**BIRD WATCHING:** The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Chicago Cubs celebrate Fourth of July weekend with the second game of a three-game series tonight at Wrigley Field ... The Cardinals are 3-1 on their six-game road trip through first place Atlanta (2-1) and Chicago (1-0) ... With 11 runs on Thursday night and another 17 yesterday, the 28 St. Louis runs scored are the most by the club over any 24-hour span since **Aug. 29-30, 2001** when Cardinals beat the visiting Padres 16-14 and 13-3 at Busch Stadium II. - *Elias*

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 2.5 games behind Chicago and 7.5 games back of Milwaukee ... The Cardinals currently own the 3rd NL Wild Card spot, 1.5 games behind the Cubs and Phillies ... The Cardinals are playing a stretch of 14 games over 13 days without an off day leading into the All-Star Break (June 30-July 12), all against teams currently in playoff position (2-1 at Braves; 1-0 at Cubs; 5 vs. Brewers; and 3 vs. Braves).

**INDEPENDENCE DAY:** The Cardinals are 94-98-2 all-time on the 4th of July (42-56-1 on the road) ... Today marks their 8th straight on the road (2018-26).

- St. Louis is 24-28-1 all-time against the Cubs on our Nation's birthday, including a 11-13 mark in Chicago (10-11 record at Wrigley Field) ... From 1949-54, the rivals played on the holiday every season.

- The last Cardinals July 4th win at Wrigley was 2003 in an 11-8 victory, when **Albert Pujols** took **Kerry Wood** deep in the first inning after Wood brushed back Pujols with an inside fastball **#Hello4thofJuly #BigBoy**

**ROAD RAGE:** St. Louis has scored 5+ runs in an MLB-leading 27 road games this season, and is averaging 5.63 runs per game on the road, 2nd-highest in MLB to the Dodgers (6.04) ... **Iván Herrera's** .454 on-base pct. and **Jordan Walker's** 45 RBI both lead all of MLB in road games.

**JJ LEATHERHOLT:** Rookie 2B **JJ Wetherholt** co-leads Major League Baseball in Fielding Run Value (16) with CF **Pete Crow-Armstrong** and Outs Above Average (17) with SS **Bobby Witt Jr.**, while sharing the MLB lead in Runs Prevented (13) with both PCA and Witt Jr. ... Wetherholt paces all MLB second basemen in Defensive Runs Saved (14) and Defensive bWAR (1.6).

**LET THE KIDS PLAY:** According to *ESPN*, the Cardinals sport MLB's youngest active roster with an average age of 26.8, while the Cubs (30.3) are MLB's oldest ... Eight current Cardinals are 25 or younger, anchored by 23-year-old rookies **JJ Wetherholt** & **Blaze Jordan**.

- According to *Elias* (weighted average by playing time), the last time the Cardinals finished any season with Major League Baseball's lowest average age was **1944**, when 23-year-old **Stan Musial**, 26-year-old **Whitey Kurowski**, and 27-year-old NL MVP **Marty Marion** led the Cardinals over the crosstown Browns in the World Series aka "Streetcar Series."

**RBI GUYS:** **Jordan Walker** (63 RBI, 1st in NL) and **Alec Burleson** (62 RBI, T-2nd in NL) are the first pair of Cards teammates with 62+ RBI in the first 85 games of a season since 1B **Jack Clark** (85) and OF **Willie McGee** (68) in **1987** ... Burly is also first Cardinals left-handed batter with 62+ RBI through first 85 games of a team's season since **Stan Musial** (72 in 1957).

- Two Cardinals have never ended a season as the top two NL RBI leaders, last coming close in **2004** with **Albert Pujols** (123) and **Scott Rolen** (124) finishing behind **Vinny Castilla** (131) ... **2011** was the last full-season when teammates finished 1st and 2nd of their respective league in RBI: **Curtis Granderson** (119) & **Robinson Cano** (118) for the Yankees in the American League. - *Elias*

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO THE SECRET WEAPON:** Happy 63rd birthday to Cardinals Hall of Famer & Player Development Fundamentals Coordinator **José Oquendo** ... Other notables sharing America's birthday include former All-Star 3B **Vinny Castilla** (59), 1986 Manager of the Year **Hal Lanier** (84), former Yankees owner **George Steinbrenner** (1930-2010), former Raiders owner **Al Davis** (1929-2011), mobster **Meyer Lansky** (1902-83), & 30th President **Calvin Coolidge** (1872-1933).

**Iván Herrera** tallied his first MLB hit vs. the Cubs with a single (June 26, 2022)...**José Fermín** notched his first career MLB hit at the Cubs (July 21, 2023) with a bunt single...**Pedro Pagés** swatted his first MLB homer (June 14, 2024) at the Cubs.

