BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles lost their third rubber game in as many series on Wednesday, falling 9-0 in Arizona...The loss capped a 2-4 road trip, which included a three-game set in Kansas City...Following last night's postponement, Baltimore opens an eight-game homestand today, tied for its longest of the year (8/21-28), with the first of two games with Toronto through Sunday, Cleveland from Tuesday-Thursday, and Cincinnati from April 18-20...The club has off days on Monday, April 14 and Monday, April 21.

👉 Baltimore is three games under .500 for the first time since July 8, 2022 (41-44).

👉 The O's were shut out for the second time this year, joining April 2 vs. Boston...They are one of seven teams to be blanked multiple times in a game this season, along with Atlanta, Cincinnati, and Kansas City (3 each), Chicago-AL, Miami, and San Francisco.

👉 Baltimore recorded four hits, the fifth time they've tallied four or fewer hits in 2025, tied with Chicago-NL for most in the majors...The club had 21 such games last year, ranked 16th in MLB.

👉 The Orioles have gone winless in their first four series to open a season for the first time since 2010, when the team did not win any of the first seven series.

👉 Baltimore has not recorded a save through the first 13 games of the season for the first time since 1988 (21 G)...The last MLB team to begin a campaign with no save chances in the first 13 games was the 2019 Colorado Rockies and the last club with more was the 2005 Tampa Bay Devil Rays (15 G).

ALL ABOUT ADLEY: **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his first 12 games, the longest season-opening streak by an Oriole since **Anthony Santander** (18 G) from April 8-27, 2022...**Aaron Hicks** also reached base safely in each of his first 12 games from May 31 to June 14, 2023, but did not sign with the club until May 30 that season.

👉 His 12-game on-base streak is tied for the third longest active stretch in the AL with MIN's Willi Castro, behind ATH's Jacob Wilson and BOS' Kristian Campbell (both 14 G).

👉 Rutschman has gone a career-high 19 straight games with one strikeout or fewer since September 21, 2024...It is tied for the second-longest active streak by an Oriole, trailing **Ramón Urías** (32 G, since 8/16/24).

'PEN PALS: Baltimore relievers had their scoreless innings streak of 11.2 frames snapped on Wednesday after allowing three runs...The O's 3.35 ERA (17 ER/45.2 IP) out of the bullpen ranks fifth in the AL.

👉 **Bryan Baker** has tossed 6.0 scoreless innings to open the season, scattering three hits with no walks and seven strikeouts across six appearances.

👉 **Gregory Soto** has thrown 5.0 scoreless innings over his first five appearances, allowing three hits, two walks, and one hit batter while fanning eight...In 25 appearances since August 8, 2024, Soto is 1-0 with a 0.84 ERA (2 ER/21.1 IP), 0.94 WHIP, and 28 strikeouts.

👉 **Seranthony Dominguez** is 1-0 with two holds, tossing 5.2 scoreless innings across six appearances while allowing one hit and six walks with seven strikeouts.

HOME COOKING: The Orioles are 94-71 (.570) at home since the start of 2023, the fifth-best winning percentage in the AL during that time...However, the team is 16-23 (.410) at Oriole Park since June 30, 2024, ranked third worst in the AL and fourth worst in MLB over that period.

👉 **Ramón Urías** has hit safely in seven straight home games since August 23, 2024, while slashing .375/.400/.583 (9-for-24) with one triple, one homer, two runs scored, and five RBI during that time.

ALL RISP, NO REWARD: In five wins, Baltimore hitters are 19-for-55 (.345) with two doubles, one triple, and two home runs with runners in scoring position, compared to 4-for-33 (.121) with no extra-base hits in eight losses.

👉 O's pitching has limited the opposition to a .190 (22-for-116) RISP average, the fourth-lowest mark in the AL behind the Blue Jays (.168), and Tigers and Astros (both .189)... This includes a .158 (6-for-38) clip over the last five games since April 6.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The O's have grounded into an MLB-leading 16 doubles plays, ahead of the Athletics (15) and Rays (13)...The 16 double plays are the most through 13 games by a Baltimore club since the 2015 Orioles (17) and the most to open a season by an MLB team since the 2024 Yankees (17).

👉 The Birds have grounded into at least one double play in 10 straight games, their longest streak since August 27 to September 6, 2019 (10 G)...It is the longest such streak by an MLB team since the Atlanta Braves from July 29 to August 11, 2024 (13 G)...An Orioles team has not grounded into a double play in more than 10 games since July 25 to August 7, 2016 (13 G).

👉 In 2024, Baltimore's 71 double plays set a record for the fewest in a full season (min. 154 G) in MLB history.

POWER OUTAGE: After hitting 10 home runs in the first three games of the season, Baltimore has registered two long balls over its last 10 contests since March 30, the fewest in the majors during that stretch with the next closest clubs being the Blue Jays and Royals (both 4 HR).

👉 The Birds have 21 extra-base hits (9 2B, 2 3B, 10 HR) and a .974 OPS in five wins, compared to nine extra-base hits (7 2B, 2 HR) and a .464 OPS in seven losses.

