**BIRDLAND BITES:** Tonight, Baltimore continues a nine-game road trip through Seattle (1-2), Los Angeles-NL (2-1), and Los Angeles-AL (3 G)...The Birds are coming off a seven-game homestand, splitting a four-game set with the Mariners before dropping two of three to the Padres...The O's enter play today 2.0 games back in the Wild Card and 10.5 games behind the Yankees in the AL East.

👉 The Orioles secured their second consecutive series win over Los Angeles-NL yesterday and their first at Dodger Stadium since a three-game set from July 4-6, 2016 (2-1)...The 11-run margin of victory against the Dodgers set a franchise record (regular season and postseason) ahead of Baltimore's 6-0 win in Game 2 of the 1966 World Series...Marked the Orioles largest margin of victory since a 12-0 win on August 17, 2025 at Houston.

👉 **Colton Cowser** tied career highs with three hits (8x, last: 8/25/25 vs. BOS) and four RBI (5x, last: 5/31/26 vs. TOR), including a solo home run in the third inning...**Taylor Ward**, **Pete Alonso**, and **Blaze Alexander** also homered...The O's four home runs were their second most of the season (6 HR, 4/24 vs. BOS) and their most on the road since September 3, 2025 at San Diego (also 4 HR).

👉 Alonso tallied his AL-leading 10<sup>th</sup> opposite field home run and trails only WSH's James Wood (11) for the MLB lead...**Leody Taveras** recorded his career-high and AL-leading fifth triple.

**BREAKING BRAD:** Kyle Bradish recorded a career-high 12 strikeouts in his last start on June 17 at Seattle, allowing one run on five hits and two walks over 7.2 innings to earn the win...It marked the longest start by an Oriole since **Brandon Young** reached 8.0 innings on August 15, 2025 at Houston and the most strikeouts by a Bird since John Means also struck out 12 on May 5, 2021, also at Seattle.

👉 Is one of nine pitchers (12 occurrences) to record 12+ strikeouts in a game this season.

**CALIFORNIA LOVE:** The Birds are 20-6 (.769) against the Angels since 2022, including a 9-3 (.750) mark in Anaheim...It is the best winning percentage by any club against the Angels in that span (min. 10 G) ahead of the Reds (9-3, .750) and Blue Jays (23-9, .719)...Baltimore went 5-1 against Los Angeles-AL last season, including a series win at Angel Stadium from May 9-11 (2-1).

👉 The Orioles have won or tied nine consecutive series against the Angels, one series shy of tying their longest undefeated streak vs. Los Angeles all-time (10 from 1965-66), per *STATS Perform*.

**WEST COASTIN':** Gunnar Henderson has hit safely in 17 of his 19 career games vs. the Angels, including nine straight since April 22, 2024 over which he's slashing .429/.475/.971 (15-for-35) with three doubles, two triples, four home runs, and five multi-hit efforts...The nine-game hitting streak is tied for the longest active streak vs. Los Angeles-AL since 2022 with CHC's Nico Hoerner and TEX's Wyatt Langford.

👉 Henderson's career 1.203 OPS vs. the Angels is the second-highest mark by any player in MLB history (min. 80 PA) behind Todd Zeile (1.356) while his .787 career slugging percentage against the club is the fourth highest (min. 50 PA) by an Orioles player against a single opponent in franchise history (since 1954) behind Luke Scott (.896) vs. Detroit, Bobby Bonilla (.890) vs. Detroit, and Wayne Gross (.796) vs. Cleveland.

**START ME UP:** Through six games of the current nine-game road trip, Baltimore starters have posted a 2.63 ERA (11 ER/37.2 IP) and a .199 (27-for-136) opponent average.

👉 Prior to this period, O's starters owned a 5.56 ERA (99 ER/160.1 IP) and .284 (178-for-626) opponent average across 32 road games.

👉 Since June 14, Oriole starters own a 2.68 ERA (13 ER/43.2 IP), the second-lowest mark in the majors behind the Brewers (2.56).

**WALKING IT OUT:** Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 70 straight games since April 6, the second-longest active streak in the majors this season behind St. Louis (75).

👉 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season on April 5 at Pittsburgh...The Orioles join the Brewers as the only teams in MLB to have only one game with zero walks.

👉 Baltimore is 29-25 when drawing 3+ walks, compared to 8-17 when drawing two or fewer free passes.

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT:** Blaze Alexander is slashing .389/.427/.583 (42-for-108) with 10 doubles, one triple, three home runs, 14 runs, 22 RBI, six walks (1 IBB), five stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 41 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

👉 Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 100 PA) in batting average (1<sup>st</sup>), on-base percentage (4<sup>th</sup>), and OPS (5<sup>th</sup>, 1.011)...His seven games with at least three hits during that stretch are tied for the major league lead with NYM's Carson Benge.

**CAN'T WARD HIM OFF:** Taylor Ward ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3<sup>rd</sup>, 64), times on base (4<sup>th</sup>, 141), and on-base percentage (10<sup>th</sup>, .393)...Gunnar Henderson led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

👉 The only Oriole player in team history (since 1954) to have more walks prior to July in a season was Randy Milligan (1990), who had 65 walks through June that season.