**JoJo Romero** recorded his first MLB save on July 30, 2023 vs. the Cubs.

**George Soriano's** first cousin is former Cubs OF **Alfonso Soriano** (2007-13).

**Carson Kelly** was drafted by St. Louis in 2012 and played three seasons (2016-18) for the Cardinals.

**Phil Maton** pitched in 40 games as a reliever for the Cardinals in 2025 after he signed a one-year deal as a free agent in March 2025.

**Brant Brown** was the Cubs 3rd round draft pick in 1992 and played parts of four seasons (1996-98 & 2000) with the North Siders.

Cardinals.TV play-by-play announcer **Chip Caray** served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

**Lars Nootbaar** and **Shota Imanaga** were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

**Jon Jay** played in 141 games for the Cubs in 2017 and was part of their playoff run to the NLCS.

**Daniel Descalso** played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

**Nelson Velázquez** played parts of two seasons with the Cubs (2022-23), where he made his MLB debut (May 30, 2022 vs. Milwaukee)...singled off Ethan Small in his first career plate appearance.

Cubs Scouting VP **Dan Kantrovitz** previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cards 25th Rd. draft pick from Brown Univ...first MLB job was Cardinals Scouting Coordinator.

**Stubby Clapp** (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made his MLB debut vs. the Cubs...was also a coach on Team Canada for the 2013 & 2026 WBC squads that featured **Jameson Taillon** on the pitching staff.

Cubs Staff Assistant **AJ Lewis** played college baseball at the University of Missouri in 2017 and John A. Logan College (Carterville, IL) in 2018.

Cubs Major League Assistant Strength & Conditioning Coach **Mark Weisman** was the Director of Performance at Southeast Missouri State University (Gape Girardeau, Mo.) in 2020.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Cardinals VP & Sr. Advisor **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Marquee Sports Network Analyst **Rick Sutcliffe** played for St. Louis in 1994.

Cardinals.TV Analyst **Mark Sweeney** made his MLB debut with St. Louis vs. the Cubs on Aug. 4, 1995 at Busch Stadium II.

Hall of Fame manager **Tony La Russa** played in one game for the Cubs in 1973.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Tom Herr** made his MLB debut vs. the Cubs on Aug. 13, 1979 at Busch Stadium II, and fellow Cards HOF **Jason Isringhausen** made his MLB debut on July 17, 1995 at the Cubs while pitching for the Mets.

## TODAY'S STARTER:

- The 29-year old makes his 17 start of the season (18th career) and 115th career appearance. First 97 appearance of his career came in relief.
- Has made four previous starts on nationally televised games including Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit, April 11 vs. Boston on FOX, Game 2 of a Doubleheader at Cincinnati on May 23 at on FOX & May 29 vs. the Cubs on FOX.**
- Made his first Major League start at Wrigley Field on the final day of the 2025 regular season; pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in a no decision.
- Snapped a six-game winless stretch in his last start vs. MIA (6/28); spanning a month of starts (5/23-6/23) with an 0-1 record, 4.70 ERA over six starts (30.2 IP).
- His six wins this season are a career high and rank T-2nd on the team to **Andre Pallante** (9).
- Three of his six wins this season have come on the road: April 5 at Detroit, April 17 at Houston and April 28 at Pittsburgh.
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

**LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, June 28 vs. Miami):** W, 2-1; 5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 3 BB, 5 SO, 0 HR - 87 pitches.

- Battled through 5.0 innings limiting the Marlins to one run on two hits as Owen Caissie and Graham Pauley hit back-to-back doubles in the 5th inning.
- Pitched in the hottest first pitch at Busch Stadium this season clocking in at 92 degrees.
- Ran his scoreless inning streak to 11.1 IP, T-3rd longest by a Cardinals pitcher this season (May 15.0 & McGreevy 14.0).

## 2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**2-AND-Q:** Ranks 4th among all MLB pitchers in batting with 2 out & RISP with a .111 BA (4-36)... trails **Chase Burns** (.086, CIN), **Braxton Ashcraft** (.091, PIT) & **Eduard Rodriguez** (.103, ARI). *min 30 AB*

**EN GARDE:** Ranks T-4th among all MLB pitchers with his 22 Opponent's Sword Swings (Max Meyer-MIA, 1st with 29). A "sword" swing is an expression of the art of forcing a batter to take an uncomfortable, awkward swing.

**AIR BENDER:** Leads Cardinals starters with an average swing & miss distance of 3.6 inches, including a season high 20.9 inch swing & miss by the Pirates Nick Gonzales on April 28.

