THE TWINS: Finished their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 5-1, going 3-0 at Texas last week, followed by a 2-1 series win at Arizona over the weekend...tonight, Minnesota will begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with the first of three against the Dodgers through Wednesday...they will enjoy an off-day on Thursday then host the Rockies for three games over the weekend.
 ☞ Twins have won six of their last seven and eight of their last 11.

THE ALL-TIME WARM WEATHER TRIP ENDS WITH TWINS REMAINING HOT: The Twins beat the Diamondbacks yesterday afternoon at Chase Field by a score of 4-2, scoring all four runs after the sixth inning, marking their 14th come-from-behind victory this season...Mike Paredes was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in a career-high 5.0 innings pitched...Cody Laweryson (1.0), Andrew Morris (1.0), Yoendrys Gómez (1.0) and Anthony Banda (1.0) combined to pitch 4.0 hitless innings of relief...the Twins scored three runs in the seventh inning, highlighted by a pinch-hit RBI single from Josh Bell, an Alex Jackson RBI-single and a Corbin Carroll throwing error to score Bell...the offense recorded 11 hits, three coming from Ryan Kreidler.

ROAD RAGE: Notables from the 5-1 roadtrip over the last week:
 ☞ Twins hit .323 (74-for-229) with 50 runs (8.3 R/G), 35 extra-base hits, a .541 slugging percentage and a .925 OPS.
 ☞ They hit .412 (28-for-68) with runners in scoring position.
 ☞ Starting pitchers went 3-1, 3.03 ERA (32.2 IP, 11 ER) with 10 walks and 22 strikeouts.
 ☞ Relievers struck out 23 batters in 20.1 innings pitched (10.2 K/9.0 IP) and held opponents to a .231 batting average.
 ☞ Individuals: Trevor Larnach went 12-for-23 (.522) with two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI...Josh Bell went 10-for-22 (.455) with two doubles, two home runs and eight RBI...Luke Keaschall went 8-for-22 (.364) with four walks.

DODGEBALL: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 29th, 30th and 31st times in their history this week, the Twins are 9-19 all-time vs. Los Angeles...in the regular season, Minnesota is 3-11 all-time at Dodger Stadium (3-14 counting the 0-3 record during the 1965 World Series), 3-8 at Target Field and 3-0 at the Metrodome.
 ☞ The Twins' .321 winning percentage against LA is their second-lowest vs. any opponent in their history (since 1961), trailing Atlanta (.286 — 8-20).
 ☞ Byron Buxton has reached base safely in 10-straight games vs. the Dodgers, dating back to August of 2022...in that span, he has posted a .321 on-base percentage and an .811 OPS.
 ☞ Victor Caratini has posted a .912 OPS over his last 13 games against the Dodgers, dating back to September of 2021.
 ☞ Josh Bell has hit safely in 15 of his last 16 games against the Dodgers (dating back to August of 2023), hitting .328 (19-for-58) with an .802 OPS in that span.
 ☞ In three career games against the Dodgers, Royce Lewis is 6-for-10 with two doubles, one home run, two walks and four RBI.

CITY OF BUCK-ERLY LOVE: Updated voting for the MLB All-Stars were released this afternoon and Byron Buxton now sits in third place among AL outfielders with 1,106,264 votes, trailing Aaron Judge (1,788,499) and Mike Trout (1,735,051)...phase one voting ends at 11 am (CT) on Thursday...the top six outfielders will be revealed on MLB Network at 5 pm (CT) on Thursday, and will advance to the second phase of voting...below are Byron Buxton's rankings among AL outfielders in a few offensive categories on the season:

ADDITIONALLY...he ranks fourth among that same group in RBI (40), trailing Bellinger (49), Adell (41) and Soderstrom (41).

CONTACT LIST: Twins have struck out just 126 times this month, the fewest in baseball, ahead of Arizona (128) and Atlanta (131)...the next closest American League team is Toronto (133)...by comparison, in May, they were tied for fourth-most strikeouts in baseball (252) and in March/April they ranked tied for ninth-most in MLB (279).
 ☞ Notable individuals this month (minimum of 70 plate appearances): Brooks Lee (8.8%) ranks first in the AL, Trevor Larnach (11.7%) ranks fifth, Luke Keaschall (12.7%) ranks 11th and Kody Clemens (16.0%) ranks 19th.

EXTRA STRENGTH: Through 19 games this month, the Twins are slugging .494, which ranks fourth-best in baseball, trailing Detroit (.496), the Athletics (.496) and Colorado (.495).
 ☞ Twins have homered 32 times over their last 16 games, since June 4...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (40).

TWINS ON TARGET: Twins return home where they have gone 20-19...Twins have won three of their last four series at home.
 ☞ Kody Clemens has hit safely in seven-straight home games...additionally, he has reached base safely in 23 of his last 24 home games, hitting .322 (29-for-90) with eight doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, a .378 on-base percentage and a .955 OPS in that span.
 ☞ In 31 home games this season, Byron Buxton is hitting .328 (40-for-122) with 13 home runs, a .713 slugging percentage and a 1.115 OPS...his home slugging percentage ranks second in baseball and his OPS ranks fourth.

24 CARAT MAGIC IN THE AIR: Victor Caratini has hit safely in 14 of his last 16 games, hitting .392 (20-for-51) with five doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, eight walks, a .475 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.142 OPS in that span.
 ☞ Caratini finished the trip going 7-for-13 (.636) with one double, one home run, four RBI and three walks.

