TODAY'S GAME:

- Is the second game (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Chris Ware's Phillies** and Game 5 (2-2) of Cin's final road trip before the All-Star break, a 7-day/6-game excursion that includes a 1-2 series loss against the **Red Sox** (Mon-Wed).
- With a win today, the Reds can move to 5 games above .500 (47-42) for the first time since 9/19/23 (79-74).
- Following tomorrow's series finale at **Citizens Bank Park**, the Reds return to **Great American Ball Park** for a 7-game homestand vs **Mia** (4g, 7/7-7/10) and **Col** (3g, 7/11-7/13).

**SERIES NOTES:** The Reds and **Phillies** are facing off for the first time this season...these teams will wrap up their season series from 8/11-8/13 at **Great American Ball Park**.

- Cin went 4-3 against **Phi** in 2024, taking 2 of 3 at **Citizens Bank Park** from 4/1-4/3 before splitting a 4-game set from 4/22-4/25 at **GABP**.
- INF/OF Spencer Steer** on 4/1/24 at **Phi** hit a go-ahead grand slam in the 10th inning of that night's 6-3 win...marked the first grand slam by a Red in extras since **Todd Frazier's** walkoff slam on 6/17/15 vs **Det**.
- The 7-0 **Phillies** win on 4/22/24 took 2 hours and 2 minutes...it was the quickest 9-inning game at **Great American Ball Park** since 9/5/06, when the Reds blanked the **Giants**, 3-0, also in 2 hours and 2 minutes.

**FRANCONA CLOSING IN ON 2000 WINS:** **Terry Francona** enters today's game 4 wins away from reaching 2,000 as a Major League manager.

- He'd become the 13th manager to reach the 2,000-win milestone.
- Would be the second active manager in the majors with 2,000 wins (**Tex' Bruce Bochy** 2,214).
- Each big league skipper with 2,000 career wins, except for **Bochy** and **Dusty Baker**, are in the Hall of Fame.
- Baker** (2,183) and **Sparky Anderson** (2,194 wins) are the only 2,000-win skippers to manage the Reds.
- Leo Durocher** is the only 2,000-win manager to play for Cin (1930-33).
- Would be the fourth manager to earn his 2,000th win for a team he once played for (1987), joining **Bochy (SF)**, **Bucky Harris (Det)**, and **John McGraw (NYG)**.

**FEELING GRAND:** **INF Christian Encarnacion-Strand** on Wed at **Bos** delivered a go-ahead grand slam off **Craig Weissert** in the 7th inning...marked the first grand slam of his career and the sixth by a **Reds** batter this season.

- Cin's 6 grand slams in 2025 are tied with **Sea** for second-most among all Major League clubs, fewer than only **AZ** (8).
- Per **Elias**, **Encarnacion-Strand** became just the fourth player in Reds history to hit a grand slam with Cin trailing by exactly 3 runs in the 7th inning or later, joining **Adam Dunn** (6/30/06 vs **Cle**), **Ken Griffey Jr.** (5/20/06 at **Det**), and **Samuel Byrd** (5/23/1936 vs **Pit**).
- Encarnacion-Strand** finished with a career-high-tying 4 RBI (3x, last: 4/14/24 at **CWS**)...marked his 10th career game with at least 3 RBI, second-most by a Red through his first 126 Major League apps since RBI became an official stat in 1920 (**Jim Greengrass**, 13g, 1952-53).
- With an estimated distance of 439 feet, marked the third-longest grand slam by a Red in the Statcast era (since 2015), behind **Matt Davidson** (449 feet) on 8/21/20 at **StL** & **Adam Duvall** (441 feet) on 5/30/18 at **AZ**.

**NATIONAL LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** **INF/OF Spencer Steer** on Mon was named National League Player of the Week for 6/23-6/29, marking his second career weekly honor (also: 4/1-4/7, 2024).

- During the week, slashed .444/.448/.815 (12-for-27) with 3 homers, 8 RBI, and 5 runs in 7 games...in that time, led qualified Major Leaguers in AVG (.522), SLG (.957), OPS (1.477), hits (12), and total bases (22).
- In the 8-1 win on 6/27 vs **SD**, he produced his first career 3-homer game, the first by a Red since **OF Jesse Winker** did it on 6/6/21 at **StL**...the second of his 3 HR on the night marked his 150th career XBH.

**NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM:** The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 29 series this season, including the current 3-game set at **Phi**.

- Marks their longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to open a season since 1989, when they went 30 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 7/17-7/19 vs **Phi**.
- The Reds are the only Major League team that have yet to be swept this season.

**WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST:** The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the 1st inning 27 times this season, most recently on 6/28 vs **SD** (1r, 3h, 1bb).

- Cin has plated 63 runs in the 1st inning this season, tied with **Wsh** for third-most in MLB, behind only **LAD** (65) and **Bos** (64)...this includes the 10 runs plated in the 1st inning on 5/10 at **Hou**.
- Cin has outscored opponents 63-41 in the first inning and are slashing .262/.345/.409 with 10 home runs.
- Have plated multiple runs in the opening frame of a game 18 times this season (last: 6/27 vs **SD**), tied with the **Tigers** for the most-such instances in MLB.

**ELLECTRICITY:** Over his last 40 games dating back to 5/19, **SS Elly De La Cruz** is slashing .314/.390/.595 (48-for-153, 10hr, 21xbh, 38r, 19bb, 29rbi).

