LET'S START AGAIN: The Giants opened their 69th season in San Francisco and 144th in franchise history on Wednesday with a 7-0 loss to the Yankees...the Giants are now 77-66-1 (.538) all-time on Opening Day and 39-30 (.565) since moving to SF in 1958.

- ▶ The seven run-defeat tied for the Giants' largest margin of defeat on Opening Day in the SF era (since 1958) since losing 8-1 at Los Angeles-NL on July 23, 2020.
- ▶ The Giants were shut out on Opening Day for the first time since 2023 at New York-AL...it was their first time being shutout at home on Opening Day since 2007 vs. SD (also 7-0).
- ▶ SF's three hits on Opening Day were its fewest in a season-opener since also being three-hit at Pittsburgh on April 12, 1965.
- ▶ The Giants went 20-14 (.588) in home day games last year, ranking 10th-best in MLB.

THAT'S LIFE: SF will try to end its seven-game home losing streak to the Yankees with a win today...the Giants have been swept in each of their last two completed home series against the Yankees (2019 and 2024).

- ▶ The Giants' last victory over the Yankees here in SF came June 24, 2007 (7-2).
- ▶ SF's 2-8 (.200) home winning percentage against the Yankees is its lowest vs. any team since Interleague play began in 1997.
- ▶ In April of 2025, SF won its first-ever series against the Yankees at Yankee Stadium.

RAY DAY: LHP Robbie Ray makes his season debut after an All-Star campaign in 2025.

- ▶ The lefty carried a perfect 7-0 record into his final start of May last season before taking a loss in his 12th start of the year on May 31st at Miami...he became the first Giants starter since Hall of Famer **Juan Marichal** (1966) to tally at least seven wins and remain undefeated through his first 11 starts of a season...he also joined **Kevin Gausman** (2021) as the only Giants starters in the Wild Card Era to start a season 7-0.
- ▶ SF won all of Ray's first nine starts, making him the first Giants starter to have the team win each of his first nine starts of a season since **Bill Swift** in 1992 (11 wins to start season).
- ▶ Ray's go-to pitch in 2025 was his four-seam fastball (51.9% usage rate)...NYY's .822 OPS vs. 4SFB since the start of 2025 ranks fifth-best in MLB over that span.

A RIGHTY? THANK YOU: SF's 2025 struggles vs. lefty starting pitchers carried over in Wednesday's loss when Max Fried allowed just two hits and a walk over 6.1 shutout innings.

- ▶ SF is now 17-29 (.370) vs. left-handed starting pitchers since the start of last season, which is the third-lowest winning percentage in MLB over that span...the Giants' .637 OPS vs. left-handed starting pitchers since the start of 2025 is the second-lowest in MLB.
- ▶ The Giants had much more success vs. right-handed starting pitchers in 2025, going 64-53 (.547), 10th-best in MLB, with a .737 OPS.

BRING ON THE VELO: NYY starter Cam Schlichter's 4SFB (55.9% usage rate) has an average velocity of 98.0 mph...he had 406 pitches at 98.0+ mph in 2025 in 14 games (*TruMedia*).

- ▶ Since last season, SF's .683 OPS vs. pitches 98.0+ mph is ninth-best while its .740 OPS vs. pitches 99.0+ mph is second-best in MLB behind only Kansas City (1.080 OPS).
- ▶ **OF Jung Hoo Lee** had a 1.138 OPS last season vs. pitches charted at 98.0+ mph on *TruMedia*, which was the fifth-best OPS in the Majors.

RAFI VS. THE YANKS: IF Rafael Devers has plenty of experience playing the Yankees...Devers owns a career slash line of .269/.347/.530 (.877 OPS) with 22 doubles, 31 homers, 78 RBI and 79 runs scored in 120 career regular season games against New York-AL.

- ▶ Below is where Devers' ranks among active players against the Yankees (min. 150 PA).

- ▶ In Devers' last 33 games versus New York (dating to June 9, 2023 with Boston), Devers is slashing .347/.462/.703 (1.165 OPS) with 12 homers, 24 RBI and 31 runs scored.

THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

MARCH 27, 2025

Trailing 3-2 in the 9th inning, the Giants scored 4 runs to take the lead and eventually win on Opening Day at Cincinnati 6-4. It marked the Giants' second Opening Day win in the last 125 seasons when trailing entering the 9th inning (other time: April 10, 1968 vs. New York Mets).

PEN TO PAPER: SF had 4.0 scoreless frames from its bullpen in game one...it's the second time in the Divisional Era that the bullpen pitched 4.0+ scoreless innings while allowing one-or-fewer hits on Opening Day (9.1 IP, 0R, 1H on Opening Day, 1998 at Houston).

- ▶ Since the start of last season, SF's 3.42 bullpen ERA (228er, 600.2ip) ranks third-best in the Majors behind only San Diego's 3.03 ERA and Boston's 3.37 ERA.

