RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Mets (1-0, 2 to play), White Sox (3 to play) and Yankees (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field... despite last night's 10-8 victory over the Mets, the Rays have still lost two of three, five of seven, eight of 11 and 12 of their last 19 games since an 8-6 start...they are a season-high-tying 6.5 GB in the AL East standings for the second straight day, but have entered a fourth-place tie with the Blue Jays, escaping sole possession of fifth for the first time since entering play on April 28 tied for fourth at 13-15.

The Rays erupted for a season-high 10 runs yesterday, exceeding their run output from their previous four games (6)...they recovered from an early 3-0 deficit, securing their third win after trailing by 3+ runs, joining a three-run comeback on April 16 vs. LAA (7-6) and a five-run rally on April 6 at COL (8-6).

Tampa Bay went 7-for-12 (.583) with runners in scoring position on the heels of a 1-for-21 (.048) skid in their previous four contests...it marked their most hits in scoring situations since Aug. 22, 2023 vs. COL (7-for-19).

Each of the Rays last six victories have come by two runs or fewer, their longest such streak since July 15-30, 2019 (6G)...their last longer streak was an eight-game run from June 3-14, 2015.

The Rays 11 wins by two or fewer tallies are tied with the Brewers for second most in MLB behind the Yankees (13)...their .647 (11-6) winning pct. in such contests ranks fourth behind the Phillies (10-2/.833), Nationals and Orioles (both 10-5/.667). With a win tonight, the Rays would claim back-to-back wins for the first time since winning three straight from April 9-12...they would also secure their first series victory since April 12-14 vs. SF, snapping a five-series winless skid (0-4-1).

CASH MONEY—Last night's victory was the 754th of Kevin Cash's career, tying his predecessor, Joe Maddon, as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader...he can claim sole possession of the title with another win tonight...in the midst of his 10th season at the helm, Cash is the longest-tenured skipper in the majors with his current club, ahead of LAD Dave Roberts and SEA Scott Servais, both of whom are in their eighth seasons...in 2023, Cash was named an AL Manager of the Year finalist by the BBWAA for the fifth time in six years, receiving 13 second-place and 13 third-place votes.

Cash's 754 career wins are sixth most among active managers, trailing TEX Bruce Bochy (2,110), SF Bob Melvin (1,532), COL Bud Black (1,133), DET A.J. Hinch (809) and Roberts (774)...his .543 career winning pct. ranks fifth.

Last season, at 45 years old, Cash became the youngest manager in MLB history to reach the postseason in five consecutive seasons, ahead of Roberts, who was 48 when he clinched his fifth straight postseason berth with the Dodgers in 2020.

HEEEERE'S JONNY!—After being reinstated from the 10-day IL yesterday afternoon, Jonny DeLuca went 1-for-4 with a career-high-tying 3 RBI (also July 22, 2023 at TEX) and 1 SB in his first game as a Ray...he became the ninth player to record 3+ RBI in his Rays debut...DeLuca is the only member of that group to also record a stolen base.

Along with Alex Jackson (0-for-3, RBI), the contest marked the fourth game in Rays history in which a pair of players making their team debuts recorded RBI... the previous instances involved Jonathan Aranda/Luke Raley (June 24, 2022 vs. PIT), Jason Bartlett/Eric Hinske (March 31, 2008 at BAL) and José Cruz/Tino Martinez (March 30, 2004 vs. NYY)....this does not include Tampa Bay's inaugural contest.

PLAYING SPOILER—The Rays will be opposed by RHP Christian Scott, who is making his major league debut in tonight's contest...Scott, who hails from Coconut Creek, FL, and is a University of Florida alum, will be the 44th pitcher to make his major league debut starting against the Rays...Tampa Bay is 22-21 in the previous 43 contests, including three straight wins and victories in nine of the last 10 such games dating back to July 1, 2019...notable debuts in that timeframe include BOS Brayan Bello (July 7, 2022) and SEA George Kirby (May 8, 2022)...one starting pitcher made his MLB debut opposite the Rays in 2023: CIN Levi Stoudt on April 19 at Great American Ball Park.

