8 JONATHAN ARANDA L/R SUN. ATTEX: 2-4, 2B, RBI CURRENT STREAK: 3G, 6-13 (.462) vs. LHP: 37-148 (.250), 3 HR, 16 RBI ATL SERIES: - TEX SERIES: 6-16, 2 2B, 2HR, 6RBI, BB, 4R vs. RHP: 110-378 (.291), 16 HR, 70 RBI .279 19 HR 86 RBI 0 SB ★ Ranks among AL leaders in multi-RBI games (T5th, 23), RBI (5th, 86), hits (T6th, 147), and multi-hit games (7th, 40). ★ On Sat. at TEX, recorded his second career go-ahead homer in extras, joining a 10th-inning walk-off on April 19, 2025 vs. NYY...was the fourth such homer by a Rays LHB vs. a LHP, first since Jake Bauers on June 24, 2018 vs. NYY (Chasen Shreve)...was the fourth time he homered in back-to-back games, the first since Sept. 26-27, 2024...has 4 HR in his last 12G. ★ Has been thrown 1,536 fastballs, third in the AL behind CLE Steven Kwan (1,546) and LAA Mike Trout (1,544)...23 of 42 XBH (16 2B, 7HR) have come on fastballs. ★ Across his last 75 games (June 12-pres.), he has multiple hits in 24 contests, tied for fifth-most multi-hit efforts in the AL over that span...produced a career-high-tying four-game multi-hit streak (4x, last: May 25-29) from July 8-11...was the third time he's turned the trick this season, and the only other Rays to do so this season are Yandy Díaz (June 17-21) and Chandler Simpson (Aug. 8-11). ★ Launched the second-farthest HR of his career Aug. 29 vs. SD, a 453-ft. shot that was the second-farthest by a Ray at Tropicana Field this season...marked his 100th career XBH...hit two long balls in a five-game span (Aug. 24-29) after hitting just four from June 1-Aug. 23 (71G). ★ In May, he led the majors in average (.374/34-for-91) and on-base pct. (.464)...he also ranked highly in OPS (2nd, 1.025) and hits (T2nd)...was the first Ray to lead MLB in average over a month since Díaz in June 2024 (.400)...his 43 RBI were second most in team history through May (Evan Longoria - 2019, 55RBI).	13 JUNIOR CAMINERO ★ R/R SUN. AT TEX: 0-2, RBI, 2BB CURRENT STREAK: 0-2 vs. LHP: 40-136 (.294), 8 HR, 16 RBI ATL SERIES: - TEX SERIES: 4-16, 2B, HR, 4RBI, 2BB, 2R vs. RHP: 113-411 (.275), 30 HR, 76 RBI .280 38 HR 92 RBI 3 SB ★ With his solo shot in the 1st inning on Sat. at TEX, became the 12th player in the modern era with 90 home runs before his age-23 season...he is two home runs shy of becoming the first player in franchise history with multiple 40-homer seasons, the second player in the modern era with back-to-back 40-home-run seasons in age-22-or-younger campaigns, and the first primary third baseman to have back-to-back 40-homer seasons since COL Nolan Arenado (2015-16). ★ With an RBI-single in the 9th inning on Fri. at TEX, reached the 90-RBI mark for the second straight season...is the sixth player since 2000 to reach 90 RBI or more in multiple seasons by his age-22-or-younger season, and is the first since Juan Soto (2019, 2021). ★ He has an RBI in 12 of his last 18 games (Aug. 19-pres.) and 17 of his last 26 (Aug. 10-pres.)...has three home runs in his last nine games after a career-high-tying 15-game drought (Aug. 12-28) without a long ball. ★ Ranks among AL leaders in home runs (T1st, 38), total bases (2nd, 290), SLG (2nd, .530), RBI (3rd, 92), hits (4th, 153), XBH (5th, 60), runs (7th, 87), and walks (T9th, 72). ★ Had his 15-game hitting streak snapped on Wed. vs. NYM...went 21-for-59 (.356) with 2 2B, 2 HR, 9 RBI, and 8 R during the streak...became the youngest Ray (23.058) to produce a 15-game hitting streak or longer...was the longest streak by a Ray this season. ★ Through 143 team games, Caminero is on pace to finish the season with 43 homers and 104 RBI...he would become the 15th player in the modern era (since 1900) to have triple-digit RBI in multiple age-22-or-younger seasons, the first since FLA Miguel Cabrera (2004-05)...he has started every game this season and could join Evan Longoria (2014) and Aubrey Huff (2003) as the only Rays to appear in each of the club's games during a single season. ★ His 37 hits of 110 mph or faster this year are the most in the majors...also leads the majors with 178 batted balls hit at 100 mph or faster and paces MLB with an average bat speed of 79.6 mph. ★ Min. 200 AB, his .323 (86-for-266) average vs. fastballs ranks fourth in the AL...has tallied 31 of his 59 XBH vs. fastballs (11 2B, 20HR). ★ Launched his 35th home run of the campaign on Aug. 11 at ATH...he became the third player in the modern era with multiple 35-HR seasons before his age-23 season, joining SEA Alex Rodriguez (1998, 1996) and MLN Eddie Mathews (1953-54)...became the fourth Dominican-born third baseman in MLB history with multiple 35-HR seasons (also: José Ramírez, 3; Adrian Beltré, 2; Aramis Ramírez, 2)...he is also the second Ray with multiple 35-HR seasons (Carlos Peña - 2009, 2007) and the only Ray to have back-to-back 35-HR seasons.	