HOT AND COLD: The Orioles are batting .268 (78-for-291) from innings 1-6, the best mark in the AL...From the seventh inning on, however, the Birds are hitting .180 (24-for-133), the third-lowest clip in MLB.

BATTLE OF THE BIRDS: The O's and Blue Jays meet for their second series of the season this weekend, now a two-game set following last night's postponement...Baltimore hosts Toronto again for a four-game series from July 28-30, before three games at Rogers Centre from September 12-14.

👉 The O's went 7-6 against the Blue Jays last season, their second consecutive winning season against Toronto...Baltimore has won back-to-back season series against the Jays for only the second time since 1997, joining 2012 (11-7), 2013 (10-9), and 2014 (11-8).

👉 **Adley Rutschman's** .997 OPS against the Jays is the third best among active players behind Los Angeles-AL's Mike Trout (1.032) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (1.007)...Rutschman has three career multi-homer games, all against Toronto, including Opening Day on March 27.

SCORING CHANGES: MLB made several scoring changes impacting statistics for the Orioles from April 6 at Kansas City.

👉 In the first inning, Bobby Witt Jr. reached base on what was originally scored a triple... This has been changed to a fielding error on **Jorge Mateo**...As a result, all three runs charged to **Cade Povich** in the inning are unearned.

👉 In the seventh inning, **Ryan Mountcastle** reached base on what originally scored a triple...This has been changed to a fielding error on Hunter Renfro.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his third career MLB start and second of the season against the Blue Jays...Is the third-ever Japanese player for the Orioles, joining right-handed relievers Shintaro Fujinami (2023) and Koji Uehara (2009-11)...Made five Grapefruit League appearances (4 GS), going 2-1 with a 3.00 ERA (5 ER/15.0 IP) on 11 hits (1 HR) and five walks with 15 strikeouts...His first four outings (10.1 IP) of the spring were scoreless...In his debut, at 35 years, 170 days, became the oldest Japanese player to make his MLB debut since New York-NL's Ken Takahashi (40-016) on May 2, 2009 at Philadelphia.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first career MLB win on April 5 at Kansas City after tossing 5.1 innings of one-run ball on five hits (1 HR), one walk, and one hit batter with four strikeouts...Surrendered a solo home run to Bobby Witt Jr. to lead off the sixth inning...Exited the sixth with one out and two runners on who were stranded on an inning-ending double play...Threw 89 pitches, 59 strikes.

2024 RECAP: Spent the entire season with the Yomiuri Giants of Japan's Nippon Professional Baseball's Central League...Went 15-3 with a 1.67 ERA (29 ER/156.2 IP), 132 hits (6 HR), 16 walks, four hit batters, and 111 strikeouts in 24 games, all starts...Tossed three complete games, including one shutout...Led NPB in wins and finished second in ERA.

- 🏆 Named Central League MVP.
- 🏆 Earned a Mitsui Golden Glove Award.
- 🏆 Surrendered four or fewer runs in all 24 starts, three or less in 23, and one or no runs in 17; tossed six scoreless outings, including his lone complete game shutout on July 28 vs. DeNa (9.0 IP, 7 H, 8 K).
- 🏆 Opened the season with a 20.0-inning scoreless streak; pitched two scoreless games (13.0 IP) to begin the year before allowing an eighth-inning run on April 18 at Hanshin.
- 🏆 Won seven of eight starts from July 21 to September 10, including four straight from July 21 to August 11.
- 🏆 Posted a 1.16 ERA (10 ER/77.1 IP) in his final 11 games beginning July 21.
- 🏆 Helped the Giants secure a bye to the Final Stage of the 2024 Climax Series, NPB's playoff format, with the best record in the Central League (77-59-7)...Suffered two defeats in the series as Yomiuri was eliminated against DeNa...Took the loss in Game 2 after allowing two runs on six hits and one walk with five strikeouts in 7.0 innings...Entered in the ninth inning of a tie game in winner-take-all Game 7 and surrendered one run on two hits.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Sugano compiled a 136-74 record with a 2.43 ERA (501 ER/1,857.0 IP) with 1,568 hits (142 HR), 347 walks (12 IBB), 52 hit batters, and 1,585 strikeouts in 276 career games (248 GS) with the Giants...Was a three-time Central League MVP (2014, 2020, 2024), a three-time Central League Mitsui Golden Glove Award winner (2016-18), an eight-time All-Star (2013-19, 2022), a two-time Eiji Sawamura Award honoree (2017-18), presented to the top pitcher in NPB each season, and MVP of the 2013 Central League Climax Series, the playoff format in NPB...Led the Central League in wins four times (2017-18, 2020, & 2024), ERA four times (2014, 2016-18), and strikeouts twice (2016, 2018)...Earned the triple crown in 2018 after leading NPB in wins, ERA, and strikeouts.

ON THE WORLD STAGE: Pitched for Team Japan at the 2017 World Baseball Classic, pitching to a 3.14 ERA (5 ER/14.1 IP) with one walk and 16 strikeouts in three starts...Tied for the tournament lead in strikeouts with teammate Kodai Senga...Started the semifinal game against Team USA on March 21, 2017, at Dodger Stadium, allowing one unearned run on three hits and one walk with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings.
