RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals embark on a seven-day, six-game road trip, beginning with the opener of a three-game weekend series against the San Diego Padres at Petco Park ... After a scheduled off-day on Monday, the Cardinals and division-rival Milwaukee Brewers begin a three-game set at American Family Field ... St. Louis finished 2-5 on its recent seven-game homestand vs. Philadelphia (1-2) and Milwaukee (1-3).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 5th place in the NL Central, 5.0 games behind 4th-place Pittsburgh ... St. Louis has spent 136 of 170 days in last place on the MLB schedule (April 26-May 19, May 29-July 7 & July 28-present) ... The Cardinals 67-86 record is their lowest at the 153-game mark since 1978 when they were 65-88 (.425).

GAMES THAT MATTER: Since Opening Day of 2011, the Cardinals have played 1,988-of-1,991 regular season games during which they still maintained playoff aspirations and had not yet been eliminated ... Wednesday was the first time St. Louis played a game after being eliminated from postseason contention since the final game of the 2018 regular season (Sept. 30, 2018).

ROSTER UPDATE: The Cardinals announced the following transactions prior to tonight's series opener in San Diego:

- Placed 3B **Nolan Arenado** (lower back spasms) and C **Willson Contreras** (left wrist tendonitis) on the 10-Day Injured List
- Transferred OF **Dylan Carlson** to the 60-day Injured List
- Selected INF/OF **Irving López** from Memphis (AAA) - *MLB Debut*
- Recalled OF **Michael Siani** (*pronounced see-AH-nee*) from Memphis (AAA) - *Cardinals Debut*

PLAYERS USED: With the first appearances by **Mike Siani** and **Irving López**, 52 different players will have appeared for the Cardinals this season, breaking the franchise single-season record of 51 players shared by the 1997, 2021, and 2022 Redbirds ... With the additions of **Nolan Arenado** and **Willson Contreras** to the Injured List today, only two Cardinals have avoided the Injured List and been active for every game this season (excluding suspension): **Miles Mikolas** and reigning National League MVP **Paul Goldschmidt**.

WHO'S YOUR PADRE: The Cardinals all-time .588 (297-208) win percentage over the Padres (1969-present) is their 4th-best against any opponent, while no National League team has higher all-time win pct. over San Diego than the Cardinals.

FRESHMAN FINISHES: 21-year-old rookie **Jordan Walker** hit safely for the 7th straight game yesterday and has done so in 15 of his 18 games played in September (.308/.378/.523, 20-65) ... Walker, with one more hit, would become just the 12th Cardinals rookie since 2000 to collect 21+ hits in Sept./Oct ... Walker entered play today ranked among NL rookies in September in batting (.308, 5th), hits (20, T-4th), homers (4, T-2nd), OBP (.378, 4th), slugging (.523, 4th), OPS (.901, 5th), runs (12, 3rd), and total bases (34, T-2nd).

IT IS YOUR BIRTHDAY. Happy 62nd birthday to Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** and 53rd birthday to former Cardinals catcher and manager **Mike Matheny** ... Others born on this day include shortstops **Carlos Correa** (29) and **Jeremy Peña** (26), pitcher **Hooks Dauss** (b. 1889), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Lemon** (b. 1920), and Hall of Fame manager **Tommy Lasorda** (b. 1927)

IMMACULATE CARDS & PADRES: According to *Baseball Reference*, nine players have appeared exclusively for both the Cardinals & Padres: RHP **John Urrea**, RHP **Rich Batchelor**, RHP **John Littlefield**, OF **Luis Melendez**, LHP **Jason Pearson**, INF **Greg Garcia**, SS **Khalil Greene**, Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford**, and Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith**.

SPRINGFIELD (AA) CONTINUES POSTSEASON: Good luck to the Springfield Cardinals (AA) tonight in Game 3 of the best-of-three Texas League Division Series against Arkansas (AA-Mariners) at Dickey-Stephens Park ... RHP **Tink Henge** (2-5, 5.47) will start for Springfield.

SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Tommy Edman was born in and resides in San Diego...graduated from La Jolla Country Day School, where he was a National Merit Scholar.

Paul Goldschmidt's cousin, **Dan Dallas**, was selected by the Padres in the 7th round of the 2016 MLB Draft...played four minor league seasons in the Padres minor league organization (2016-19).

Tommy Edman and **Ha-Seong Kim** were teammates on South Korea in the 2023 WBC.

Fernando Tatis, father of Padres outfielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

Miles Mikolas was selected by San Diego in the 7th round of the 2009 MLB draft...pitched parts of two seasons with the Padres (2012-13), where he made his MLB debut...traded by San Diego with Jaff Decker to Pittsburgh for Alex Dickerson (Nov. 25, 2013).

Matt Carpenter played parts of 11 seasons with the Cardinals (2011-21) where he was a three-time NL All-Star and 2013 Silver Slugger Award winner...also appeared in 50 postseason games...originally selected by St. Louis in the 13th round of the 2009 MLB Draft.

Rich Hill pitched in 23 games for Memphis (AAA) in the Cardinals organization in 2010.

