THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 13
2022 - The Astros beat the Nats in Washington by a score of 6-1, extending their win streak to 11 games...**LHP Framer Valdez** (1ER/7.2IP) dominates in the outing, while **2B Jose Altuve** hits a leadoff homer...the streak, which ended the following day, fell one win shy of the club record...the win also gives manager **Dusty Baker** his 2,009th managerial win, which moved him past **Leo Durocher** (2,008) for 10th on the all-time manager win list.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will continue their homestand tonight in the third game of a four-game series against the rival Seattle Mariners... Astros starter **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.**, a veteran of nine Major League seasons, enters tonight's game with 898 career strikeouts and is looking to become the 15th pitcher in franchise history to reach 900 career strikeouts...he'll be opposed by the Texas native **RHP Bryce Miller**, who's returning from the IL today to make his 2026 debut.

LANCE VS. THE M'S: **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** is set to make his eighth start of the season and his second against the Mariners, also April 11 at SEA (4.1IP)...McCullers has gone 10-3 in 21 career starts against the Mariners and also faced them once in the postseason, in Game 3 of the 2022 ALDS, in which McCullers tossed 6.0 shutout innings in the Astros 1-0 win in 18 innings.

FIGHTIN' AGGIES: The Astros will face off tonight against Texas A&M Aggie **RHP Bryce Miller**, who pitched three years at A&M (2019-21) before being selected by the Mariners in the fourth round of the 2021 draft...notably, the Astros **SS Braden Shewmake** also played three seasons at A&M (2017-19) and was a teammate of Millers in the 2019 season...the 2019 Aggies made it to the finals of the Morgantown Regional, losing to Duke, a team that featured Astros **OF Joey Loperfido**.

VS. SEATTLE: The Astros and Mariners are playing their second series of the 2026 season this week in Houston and will not see each other again until August...tonight, the Astros are looking to snap a nine-game losing streak to Seattle, which spans back to September of 2025.

ON THE RADIO: The Astros radio broadcast for the Mariners series will feature **Robert Ford** and **Kevin Eschenfelder** on SportsTalk 790...the Spanish broadcast can be heard on TUDN 102.9 FM with **Francisco Romero** and **Alex Treviño** on the call.

ABOUT THE SKIPPER: Astros manager **Joe Espada** has 191 career managerial victories which ties him with **Harry Craft** (1962-64) for 12th in franchise history...the two immediately trail **Jimmy Williams** (215) for 11th on that all-time list.

FRIDAY'S FASHION SHOW: The annual Astros Foundation's Champions for Healthy Families Luncheon & Fashion Show will take place on Friday beginning at 11 a.m. in Union Station at Daikin Park...the models of the fashion show will be wives and girlfriends of Astros players and coaches...the goal of the event is to impact and promote healthy families in support the Astros Foundation and a variety of local nonprofits...media availabilities will be held at 11:30 a.m. in the Atrium and media is invited to gather b-roll of the fashion show beginning at approximately 12 p.m...media wishing to cover the event must RSVP with **Rachel Caton** at rcaton@astros.com.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros dropped a 10-2 game to the Mariners last night...tied 2-2 after the 3rd, the Mariners jumped ahead in the 4th on a grand slam off Astros starter **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (4IP)...the Astros offense had five hits on the night, include a 2x4 night by **SS Braden Shewmake** (RBI).

THE ORDER: The Astros have used 43 different batting orders in their 43 games in 2026...only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (second), while **1B Christian Walker** has played in every game (42 starts).

AIR YORDAN: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is batting .308 (49x159) with 10 doubles, 13 HR, 29 RBI and a 1.029 OPS (.413 OBP/.616 SLG)...in the AL, he ranks tied for first in total bases (98), tied for first in extra-base hits (23), tied for third in hits, tied for third in homers, tied for third in RBI, fourth in OPS, fourth in SLG, fifth in batting average, and sixth in OBP.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has 355 career extra-base hits, which ties him with **3B Doug Rader** for 10th in extra-base hits in Astros franchise history...the two immediately trail **1B Bob Watson** (410) for ninth on that all-time list.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: With 238 career homers as a second baseman, **Jose Altuve** needs one more to tie **Lou Whitaker** for seventh place all-time in MLB history among second basemen...Altuve also needs two RBI to become the fifth player in franchise history to reach 900.

THE SHEW FITS: **SS Braden Shewmake** went 2x4 with an RBI last night, which extended his current hitting streak to a career-long seven games...Shewmake has hit .357 (10x28) with three homers and a 1.036 OPS in 12 games since being acquired by the Astros in a trade from the Yankees on April 19.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** is hitting .303 (23x76) in his last 20 games (since April 20) with five homers and 12 RBI...among AL players this season, Walker ranks sixth in extra-base hits (19), seventh in total bases (80), seventh in SLG (.516), and tied for seventh in RBI (28).

GUN 'EM DOWN: In just 20 games, **C Christian Vázquez** has thrown out nine baserunners attempting to steal (in 24 attempts), which ranks tied for first in the AL and tied for third in the Majors.