AHH-RISE!: IF Luis Arraez is riding a career-best tying 16-game hitting streak into today's game that dates to last September (Sept. 10)...his other 16-game hitting streak came earlier in 2025 (July 18-August 3).

- ▶ During this season-spanning streak, Arraez is 24-for-63 (.381) with a double, homer, seven RBI, five walks and three strikeouts.
- ▶ Arraez, who was named to the WBC All-Tournament team for his performance with tournament-winning Venezuela, signed a one-year deal with SF in the offseason.
- ▶ In 14 career games here at Oracle Park, Arraez is a .291 hitter (16-for-55) with four doubles and two RBI...in his 14 career games here he's only struck out one time.

TONY THE GIANT: Manager **Tony Vitello** made his MLB managerial debut in Wednesday's loss...he looks for his first career win today after being named the 40th field manager in Giants history on October 22, 2025.

- ▶ Oddly enough, Vitello joined each of the last four SF managers (**Bob Melvin**, **Kai Correa**, **Gabe Kapler** and **Bruce Bochy**) in losing their first game as Giants manager...the last Giants manager to win in their debut was **Felipe Alou** in 2003.
- ▶ Melvin and Correa each won their second game as manager while Bochy and Kapler had to wait until their third game.
- ▶ Vitello spent the last eight years (2018-2025) as head coach of the University of Tennessee where he went 341-131 (.722), leading the Vols to a National Championship in 2024.
- ▶ The 47-year-old helped transform Tennessee baseball into a national powerhouse during his time in Knoxville, guiding the program to six NCAA regional appearances (2019, 2021-2025), five super regionals (2021-2025) and three Men's College World Series appearances (2021, 2023, 2024).

COACHES CORNER: Along with the hiring of **MGR Tony Vitello** came almost an entirely new coaching staff save for three members of the 2025 staff.

- ▶ Assistant Hitting Coach **Oscar Bernard**, ML Field Coordinator & Catching Coach **Alex Burg** and Quality Control Coach **Taira Uematsu** all remained from last year's staff with Burg adding the Major League Field Coordinator role to his duties.
- ▶ Joining Vitello's staff for 2026 are Bench Coach **Jayce Tingler**, Pitching Coach **Justin Meccage** (*message*), Assistant Pitching Coach **Christian Wonders**, Director of ML Pitching **Frank Anderson**, Bullpen Coach **Jesse Chavez**, Hitting Coach **Hunter Mense** (*mehns*), 3B Coach **Hector Borg**, 1B Coach **Shane Robinson** and ML Infield Coach **Ron Washington**.

REINFORCEMENTS, ASSEMBLE: The Giants brought in nine players on Major League contracts this past offseason...a full chart of the newbies can be found below.

- ▶ The deal for **RHP Adrian Houser** also includes a club option for the 2028 season, while the contract for **RHP Rowan Wick** includes a club option for the 2027 campaign.
- ▶ **LHP Ryan Borucki** was signed this past Saturday after he opted out of his minor league deal with the Chicago White Sox and joined SF on its flight home from Arizona on Saturday.
- ▶ Additionally, the Giants brought in **C Daniel Susac** in a trade with the Minnesota Twins on December 10...Susac was selected by the Twins in the Major League phase of the Rule 5 draft and must stay on the Giants' roster all season or be offered back to the team he was selected from (the A's).
- ▶ Susac is still seeking his MLB debut after not getting into the game on Wednesday afternoon.
- ▶ **RHP Jason Foley** (60-day IL), **LHP Sam Hentges** (15-day IL) and Wick (60-day IL) will begin the season on the IL as they recover from surgeries performed in 2025.

SPRING SZN: SF was 19-9-1 during Cactus League play, the second-best mark in the circuit behind only the Dodgers (20-9-2)...the Giants hit .300 as a team, best in MLB ahead of the Rockies (.284)...the club's .848 OPS in spring was third-best in the Majors behind only the Rockies (.858) and A's (.855).

- ▶ Additionally, the Giants struck out 216 times in 29 Cactus League games, which was second-fewest in MLB this Spring Training...only the Tigers (214) had fewer strikeouts...for comparison's sake, SF struck out 296 times in 31 contests during Cactus League play last year.

THE DUBBA DUBBA WBC: San Francisco had six players from its Opening Day roster participate in the WBC with **IF Luis Arraez** and **RHP José Buttó** playing for the victors Venezuela.

- ▶ The others were **OF Harrison Bader** (Israel), **OF Jung Hoo Lee** (Korea), **OF Heliot Ramos** (Puerto Rico) and **RHP Logan Webb** (USA).
- ▶ Two of SF's seven players made the WBC All-Tournament Team in Arraez and Webb.