Michael Wacha pitched seven seasons with St. Louis (2013-19)...2015 NL All-Star and 2013 NLCS MVP...originally selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (#19) of the 2012 MLB Draft as compensation for **Albert Pujols** signing w/ the Angels.

Luis García pitched in 34 games for St. Louis in 2021.

Padres Coach **Peter Summerville's** brother, **Andrew**, was selected by St. Louis in the 12th round of the 2017 MLB draft...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)...traded by San Diego with pitchers Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for pitcher Luis DeLeon, outfielder Sixto Lezcano and shortstop Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

Mike Shildt coached and managed parts of 18 seasons in the Cardinals organization (2004-21)...served as an area scout (2004-07) and coach (2005-08) before transitioning to minor league manager (2009-16)...Joined the St. Louis coaching staff in 2017 and was Cardinals manager for parts of four seasons (2018-21)...led the Cardinals to three postseason berths and was named 2019 NL Manager of the Year.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Padres Catching Coach **Brian Esposito** played parts of two seasons for Memphis (AAA) in 2006-07 and one game for St. Louis in 2007.

Cardinals Hall of Famer and broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played part of the 2008 season for San Diego (26 games)...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for **David Freese** (Dec. 14, 2007).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for Woody Williams (Aug. 2, 2001).

Padres Assistant Hitting Coach **Scott Coolbaugh** played 15 games for St. Louis in 1994...his brother **Mike**, played five games for St. Louis in 2002

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** appeared in 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with Nate Tebbs from the Padres for Heathcliff Slocumb and current Memphis (AAA) manager **Ben Johnson**, who played parts of two seasons in San Diego (2005-06).

The Athletic reporter **Katie Woo** spent the 2018 MLB season covering the Padres as an associate reporter for MLB.com.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 11th start of the season and 17th appearance since his promotion from Memphis (AAA) at the beginning of July. It's his 2nd meeting of the year against Philadelphia.
- Compiled a career-best six game win streak from Sept. 17, 2022-Aug. 20, 2023, which including five-straight this season (July 15-Aug. 20).
- Has not pitched more than 5.0 innings in each of his last three starts.
- St. Louis has won 7 of Hudson's 10 starts this season (.700). The Cardinals were 13-7 in **Jack Flaherty's** starts, the only other Cardinals starting pitcher this season that the team sported a winning record in his starts.
- The Cardinals are 47-30 (.610 win pct.) in his 77 career games started and 29-10 (.744) in his 39 career games started at Busch Stadium.
- Went 4-1 in August, one of six MLB pitchers with four wins during the month.
- Was 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA (16.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in six games as a reliever.
- Since 2018 when Hudson made his MLB debut, leads active MLB pitchers in GIDP/9 (1.23) and 3rd MLB in groundball percentage (55.4%).
- Tied for the 2022 Major League lead in opponent ground into double play with 25.
- Among active pitchers with 50 or more decisions, ranks 5th in career winning percentage (.667, 38-19) with **Walker Buehler** (.742, 46-16) ranking first; ranks 21st all-time in MLB history.
- His .667 career winning pct. ranks 4th among all Cardinals since 1900 (min. 75 starts) behind only **John Tudor** (.705), **Chris Carpenter** (.683) & **Woody Williams** (.672).

LAST TIME OUT

- Departed with a 5-3 lead after 5.0 innings and tied his season-low in pitches in a start with 66. Cardinals blew the lead in the top of the 8th inning before taking the lead back in the bottom half for a 6-5 win.

- He's 21-5 (.808 win pct.) in 56 career games (39 starts) at Busch Stadium, and ranks 3rd in ERA (2.74) all-time at Busch III among pitchers with a minimum 200.0 IP.
- Has lost 2 of his last 3 decisions, but still owns a 5-game win streak at Busch Stadium that dates back to his last loss here on 7/14/22 vs. LAD.
- Of pitchers with 25 or more home decisions, his .808 home winning pct. (21-5), ranks 3rd among starting pitchers in MLB history trailing **Jose Fernandez** (29-2, .935) and **Emil Yde** (27-6, .818).

CAREER

- Has appeared in 111 career MLB games (76 starts), going 38-19, 3.82 ERA, including team-leading 16 wins in 2019 when he finished 5th in NL ROY voting.
- Was 8-7, 4.45 ERA in 27 games (26 starts) for Cardinals last season. Tied for MLB lead with 25 GIDPs induced.
- Has not lost three straight decisions dating back through his freshman season at Mississippi State, including minor league baseball.

- Last start at Petco Park imploded to a 12-2 loss fueled by a 7-run 2nd inning as his own throwing error opened up a two-out rally culminated on back-to-back home runs by Manny Machado and Franmil Reyes. The six unearned runs was the second such game of his season and most since Andy Benes allowed 7 UER at ARI in 2002.
- Threw 7.0 innings allowing one run on four hits in a 5-2 win at Busch Stadium on June 1, 2022. Corey Dickerson hauled in a Robinson Canó pinch-hit fly out representing the go-ahead run with two outs in the 9th.
- Holds a 9-4 record with a 2.73 ERA over 14 starts (23 app.) against N.L. West Division opponents in his career.
