AROUND THE HORN

TEACHER APPRECIATION NIGHT TONIGHT: The D-backs are celebrating teachers and administrators with Teacher Appreciation Night, presented by FOX10, featuring a limited-edition teacher-themed coffee mug and a pregame parade.

ASU NIGHT TOMORROW: Sun Devils will come together for the start of the school year with ASU Night, featuring a co-branded D-backs x ASU Merrill Kelly jersey.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 7-4 in their last 11 games.

- The D-backs are 6-4 in their last 10 home games.
- **Tim Tawa** has a career-best 16-game on-base streak, hitting .293 (17-for-58)/.869 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has an 8-game hitting streak, batting .407 (11-for-27)/.907 OPS with 3 RBI and 5 walks.
- **Brandon Pfaadt**, in his last 4 home starts since the All-Star break, is 2-0 with a 2.10 ERA (7 R-6 ER in 25.2 IP), an opponent .207 AVG (19-for-92)/.534 OPS, 5 walks and 11 strikeouts.

LAST GAMES: The D-backs played their 27th all-time doubleheader (33-21 overall, 27-21 on the road) on Saturday @ Giants, with a 7-1 win in Game 1 and lost 7-2 in Game 2.

GAME 1: **Merrill Kelly** had a quality start with 7.0 shutout frames (2 H, 4 BB, 7 K), his first such star of the season and 15th of his career.

- **Lars Nootbaar’s** pinch-hit grand slam -- his first career grand slam -- in the seventh inning to break a 0-0 tie was the D-backs’ fifth all-time pinch-hit grand slam along with David Dellucci (July 21, 2001 @ Giants), Tony Clark (May 19, 2007 @ Pirates), Chad Tracy (Sept. 26, 2009 vs. Padres) and Alfredo Marte (July 25, 2014 @ Phillies).

GAME 2: **Lars Nootbaar** had a RBI double in the third inning and **Ildemaro Vargas** had a RBI single in the seventh inning.

- **Mitch Bratt** worked 4.1 innings with 3 runs (2 after he departed) on 3 hits and 2 walks with 2 strikeouts.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are third in the NL Wild Card race, 4.5 games behind the Phillies (WC2, lead season 2-1) and 4.5 games behind the Cubs (WC1, trail season 2-4) as well as a 0.5 game ahead of the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5).

WIN THE SERIES: The D-backs are 9-3-2 in their 14 series post-All-Star break.

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs’ 28 wins (28-18) since July 9 are tied for third in the Majors with the Rays (28) and Yankees (28) behind the Red Sox (31) and Braves (29) and ahead of the Brewers (27).

RECAPING AUGUST: The D-backs are 15-12 in August (9-7 at home, 6-5 on the road).

- The offense, among all teams, ranks in SLG (3rd, .423), total bases (3rd, 397), OPS (4th, .753 OPS), XBH (4th, 85), OBP (6th, .330), AVG (9th, .254) and runs (9th, 129).
- **Brandon Pfaadt’s** opponent .228 OBP is the fifth lowest in August in franchise history (low is Randy Johnson’s .218 OBP).

1-2 PUNCH: **Brandon Pfaadt** (team is 4-1)and **Eduardo Rodriguez** (team is 4-1), in a combined 10 starts (6 quality) in August, are 6-1 with a 2.52 ERA (21 R-18 ER in 64.1 IP), an opponent .206 AVG (49-for-238)/.566 OPS, 12 walks and 54 strikeouts.

HOMER HAPPY: The D-backs have homered in 5 of their last 6 games (7 HR) and 16 of their last 20 games (23 HR).

HOME SWEET HOME: **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 13 of 15 home games in August, batting .345 (20-for-58)/.855 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 triples, 4 RBI and 6 walks.

- **Tim Tawa** has reached base safely in 6 straight home games, batting .350 (7-for-20)/.985 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 33 of his last 34 home games, batting .315 (39-for-124)/.872 OPS with 10 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 18 RBI and 21 walks.

BULLPEN BOYS: **Juan Morillo** has an 8-home-game scoreless streak (8.0 IP) with an opponent .185 AVG (5-for-27)/.489 OPS, 2 walks and 6 strikeouts.

- **Brandyn Garcia** has held opponents scoreless in 23 of 24 home games this season, with a 0.43 ERA (1 ER in 21.0 IP), an opponent .145 AVG (10-for-69)/.395 OPS, 4 walks and 17 strikeouts.

NOOT: **Lars Nootbaar** has hit safely in 4 straight games, batting .500 (6-for-12)/1.705 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 1 walk.

- Hit a leadoff homer on Friday @ Giants then hit a pinch-hit grand slam in Game 1 on Saturday @ Giants...the last player to hit a lead-off homer in a game then a grand slam in the next game was in 2016 when Charlie Blackmon/COL hit a leadoff homer on May 30 vs. Reds then hit a grand slam on May 31 vs. Reds (additionally, led off that game with a leadoff homer) [source: TruMedia].

BACKSTOPS: **D-backs Catchers** among all teams (when batting as the catcher) rank first with a .287 AVG (ahead of MIL .268, TB .267, MIN .267) and 146 hits (ahead of MIL 142 and COL 134), third with a .346 OBP (to MIN .350, MIL .347), third with a .792 OPS (to COL .845, DET .797) and fourth with a .446 SLG (to COL .532, DET .480, ATH .452).

COMEBACK KIDS: The D-backs’ 41 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (40).

- 21 comeback wins at home are tied for fifth in the Majors.

VS. NL EAST: **Corbin Carroll** has an 11-game on-base streak vs. NL East (.263, 10-for-38, .981 OPS, 9 walks).

- **Gabriel Moreno** has an 11-game on-base streak vs. NL East (.375, 15-for-40, 1.149 OPS, 6 walks).

VS. PHILLIES: The D-backs are 5-2 in their last 7 games.