21 JONNNY DeLUCA R/R SUN. AT TEX: 2-5, RBI CURRENT STREAK: 1G, 2-5 (.400) vs. LHP: 32-121 (.264), 2 HR, 20 RBI ATL SERIES: - TEX SERIES: 2-8, BB, RBI vs. RHP: 45-173 (.260), 7 HR, 23 RBI .262 9 HR 42 RBI 14 SB ★ Min. 100 AB, his .328 (45-for-137) average on the road leads the AL and ranks fourth in MLB...has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 road starts (July 17 [G1]-pres.). ★ Has hit safely in 23 of 37 games since the All-Star break, going 35-for-129 (.271) with 7 2B, 4 HR, 18 RBI, and 10 multi-hit efforts in that span. ★ Has batted .333 (5-for-15) with 7 RBI as a pinch hitter, the most hits as a pinch hitter by a Ray since Harold Ramírez recorded a franchise-record 11 in 2023...his 7 RBI as a pinch hitter are third in the majors and his five hits are tied for seventh in the AL. ★ Launched a game-tying, two-run home run in the 9th inning Aug. 30 off of SD Mason Miller...he later reached on an error in the 11th inning that tied the game... it is the second time in team history that a player tied the same game twice in the 9th inning or later (Aubrey Huff - Aug. 31, 2004 vs. BAL, 9th, HR; 11th, 1B).	2 YANDY DÍAZ ★ R/R SUN. ATTEX: 2-5, RBI, R, SO CURRENT STREAK: 1G, 2-5 (.400) vs. LHP: 46-153 (.301), 8 HR, 26 RBI ATL SERIES: - TEX SERIES: 7-18, 2B, RBI, BB, 3R vs. RHP: 121-395 (.306), 13 HR, 51 RBI .305 21 HR 77 RBI 3 SB ★ Has tallied multiple hits in 14 of his last 27 games (Aug. 9-pres.), tied with teammate Chandler Simpson for most in the AL over that span...over those 27 games, he is 40-for-114 (.351) with 4 2B, 6 HR, 13 RBI, and 22 R...included a season-high 11-game hitting streak from Aug. 9-20. ★ Paces the AL in hits (167) and ranks highly in hard-hit balls (T1st, 225), multi-hit games (2nd, 49), average (3rd, .305), total bases (5th, 256), and OBP (5th, .372). ★ He leads MLB in average from the 7th inning on (.382/58-for-152) and average vs. relievers (.368/74-for-201) and is third in RISP average (.387/41-for-106). ★ His 14.5 pct. whiff rate is third lowest in the AL behind CLE Steven Kwan (8.4%) and teammate Chandler Simpson (10.3%)...his 13.1 pct. whiff rate vs. breaking balls is the third lowest in the majors behind PHI Luis Arraez (10.2%) and SF Jung Hoo Lee (12.8%) (min. 300 breaking pitches). ★ His 38 opposite-field home runs are tied with NYM Juan Soto for second most in MLB since he joined the club in 2019, behind NYY Aaron Judge (57)...he accounts for 10.6 pct. of all opposite-field long balls (38-of-360) in team history, according to Baseball-Reference. ★ Launched home runs in back-to-back games (Aug. 10-11) for the eighth time in his career (last: May 29-30, 2026)...his leadoff home run on Aug. 10 at ATH was his sixth of the year (T5th in MLB) and 27th of his career and as a Ray...since his first season with the Rays in 2019, he has the eighth-most leadoff home runs in the majors...the Rays are 5-1 when he launches a leadoff home run this season. ★ He had three hits or more in consecutive games for the seventh time in his career (last: June 5-6, 2026) with four hits on Aug. 9 at SEA and three hits Aug. 10 at ATH...his 13 games with three hits or more in 2026 are tied for second most in the AL and tied for fifth most in the majors. ★ With his solo home run on Aug. 28 vs. SD, surpassed B.J. Upton (118) for fifth-most home runs in franchise history...is eight shy of tying Aubrey Huff (128) for fourth most...also surpassed Carlos Peña (468) for fourth most RBI in team history...is now 38 shy of tying Ben Zobrist (511) for third most. ★ July 24 vs. CLE was his 915th game with the Rays, surpassing Kevin Kiermaier (914) for fifth most in franchise history...is now 12 games behind B.J. Upton (966) for fourth most...he played in his 1,000th career game on July 21 at TOR, becoming the 24th Cuban-born player to reach the millennium mark.	40 NICK FORTES R/R SUN. - ★ Launched a solo home run in the 5th inning on Sat. at TEX, his second in as many games...marked the second time in his career he has homered in back-to-back games (also: Sept. 12-13, 2023 w/ STL)...has three homers in his last four games with a PA after going homerless in his previous 22 contests (Aug. 4-31)... each of his last five have come with two outs...five of his eight have come since the All-Star break.