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner enters his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors...the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LOOKIN' SHARP IN CACTUS LEAGUE: Made six starts in Arizona's Cactus League this spring and posted a 2-0 record with a 1.37 ERA (3er, 19.2ip)...he struck out 21 batters, allowed just five hits and posted a 0.86 WHIP overall his six outings...had a two-start stretch from March 9-15 where he did not allow a hit (9.0 total innings) hit one, walked four and struck out 12...his last start came on March 21 against Cleveland where he threw 5.0 innings and allowed one run on three hits with six strikeouts.

AGAINST THE YANKEES: Is slated to make his eighth career start against New York-AL...is 2-3 with a 3.96 ERA (16er, 36.1ip) over seven career starts, dating back to 2016...he most recently faced the Yankees on April 11, 2025 in New York and earned the win as he threw 4.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits with seven strikeouts in a rain-shortened game...he's never faced the Yankees here at Oracle Park.

2025 RECAP: Was selected to the NL All-Star team for the second time in his career (also 2017 with the Diamondbacks), pitching the best first half of his 12-year MLB career, as he posted his lowest career ERA (2.65) before the break (min. nine starts)...overall he started 32 games for SF, finishing the year with a 11-8 record and 3.65 ERA after posting a 5.54 ERA in 12 starts after the break...the 3.65 season ERA was his lowest since his Cy Young season in 2021 (2.84) and fourth-lowest in his 12-year career.

LUCKY CHARM: The Giants won each of Ray's first nine starts in 2025, making him the first Giants starter to have the team win each of his first nine starts of a season since **Bill Swift** in 1992 (11 wins to start the season).

SEVEN UP: Last season, he carried a perfect 7-0 record into his final start of May before taking a loss in his 12th start of the year on May 31st at Miami...became the first Giants starter since Hall of Famer **Juan Marichal** (1966) to tally at least seven wins and remain undefeated through his first 11 starts of a season...he also joined **Kevin Gausman** (2021) as the only Giants starters in the Wild Card Era to start a season 7-0.

ROBBIE RAY MAY: Was named the National League Pitcher of the Month for May 2025 after going 4-1 with a 1.38 ERA (6er, 39.0ip), 45 strikeouts, a 0.87 WHIP and a .169 opposing batting average in six May starts...the southpaw became the first Giant with an ERA of 1.38 or lower in a month and at least 39.0 innings pitched since **Madison Bumgarner** in May 2016 (1.05 ERA, 42.2ip)...the honor was the second Pitcher of the Month award of Ray's career (also: AL Pitcher of the Month in August 2021 with Toronto).

CHANGING THINGS UP: Last spring, he told reporters that he added a changeup to his pitch mix after connecting with 2024 AL Cy Young Tarik Skubal in the offseason to learn about his grip...Skubal sent Ray pictures, video and was available to chat with him about the pitch...Ray threw it 399 times (13.0% of the time) through 32 starts last year (all to righties), with batters going 17-for-73 (.233) with 16 strikeouts off the pitch.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers slashed .188/.282/.318 off him last season...the .188 average was third-best in the National League, trailing LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (.174) and SD's Nick Pivetta (.185).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Batters hit .208 (75x361) off his four-seamer last season, his most used pitch (52.0%)...the pitch had a +9 run value, his highest of any pitch since 2022 (slider)...additionally, Ray's 108 strikeouts with a four-seamer were most in the NL and ranked second in the Majors behind only MIN's Joe Ryan (109).

GOOD LUCK CHUCK: The Giants were 22-10 in his starts last season...the .688 winning percentage ranked as the second-best record of any NL team behind the same starter, trailing only the Phillies 23-9 (.719) record with Cristopher Sánchez on the mound...it also tied NYY's Max Fried for the third-best team record among starters in MLB, (other: Boston's Garret Crochet at 23-9).

TYLER MAHLE RHP #54

2025 RECORD: 6-4, 2.18 ERA

- ▶ Will make his first start in a Giants uniform tomorrow.
- ▶ The 31-year-old signed a one-year deal with the Giants on January 5, 2026 and is entering his 10th MLB season.
- ▶ Spent the 2025 season with Texas under Bruce Bochy and owned a career-best 2.18 ERA and 1.13 WHIP in 16 starts.
- ▶ Named Rangers Player of the Month for March/April after going 3-0 with a 1.14 ERA and 0.98 WHIP in six starts through April and led the AL in ERA, opponents' OPS (.465), and slugging (.211) in the first month of the season.

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 3/23 vs. MTY; 1.0ip (14 pitches)

- ▶ Was on his fourth career Opening Day roster (also with Pirates in 2025, 2024 and with Blue Jays in 2021).
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20... was in camp with the Sox as a NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings...threw 1.0-scoreless inning for SF in their exhibition game on 3/23 vs. Monterrey.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).
