## AROUND THE HORN

**\$100 MILLION IN GIVING:** On March 9, the D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation celebrated earning a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations, in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

**HERE'S THE STORY: Ildemaro Vargas'** career-best 27-game hitting streak since Sept. 26, 2025 is MLB's longest active streak and tied for the second-longest streak (also: Trea Turner) since 2018, behind Whit Merrifield's 31-gamer (Sept. 10, 2018-April 10, 2019).

- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base 18 times in his last 9 games, hitting .448 (13-for-29)/1.219 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 5 walks (5 K).
  - Since April 21, ranks among top third basemen [min. 30 PA] in the Majors in OPS (1st, 1.219), OBP (1st, .529), SLG (1st, .690), runs (T-2nd, 8), AVG (2nd, .448), hits (3rd, 13) and total bases (6th, 20).
  - In his last 16 games, is hitting .370 (20-for-54)/1.083 OPS with 1 double, 5 homers, 15 RBI and 5 walks (9 K).
- **Jose Fernandez** has a 12-game on-base streak as a starter, hitting .348 (16-for-46)/.844 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 3 walks (8 K).
  - In his last 18 starts, is hitting .343 (24-for-70)/.798 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 3 walks.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 6-5 @ Cubs yesterday... were down 6-1 and scored 4 runs in the sixth inning.

- **Ildemaro Vargas** extended his career-best 27-game hit streak while reaching base a career-high-tying 5 times (4-for-4, RBI, BB).
- **Geraldo Perdomo** hit a 3-run homer (2) in the sixth inning to bring the D-backs to within 1 run.
- **Jorge Barrosa** went 2-for-4 with 2 doubles, including a RBI bunt double down the left field line...**Barrosa** is the first MLB player to record a RBI bunt double since 2023 (Michael Taylor/MIN on April 28, 2023) and just the second D-back ever with a bunt double (also: Gerardo Parra July 4, 2013).

**VARGY'S RECORD STREAK: Ildemaro Vargas'** 24-game hit streak to start a season is tied for MLB's second-longest streak since 1940 [source: Elias Sports Bureau]:

30 Ron LeFlore/DET April 17-May 27, 1976

**24 Ildemaro Vargas/AZ March 30-present**

- In the span, is hitting .404 (38-for-94)/1.131 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 triples, 6 homers (team high), 21 RBI (team high) and 4 walks.

**VARGAS' ROAD STREAK: Ildemaro Vargas'** 20-game road hitting streak since Sept. 8, 2025 is MLB's longest active streak and the franchise record.

- Is batting .380 (30-for-79)/.878 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 7 RBI and 4 walks during the span.

**A TALE OF 3 STREAKS: Ildemaro Vargas'** hitting streaks are etching their place in the D-backs record books:

- His 24-game hitting streak to start the season is the franchise record.
- His single-season 24-game hitting streak is tied for the second-longest in club history:

30 Luis Gonzalez 1999

**24 Ildemaro Vargas - Active**

24 Tony Womack 2000

- Including streaks spanning multiple seasons, his 27-game hit streak is the second-longest:

30 Luis Gonzalez April 11-May 18, 1999

**27 Ildemaro Vargas Sept. 26, 2025-present**

**VARGAS MEETS RUTH: Ildemaro Vargas** is the fourth MLB player in the last 40 years to record 35+ hits, 6+ homers, 6+ doubles, 2+ triples and 20+ RBI within their first 25 games of a season (previous 3: Jimmy Paredes/BAL in 2015, Carlos Beltrán/NYM in 2007 and Hubie Brooks/WSH in 1986)...since 1901, the feat has been met by 21 players, including Babe Ruth/NYY (1921), Lou Gehrig/NYY (1927), Stan Musial/STL (1948) and Ted Williams/BOS (1955) and Willie Mays/SF (1958).

**PRODUCING AT THE BOTTOM:** Since April 13, the D-backs' 7-9 hitters in the lineup rank among MLB leaders in combined SLG (1st, .512), extra-base hits (1st, 21), RBI (1st, 34), homers (2nd, 9) and OPS (3rd, .828).

**ROAD SNAKES: Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in 14 of his last 15 road games (12 H, 12 BB)/.375 OBP with 1 double, 2 homers and 6 RBI.

- **Adrian Del Castillo** has reached base in 9 of his last 10 road games (10 H, 2 BB) with 1 double, 2 homers and 9 RBI.
- **Jose Fernandez** has reached base in 10 of his last 11 road starts, hitting .295 (13-for-44) with 2 doubles and 4 RBI.

**VS. LEFTIES: Corbin Carroll** is hitting .462 (18-for-39)/1.295 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 triples, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 3 walks.

- **Ketel Marte** is hitting .333 (11-for-33)/.765 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 RBI and 2 walks.
- **Jose Fernandez** is hitting .364 (8-for-21)/.800 OPS with 1 double, 3 RBI and 1 walk.

**DAY SNAKE BITES: Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in 12 day games at a .429 clip (21-for-49)/1.084 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 7 RBI and 2 walks, including multi-hits in 3 straight games.

- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base in 11 of his 14 day games, hitting .320 (16-for-50)/.994 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base 15 times in his last 12 day games (12 H, 3 BB)/.313 OBP with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 4 RBI.
- **Nolan Arenado** in his last 8 day games, is hitting .321 (9-for-28)/.333 OBP with 2 RBI and 1 walk.

**VS. CUBS:** Are 3-3 @ Wrigley Field since 2024.
