TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to clinch their final series of the season with a win in today's penultimate game of 2025.

- ▶ SF is coming off winning Friday's series opener 6-3 behind a 10 strikeout game by rookie **RHP Trevor McDonald**...the 10 strikeouts by McDonald last night gave SF eight games this season in which a pitcher struck out 10 or more batters (ninth-most in MLB).
- ▶ The Giants are 4-9 in their last 13 games (started September 13), getting outscored 75-55 in that span...SF is 3-5 in its last eight home games since September 10.

DREW'S DAY: Giants OF Drew Gilbert celebrates his 25th birthday today.

ROCK ON: SF enters this series with a 9-2 record (.818) vs. the Rockies in 2025...SF's best season record vs. the Rockies was in 2021 when the Giants went 15-4 (.789) in 19 games vs. COL...their fewest losses in a season vs. COL is three (done in 1993, 1994 and 2024).

- ▶ SF has scored at least six runs in nine straight games vs. COL, which is SF's second longest such streak behind only an 11-gamer from September 6, 2021 through May 17, 2022.
- ▶ The Giants have a chance to join the Guardians (over the White Sox) and Dodgers (over the Rockies) as the only teams to have 11 wins vs. one opponent this season.
- ➤ SF will face Rockies starter Kyle Freeland for the fourth time this season...**IF Rafael Devers** is 2-for-4 with two homers in his career vs. Devers while **OF Heliot Ramos**, **IF Willy Adames** and **IF Wilmer Flores** all have also homered vs. Freeland.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Giants enter this series with a 40-39 record at Oracle Park this season...the .506 winning percentage at home ranks tied for 20th in MLB.

- ▶ Discounting the 2020 season, in which there were only 33 home games (19 wins) in a shortened season, SF would need to sweep this three-game series to avoid having its fewest wins at home since its ballpark-worst 35 home wins in 2019.
- ▶ Giants fans have packed Oracle Park this season, with the team's 36,077 average home attendance ranking seventh-best in the Majors this season...that average attendance is SF's best since 2018 (38,965).
- ▶ The Giants logged their 28th sellout (40,048) of the season last night...the 28 sellouts are SF's most in a season since selling out 50 games in 2017.

JV ON A SATURDAY: RHP Justin Verlander will make his final start of 2025...the veteran received the loss in his last start, allowing six runs (four earned) on nine hits and two walks vs. the Cardinals on September 22.

- ▶ Since August 26, Verlander is 2-1 with a 1.78 ERA (7er, 35.1ip), 31 strikeouts and a 1.22 WHIP in six starts...three of those six starts were scoreless while one had one run allowed.
- ▶ This will be Verlander's eighth career start vs. the Rockies (second this season)...he allowed two runs on five hits and a walk while striking out four in 6.1 innings on May 1 at Oracle Park (SF's one loss at home vs. COL this season).

WILLY THE KID: IF Willy Adames was named the 2025 Willie Mac Award winner in a pregame ceremony last night...the award, named after Hall-of-Famer **Willie McCovey**, is annually awarded to the most inspirational player on the Giants, as voted upon by Giants players, coaches, training staff, clubhouse staff, and the fans.

- ▶ He continued the celebration in his first at-bat when he hit a go-ahead two-run home run in the 1st inning last night...he is just one home run away from being the first Giant to have a 30-homer season since **Barry Bonds** in 2004.
- Adames also scored two runs last night, giving him 93 on the season...the 93 runs are the second-most by a Giants primary shortstop in the SF era (since 1958), trailing only the 114 runs scored by **Rich Aurilia** in 2001.

PEN TO PAPER: SF's bullpen tossed 2.0 shutout innings last night (1.0 each from **RHP Joel Peguero** and **RHP Ryan Walker**)...SF's 3.46 bullpen ERA (227er, 590.0ip) is on pace to be its lowest since posting a 2.97 ERA (206er, 623.2ip) in 2021.

