPS (8th, .903), and slugging percentage (8th, .538).

④ He's on pace to score 123 times; Roberto Alomar is the only player in team history (since 1954)

- he's on pace to score 123 times; **Roberto Alomar** is the only player in team history (since 1954) with more than 122 runs scored in a season, when he set the club record with 132 runs in 1996. Three players in team history have led the AL in runs scored: Hall of Famer and Orioles legend **Frank Robinson** in 1966 (122), Ripken, Jr. in 1983 (121), and **Don Buford** in 1971 (99).

MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander leads MLB switch-hitters with a career-high 39 home runs, the most by an 0's switch-hitter in team history...Ken Singleton held the previous record when he hit 35 in 1979...The last MLB switch-hitter with 39 homers in a season was Cleveland's José Ramírez in 2018... Only seven switch-hitters (11 occurrences) in MLB history have hit at least 40 home runs in a season: New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2, 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4, 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

② Santander has hit 30 home runs since the start of June, trailing Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (31) for the most in MLB during that time; his 39 home runs rank third in MLB behind Ohtani (45) and Judge (51).

③ His 100 home runs since the start of 2022 are tied for the sixth most in MLB during that time and for second most in the AL with Houston's Yordan Alvarez, behind only Judge (150).

﴿ He's the ninth player in 0's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining Manny Machado (3, 2015-17), Chris Davis (4, 2012-13, 15-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Rafael Palmeiro (4, 1995-98), Hall of Famer and Orioles legend Eddie Murray (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), Orioles Hall of Famer Boog Powell (4, 1964, 68, 69-70), Hall of Famer and Orioles legend Frank Robinson (3, 1966-67, 69), and Orioles Hall of Famer Jim Gentile (2, 1961-62).

HOME SWEET HOME: Baltimore concludes a six-game homestand today with the last of three games against the Rays...The 0's went 2-1 against the White Sox to open the homestand before welcoming in the Rays...The 0's are 13-15 (.464) at Camden Yards since the beginning of July...Since the start of 2023, the Orioles have an AL-best 91-64 (.587) record at home.

RAYS UP: The Orioles and Rays finish their season series today with the finale of a three-game set at e Park...Baltimore has gone 9-3 (.750) against Tampa Bay so far this season, including 6-1 at the ...The Birds won two of three at Oriole Park from May 31 to June 2 in their first series against the at home this year...The 0's have clinched the best winning percentage in one year against the Rays

The Birds have hit 21 homers in 12 games against Tampa Bay this year; the 1.75 home runs per game would be the second-highest mark in team history against the Rays in one season just behind the 1.79 home runs per game produced by the 2018 0's.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 29th start of the season this afternoon against the Rays...Started for the AL in the 2024 All-Star Game in Arlington, becoming the fifth 0's pitcher to start a Midsummer Classic...Placed on the Pafernity List on June 28 for the birth of his twin daughters, Charlotte and Harper...The 0's are 18-10 in his starts this year...Has allowed a career-high 38 stolen bases this season, most in MLB, and the most by an Orioles pitcher in team history...A four-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draff out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Set a career high with his 13th win on September 2 vs. Chicago-AL, allowing two runs (1 ER) on six hits and a walk with four strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Had lost his last three starts for the first time in his career...Both runs scored in the first inning...Threw 89 pitches and a season-low 53 strikes.

AGAINST THE RAYS: Scheduled to make his third start of his career and the season against Tampa Bay...Is 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP) with nine hits (1 HR), five total runs, two walks, and 11 strikeouts...Both of his previous starts against the club came at Tropicana Field...Last faced the Rays on August 10 and did not factor in the decision after surrendering three runs on four hits and a walk with five strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Allowed the first hit on a one-out single in the fifth inning to Josh Lowe; all three runs and four hits came in the fifth...Has failed to complete 6.0 innings in four consecutive starts, the longest such streak of his career as a starter...Threw 98 pitches, 57 strikes.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Will be making his 15th career appearance, all starts, against the division...Has gone 7-2 with a 2.24 ERA (23 ER/92.11P) and a .176 opponent batting average in those games...Ten of those starts have been in 2024, while going 5-2 with a 2.86 ERA (18 ER/56.2 IP) and a .203 opponent average...Last pitched against an AL East foe on August 16 vs. Boston, when he suffered the loss after allowing career highs in hits (10) and runs (8) in a season-low 4.0 innings; also surrendered a season-high-tying two home runs and three walks with seven strikeouts.

STEAL MY SUNSHINE: Burnes has allowed a career-high 38 stolen bases, the most in MLB this season and the most by an Oriole in team history...It's the most by a major leaguer since New York-NL's Noah Syndergaard (42) in 2019; Syndergaard also surrendered 48 in 2016...Since 1901, the highest total is 60 by New York-NL's Dwight Gooden in 1990.

HIGH QUALITY: Burnes has tallied 19 quality starts this season, tied for his second most in a season in his career with 2023, trailing 2022 (21)...His 19 quality outings are tied for fifth in MLB, while his 77 quality starts since the start of 2021 are two behind Philadelphia's Zack Wheeler for the most in MLB...His 19 this season are the most by an Orioles hurler since Dylan Bundy in 2017 (also 19); no 0's pitcher has thrown 20 since Wei-Yin Chen in 2015; Chris Tillman is the last Oriole with more than 20, tossing 21 in both 2013 and 2014...Burnes tossed a career-high 10 consecutive quality starts from April 26 to June 16, the longest such streak by an Oriole since Jeremy Guthrie in 2007 (10, 5/8-6/26).

SUPPORT SYSTEM: Burnes has received 123 runs of support this season, the second most in MLB behind Detroit's Tarik Skubal (126)...His 6.54 run support average is the best mark among qualified pitchers in MLB this year...Since it was first tracked in 1974, Burnes' 6.54 RS/9 would be the sixth-highest mark by an Oriole and the best since Pat Rapp (7.14) in 2000.

STREAK SNAPPER: His start on August 4 at Cleveland snapped a streak of 17 straight games going at least 6.0 innings, the longest such run in MLB since 2022...Marked the longest such stretch by an 0's pitcher since Mike Mussina's 19-gamer from June 17 to September 22, 1998...He did not allow more than four earned runs during that time; the 17-game run of at least 6.0 innings and no more than four earned runs was the longest stretch in 0's history.

RING 'EM UP: Burnes' 831 strikeouts since the start of 2021 are behind only Dylan Cease (872) during that time...He has 154 strikeouts this year after striking out at least 200 in his previous three years with Milwaukee...His 8.19 strikeouts per nine innings and 22.3 percent strikeout rate this season are both career lows.

<u>INNINGS EATER:</u> The 732.0 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 are tied third in MLB with Philadelphia's Zack Wheeler, behind Philadelphia's Aaron Nola (756.1) and San Francisco's Logan Webb (746.1).

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Selected to his fourth consecutive All-Star Game and made his first start...Became the fifth Orioles pitcher to start the Midsummer Classic, joining Steve Stone (1980), Jim Palmer (1978, 1977, 1972, 1970), Milt Pappas (1965), and Jerry Walker (1959)...Pitched a scoreless first inning, allowing a walk to Los Angeles-NLTs Shohei Ohtani and a double to Philadelphia's Bryce Harper; left both runners stranded in scoring position...Caught by Adley Rutschman, the first all-Oriole starting battery in an All-Star Game.