STARS DOWN IN CORPUS: **SS Jeremy Peña** (right hamstring strain), **CF Jake Meyers** (right oblique strain) and **LHP Josh Hader** (left biceps tendinitis) all played on rehab assignments for Double A Corpus Christi last night...Peña went 1x2 with a double and a HBP...Hader pitched 1.0 inning, allowing 1 hit with a strikeout, but faced the minimum due to a caught stealing...Meyers went 0x4.

HADER'S HEART RESCHEDULED: **LHP Josh Hader** had a group from **Covenant House** scheduled to take part in his **Hader's Heart** program today, but that experience has been rescheduled to a date in June.

LAST START, 5/6 vs. LAD: Worked 2.2 innings, allowing 6 runs on 4 hits with 3 walks and 4 strikeouts (70 pitches-39 strikes)...retired 6 of the first 8 batters he faced to open the start prior to an injury to the fingernail on his right index finger...marked his shortest start of the season and the 1st in which he did not complete at least 4.0 innings.

APPROACHING 900: Enters tonight start with 898 career strikeouts and is looking to become the 15th pitcher in Astros history to record 900 strikeouts with the club...is set to make his 154th career appearance today, and would become the 1st pitcher in Astros history to record 900 career strikeouts within their first 154 career appearances.

THE REPERTOIRE: Has thrown his cutter at a 25.9-percent rate, the highest of any of his pitches this season...prior to this season, the highest rate he had thrown his cutter was at 9.0 percent in 2022...has also held hitters to a .167 average (4x24) with his sweeper, which he's thrown at a 16.3-percent rate.

VS. SEA: including the postseason, has gone 10-3 with a 3.29 ERA (44ER/120.1IP), 140 strikeouts (10.47 SO/9IP) and a .209 opponent batting average through 22 career starts vs. the Mariners, including 10 quality starts...his 22 starts vs. the Mariners (including the postseason) are the 3rd-most among active players, behind former teammate **RHP Justin Verlander** (41) and **LHP Martín Pérez** (27)...his 10.47 SO/9IP vs. the Mariners ranks 1st all-time (min. 120 IP, incl. postseason), with **LHP Andrew Heaney** the next-closest at 9.56 SO/9IP...has faced the Mariners once this season, allowing 6 runs on 5 hits with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts, not factoring into the decision in an 8-7 Astros loss on April 11 at T-Mobile Park.

GROUNDING: Is one of the game's elite groundball pitchers...his 55.0 ground-ball percentage ranks 3rd in the Majors among active pitchers since 2015 (min. 700 IP)...trails only **LHP Framber Valdez** (62.1%) and **RHP Logan Webb** (58.0%).

SEASON DEBUT: Had a spectacular debut to his 2026 season, striking out 9 over 7.0 innings while allowing just 1 run on 4 hits with 1 walk (96 pitches-63 strikes) on March 30 vs. BOS...was his longest start since also tossing 7.0 innings on Sept. 21, 2022 at TB...was his longest start while allowing 1-or-fewer runs since allowing 1 run through 7.0 innings on July 16, 2021 at CWS...was his longest start in a season debut in his 9-year MLB career and were his most strikeouts in a season debut since striking out 10 batters on March 31, 2018 at TEX...is also tied for the longest start by an Astro this season.

2025 RECAP: Made his return to the mound after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...worked around four IL stints to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP through 16 games (13 starts)...made his season debut on May 4 at CWS, marking his first appearance on a Major League mound since Game 3 of the 2022 World Series in Philadelphia, a span of 915 days...logged his 50th career win on June 3 at PIT...became the 23rd pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark.

ABOUT MCCULLERS JR.: The 2017 All-Star has made 152 apps. (146 starts) in 9 MLB seasons with Houston (2015-18, 2020-22, 2025-26), posting a 53-39 record with a 3.80 ERA (340ER/805.1IP) and 894 strikeouts (10.0 SO/9IP)...missed the 2019 and 2023-24 seasons due to injury.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/9 at CIN): Tossed 0.1 of a scoreless inning on Saturday at CIN, retiring the only hitter he faced (**Sal Stewart**) on 5 pitches (3 strikes).

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (1ER/5.1IP) in his last 5 games dating back to April 24...within that span, picked up his 1st win of the season on May 3 at BOS after he allowed 1 hit and 1 walk with 1 strikeout in 2.0 scoreless innings...was his longest outing of the season...prior to this hot streak, posted a 14.73 ERA (12ER/7.1IP) in his first 9 games of the season.

VS. SEA: Has struck out 52 batters through 36.1 innings in 34 career appearances vs. the Mariners, holding an impressive 12.88 SO/9IP with a 3.47 ERA (14ER/36.1IP)...has the most strikeouts among active relievers against Seattle with 52...has held **C Cal Raleigh** to a 2x10 mark with 6 strikeouts in their career matchups.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...currently has 342.1 IP, with **RHP Xavier Hernandez** next on the all-time list at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (468) and 7th in apps. (331).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: Is 2.0 innings from matching **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for the 4th-most innings pitched by a reliever in Daikin Park history...is also 4 strikeouts from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most strikeouts by a reliever in Daikin Park history.

CAREER: In 331 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.89 ERA (110ER/342.1P) with 468 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, 12.30 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