- His 60 RBI in 2025 are most by a primary Reds shortstop (>50% of G at the position) before the All-Star break in club history (the first ASG was in 1933), surpassing the previous mark of 52 set by **Barry Larkin** 1999...are also the most ever by a Cin switch hitter prior to the ASB.
- Is batting .295/.378/.537 this season vs **RHP** (67-for-227, 13hr, 44rbi).
- Against left-handed pitchers in June, slashed .338/.442/.646 (3hr).
- Is 2 HR shy of joining **Eric Davis** (23hr/33sb, 1987) as the only players in Reds history with at least 20 HR and 20 SB before the All-Star break.
- Swiped his 20th base of 2025 in the 4th inning of the 1-0 win on 6/10 at **Cle**, making him the first player in Reds history with 20 or more steals in each of his first 3 seasons in the majors (courtesy **Elias**).

**THE FUTURE IS HERE:** **C Alfredo Duno** and **INF Sal Stewart** on Mon were selected to represent the Reds organization in the 26th edition of the **All-Star Futures Game**, which will take place on 7/12 at **Truist Park** in Atlanta, GA.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision in the 3-2 win vs SD on Sun, 6/29 (5.1ip, 7h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr, 1hb, 95TP).

- The only run he allowed came off Xander Bogaerts 4th inning solo homer.
- Threw 49 pitches combined in innings 3 & 4.
- Was ahead in the count to just 38% of his 26 batters (10-of-26)...his average this year is 48.8%.
- Threw first pitch-strikes to 57.7% of his 26 batters (15-of-26)...his average this year is 66.5%.
- It marked just the second time in his career in which he allowed at least 7 hits and fewer than 2 runs in a game... he also did it on 4/19/24 vs LAA (7-1 win, 6.1ip, 7h, 1r/1er).

**JUNE 23 vs NYY:** Did not factor in the decision in the 6-1 win vs NYY on Mon, 6/23 (4.1ip, 6h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 6k, 1hr, 94TP).

- Gave up Aaron Judge's 343rd career home run (1st inn.).
- Threw 53 pitches through the first 2 innings.
- Was his fifth start this season in which he didn't walk anyone.

**JUNE 18 CG vs MIN:** Earned the rain-shortened 4-2 CG win vs Min on 6/18 at Great American Ball Park (6.0ip, 3h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 1hb, 87TP)....the game ended in the bottom of the 6th inning with 2 outs...the 6-inning complete game marked his first CG at any professional level.

- Was his ninth quality start of the season.
- Retired 19 of the final 23 batters he faced.
- With Andrew Abbott's 9-inning complete game at Det on 6/10, the Reds turned in CGs over a 7-game for the first time since 2017 (Scott Feldman 5/7 vs SF & Lisalverto Bonilla 5/13 at SF).
- Lodolo's was the first Reds' CG at GABP since Hunter Greene's on 6/6/22 vs AZ (7ip).

**JUNE 11 at CLE:** Suffered the 11-2 loss on 6/11 at Cle (3.1ip, 5h, 6r/6er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 1hb, 76TP).

- Was his shortest start since 8/17/24 vs KC (2.1ip).
- Gave up a 3rd-inning grand slam to Carlos Santana...was the second grand slam he's allowed in his career (also: SF's Matt Chapman, 5/11/24, 1st inning).

**JUNE 6 vs AZ:** Did not factor in the decision in the 10-inning walkoff 4-3 win vs AZ on 6/6 (6.0ip, 5h, 3r/3er, 0bb, 4k, 2hr, 86TP)...was due to come out for the 7th inning until the game was suspended by rain (completed next day).

- Was his fourth start in which he pitched 6.0 innings and didn't walk a batter.
- Was his team-leading eighth quality start of the season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** On 6/30, in his second career Major League app, was reached for 7 runs (5er) on 5 hits in 0.1 inning (2bb, 1hr, 33TP, 9 batters faced) in the Reds' 13-6 loss at Bos.

- Was the shortest start of his professional career and the shortest by a Reds pitcher this season.
- His outing marked the first time a Cin non-opener was pulled before the end of the 1st inning since Frankie Montas on 4/21/24 vs LAA (0.2ip)...RHP Connor Phillips was the last Reds pitcher to record 0.1 inning or less when he didn't get anyone out in his start on 9/30/23 at StL.
- Became the ninth Reds pitcher since at least 1901 to record 1 or 0 outs in a start within their first 2 career games, the first since Eddie Priest on 6/1/98 at SF (0.1 IP).

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT, 6/24:** Was selected from AAA-Louisville on 6/24 and that night made his Major League debut vs NYY, 345 days after the Reds drafted him with the second overall pick in the 2024 First-Year Player Draft.

- Became the second Reds' draft pick in as many seasons and the 13th in franchise history to debut within a year of being drafted (Rhett Lowder debuted in 2024 after being selected seventh overall in 2023).
- Became the first starting pitcher in the expansion era (since 1961) to retire the first 5 batters he faced via strikeout in his ML debut (*Elias*).

Has thrown at least 2 strikes in his first 3 pitches of a plate appearance to 59.6% of his opposing batters (for PAs that qualify)...league average is 53.3%.

350 STRIKEOUT MILESTONE

Collected his 350th career strikeout on 5/25 vs Chc (Ian Happ, 1st inning)...became the second-fastest Reds pitcher by appearances (58g) to reach the 350 strikeout mark since 1893, behind only teammate Hunter Greene (51g, 2022-2024)...(*courtesy Elias*).

NO WALKS TO THE BOTTOM OF THE ORDER:

Has not issued a walk to any of the 110 batters he's faced this year who've batted 7th, 8th, or 9th in the order...he last walked a batter at the bottom of the order on 8/22/24 when he issued a 5th inning free pass to Pit's Jared Triolo, the Pirates' #7 hitter.

- Graduated from Damien High School in La Verne, CA, the same school attended by **Mark McGwire**, rock guitarist **Buckethead** and former Reds pitcher **Frank Pastore**.
- As a junior at Texas Christian University in 2019 was named second team All-American and first team All-Big 12.