BATTING 1ST: OF Heliot Ramos hit his 21st home run of the season in the 2nd inning last night...his 12 home runs this season when batting first in the lineup are the most by a Giant right-handed batter since **Bill Madlock** had 15 in 1978.

FOR 3: OF Jung Hoo Lee hit his 12th triple of the season, which are the most triples by a Giant since **Ángel Pagán** had 15 in 2012...Lee's 12 triples rank third-most in the Majors behind only AZ's Corbin Carroll's 17 and BOS' Jarren Duran's 13.

WITH THE GIANTS: The nine-time All-Star (2007, 2009-2013, 2018-19, 2022), three-time Cy Young Award winner (2011, 2019, 2022) and two-time World Series Champion (2017, 2022) is in his first season with the Giants after signing a one-year, \$15 million deal on January 11, 2025...it marks his 20th season in the Majors.

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed more than two runs for the first time in just over a month on Monday in the Giants' 6-5 loss to the Cardinals to open this homestand...he permitted six runs (four earned) and did not escape the fifth inning, finishing only 4.1 frames with nine hits allowed (one homer), two walks and three strikeouts...it was his shortest outing since also working 4.1 innings back on August 21 at San Diego.

VINTAGE JV: Despite the hiccup last time out, Verlander still owns a 2.57 ERA (19er, 66.2ip) over his last 12 starts dating to July 23, eighth-best in the Majors (fourth-best in the NL) in that time... he's allowed one earned run or fewer in eight of those 12 outings... Verlander has a 3.18 FIP in this stretch, 12th-best in the Majors (eighth-best in the NL)...more recently, Verlander has a 1.78 ERA (7er, 35.1ip) with 31 strikeouts and an opponent's average against of .218 in his last six starts.

COMPARE & CONTRAST: Nearly every pitch in Verlander's arsenal was hit hard last time out...Cardinals' hitters went 4-for-7 with two XBH off his four-seamer, 2-for-7 off his slider (both doubles), 2-for-2 off his curveball and 1-for-2 off his changeup...over his five starts leading up to his last outing vs. St. Louis, batters were 8-for-44 (.182) off his fastball, 6-for-31 (.194) off his slider, 5-for-14 (.357) off his curve, 0-for-15 off the sweeper and 1-for-8 (.125) off the changeup.

START ME UP: Is slated to make his 29th start of the season today, his most in a season since his 2019 Cy Young season with Houston when he made 34 starts...the last Major Leaguer 42 years of age (or older) to make at least 29 starts in a season was R.A. Dickey in 2017 for the Braves.

LEFT ON READ: Verlander has three wins in 2025 but has been in line for seven others upon leaving the mound this year only to see them fall by the wayside...the most recent of those was in St. Louis earlier this month...in Verlander's starts this year, the bullpen has a 3.92 ERA with nine blown saves...in all other games combined, the unit has a 3.36 ERA with 13 blown saves.

A WINDOW IN TIME: Verlander's 265 wins are 36th-most in AL/NL history according to *Elias...he needs one victory to tie Bob Feller and Eppa Rixey, who are tied at 34th with 266 wins*.

VS. COLORADO: Is facing the Rockies for a second time this season...his other outing against them came here at Oracle Park on May 1 when he allowed just two runs on five hits in 6.1 innings while striking out four in his 85-pitch effort...today's outing marks his eighth career start overall vs. the Rockies...he helped guide his team to victory in each of his first four career starts against the Rockies but his teams are winless in his last three outings against them dating to 2018 (one start apiece with Houston, the Mets and Giants).

HELP, PLZ: The 42-year-old has received 59 total runs of support in his 28 starts (3.64 run support average)...he's received three or fewer runs of support in 22 of his 28 starts this season...the Giants are 5-17 in those contests.

ALL-TIME STARTS: Is making his 555th career start today, which will give him sole possession of 27th-most all time in AL/NL history...he's currently tied with Eppa Rixey according to *Elias*.
