YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles earned the series win with an 11-3 victory, improving to 4-2-0 in series play and 3-1-0 in home series...Gunnar Henderson, Ryan O'Hearn, and Jordan Westburg each homered in the win...Cedric Mullins extended his hitting streak to eight games, the longest by an Oriole this season and his longest since another eight-gamer from September 21-29, 2022...**Grayson Rodriguez** earned his third win of the campaign, completing 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on four hits and three walks with six strikeouts and one wild pitch...**David Bañuelos** made his Major League debut after pinch hitting in the eighth inning; flied out to right

SWEEP DREAMS: The 0's are seeking their second sweep of the season in today's three-game finale against the Twins...The Birds swept the Red Sox in three games at Fenway Park from April 9-11...This would be Baltimore's first sweep of Minnesota since a three-game set at Target Field from July 7-9, 2023...The Orioles haven't swept the Twins at Oriole Park since a three-game set from April 4-7, 2016.

HOMER HAPPY: Entering today's games, the Orioles lead MLB with 27 home runs, tied with the 2016 0's for the most through the first 17 games of a season in club history (since 1954); the most homers through the first 18 games is 29 by the 1966 club...Bird batters have hit at least three home runs in four consecutive games for the first time since May 21-24, 2013; the Orioles have hit three-or-more home runs in at least five consecutive games twice in team history: August

1996 (5 G) and May 8-13, 1987 (6 G).

Ryan O'Hearn has homered in three straight games for the second time in his career, joining May 27 to June 23, 2021 with Kansas City; he is the first O's batter to do so since Anthony Santander from June 23-25, 2023; the last Oriole to homer in four straight games was DJ Stewart from September 5-9, 2020.

Gunnar Henderson has homered in back-to-back games for the third time in his career and first since July 31 to August 1, 2023; his career-best is a three-game streak from June 10-13, 2023. 0

KEEP IT 100: Entering today's games, the Orioles lead the AL and rank fifth in MLB with 100 runs scored, and their +25 run differential is third in the AL and fourth in MLB...Marks the fourth time in team history that the 0's have scored 100+ runs in their first 17 games of a season: 2004 (101 R), 2006 (103 R), and 2000 (109 R)...The team record for the most runs through the first 18 games of a season is 111 by the 2000 squad.

<u>COMEBACK KIDS:</u> Seven of the Orioles' 11 wins this season, including four of their last six, have been in comeback fashion, the most in MLB...Baltimore's 55 comeback wins since the start of last season are the most in MLB...Their 91 come-from-behind victories since the start of 2022 are also the most in MLB.

KIMBREL COUNT: Craig Kimbrel recorded the 421st save of his career Monday night against Minnesota, one behind Billy Wagner for seventh in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (424) has more among active players...Kimbrel now has 1,205 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever; he trails Hoyt Wilhelm (1,363), Goose Gossage (1,340), and Lee Smith (1,225).

STRIKE A POSE: Baltimore pitchers have fanned 158 batters so far in 2024, the most strikeouts in 17 games in 0's history...The total would also be the most through the first 18 games, sing the mark of 155 by the 2023 team.

The Birds have an MLB-best 4.16 strikeout-to-walk ratio; since the mound moved back in 1893, the best K/BB in a full season is 3.98 by the 2017 Cleveland Indians.

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles have gone 97 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in 0's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3).

The 2023 Orioles (52 series) were the fourth MLB team since 2000 to go a full regular season without being swept in a series of at least two decisions, joining the Braves teams of 2022 (51 series), 2004 (52 series), and 2002 (52 series).