Rookie debutants have gone 0-4 with an 11.63 ERA (24.0IP, 31ER) in their last seven starts against the Rays dating to Aug. 13, 2020 at BOS...Kirby (6.0IP, OR) was the only starter in that timeframe that did not allow 4+ runs.

OPENING BLAZE, MIDDLE DAZE—The Rays -41 run differential is fourth lowest in the majors, better than only the Marlins (-61), Rockies (-74) and White Sox (-87)...they have outscored opponents, 46-35 (+11), in innings 1-3, tied for 11th best in the majors, and have a -1 (41-42) run differential from the 8th inning on...however, they have been outscored by 51 runs (94-43) in innings 4-7—only the Marlins (-60) have recorded a lower mark.

SLOW AND STEADY—Over their last four games, 25 of the Rays 29 hits (86.2%) have been singles...the Rays and Athletics are the only clubs that have yet to record more than 5 XBH in a game this season...the 33-game drought without a 6+ XBH performance is the second-longest season-opening streak in club history behind 2008 (43G) and their longest at any point in a season since May 13–June 23, 2018 (39G)...only 26.4 pct. of the Rays hits have gone for extra bases, the lowest mark in the majors...they sit near the bottom of MLB in home runs (25th, 27), slugging pct. (25th, .357) and extra-base hits (T26th, 71), but rank highly in infield hits (2nd, 44), singles (4th, 198) and total hits (12th, 269).

The Rays 33 SB are tied with the Guardians and Royals for the AL lead and are tied for fifth most in the majors...however, Tampa Bay baserunners have gone 2-for-6 (33.3%) on SB attempts in their last four games and 8-for-15 (53.5%) in their previous 10...the Mets (43) and Rays (35) have allowed more stolen bases than any other clubs in the majors.

**MEET THE METS**—The Rays and Mets meet for their 12th all-time series, including the sixth at Tropicana Field...the Rays are 6-4-0 in series play against the Mets (3-2-0 at home), winning four of the last five sets dating back to 2015...the Rays swept the Mets in three games the last time the clubs met in this venue from May 14-16, 2021...they have won a club-record six consecutive home games over the New York dating back to Aug. 8, 2015... overall, the Rays have won six of eight, nine of 12, and 11 of the last 15 matchups.

REHAB UPDATES—RHP Taj Bradley (right pectoral strain) turned in 6.0 frames of one-run ball in his second rehab start with Triple-A Durham last night at Gwinnett (6.0IP, 2H, ER, 2BB, 8SO, HR)...Bradley has pitched to a 0.82 ERA (11.0IP, 1ER) over two rehab outings with the Bulls...RHP Shane Baz (recovery from Tommy John surgery) is scheduled to

with the Bulls...RHP Shane Baz (recovery from Tommy John surgery) is scheduled to pitch four innings with Durham tonight.

OF Josh Lowe (right oblique strain, right hamstring tightness) and INF Jonathan Aranda (right fourth finger fracture) are both in the midst of rehab assignments with Durham...RHP Pete Fairbanks (nerve-related issue) and INF Brandon Lowe (right oblique strain) are scheduled to begin rehab assignments with the Bulls on May 7.

LHP Colin Poche (mid-back tightness) is scheduled to throw a side session at Tropicana Field on May 6.

**TONIGHT'S START**—The right-hander makes his seventh start of the season, including his fourth at home...is seeking his first victory since his season debut on March 30 vs. TOR, taking three no-decisions and two losses since that outing.

LAST TIME OUT—Suffered his second defeat of the season on April 28 at Chicago-AL...worked 6.0 innings, allowing two runs on eight hits with no walks and six strikeouts.