TREVOR LARNACH, PROFESSIONAL HITTER: Over his last six games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .500 (13-for-26) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, a .519 on-base percentage, an .808 slugging percentage and 1.326 OPS.
 ☞ In 16 games this month, he is hitting .358 (19-for-53) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, five walks and a .971 OPS...his batting average ranks seventh-best in baseball among players with at least 60 plate appearances this month.
 ☞ Has gone 29 consecutive plate appearances without a strikeout, the second longest active streak in Major League Baseball, only behind San Francisco's Luis Arraez (48).

KEEP THEIR HEADS RINGIN': Josh Bell has hit safely in seven-straight games, tying his season-high (previously May 28-June 3)...his career-high is 15 (April 28-May 15, 2019)...he has hit safely in 21 of his last 24 games, since May 28...over his last 20 games, he is hitting .357 (25-for-70) with five doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI, a .400 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.000 OPS.
 ☞ He leads the club with 48 RBI...16 of those RBI have come in his last 15 games.

- Tonight will be Zebby's first career start against the Dodgers and ninth career start against a National League opponent.
- In his most recent start this season on June 16 at Texas, Zebby pitched 7.0 innings of two-run, eight-hit ball, with zero walks and four strikeouts in the Twins 12-2 victory.

LAST TIME OUT: On June 16 at Texas, Zebby made his seventh start of the year opposite Rangers right-hander Kumar Rocker...Matthews earned his third win of the season in a quality start and turned in his third start this season of 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on eight hits, with zero walks and four strikeouts in a 12-2 Twins win...gave up only two extra-base hits (both doubles) to Brandon Nimmo (2nd inning) and Elias Díaz (5th inning) in the outing.

- BULLDOG:** Zebby has now recorded three 7.0-inning outings in his seven starts with the Twins which is the most outings of 7.0-or-more innings by a Twins starter this season (second: Joe Ryan - two).
- HIGH QUALITY:** Since making his major league season debut on May 14, Matthews has recorded five quality starts which is tied for third in MLB (11 others with five) and tied for first in the American League (eight others) during that span...the only two pitchers with more quality starts (six) than Zebby in baseball are Jacob Misiorowski (MIL) and Cristopher Sánchez (PHI), while other notable starters he is tied with in the American League include Cam Schlitler (NYY), Sonny Gray (BOS) and his teammate Joe Ryan.
- RUNNERS ON AND RISP:** Came into his start against the Rangers allowing a .333 (16-for-48) BAA with runners on base and a .346 (9-for-26) BAA with runners in scoring position on the season...in his June 16 start, held Texas to a .214 (3-for-14) BAA with three strikeouts with runners on and a .000 (0-for-9) BAA with three strikeouts with runners in scoring position.

NOT A COINCIDENCE: Through seven starts this season, Matthews has given up a homer in four of them and held opponents homerless three times...below is a breakdown of Zebby's stats this year in games he gives up one-or-more homers compared to when he does not allow a homer:

TWO STARTS AGO: On June 11 at Detroit opposite right-hander Keider Montero, Zebby took his fourth loss of the season after allowing seven runs on nine hits (3 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in an 11-0 Twins defeat...allowed runs in four of his six innings pitched (1st - 1, 4th - 3, 5th - 1 and 6th - 2) and home runs in each of his last three innings (Spencer Torkelson two-run homer in the fourth, Gleyber Torres solo shot in the fifth and Colt Keith two-run jack in the sixth)...despite the damage, Matthews managed to stay efficient, needing only 81 pitches (51 for strikes) to work his way through the sixth inning for the fifth time in six MLB starts this season.

INTERLEAGUE NUMBERS: Tonight will be Matthews' ninth career start against a National League opponent; is 3-4 with a 4.69 ERA (40.1 IP, 21 ER), nine walks, 41 strikeouts, a .253 (40-for-158) BAA and a 1.21 WHIP through his first eight starts against the NL.

- AGAINST THE NL WEST:** Will make his fourth career start against the National League West; currently holds a 1-2 record with a 5.40 ERA (15.0 IP, 9 ER), three walks, 10 strikeouts, a .302 (19-for-63) BAA and a 1.47 WHIP through three starts...in his most recent start against San Diego on August 29, 2025 he earned the win after throwing 6.0 innings of three-run ball, with no walks and three strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (SEASON): Matthews has made three home starts this season, going 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA (20.0 IP, 4 ER), five walks, 13 strikeouts and a .200 (14-for-70) BAA compared to 1-3 with a 7.33 ERA (23.1 IP, 19 ER), four walks, 21 strikeouts and a .292 (28-for-96) BAA in four road starts.

- HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER):** Matthews has gone 5-5 with a 5.65 ERA (71.2 IP, 45 ER), 19 walks, 76 strikeouts and a .296 (86-for-291) BAA in 15 career major league starts at home, compared to 4-9, 5.58 ERA (88.2 IP, 55 ER) with 25 walks, 89 strikeouts and a .279 (101-for-362) BAA in 17 career major league starts on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through seven starts this season, lefties are slashing .269/.330/.452 (25-for-93) with five doubles, four home runs, seven walks and 21 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .233/.253/.452 (17-for-73) with four doubles, four home runs, two walks and 13 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Zebby has used a six-pitch mix in his seven starts with the Twins this season...here are some of his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

- TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE:** Opposing hitters are batting .133 (2-for-15) against Matthews' curveball this season; his .133 BAA leads all Twins pitchers and ranks 14th in baseball among starting pitchers (min. 10 PA and 500 total pitches thrown).
- PINPOINT:** Zebby continues to keep his walk rate low, at a miniscule 5.1%; that number ranks in the 93rd percentile among all pitchers in baseball.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOE RYAN (2026: 5-3, 3.17 ERA // CAREER: 51-39, 3.69 ERA)