**FISH IS THE DISH:** Snapped a six-game stretch without a win in his last start vs. MIA (6/28) tossing 5.0 innings allowing one run on two hits; kept the Marlins from their first Cardinals sweep in 30 years.

**HIGHS & LOWS:** Struck out a career-high 8 batters in his 5/23 [2] start at CIN, but also allowed a career-high 5 runs - all coming in his 5th and final inning of work

**PARK PLACE:** Each of his first six road games took place at Parks ( Petco Park, Comerica Park, Daikin Park, loanDepot park, PNC Park, Great American Ball Park). His start at Target Field on June 12 ended the string.

**CENTRAL FOCUS:** Earned wins in two of his five starts against NL Central opponents this season (April 28 at PIT & May 4 vs. MIL) to improve to 4-1 in his career against divisional opponents.

**DECISIONS, DECISIONS** Has earned the decision in nine of his 15 starts, but just one decision in his last 6 starts.

**STRETCHING OUT:** Pitched a career-high 6.1 innings on 6/22 vs. ARI and has worked at least 5.0 innings in 12 of his 15 starts on the year.

**SNAKE CHARMER:** Blanked the Diamondbacks on just 3 hits over his career single-game high 6.1 IP on 6/22 vs. ARI, but took a no-decision while exiting the game with a scoreless tie.

**OH MOTHER:** Blanked the Padres over his 5.0 IP on just 2 hits on May 10 (Mother's Day), and was in line for the win before the Padres Nick Castellanos tied the game with a 2-out, 2-strike 2-run HR to tie the game at 2-2, and then SD won it in the 10th, 3-2.

**BROOM RIDE:** Gained the win in the middle game of the Cardinals three-game series sweep at HOU in a 9-4 win on 4/17; Struck out a season high 6, but allowed 3 solo HR's.

**ALL EYES ON US:** Drew back-to-back starting assignments in nationally televised games on Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit and April 11 vs. Boston on FOX. Made the start on 5/23 [2] at Cincinnati on FOX in national telecast Memorial Day weekend.

**EASTER DELIGHT:** Gained his 1st win of the season on April 5, allowing 2 runs over 5.0 IP in the Cardinals 5-3 Easter win over the Tigers. He threw a career-high 97 pitches as he earned the winning decision as a starter for the 1st time - all while helping to prevent a series sweep by Detroit.

**IT'S COLDER IN BOULDER:** Colorado native worked in game time temps of 42° on Easter Sunday in Detroit, his third career MLB appearance in temperatures 45° and below, two shy of matching Cards announcer **Brad Thompson** (5) for T-3rd among Cardinals in the frosty temps.

**CAREER:**

- Graduated from Erie (Colo.) High School. Named Boulder County POY and was selected to play at the High School Futures Game at Coors Field.
- Played college baseball at Colorado Mesa Univ. in Grand Junction, CO, going 22-2 with a 3.13 ERA (204.1 IP), 188 K and six complete games.
- Allowed nine home runs to 852 total batters faced while pitching in high altitude (Grand Junction is 4,583 ft above sea level).
- Posted a 13-0 record with a 1.41 ERA during his sophomore season, earning First Team All-American, First Team Academic All-American, and was the South Central Regional Tournament MVP.
- His father, Tim Leahy, played college basketball at Kansas State University and his uncle, Thomas Leahy, pitched in the Braves organization (1991-93) advancing to Durham (High-A).

**LEAHY VS. CHICAGO (N.L.):**

- Makes his 3rd career start and 11th career appearance against the Cubs tonight. Has yet to register a decision in his career vs. CHI.
- Is 0-0 with a 1.23 ERA in two career starts (7.1 IP) and 0-0 with a 4.66 ERA in eight career relief appearances (9.2 IP).
- Last started vs. CHI at Busch Stadium on May 30 in a 6-1 Cardinals loss. Allowed one run over 4.1 innings before exiting after 78 pitches.
- Made 1st career MLB start in 2025 season finale on Sept. 28, 2025 at Wrigley & took ND in the 2-0 defeat while blanking the Cubs on 1 hit over 3.0 IP.
- Seven of his previous 10 appearances against the Cubs have taken place at Wrigley Field.

**LAST APPEARANCE VS. CUBS (May 30, 2026 at Busch Stadium):** ND, L, 6-1; 4.1 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 4 SO, 0 HR - 78 pitches

- Exited a 1-1 game in the 5th inning as the Cubs scored in the top of that inning as Michael Busch singled in Pete Crow-Armstrong.
- The run scored snapped a 8.1 scoreless inning streak against the Cubs dating back to his last relief appearance vs. CHI (7/6).