- Was scoreless through 3.0 innings...retired Tommy Pham to open the 4th inning, but allowed consecutive singles to Gavin Sheets and Eloy Jiménez...fanned Andrew Benintendi for the second out of the inning before Robbie Grossman and Danny Mendick registered back-to-back RBI-singles.
- Finished the outing with scoreless 5th and 6th frames

MR. MET-Littell has made six career relief appearances opposite New York, going 0-1 with a 1.29 ERA (7.0IP, 1ER)...in two appearances last season, both coming at Citi Field, he went 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (2.0IP, 1ER).

In 27 appearances (1GS) against NL East opponents, he is 3-1 with a 4.50 ERA (2.0IP, 1ER).

a 3.86 ERA (35.0IP, 15ER)...in his lone start, he was utilized as an opener in front of bulk reliever **Yonny Chirinos** on July 5, 2023 vs. Philadelphia...Littell allowed two runs on four hits with two strikeouts across 2.0 innings.

TAKING SOME HITS—Over his last three starts, Littell has gone 0-2 with a 5.09 ERA (17.2IP, 10ER) while allowing 25 hits.

- He is the first Ray to allow 8+ hits in three straight starts since Michael Wacha (4GS) from Aug. 2-20, 2021.

  He joins WSH Patrick Corbin, COL Ryan Feltner and CHC Kyle Hendricks as the only pitchers this season to allow 8+ hits in three consecutive starts.
- He has allowed 40 hits overall, T6th most among AL hurlers
- Despite the high hit total, Littell has worked at least 5.2 innings in each of the three starts, including two straight 6.0-inning outings.

PINPOINT PRECISION-After issuing three walks in the 1st inning of his April 10 start at Los Angeles-AL, Littell has gone 21.0 straight innings without issuing a free pass spanning 95 BF.

His 3.55 pct. walk rate is sixth lowest in the majors behind teammate

- Zach Eflin (2.34%), SEA George Kirby (2.56%), CHC Shota Imanaga (3.03%), DET Jack Flaherty (3.40%) and PHI Ranger Suárez (3.47%).
- Littell's 69.4 pct. strike rate since the beginning of last season ranks fourth in the majors (min. 1,250 pitches thrown) behind Kirby (70.9%), DET Tarik Skubal (69.5%) and SF Tyler Rogers (69.5%)

DAY 'N' NITE—In two nighttime starts this season, Littell is 0-1 with a 6.17 ERA (11.2IP, 8ER) with a .327 (17-for-52) opponent average...in four daytime starts, he is 1-1 with a 1.69 ERA (21.2IP, 4ER) while limiting the opposition

to a .277 (23-for-83) clip...all 3 HR he has surrendered have come at night.

Min. 4 GS, his 1.69 daytime ERA is fourth lowest in MLB behind K Cole Ragans (1.16), SF Jordan Hicks (1.17) and MIL Colin Rea (1.63).

A LITTLE HELP?—Littell has received three runs of support or less in five of six starts, including one run or fewer in three straight starts.

**SLIDE PIECE**—Littell's most effective pitch through six starts has been his slider...opponents are 9-for-48 (.188) with 1 XBH and 12 SO against the pitch, including 3-for-20 (.150) with 10 SO against left-handed hitters... opponents are 31-for-87 (.356) against his other four pitches.

ODDS AND ENDS—Opposing leadoff hitters are 2-for-17 (.118) against him, but the 2-4 spots are batting 16-for-48 (.333) with 5 of the 10 total XBH he has allowed...opponents are 16-for-50 (.320) the first time through the order and 14-for-53 (.264) the second time...when his pitch count sits between 1-15, opponents are 8-for-21 (.381) with 3 2B and 2 HR...from pitches 16-45, opponents are 9-for-39 (.231) with zero extra-base hits...from pitch 46 and on, opponents are 23-for-75 (.307) with 4 2B and 1 HR...all three of the home runs he has allowed have been solo shots.