👉 Ward recorded 63 walks and 70 hits through 75 career games with the Orioles...The only other player to have at least 60 walks and 70 hits through 75 career games with the club in franchise history (since 1954) was Ken Singleton (64 BB, 81 H).

👉 His 15 multi-walk games are second most in the majors behind LAA's Mike Trout (19)...Last season, Jackson Holliday led the Orioles with nine multi-walk efforts.

**TROUBLE WITH THE 2'S:** Orioles pitching has allowed opponents to slash .260/.350/.408 with two outs...The batting average is second highest in MLB ahead of the Rangers (.261)...The on-base percentage is third highest in MLB ahead of the Angels (.364) and Reds (.352)...Their .758 OPS is fourth highest in the majors ahead of the Royals (.791), Rangers (.763), and Reds (.761).

👉 Baltimore hurlers own a .552 opponent OPS with two strikes, the third-highest clip in MLB ahead of Colorado (.607) and the Athletics (.565).

👉 Orioles hitters own a .154 batting average with two strikes, tied for the second-lowest clip in the majors ahead of the Mets (.152).

**QUICK HITS:** Bradish is scheduled to make his 16<sup>th</sup> start of the season and 83<sup>rd</sup> of his career tonight in the series opener at Los Angeles-AL... Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

**WHIFFIN' IN SEATTLE:** Bradish recorded a career-high 12 strikeouts in his last start on June 17 at Seattle, earning his fourth win of the season with 7.2 innings of one-run ball on five hits and two walks... It marked the longest start by an Oriole since **Brandon Young** tossed 8.0 scoreless innings on August 15, 2025 at Houston...Threw 100 pitches, 65 strikes.

- ⚡ Became the first Oriole to record 12+ strikeouts since John Means (also 12 Ks) threw a no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle.
- ⚡ Talled a career-high-tying 18 whiffs (also 9/20/23 at HOU), the most by an Oriole this season ahead of **Cade Povich** on April 12 vs. San Francisco and **Trevor Rogers** on April 14 vs. Arizona (both 17).

**FAMILIAR FOE:** Bradish was originally selected by Los Angeles-AL in the fourth round (No. 121 overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, and he made his professional debut the following year for High-A Inland Empire, going 6-7 with a 4.28 ERA (48 ER/101.0 IP) and 120 strikeouts over 24 appearances (18 GS)...He was acquired by the O's on December 4, 2019, along with three other players from the Angels in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy.

- ⚡ Has made one start vs. the Angels, earning the win on May 17, 2023 at Camden Yards after tossing 6.2 innings of one-run ball on four hits (1 HR) and zero walks with five strikeouts.

**WALK DON'T RUN:** Bradish's 11.7 percent walk rate this season is the highest of his career (9.2%; 2024) and is the second-highest mark in the majors among qualified pitchers ahead of LAA's José Soriano (12.0%).

- ⚡ Has allowed at least three walks in 11 of his 15 starts this season... The 11 starts with 3+ walks mark the most such games among MLB starters behind Soriano (9 G).

**ABOVE THE CURVE:** In his last start at Seattle, opponents went 1-for-6 with four strikeouts and eight whiffs on his curveball.

- ⚡ Over his first 12 starts this season, Bradish used it 23.0 percent of the time and held opponents to a .154 (8-for-52) average on the pitch with four doubles and no home runs.
- ⚡ Prior to his last start, opponents went 4-for-4 with one double and two home runs off Bradish's curveball across two outings from June 6-11.
- ⚡ Bradish's 43.1 percent whiff rate on his curve is the third-highest mark among all MLB starters (min. 150 curveballs thrown) behind CWS's Davis Martin (44.1%) and WSH's Jake Irvin (43.9%).

**SLIDE AWAY:** Opponents have gone 21-for-78 (.269) off Bradish's slider with three doubles, two triples, and six home runs...His .590 opponent slugging percentage off the offering is the highest mark in MLB (min. 60 AB ending in pitch) with the next closest pitchers being WSH's Mitchell Parker (.543).

- ⚡ Opponents slashed .063/.063/.156 (2-for-32) off his slider with one home run in 2025.

**THAT'S LIFE:** Over five starts from May 8-31, Bradish went 2-2 with a 1.72 ERA (6 ER/31.1 IP), .171 (19-for-111) opponent average, and 0.99 WHIP...His 1.72 ERA during that period was third lowest in MLB (min. 30.0 IP) behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (0.00) and MIL's Jacob Misiorowski (0.27).

- ⚡ In three starts this month, he is 1-1 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER/15.2 IP), .339 (21-for-62) opponent average, and 1.85 WHIP.

**BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL:** Bradish owns a 55.0 percent first-pitch strike rate, the third-lowest mark in MLB among qualified pitchers ahead of CLE's Joey Cantillo (54.4%) and ATH's J.T. Ginn (54.7%)...Has thrown 44 of 70 (63.0%) first pitches for strikes over three starts this month.

- ⚡ In his six starts last season, Bradish posted a 63.5 percent first-pitch strike rate.

**FIRST-INNING FOCUS:** Bradish has allowed only two runs in the opening frame this season, one of which was a leadoff homer in his previous start on June 11 vs. Seattle...Opponents are slashing .204/.304/.347 (10-for-49) in the first inning compared to a .274/.359/.452 (71-for-259) line from the second inning on.