- ★ Has gone 4-for-39 (.103) since hitting .375 (12-for-32) over an 11-game span (Aug. 8-19)...snapped an 0-for-24 skid with a single on Aug. 31.
- ★ When the Rays are leading, he is hitting .254 (32-for-126) compared to a .208 (37-for-178) average when the game is tied or the Rays are trailing.
- ★ Hit safely in four straight games from Aug. 11-15, matching his longest hitting streak as a Ray (6x) and his longest this season (also: May 18-22).
- ★ Notched his 16th multi-hit game of the season on Aug. 14 vs. BAL, four of which have come in his last 28 games (Aug. 3-pres.)...has gone 18-for-77 (.234) with 4 2B, 4 HR, 13 RBI, and 10 BB in that span after going 5-for-40 (.125) with 1 2B, 2 HR, 4 RBI, and 5 BB in his previous 15 contests (July 9-Aug. 2).

- * In 71 games between Triple-A Durham (5G) and Double-A Montgomery (66G) this season, has hit .270 (68-for-252) with 24 2B, 1 3B, 12 HR, 43 RBI, 37 BB, and 42 R...began the season with the Biscuits (April 3–May 20) slashing .287/.360/.563 (25-for-87) with 9 2B, 5 HR, 17 RBI, and 14 R over his first 24 games.

- ★ Has notched multiple hits in 21 of his last 39G (July 24–pres.)...his 51 multi-hit games are the most in the AL (3rd in MLB) and the third most by a Ray since 2020 behind **Yandy Diaz** (2025 & 2023, both 53).
- ★ He has 57 infield hits this season, according to Baseball Savant, tying SEA **Ichiro Suzuki** (57, 2008) for fifth most in a single season in the pitch-tracking era (since 2008)...is two shy of tying **Dee Strange-Gordon** (59, 2015) for fourth most and eight shy of tying Ichiro (65, 2010) for the most...is tied with **Jason Tyner** (14, 2001) for most bunt hits in a single season in franchise history, per Stats Perform.
- ★ Has reached base in 56 of his last 66 games (June 19–pres.), batting .358 (91-for-254) with 10 2B, 2 3B, 17 RBI, 10 BB, 25 R, 15 SO, 25 SB, and 31 multi-hit efforts over that span, after going 3-for-44 (.068) in his 16 games prior...leads the majors in average, hits, multi-hit games, and stolen bases in that span.
- ★ With 41 hits and 11 steals in August, he became the first player in franchise history to lead the majors in both hits and steals during a month and the first major leaguer to turn the trick since LAD **Shohei Ohtani** (42H/16SB) in September 2024, per Elias.
- ★ His 82 SB are the most within a player's first two seasons in Rays history, ahead of **Carl Crawford** (64)...is the second player to debut during the Wild Card era (since 1995) and reach that mark across his first two campaigns, joining CIN **Elly De La Cruz** (102; 2023-24) and SEA **Ichiro Suzuki** (87; 2001-02).
- ★ His 279 career hits are the fourth most by a Ray over his first two MLB seasons, 7 shy of tying **Evan Longoria** (286) for third most...is on pace for 300 career hits by the end of the season, which would be the third most by a Ray across his first two campaigns behind **Rocco Baldelli** (329, 2003-04) and **Aki Iwamura** (312, 2007-08).
- ★ Is 32-for-78 (.410) vs. LHP over his last 61 games (June 24–pres.) after going 0-for-22 against southpaws in his previous 21 games (May 30–June 23).
- ★ Ranks highly among MLB hitters in infield hits (1st, 57; Baseball Savant), ground-ball hits (1st, 99), and bunt hits (2nd, 14)...is tied for the AL lead in triples (6), is second in AVG (.308), and is second in stolen bases (39) behind NYY **Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (40).
- ★ Owns the fastest home-to-first time in MLB (3.96 sec.)...has the most "bolts" in MLB with 108 (defined as any run at or above 30.0 ft./sec.).
- ★ His 83 stolen bases are ninth most in franchise history...is four shy of tying **Taylor Walls** (87) for eighth most...has recorded 14 career multi-steal games, tying **José Caballero** for third most in franchise history.
- ★ Is the fourth Ray with multiple seasons of 30 stolen bases or more (last: Caballero, 2024-25) and is one steal shy of joining Crawford and **B.J. Upton** as the only players in Rays history with multiple seasons of 40 or more...was successful on a career-high 16 straight stolen base attempts from July 2–Aug. 14.
